I. Chair's Announcements

Commissioner Thao, the Commission's First Vice-Chair, chaired the meeting. A Nominations Committee has been formed; they will be working on a slate of officers for 2018.

NEW BUSINESS

#17-215-889 PDMC LLC Senior Living – Rezone from B2 Community Business to T2 Traditional Neighborhood. 739 Selby Avenue, between Grotto and St. Albans. (Tony Johnson, 651/266-6620)

Commissioner Ochs said that, in the T2 district, one of the themes is to ensure that there is improved parking or improved circulation. How can we ensure that the proposed development will maintain or improve circulation and off-street parking?

Tony Johnson, PED staff, said that the applicant is providing 96 parking spaces, which is way over the required minimum. This is allowed because they are providing the excess parking spaces in a structured parking facility.

Commissioner Ochs said that even though this is a rezoning case, his issue is with the ingress and egress to the parking facility using the alley as a maneuvering lane.

Mr. Johnson said that the intent of the design is to maintain the pedestrian orientation along Selby Avenue. The applicant did not want a curb cut on Selby to access their parking spaces. The amount of parking off of the alley is a zoning issue that could have been considered as a variance at the time of rezoning. Staff thought it was more appropriate to address this issue at site plan review, so that the traffic engineer would have ample time to determine whether parking access would have a significant impact on traffic conditions in the area.

<u>MOTION</u>: Commissioner Baker moved the Zoning Committee's recommendation to approve the rezoning. The motion carried unanimously on a voice vote.

#17-212-449 Halima Duale – Reestablishment of non-conforming use as a duplex. 1508 Van Buren Avenue, between Simpson and Asbury. (Josh Williams, 651/266-6659)

Josh Williams, PED staff, said that conditions #3 and #4 were included in the original staff recommendation for approval, but after speaking with DSI staff further, it was determined that these two conditions are not necessary. He noted that an amended staff report with those two recommended conditions deleted was submitted to the Zoning Committee. He stated that the intent of the conditions as originally proposed was to make sure that the structure was code compliant. After further discussions with DSI staff, he felt that previous inspections and those that would automatically be required for the work to convert the structure to a duplex were sufficient for that purpose.

<u>MOTION</u>: Commissioner Baker moved the Zoning Committee's recommendation to approve the reestablishment of legal nonconforming use subject to additional conditions. The motion carried unanimously on a voice vote.

Commissioner Baker announced the items on the agenda for the next Zoning Committee meeting on Thursday, January 4, 2018.

Applicants should attend the Site Plan Review Committee meeting.

At the Site Plan Review meeting, applicants will discuss their project's site plan with Saint Paul's Site Plan Review Committee. The Committee includes City staff from Zoning, Planning, Traffic, Sewers, Water, Public Works, Fire Inspections, Forestry, and Parks.

The purpose of the meeting is to coordinate Site Plan approval across City departments.

- Applicants are encouraged to bring the project's engineer, architect, and/or contractor to handle technical questions.
- Site plan application and documents were routed for City staff review prior to the meeting.
- City staff will provide comments and ask questions based on review of the site plan.
- At the end of the meeting a decision will be made whether the site plan can be approved as submitted or if revisions are required.
- City staff will document site plan comments in a letter to be emailed to the applicant.

Location and Parking:

The meeting room is at 375 Jackson Street on the 2nd floor, skyway level, to your left as you exit the elevator.

A few free parking spaces are available in the DSI visitor parking lot off of 6th Street at Jackson. On-street parking meters are also available. The closest parking ramp is on Jackson one block south between 4th and 5th Street.
