## Transportation Committee Staff Report for Projects

**Project Name:** Capital City Bikeway Interim Design – 9<sup>th</sup> Street and 10<sup>th</sup> Street

**Geographic Scope:** 9<sup>th</sup> Street from Jackson Street to Broadway Street and 10<sup>th</sup> Street from Dorothy Day Place to Jackson Street

**Project Description:** Through the Capital City Bikeway Interim Design Study process a preferred alternative for the implementation of the interim Capital City Bikeway on 9<sup>th</sup> Street and 10<sup>th</sup> Street in downtown has been determined. This recommendation consists of adding a two-way separated bikeway on 10th Street between Dorothy Day Place and Jackson Street, and adding bike lanes on 9<sup>th</sup> Street between Jackson Street and the I-94 bridge. To accommodate the installation of bike facilities, removal of on-street parking is proposed on:

- Both sides of 10th Street between St. Peter Street and Cedar Street.
- The south side of 10th Street between Cedar Street and Jackson Street.
- The south side of 9th Street between Jackson Street and Wacouta Street.

In addition, 10th Street between Cedar Street and Jackson Street is proposed to be converted from two-way motor vehicle traffic to one-way (westbound) motor vehicle traffic.

**Project Stage & General Timeline:** The Interim Design Study for 9<sup>th</sup> Street/10<sup>th</sup> Street is complete and a preferred alternative for this segment of the Capital City Bikeway has been determined. With project approval it is anticipated the project will be implemented in the fall of 2020 concurrent with the downtown Saint Paul street resurfacing work.

**Cost & Primary Funding Source(s):** \$630,000. CIB and Parking Fund.
