# **Rondo Streets Study**

March / April Engagement Summary



## **Study Overview**

The City of Saint Paul is developing a community-led vision for street improvements within the Rondo neighborhood and adjacent areas. As part of the City's commitment to the Rondo neighborhood to have the vision for street improvements reflect the needs and wants of Rondo residents, the City is partnering with Community Based Organizations (CBOs) such as the J.K. Movement and 825 Arts, as well as District Councils to facilitate engagement with a diverse and representative audience. Information about the study is also being shared with community members through other CBOs.

Engagement during Phase I of the study is intended to collect feedback from community members on their vision for travel throughout the neighborhood. Below is a summary of engagement conducted during March and April 2025. The list below does not include one-on-one coordination meetings with CBO and District Council staff for upcoming events.
