Robert Street in St. Paul

Robert St. from I-94 in downtown St. Paul to Annapolis St. in West St. Paul is in need of repair. The urban road averages 18,000 trips a day and serves businesses, freight haulers, commuters, schools and local residents through three distinct districts—downtown St. Paul, West Side Flats and West Side.

Summary of work

2020

- Make minor drainage repairs to the historic Robert St. Bridge
- Resurface Robert St. just south of the bridge, which will close for six weeks in summer 2020.

2022

- Replace Robert St. bridge deck over I-94 in downtown St. Paul
- Make minor repairs to Robert St. through downtown
- St. Paul

MnDOT, Ramsey County and the city of St. Paul will gather more information and proceed with a plan to repair the road in downtown St. Paul.

• Repair and resurface the Robert St. Flats bridge over the Union Pacific Railroad and at George St.

2025 or 2026

• Engage the West Side community to help develop a vision for the future of Robert St. This work will begin in 2025 or 2026.
