

RESOLUTION # 18-11
Parkland Diversion Behind 1400 Jackson Street

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission (“Commission”) is an appointed body established to advise the Mayor and City Council on long-range and city-wide matters related to the Department of Parks and Recreation; and

WHEREAS, Section 13.01.1 of the City Charter requires that the Commission review any diversion or disposal of park property and present a recommendation to the Saint Paul City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul (“City”) owns land with Parcel ID 19.29.22.43.0030 along L’Orient Street abutting 1400 Jackson Street, a landlocked parcel; and

WHEREAS, CenturyLink QC, on behalf of the owner of 1400 Jackson Street, is requesting that the City grant property rights over a portion of its parcel for installation of underground utility lines between the public right-of-way and the private parcel; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation has determined that the parkland may be diverted of for this purpose; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission concurs with the request to dispose of the parkland, in a manner that meets all requirements of the Saint Paul City Charter relating to disposal or diversion of parkland, to Advanced Shoring Company, and in accordance with City Charter Section 13.01.1 recommends approval by the Saint Paul City Council.
