Sewer Repair Work on Sumac Street

Dear Resident,

Sanitary sewer repair work will be happening on Sumac Street between Stewart Avenue and Butternut Avenue beginning the week of January 20 and lasting approximately three weeks.

The City of Saint Paul is working with a contractor (ECI) to repair a sanitary sewer tunnel. *See attached map for project area and road closures.*

How this impacts you:

- Sumac Street will be closed to traffic from the alley to Butternut Avenue.
- Sumac Street will be closed to thru traffic at Stewart Avenue. Butternut Avenue will be closed to thru traffic at Bay Street. Local traffic will be allowed.
- Access to private driveways and alleys will be maintained.
- No parking signs may be posted near the construction site. Please follow all posted signs.
- Sidewalks in the construction area on Sumac Street will be closed. Please follow all posted signs.
- Snow removal on Sumac Street from Stewart Avenue to Butternut Avenue will be done by the contractor.

What is the cost?

There is no cost to property owners for the sewer work.
