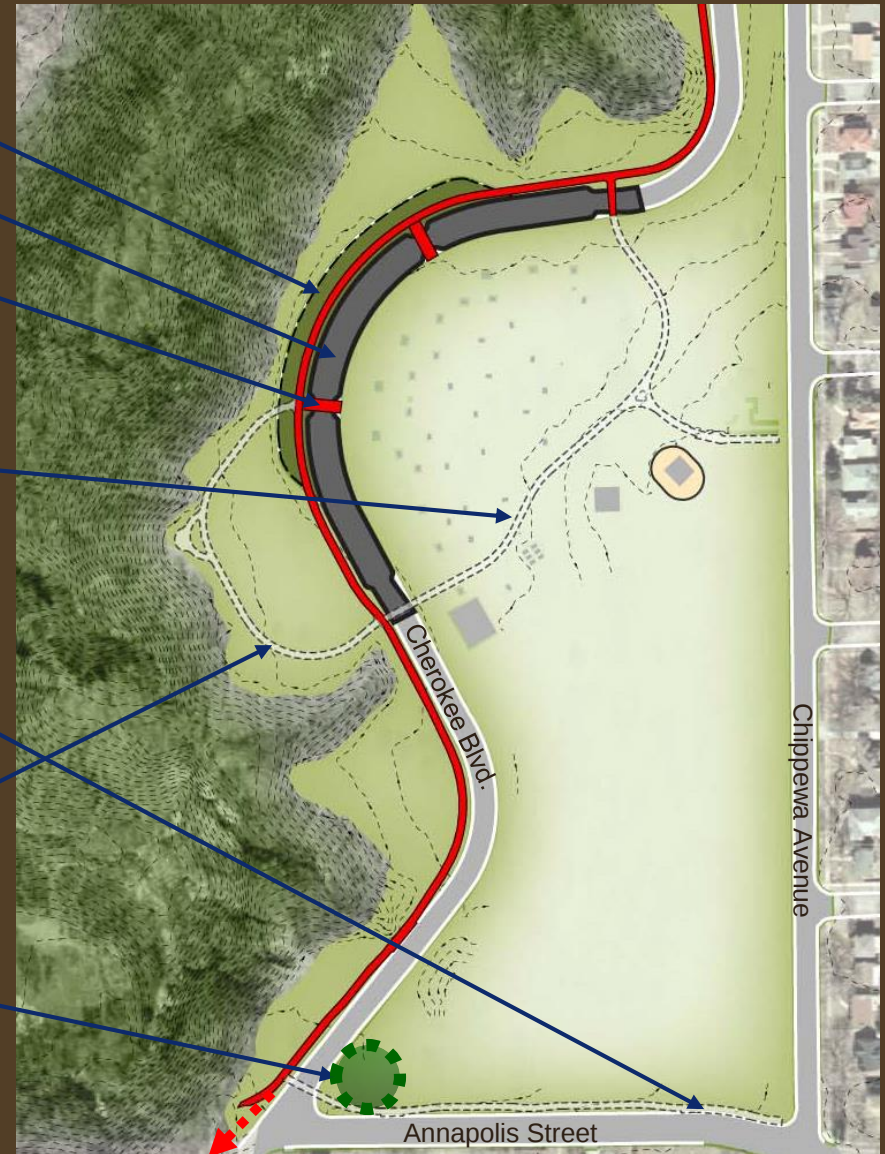

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Trail Segment along Cherokee Boulevard (2007)

- Remove existing parking lot
- Replace with on-road parallel parking
- Install traffic calming measures in conjunction with trail crossing
- Bid Alternate to provide internal trail connection to restrooms/drinking fountain
- Bid Alternate to provide trail connection along Annapolis Street
- Future overlook connection to Pickerel Lake
- Future trail enhancement to develop entrance gateway/signage at Annapolis and Cherokee Boulevard

Scope of Work:

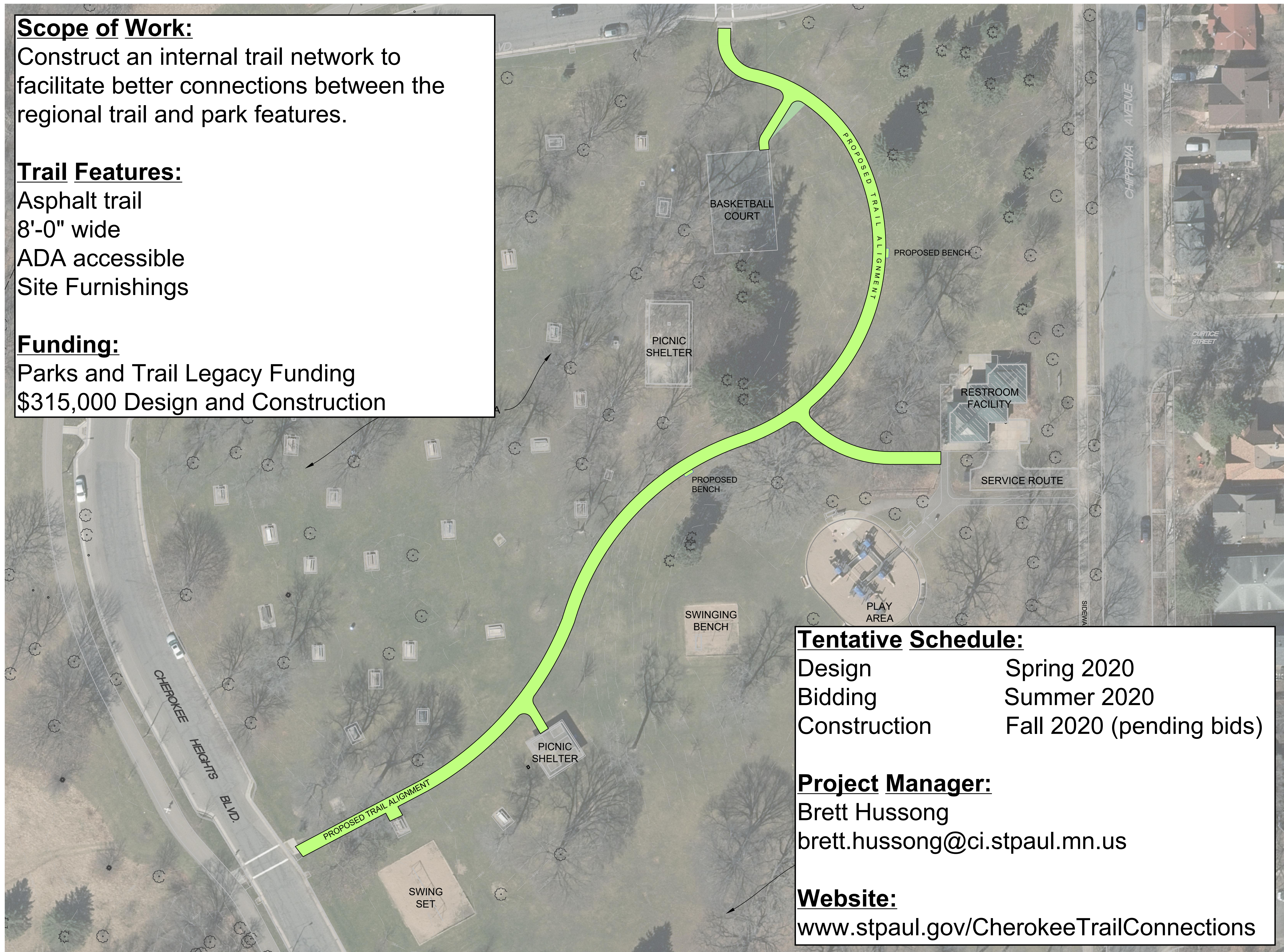
Construct an internal trail network to facilitate better connections between the regional trail and park features.

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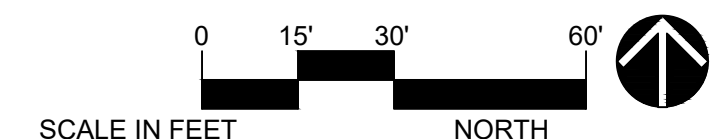

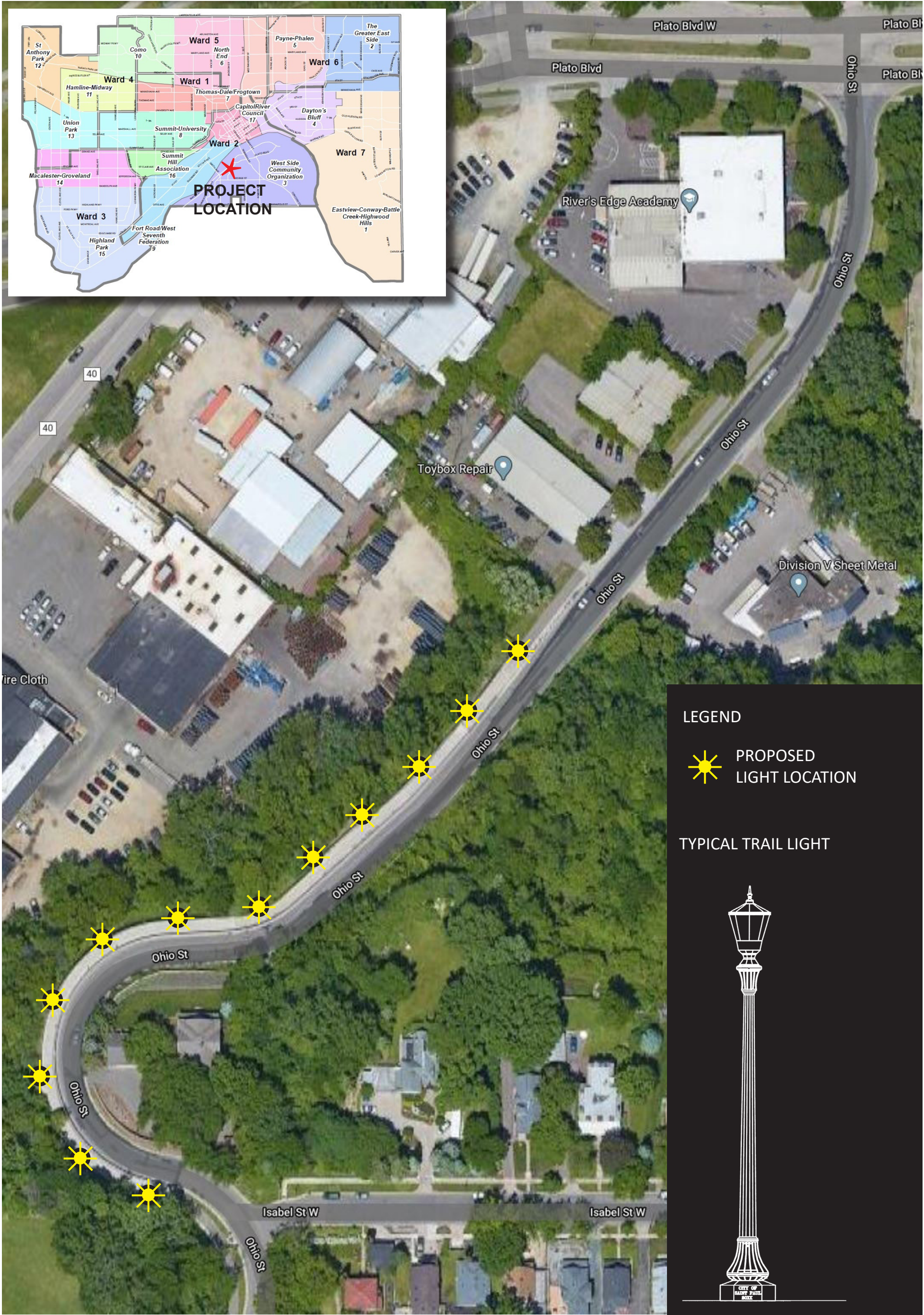
