

PARQUE de CASTILLO



CONCEPT PLAN

The concept plan creates an active zone at the north side of the park with a new and enlarged play area. The play area separates play space per age group and for a bay of swings. A splashpad plaza is added for water play and to create a flexible entertainment space when the water features are turned off. A circular pathway facilitates circulation throughout the park and creates a shared community greenspace in the center of the park for gatherings. Entryways from Cesar Chavez are marked with plantings and gardens. Benches are added throughout the park and picnic area is located near the play area.

- Entry from Clinton Avenue - Path to relate to the crossing to fields
- Existing monument- Queen of the Wandering Races (Craig David)
- Proposed picnic space
- Splashpad Plaza
- Proposed garden
- Benches and drinking fountain location
- Benches around circular path
- Light Poles
- “Celebration Lawn” - a open flat lawn space to support gatherings, performances, yoga, etc.
- Existing stage platform to remain
- Existing shade trees to remain
- Proposed garden
- Proposed bike rack location
- Existing Castillo monument - remove tall plants around to open up sight lines
- Replace street trees and coordinate with Public Works on sidewalk repairs



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
