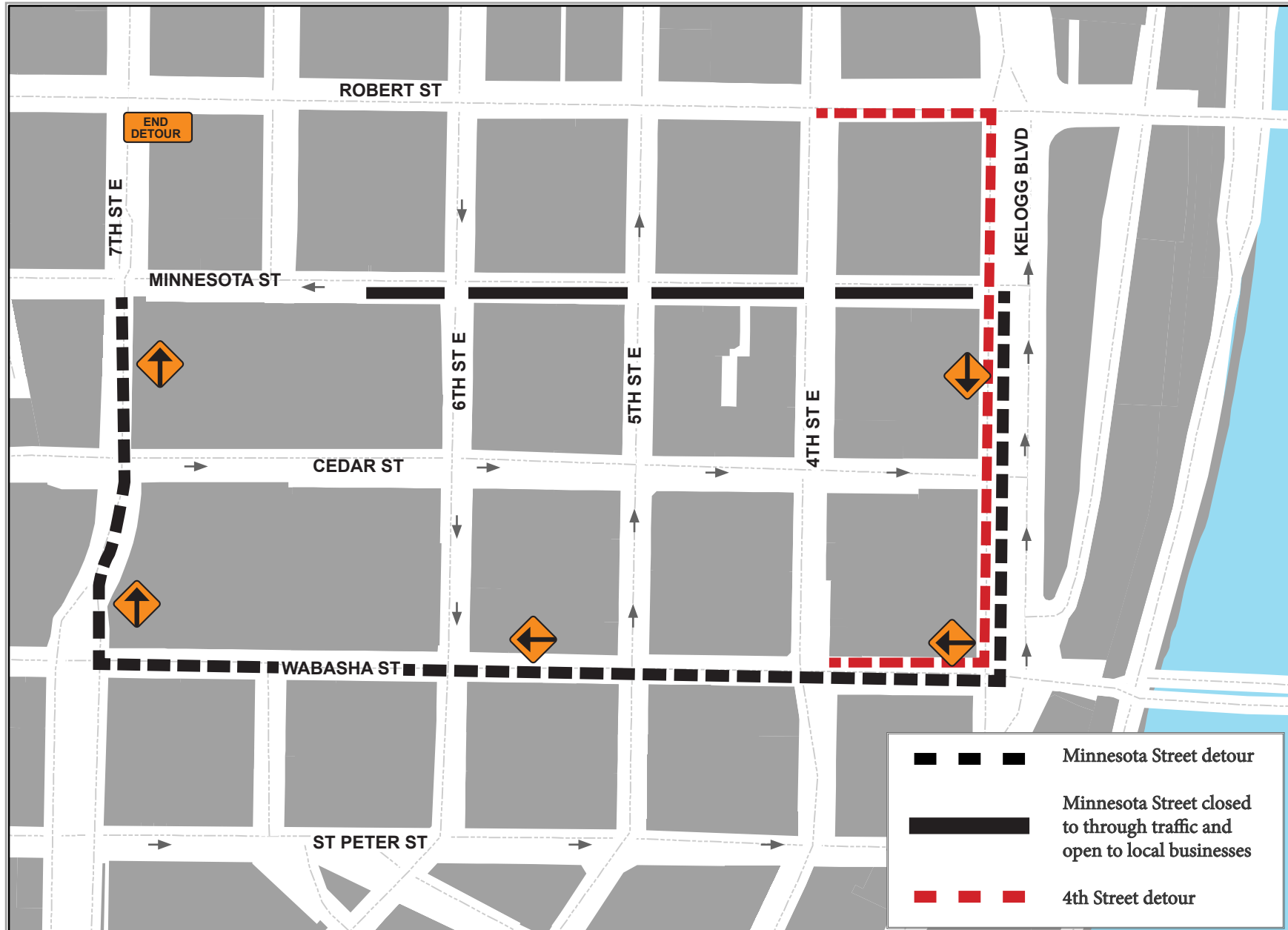

What's Happening?

- Veit & Company, Inc. continued to work on various removals of concrete and bituminous throughout the project.
- The crew excavated for the installation of watermain at Minnesota Street from Kellogg Boulevard to 4th Street.
- Bituminous Roadways (sub-contractor to Veit) pipe bursted the existing watermain to allow for a new watermain on Minnesota Street between Kellogg Boulevard and 4th Street.
- Additional signage was placed on the project to assist motorists with direction on how to traverse the project.
- Several private utilities companies performed work on the project relocating their utility to allow for future project upgrades. These relocations are taking place at Minnesota Street between 4th Street and 5th Street. There are also relocations taking place at the 5th Street and 6th Street intersections.

What's to Expect

- Veit & Company, Inc. will continue watermain installation at Minnesota Street between Kellogg Boulevard and 4th Street. The crew will also install storm sewer at the intersection of Minnesota Street and 4th Street. Veits street crew will start to grade and shape Minnesota Street between Kellogg Boulevard and 4h Street in preparation for new curb and gutter.
- Private utility work will continue on the project at Minnesota Street between 4th Street and 6th Street.
- Minnesota Street is closed to through traffic but will remain open to local business and parking ramps. We do not anticipate major changes to traffic control on the project. Access to businesses and parking ramps will remain the same.
