City of Saint Paul Park Landscape Architects, Don Varney and Bianca Paz held an Open house to inform the community about the Master Plan Draft and planning process. Around 20 people stopped by and commented on the plan. The following is a summary of the written and oral comments and suggestions we received.

- The dog park area is too small. Prefer to be more than 1 acre.
- Most of the attendees supported the addition of active recreational programs
- A couple of people expressed concerns about having too much hard surface at the entrance of the park. They suggested keeping more green area at the entrance.
- Add a fishing spot with access to the river
- Add Zip line
- Add Skate board
- Overlook should be covered
