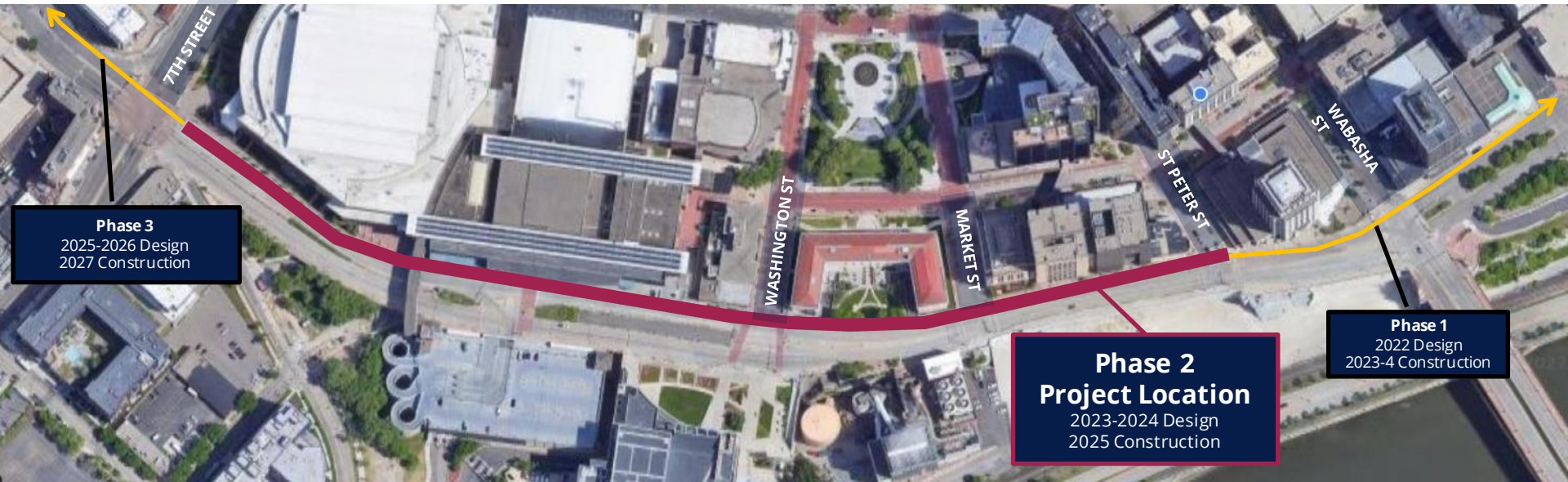
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Project Purpose and Location

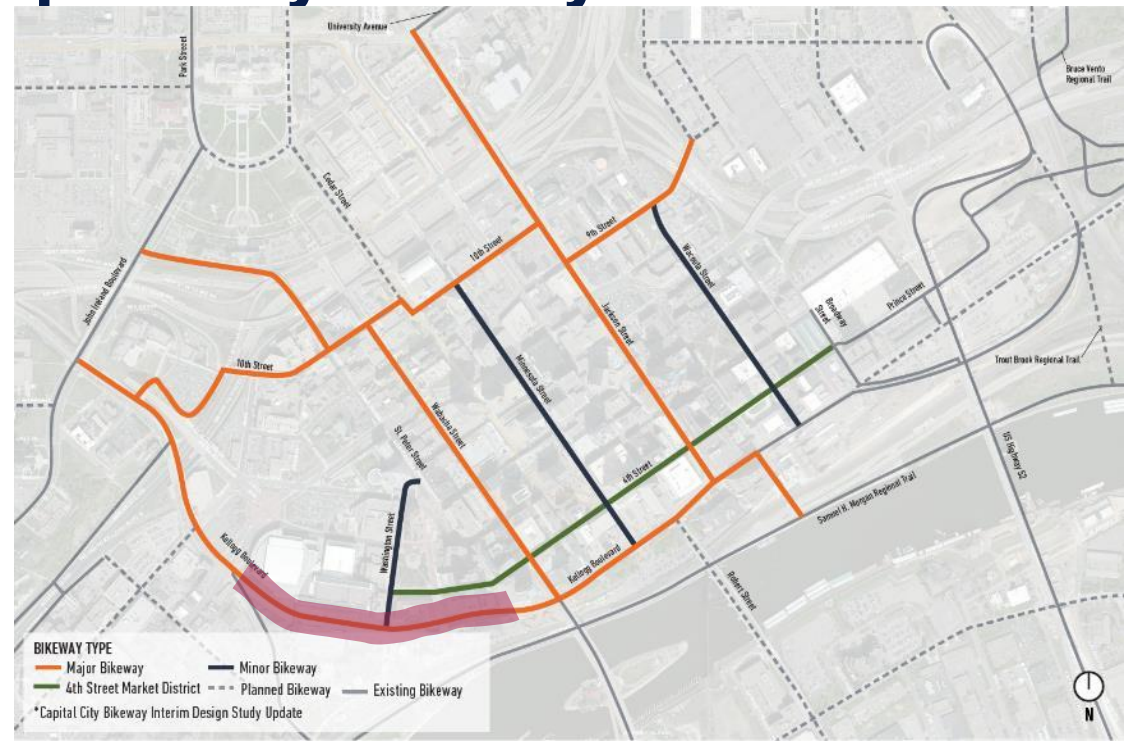
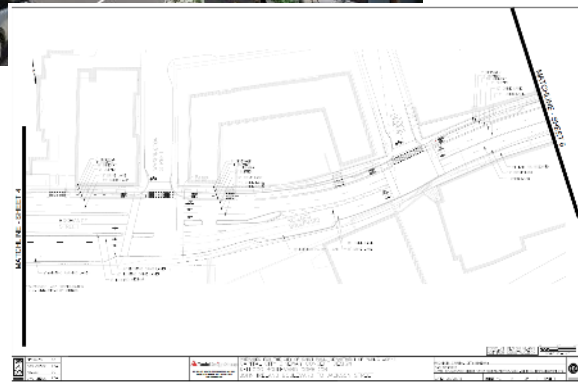
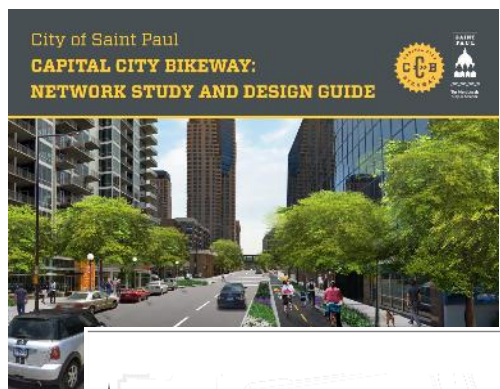

- Support future increase of density and reorientation of downtown towards the river

 - » RiverCentre Parking Ramp
 - » River Balcony
 - » Riverview Corridor
- Be compatible with event center operations as an economic engine of downtown
- Be compatible with Eastbound Kellogg Bridge at RiverCentre
- Be compatible with the Riverview Corridor

Design Concept



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
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Corridor Design Parameters

- The bikeway needs to be on the north side of Kellogg at sidewalk-level (consistent with Phase 1)
- Exchange Street will still exist
- Design will be compatible with EB Kellogg Bridge design
- Historic property designation impacts realm of possibilities and creates a very constrained existing sidewalk at Market Street
- Drop-off zone on Kellogg and westbound access to parking ramp outside RiverCentre needs to be maintained. These features create a very constrained pedestrian and bicycle environment at River Centre front entrance
- Travel patterns by all modes are unique during events (dismount zone, rerouted traffic, etc.)
- Streetcar would be in mixed traffic and station locations are to be determined
- 4 lane undivided cross-section is undesirable for all modes

Project Timeline

- Spring 2024: Finalize Concept
- Summer – Fall/Winter 2024: Final Engineering
- Early 2025: Bidding
- Spring/Summer/Fall 2025: Construction
 - ***Construction timing and staging to be coordinated with Eastbound Kellogg Bridge***
