

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

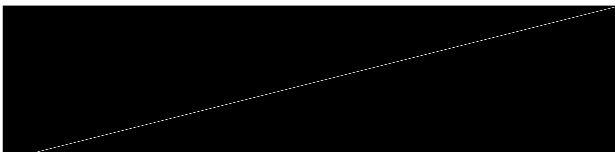


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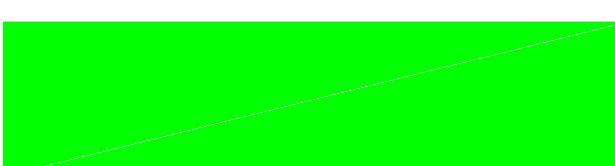

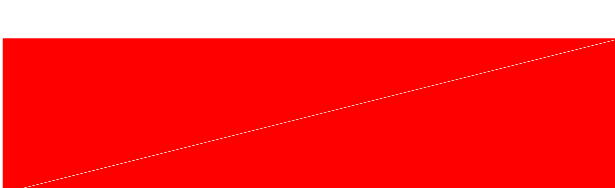
Western Ave Bike Lanes Concept

Existing parking to be maintained




Existing parking proposed for removal



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
