Business growth

- Saint Paul has added on average more than 175 new businesses each year since 2007



Population growth

- 6.1% population increase in Saint Paul from 2010-2016



Private sector job growth

- 2013 to 2016 downtown private sector job increase = 5.4%
- 2013 to 2016 citywide private sector job increase = 4.9%
- By 2020, Saint Paul is projected to have more employed residents than ever before
