**Citywide Sewer Work: 9th Street
July 2025**

Dear Saint Paul Resident or Property Owner:

The Saint Paul Public Works Sewer Utility is working with a contractor (Minger Construction) to repair a sanitary sewer at the intersection of 9th and Sibley. *See the map on the backside of this letter for details.*

The sewer repair work will begin July 10th. Anticipate repairs (including surface restoration) will be completed within a two week duration (as weather allows).

How this impacts you:

- 9th street will be closed from Sibley Street to Wacouta Street.
- Signs will be posted near the construction site. Please follow all posted signs.
- There will be no impacts to your sewer service.

What is the cost?

There is no cost to property owners for the sewer repair work.

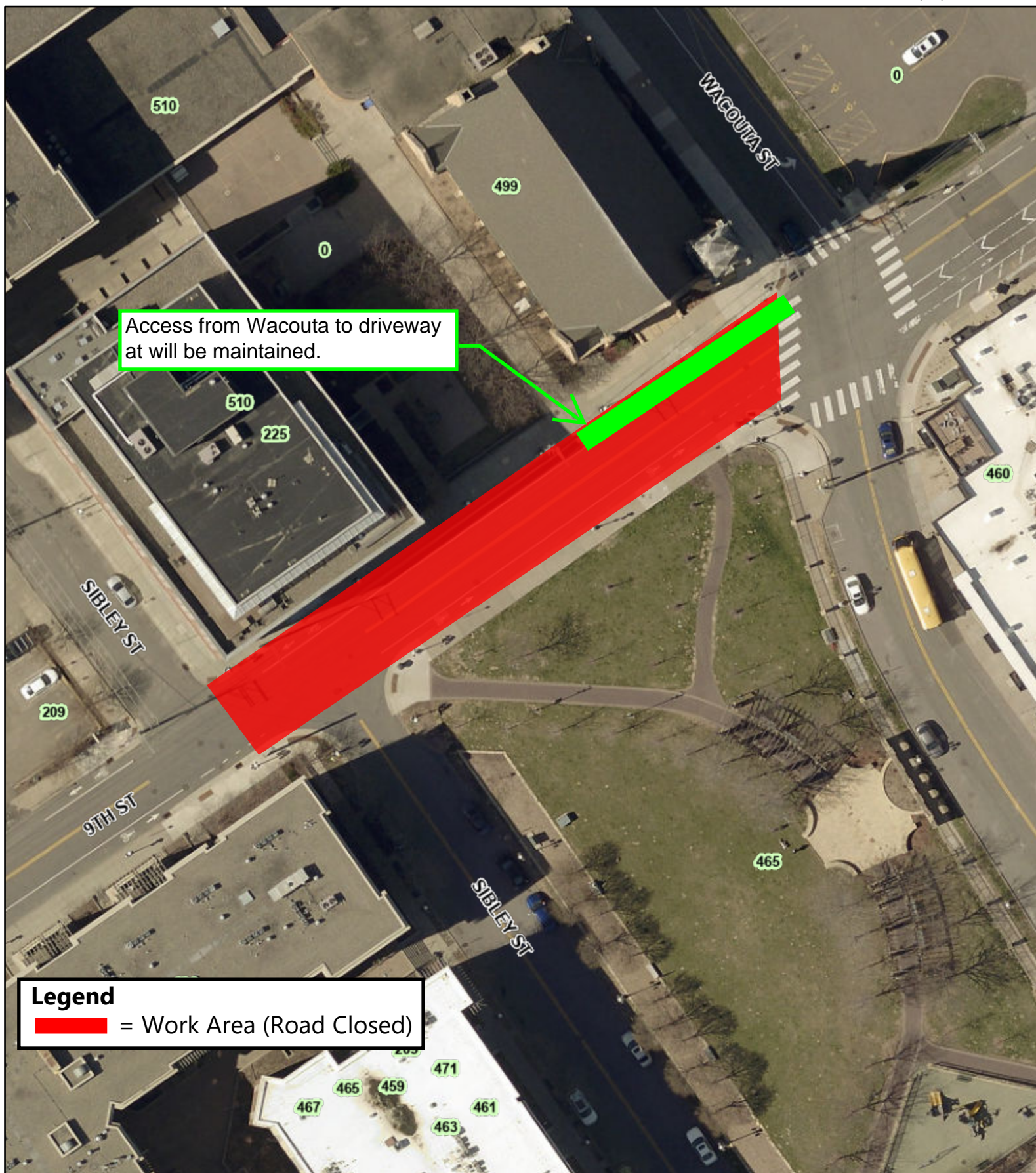
