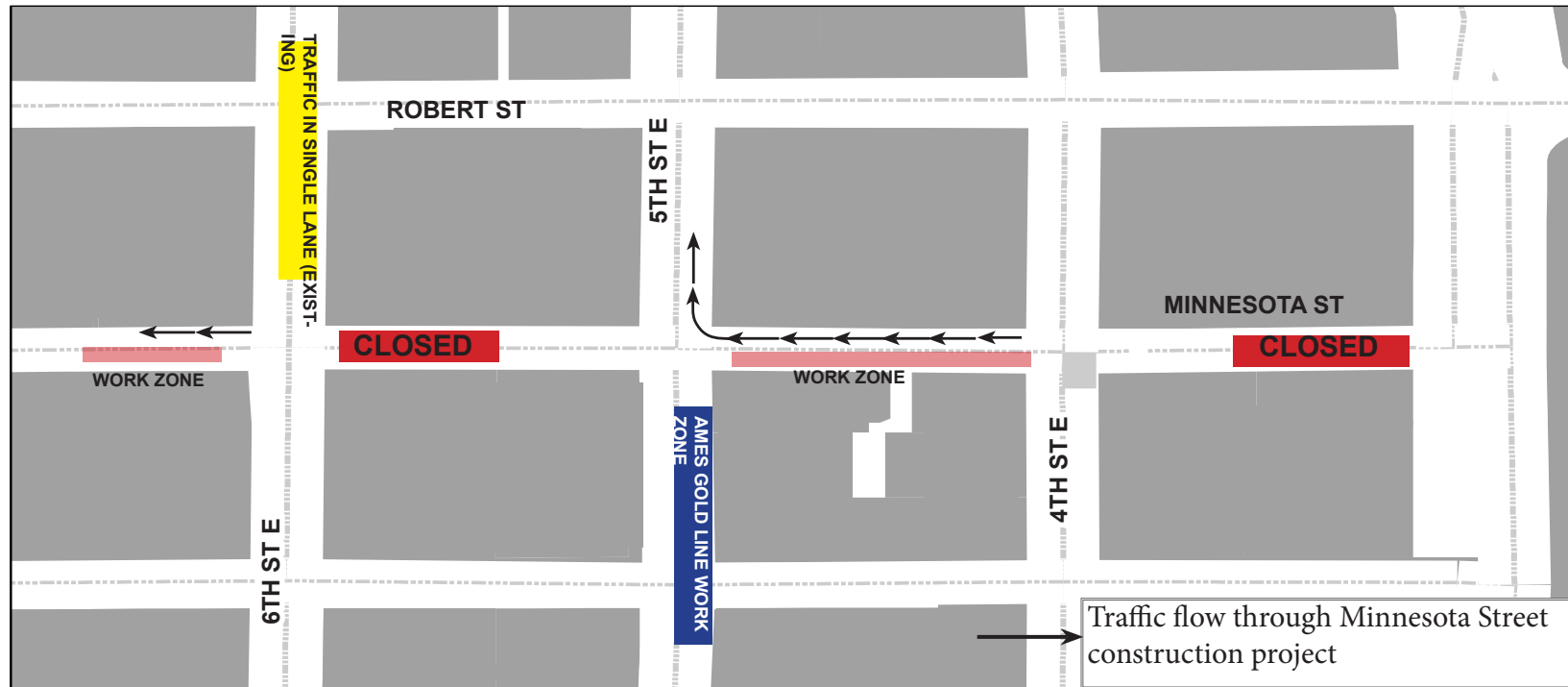








Access to local businesses on Minnesota Street

What's Happening?

- Veit & Company utility crews are installing storm structure (BMP's).
- Veit & Company will continue lining manholes at Minnesota Street between Kellogg Blvd. and 6th Street.
- Curb Masters is pouring misc. concrete sidewalk at Minnesota Street between 4th Street and 5th Street.
- Private utility work will continue on the project at Minnesota Street between 5th Street and 6th Street.
- Signal work will continue at the intersection of Minnesota and 5th Street and 6th Street.

What's to Expect

- Veit & Company utility crews will complete the installation of storm structure (BMP's)
- Veit & Company will complete the lining of manholes at Minnesota Street between Kellogg Blvd. and 6th Street.
- Curb Masters will pour concrete sidewalk at all open areas on Minnesota Street between Kellogg Blvd. and 6th Street.
- Curb Masters will finish curb and gutter at all open areas at Minnesota Street between Kellogg Blvd. and 6th Street.
- The new bituminous trail will be paved at the west side of Minnesota Street between Kellogg Blvd and 6th Street.
- Signal work will continue at the intersection of Minnesota and 5th Street and 6th Street.
- Please understand that there may be times during deliveries of materials to the project and during construction activities that access may be temporarily blocked. The contractor will make sure that these disruptions are infrequent and a very short duration. The contractor will also notify businesses when these occurrences take place.
- We very much appreciate your patience during the construction of Minnesota Street we understand that construction can be an inconvenience.
