



RESOLUTION 16-08

Endorsing the proposal to name the new park, located within Ward 2, District 9, between Adrian Street and Shepard Road, west of Otto Ave and east of Montreal Way as “Quarry Farm Park”.

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission is an appointed body established to advise the Mayor and City Council on long-range and city-wide matters related to Parks and Recreation; and

WHEREAS, approximately 40 acres of land will be acquired by the City to be developed into a park located within Ward 2, District 9, between Adrian Street and Shepard Road, west of Otto Ave and east of Montreal Way; and

WHEREAS, the interim name for the site has been “Victoria Park” and refers to the master plan for the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the new park requires an officially recognized name that can be posted on its identity signage and used on City maps and location reference materials; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Road Federation has reviewed names according to the criteria set forth in the Parks Commission naming policy PC.9; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Road Federation is interested in changing the name to Quarry Farm Park; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission endorses the proposal to name the new park, located within Ward 2, District 9, between Adrian Street and Shepard Road, west of Otto Ave and east of Montreal Way as “Quarry Farm Park”.
