- 1) Re-assess Ebuilder – look for new project management software
- 2) Develop 5 year plan with look back on previous investments
- 3) Update Systems Plan in conjunction with Comprehensive Plan
- 4) Train new staff on Racial Equity work
- 5) Provide services for extended hours and continue to respond to changing demographics
- 6) Explore role of Design Center within RiverFront Corporation
- 7) Explore lottery for annual permits
- 8) Explore paid parking
- 9) Clarify park rules and define boulevard versus parkway plantings
- 10) Expand on community engagement work; continual refinement
- 11) Citywide signage reflecting revised Rules and Park Information
- 12) Enhance collaboration with Great River Passage Division and explore ways to support
