Water Street Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project in 2023 and 2024

Dear Saint Paul Resident or Business:

In early June 2023, a contractor working for the City of Saint Paul (Minger Construction) will begin construction on the Water Street Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project. This is a 2-year project and includes reconstruction of sanitary sewer lines, constructing a new lift station, and some watermain reconstruction. *Please see back of this letter for project location map.*

In 2023 construction will occur at the intersection of Wabasha Street and Plato Boulevard, on Plato Boulevard west of Wabasha Street, and along the west side of the Farwell Yards and 115 Plato Blvd W development sites between Water Street and Plato Boulevard (vacated Moses Street). In 2024 construction areas include portions of Water Street and along the development sites.

How this impacts you:

- Traffic lane closures and detours will occur. Please follow all posted signs.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained, but alternative routes may be used. Temporary interruptions in access may occur.
- Sewer service will be maintained during construction.
- Temporary water services will be installed during some construction phases.
- Harriet Island access will be maintained, but temporary interruptions in access may occur.
- Trail detours will occur to maintain access.

Additional information will be provided about access, road closures, and construction impacts as needed.
