PAYMENT INFORMATION

If you are paying for your permit by *American Express, Discover, MasterCard or Visa*, you may fax your application to our office. Our fax number is 651-266-9124.

Effective April 3, 2021, a 2.49% service fee will be charged for all credit or debit card transactions and will appear as a separate transaction on your card statement. This fee is charged by the service provider the Department of Safety and Inspections uses to process credit card transactions. These fees are paid directly to the vendor; the city does not receive any of these fees.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PERMIT FEE CALCULATION (Effective: February 25, 2023)

Gas or Oil Burner

Each burner: \$85.00 for the 1st 100,000 BTU per hour input or fraction thereof, plus \$15.00 for each additional 100,000 BTU per hour input or fraction thereof. Maximum fee for each individual burner, regardless of input, is \$1,007.00. Where dual fuel installations are made, the maximum combined permit fee shall not exceed \$1,830.00.

State surcharge is a flat \$1.00 per **<u>permit</u>**, not burner.

Steam/Hydronic, Solar Hydronic, Refrigeration and Process Piping Systems

Fee is one percent of the total valuation of the work. Value of work must include the cost of installation, alteration, addition, and repairs including heat transfer units, accessories to the heating or refrigeration system, including pipe, fittings and all labor, materials, and equipment necessary for installation. In addition, it shall include all materials supplied by other sources when these materials are normally supplied by contractor. Minimum fee is \$85.00.

The state surcharge is based on the valuation of the job: \$1.00 to \$1,000.00 is \$0.50.

\$1,001.00 and up is 0.0005 times the value of the job.

Factory Fireplaces and Stoves

The fee for factory-built fireplaces, fireplace inserts, and stoves is \$85.00 per unit. Please indicate if the unit is gas or solid fuel fired in the area provided on the form.

State surcharge is a flat \$1.00 per **permit** not per fireplace or stove.

Tank Installation and Tank Removal Permits

All permanent tank installations, tank removals, abandoning above or underground shall be permitted through the City of Saint Paul Department of Safety and Inspections/Fire Safety Division.

However, if the tank is for fuel oil to a heating plant, (boilers or other heating devices) the permit from the Fire Division is applicable only for the tank and piping up to the first valve. The remaining piping from the first valve up to and including the heating appliance will require a separate mechanical permit.
