What is Right Track?

Right Track connects Saint Paul youth with meaningful training, work and career exploration opportunities so they are better prepared to thrive in the workforce.

Right Track was launched in 2014 by Mayor Chris Coleman in collaboration with Saint Paul Public Schools and the Saint Paul Area Chamber of Commerce to establish a pipeline of career development opportunities for Saint Paul youth.

Right Track operates out of the City of Saint Paul Department of Parks and Recreation, building on the department's long history of providing summer jobs for Saint Paul youth.

Right Track Total Impact Numbers

2,028 youth participated in Right Track 207,722 hours worked \$2,488,150 in earned wages

608 youth worked 82,306 hours and earned \$618,538 in wages.

2015

609 youth worked 87,046 hours and earned \$762,362 in wages.

2016

811 youth worked 118,370 hours and earned \$1,107,250 in wages.
