**Site Furniture/ Play Equipment:**

- Consider more seating at center of play area
- Consider more group picnic seating
- Consider grills
- Consider swing benches
- Consider moving Wilder elf house
- Keep the fence parallel to Victoria
- Consider more above ground net structures
- Utilize slope to create a bridge play feature
- Incorporate a variety of log steps for 2-5 year old children
- Consider keeping cut logs and branches onsite for free play. Opportunity for inexpensive and temporary moveable elements; Potential fire hazard
- Contact recreational programming for moveable Katow/Volleyball post and nets
- Adam Buhr (TPL) to ask Landscape Structures about donating nature play element
- Sledding hill to remain
- Consider path lighting. Lighting was not included in original CIB budget.

**Public Art:**

- Potential opportunity for interactive energy
- Animal footprints
- Located at VanBuren Ave and Victoria St.
- Consider incorporating hidden elements throughout play area including frog engravings, or statues

**Plant Material:**

- Connect Orchard to future food forest to be location on top of bluff
- Opportunity for Frogtown Frog's to supply and plant orchard fruit trees
