FACT SHEET: Great New Community Green Space

Allianz Field brings more than 20,000 square feet of new public space

The City of Saint Paul supports developments like Allianz Field to ensure our city works for our families, businesses, and cultural communities for years to come. Key to that vision are public spaces that bring neighbors together in our community.

As part of the new Allianz Field development, Minnesota United have built a new park that covers 28,000 square feet. The "Great Lawn," which sits on the north side of the stadium, facing University Avenue, includes more than 20,500 square feet of grass.

While Minnesota United will cover construction and maintenance for the new park, the City of Saint Paul has also invested in infrastructure and improvements to make the park accessible and enjoyable for all – including improved pedestrian facilities and benches throughout the park.

The grounds around Allianz Field also include 192 mature trees, including a number of trees native to the area like the multiple species of maple that can be found around the site. These trees, along with the grass on the Great Lawn, will be watered by the landmark new rainwater reuse system developed by the City of Saint Paul.

The new park, maintained by Minnesota United, will be open and accessible for community members year-round outside of selective closures for game days and other scheduled events.
