ACCESSIBLE CITY

Saint Paul has **free-flowing accessibility**. It is easy for people to get around downtown on foot, by bicycle, on public transit, or in a vehicle, and the city boasts a **multimodal freight hub** for shipments.

- Connected transportation system
- Interstates 94 and 35 intersect
- 11-mile Green Line light rail connecting the two downtowns and the University of Minnesota
- MSP international airport ranked among the top airports in North America, with direct flights to Tokyo, Amersterdam and London
- Regional airport serving corporate jets located less than 3 miles from downtown
