The City of Saint Paul is expanding the Wabasha Street bikeway and we want to hear from you.




The project will expand the Wabasha Street bikeway, connecting it to the existing protected bicycle lanes on 10th Street before crossing Interstate 94 to connect with the Capitol grounds and the existing bikeway. The bikeway will continue to John Ireland Boulevard and the planned bikeway on Rice Street.

Project Goals

- Connect downtown bikeway users across the interstate to the Capitol grounds.
- Reconstruct Wabasha Street from 7th Street to 11th Street to improve pavement quality, upgrade underground utilities, and enhance drainage.
- Create a safer, more accessible environment for all users including those who walk, bike, roll, use transit, or drive.
- Support downtown vibrancy with trees and sustainably maintained pedestrian amenities.
- Enhance access to and visibility for streetlevel businesses
