Zoning Amendments

- Ryan is proposing single family homes in the F1 River District
- Ryan is proposing to rezone one F2 residential mixed low district block along Mississippi River Boulevard to F1 River Residential District
- Ryan is proposing changes to FAR, required land use mix requirements, and parking requirements



Zoning & Block # Map






Building Standard Amendments

- Ryan is proposing minor changes to landscape requirements and rooftop materials
- Ryan is proposing changes to car-share requirements and electric vehicle infrastructure requirements

Roadway Adjustments

• Ryan is proposing a slightly different street grid than originally proposed in the Master Plan
