

**RESOLUTION # 17-12**

**Approval of the Donor Recognition Plan for the Sepak Takraw/Kato Court Project for City owned Duluth and Case Recreation Center within Ward 6, District 5, located at the northeast side of the park.**

WHEREAS, The Sepak Takraw/Kato Courts Campaign Committee, a partnership between the Saint Paul Parks Conservancy and the Sepak Takraw of USA, Inc., has established a fundraising campaign to raise funds for capital improvements to Duluth & Case Recreation Center with the goal of reaching \$100,000 in private funding; and

WHEREAS, the Committee proposes to recognize donations of \$10,000 or less in print and online for a temporary amount of time; and

WHEREAS, the donor recognition plan proposes that donations of \$5,000 and above may be recognized within the park with the names of donors displayed on proposed 12”x12” plaques within the park; and

WHEREAS, the donor recognition plan proposes that private donations of \$30,000 and over may have naming rights of one of a specific court and displayed with a plaque embedded in the ground; and

WHEREAS, as part of this project the city will consolidate all donor recognition currently present within park in order to simplify and minimize the quantity of donor recognition methods; and

WHEREAS, the plan proposes that signage is not guaranteed in perpetuity and that a maximum of up to 20 years is anticipated for the recognition of donors to this campaign; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Saint Paul Council hereby endorses the Donor Recognition Plan for the Sepak Takraw/Kato Court Project for City owned Duluth and Case Recreation Center within Ward 6, District 5, located at the northeast side of the park.
