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# City Council resolution initiated the study in December 2015

- Resolution sprang from permit request earlier that year. The resolution noted concerns about:
  - Environment
  - Health
  - Safety
- Air quality monitoring results were of concern around this time as well led to year-long monitoring in 2106

#### **Community Forums**

- O City and Port Authority staff met with the Protect Our Riverfront Together (PORT) group in July 2016. This led to a plan for community forums. Concerns and questions raised at the forums provided direction for the study. Forum topics included:
  - Air Quality & Environment
  - Railroads & Emergency Management
  - Air Quality & Fugitive Dust
