



2023 SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

What is happening?

Sidewalk improvements, including curb and pedestrian ramps, are starting soon! Expect some disturbance to surrounding grass boulevards and lawns.

When is it happening?

Demolition of existing sidewalk will begin **within seven (7) days** of this notice. Improvements are expected to be completed within three weeks. Timelines are dependent on weather, the contractor's schedule, and the extent of work taking place.

What should you do?

Remove all personal property from the City's right of way. Personal property includes, but is not limited to furnishings, plantings/planters, irrigation, and fencing. All remaining items in conflict with sidewalk improvement work will be removed and disposed of by the City contractor.

Please be mindful of posted parking restrictions. All vehicles must be moved off impacted streets and driveways to enable safe and efficient construction operations. Properties will be notified the day of driveway-apron removals so vehicles parked in driveways or garages can be relocated.

How will the sidewalk improvement work impact you?

Street parking in front of homes/businesses will be prohibited where construction is underway. Access to the public sidewalk from your front entrance may also be restricted. If your driveway-apron is replaced, you will not be able to access your driveway for five (5) days after concrete has been poured and cured. Please relocate vehicles from driveways and garages beforehand.

Keep in mind:

Please remember to observe posted parking restrictions to avoid being towed. One end of an alley will remain open if alley driveway-aprons are replaced.
