YJ02 INTERN DRESS CODE POLICY

All Right Track – Youth Jobs 02 interns are expected to wear work appropriate attire to internship and training. Each internship site will have their own expectations regarding what is appropriate attire for work. Please check in with your supervisor right away to learn what is expected of you.

Some workplaces are more formal than others and some workplaces allow casual clothing (like jeans) on Fridays, but you should never be dressed more casually than your colleagues.

As with all Right Track policies, we expect you to also always follow whatever dress code is put in place by your employer.

GUIDELINES

- All employees must be clean and well-groomed. Grooming styles dictated by religion, culture, or ethnicity are not restricted.
- All clothes must be work appropriate. Clothes that are typical in workouts and outdoor activities are not allowed.
- All clothes must project professionalism. Clothes that are too revealing or inappropriate are not allowed.
- All clothes must be clean and in good shape. Discernible rips, tears or holes are not allowed.
- Interns must avoid clothes with offensive language or stamps on them.
- Clothing that reveals undergarments, mid-drifts, or exposes an excessive amount of skin is not allowed.
