Capital City Bikeway Phase 2 Kellogg Boulevard Project



Project Details

Description

The City of Saint Paul will be constructing a portion of the Capital City Bikeway along Kellogg Boulevard from St. Peter Street to West 7th Street in 2025. The bikeway will be constructed on the north side of Kellogg Boulevard linking Saint Paul RiverCentre, George Latimer Central Library, the Xcel Energy Center, and the Science Museum of Minnesota. The Capital City Bikeway is a vital connection to important destinations in downtown Saint Paul.

The City's goals for Kellogg Boulevard include:

- Make the Capital City Bikeway connection
- Be compatible with event operations as an economic engine of downtown
- Create a welcoming pedestrian event experience and environment
- Be compatible with Eastbound Kellogg Bridge at RiverCentre
- Be compatible with the Riverview Corridor


- February 2024: Kellogg CCB Pop Up Event
