



Kellogg Boulevard spring construction begins in April

Beginning April 8 (with minor daytime impacts starting April 3), reconstruction work will resume on Kellogg Boulevard between St. Peter Street and Jackson Street as part of the Capital City Bikeway project, with primary impacts between St. Peter Street and Cedar Street. This project includes the addition of a new two-way separated bikeway, sidewalk, roadway, and center medians. It will also include improvements to drainage, underground utilities, traffic signals, lighting, and replacement of the median trees. Expect this work to impact traffic for approximately two months, separated into two phases. Additional cleanup and restoration work, which may include lane closures, is anticipated to last until mid-summer.

Phase 1 - April: Intersection of Wabasha Street and Kellogg Boulevard

Wabasha Street will be closed on the north side of the Kellogg Boulevard intersection. Northbound traffic on Wabasha will be able to turn both left (westbound) and right (eastbound) onto Kellogg Boulevard. Intermittent lane closures will reduce eastbound and westbound Kellogg Boulevard to one lane each direction through the Wabasha intersection. Please follow the signed detour routes for northbound Wabasha. Expect congestion on Wabasha Street between Fillmore Avenue and Kellogg Boulevard and on Kellogg Boulevard near the intersection of Wabasha Street and Kellogg Boulevard. Sidewalks in the area will be impacted, please follow posted pedestrian signage. This impact will be approximately one month.

Phase 2 - May: Kellogg Boulevard Lane Closures

Wabasha Street on the north side of Kellogg Boulevard will reopen to traffic. Kellogg Boulevard traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction between St. Peter Street and Cedar Street. This impact will be approximately one month.
