


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## **Project Overview**

Full reconstruction of Grand Avenue in 2 phases:

- Phase 1: 2024 Fairview Avenue to Cambridge Street, including the Fairview and Cambridge intersections
- Phase 2: 2025 Cambridge Street to Snelling Avenue, including the Snelling intersection

# Project Improvements

- New street pavement
- Replacement of concrete curb and gutter
- Pedestrian improvements
  - $\circ$  New sidewalk
  - ADA-compliant pedestrian crossings
  - Center pedestrian refuge at Cambridge Street
  - Upgraded pedestrian crossing through Macalester College
- Sewer and water main pipelines
- Storm sewer drains
- Street lighting
- Traffic signals
- Replant trees

# **Construction Timeline & Other Projects**

- Spring or early Summer 2024
  - Tree removals may be in both Phase 1 & 2 areas
  - Utility work (water, Xcel, Comcast) may be in both Phase 1 & 2 areas
- Summer and Fall 2024
  - Full construction of Phase 1 from Fairview Avenue to Cambridge Street, including the intersections
  - Closure of Grand Avenue to vehicles
- Other constructions projects in area
  - <u>Hidden River Middle School</u> summer 2024 to fall 2025
  - <u>Snelling Avenue (MnDOT)</u>
    - Grand Avenue to St Clair Avenue mid-July through August 2024
    - Montreal Avenue to Ford Parkway spring through summer 2024
  - Macalester College 2026

\*Construction timelines are tentative and subject to change. More information will be shared as it is available.

# **Detours & Access to Grand Avenue**

- Grand Avenue will be closed to thru vehicle traffic between Fairview Avenue and Snelling Avenue
  - Local vehicle traffic between Cambridge Street and Snelling Avenue will be allowed in 2024
- Thru vehicle traffic will be officially signed and detoured to Summit Avenue
  - Metro Transit bus route 63 will be detoured; currently Summit Avenue
- Pedestrian access on Grand Avenue will be maintained, but limited at times
- Access to businesses and properties will be maintained
  - Coordinate deliveries and other access needs with project staff
- Parking on Grand Avenue will not be available during construction
- Anticipate parking and increased traffic on neighborhood streets
- Access routes will change during construction. Follow all signs
- Alleys in the area were pothole patched in March 2024 in anticipation of this project work





#### **Road Closed to Thru Traffic**

You can get to your business or home, but you cannot get all the way through. You will eventually come to a **Road Closed** sign.

### **Construction Impacts**

- Construction is dusty, noise, and inconvenient
- Your street will be dug up numerous times
- The work is done in layers and often by different crews doing different types of work
- Parking on Grand Avenue will be impacted during construction
- Project will coordinate with properties for access







### **Temporary Water Mains & Water Connection**



- 2" PVC pipe laid on edge of sidewalk
- Water connected to properties through outside spigot
- Notification of temporary water will be posted on front door
- Staff will need to access the water meter inside the building twice, once during install and once to uninstall
- Temporary water may become warm during the summer
- No cost for temporary water



# **Preparing for Construction**

- Remove items in the boulevard space or along your building on the sidewalk, such as sprinklers, benches, signage, planters, plantings to keep, etc.
- Notify Public Works if you have areaways or vaults (areas that extend from the basement of your building under the sidewalk)
- Notify customers, clients, employees, visitors, and others about the upcoming construction
- Look for additional mailings about replacement of your private sewer and water service lines. Please inspect your utilities and coordinate any work with the project.

## **General Project Assessment Information**

- Street reconstruction project funded by:
  - New 1% city sales tax
  - Municipal State Aid
  - Assessments to abutting property owners
- Estimated assessment project rate has not yet been determined and will be determined through a special benefit analysis before the project starts
- Property owners will receive a letter with the estimated assessment rate and notice of a public hearing before the project starts
- Property owners are assessed after the construction project is complete
