
NEW BRIDGE DESIGN - PROJECT LIMITS





NEW BRIDGE DESIGN - DECK LAYOUT

- Barrier-protected 12 foot wide shared-use trail on each side
- Two vehicle lanes in each direction
- Taller concrete beams (longer spans)






NEW BRIDGE DESIGN – ART & AESTHETICS

Above (on the bridge deck)

 Custom railing sections, with artistic designs inspired by public participation, will add interest and cast dynamic shadows on bridge sidewalks.






Below (under the bridge)

 Subtle patterns, cast into the concrete bridge supports, will evoke the Lakota theme of "Kapemni", a mirroring symbol reflecting intertwining and balance in the universe.


