


- Veit & Company, Inc. is currently working on pouring new storm sewer structures at the intersection of Minnesota Street and 4th Street. The crew is also installing piping between storm structures that are being constructed.
- The crew is working on the removal of the existing concrete road section as well as existing sidewalks at Minnesota Street between Kellogg Blvd. and 4th Street.
- Additional removal work took place between 4th Street and 5th Street for the installation of new storm sewer structures and piping.
- Pavers were removed at the Minnesota Street and 4th Street Intersection for upcoming concrete walk.
- Watermain installation was completed and the testing of the watermain took place on 7/20/2023.
- Several private utilities companies performed work on the project relocating their utility to allow for future project upgrades. These relocations are taking place at Minnesota Street between 4th Street and 5th Street. There are also relocations taking place at the 5th Street and 6th Street intersections.

- Veit & Company, Inc. will continue storm sewer installation at Minnesota Street and 4th Street as well as Minnesota Street between 4th Street and 5th Street.
- Veits street crew will start to grade and shape Minnesota Street between Kellogg Blvd. and 4th Street in preparation for new curb and gutter
- Curb and gutter will be installed at Minnesota Street between Kellogg Blvd. and 4th Street. Concrete paving may also take place if time allows.
- Watermain installation will take place on Minnesota Street between 4th Street and 6th Street. This night work will require a water shut-down. The watermain shut down is anticipated to take place on July 27th. Affected businesses will be notified with the hours of the shut down.
- Private utility work will continue on the project at Minnesota Street between 4th Street and 6th Street.
- Minnesota Street is closed to through traffic but will remain open to local business and parking ramps. We do not anticipate major changes to traffic control on the project. Access to businesses and parking ramps will remain the same.
