Project Description: Public Works will be performing mill and overlays on the following streets in 2018:

Arlington Ave: Rice to Jackson, Forest St: Maryland to 7th, Franklin Ave: TH 280 to Pelham, Prior Ave: University to Minnehaha, Stryker Ave: Baker to Anapolis, Third St: Ruth to McKnight, Victoria St: Summit to St. Clair, Western Ave: Como to Front.

New bike facilities are proposed for installation on Arlington Ave, Forest St, and Western Ave with the scheduled mill and overlays. Reconfiguring the existing striping on Prior Ave is also proposed to reduce excess lane width.

Project Stage & General Timeline: Design/Approval. If approved, expected implementation in summer or fall 2018.
