





Cannabis and Lower-Potency Hemp Edible Business Owner Worksheet

Thank you for your interest in starting a cannabis or lower-potency hemp edible business in Saint Paul. After you receive your preliminary approval from the Office of Cannabis Management, you will need to obtain Zoning, Building Code, and Fire Code approval from the City of Saint Paul. The following provides you guidance on achieving these approvals.

Submission Requirements to Obtain City Review and Approvals

Zoning approval

City review will require submission of the following:

- Business location address
- Current uses at the location
- All proposed uses at the business location
- Building square footage of each use
- Distance from schools (retail uses only)
- * The City's regulatory reviews will be based on these indicated licenses and endorsements. Be aware, any additional ones which you request in the future will require new regulatory reviews. If you are thinking about additional licenses or endorsements in the future, you are encouraged to request all those in your proposal to the City for review.

** Check with Metropolitan Council on any SAC Requirements

Building and Fire Code approval**

Building Plan approval:

- City review requires submission of plans (with square footage of the uses) by a designer or designer of record if you will be completing any of the following:
 - Change of use of the business location
 - Any new building construction or expansion
 - Adding new doors, walls, or other items impacting people flow within the property

Building Permits:

• City review on permits requires submitting a list of all additions, expansions, and changes to the building and any building system(s), including square footage of the uses

Once you have assembled all the required information/plans for your business, you can bring them to 375 Jackson Street, Suite 220 (between 8:00am-4:00pm), or you can submit your zoning information by emailing to <u>DSI-ZoningReview@ci.stpaul.mn.us</u> and submit your building/fire code information/plans online <u>https://www.stpaul.gov/</u> <u>departments/safety-inspections/building-and-construction</u>.
