

RESOLUTION # 18-10 Scheffer Recreation Center Name Change to Frogtown Community Center

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission ("Commission") is an appointed body established to advise the Mayor and City Council on long-range and city-wide matters related to Parks and Recreation; and

WHEREAS, A new community center is currently under construction at Scheffer Park and the new facility provides additional and improved programmatic opportunities and facilities for all ages, interests, and backgrounds to better suit the diverse community; and

WHEREAS, surveys of Scheffer Recreation Center building and park users suggested that the name of the facility be changed to Frogtown Community Center to be more reflective of the neighborhood and would help the neighborhood create a fresh start and identity for the new facility; and

WHEREAS, the future activities hosted by the facility will be influenced by members of the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission Policy #7, Naming Parks and Recreation Sites, 2012 Update, provides criteria for naming of parks, and this recommendation complies with the spirit of the policy; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission recommends to the City Council that Scheffer Recreation Center be renamed to Frogtown Community Center.
