2024 New Sidewalk on Burns Avenue and Suburban Avenue

Dear Saint Paul Property Owner or Current Resident,

The City of Saint Paul is working to improve the streets in your neighborhood. In 2024, Public Works will be constructing new sidewalk and pedestrian ramps on the south side of Suburban Avenue and Burns Avenue between White Bear Avenue and McKnight Road.

Location of project work:

- New sidewalk on south side of Suburban Avenue between White Bear Avenue and Burns Avenue
- New sidewalk on south side of Burns Avenue between Suburban Avenue and McKnight Road
- Intersection improvement at Suburban Avenue and Burns Avenue
- Intersection improvement at Ruth Street and Burns Avenue

What you need to do prior to construction in 2024:

- Remove any personal property, plantings, or sprinkler systems in the boulevard near pedestrian improvements as they may be impacted by construction. These items will not be replaced by the city.
- A flyer will be placed on your door if sidewalk or other pedestrian improvement work is happening adjacent to or near your property.
- The street will have temporary closures or lane restrictions during operations. We will try to maintain access to driveways, but there may be temporary access restrictions.
- Please notify tenants/renters/visitors about the project and any parking restrictions.

Property owners:

Once the sidewalk is installed, property owners are responsible for maintenance of the sidewalk adjacent to their property.

How the project is funded:

The project is federally funded. There are no assessments for property owners.
