Intersection improvements at Minnehaha Avenue and Pierce Butler Route Construction starts September 5

The City of Saint Paul Department of Public Works will be reconstructing the intersection and traffic signal at Minnehaha Avenue and Pierce Butler Route. Construction is scheduled to start on September 5, 2023.

What are the benefits of the project?

- Improved signal operations.
- Bumpout added to improve pedestrian safety and crossing of Minnehaha Avenue at Pierce Butler Route.
- Bike lane on the east side of Pierce Butler Route will continue to Minnehaha Avenue.

When is it happening?

Construction is scheduled to start Tuesday, September 5 and be completed by the end of October 2023.

How will travel be impacted during construction?

- Minnehaha Avenue will be open to traffic.
- Pierce Butler Route will be closed to traffic from Minnehaha Avenue to Grotto Street.
- The posted detour will be Minnehaha Avenue to Victoria Street to Pierce Butler Route.
- Local traffic only on Grotto Street and Avon Street.

How is the project funded?

There is no cost to property owners.
