
ACCEPTED ITEMS FOR A FEE:

Items with Costs: General refuse, household construction and demolition, scrap metal and concrete will be charged by the size of your load. If you only have bulky items or items that require special handling (listed here) you will be charged for those only. *If you have a mixed load, you'll be charged for both.*


General Refuse, Construction & Demolition

- 
- Refuse and demolition debris, scrap metal, concrete
 - \$10** – Car Load
 - \$15-20** – Pickup / Van
 - \$15-20** – Trailer
 - \$30 +** – Large Box Truck

Electronics

- 
- \$8 per item*** TVs, DVDs, VCRs, Stereos, Computer Equipment, etc.
 - *No charge for small items (cell phones, accessories and cords)*

Tires

- 
- \$3** – Per Car Tire
 - \$5** – Per Truck Tire
 - \$10** – Per Tractor Tire

Appliances

- \$10** – Dehumidifiers, Microwaves, Stoves, Refrigerators, Washers, Dryers, Water Heaters
 - \$20** – Air Conditioners


Upholstered Furniture

- \$5** – Chair
 - \$7** – Love Seat
 - \$10** – Couch/Futon
 - \$15** – Mattress/Box Spring Each (All Sizes)
 - \$20** – Hide-a-Bed
