SAINT PAUL CITY COUNCIL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING 1-4 Unit Housing Study - Phase 2 Zoning Amendments

The Saint Paul City Council will hold a public hearing on proposed Zoning Code and Zoning Map amendments as well as other changes to the Legislative Code regarding additional zoning flexibility to support greater housing diversity in residential zoning districts on Wednesday, October 4, 2023, at 3:30 p.m.

Proposed amendments include new residential zoning districts H1 and H2 to replace existing one-family districts (R1, R2, R3, R4), two-family districts (RT1), townhouse districts (RT2), and lower-density Planned Development districts (PD) with new dimensional standards regulating lot area, height, setbacks, and lot coverage and updates to the dimensional standards for the semirural RL one-family large lot residential district and to standards related to accessory dwelling units, accessory buildings, cluster developments, subdivision regulations, site access, and building and fence design.
