OVERTIME

Overtime rate of one and one-half (1.5) the basic hourly rate shall be paid for work performed under the following circumstances:

Time worked in excess of eight (8) hours in a normal work day;

Time worked in excess of forty (40) hours in any seven (7) day period; and

Time worked on Saturday

All work performed on Sunday shall be compensated at double time

Overtime hours worked as provided by Article 8 of the Labor Agreement shall be paid on the paycheck or in compensatory time. The default method of payment shall be paid on the paycheck unless compensatory time is requested by the Employee and approved solely by the authority of the Employer.

CALL IN/CALL BACK

Employees called in or called back shall receive a minimum of four (4) hours straight time pay at the basic hourly rate or shall be compensated in accordance with Article 8 (Overtime), when applicable whichever is greater.
