#### 2025 DOWNTOWN SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

The City of Saint Paul is making sidewalk improvements in downtown this summer. Sidewalk improvements include:

- Replacement of existing concrete with new concrete
- Installation of ADA pedestrian ramps
- Repair and replacement of brick pavers
- Sidewalk grinding to level and even out surfaces

#### What is happening?

Sidewalk improvements, including brick replacement, concrete grinding, curb, and pedestrian ramps, are starting soon. During construction expect sidewalk closures, temporary no parking signs, possible lane and road closures, and some disturbance to the adjacent area. Access to buildings, parking lots, and driveways will be maintained.

### Where is it happening?

### When is it happening?

Sidewalk work will begin **within seven (7) days** of this notice. Improvements are expected to be completed within three weeks. Timelines are dependent on weather, the contractor's schedule, and the extent of work taking place.

#### What should you do?

Remove all personal property from the city's right of way. Personal property includes, but is not limited to sidewalk cafes, furnishings, plantings/planters, signs, and fencing. Any remaining items in conflict with sidewalk improvement work will be removed and disposed of by the contractor.

Please be mindful of posted parking and/or lane restrictions.
