Rape

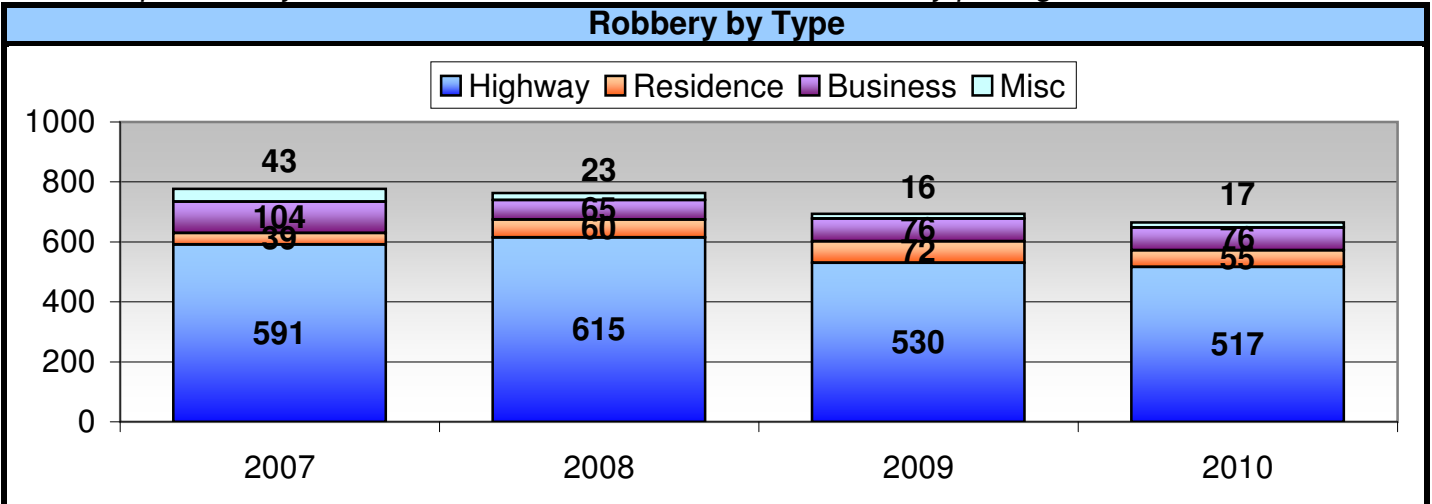
Definition: The carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will.

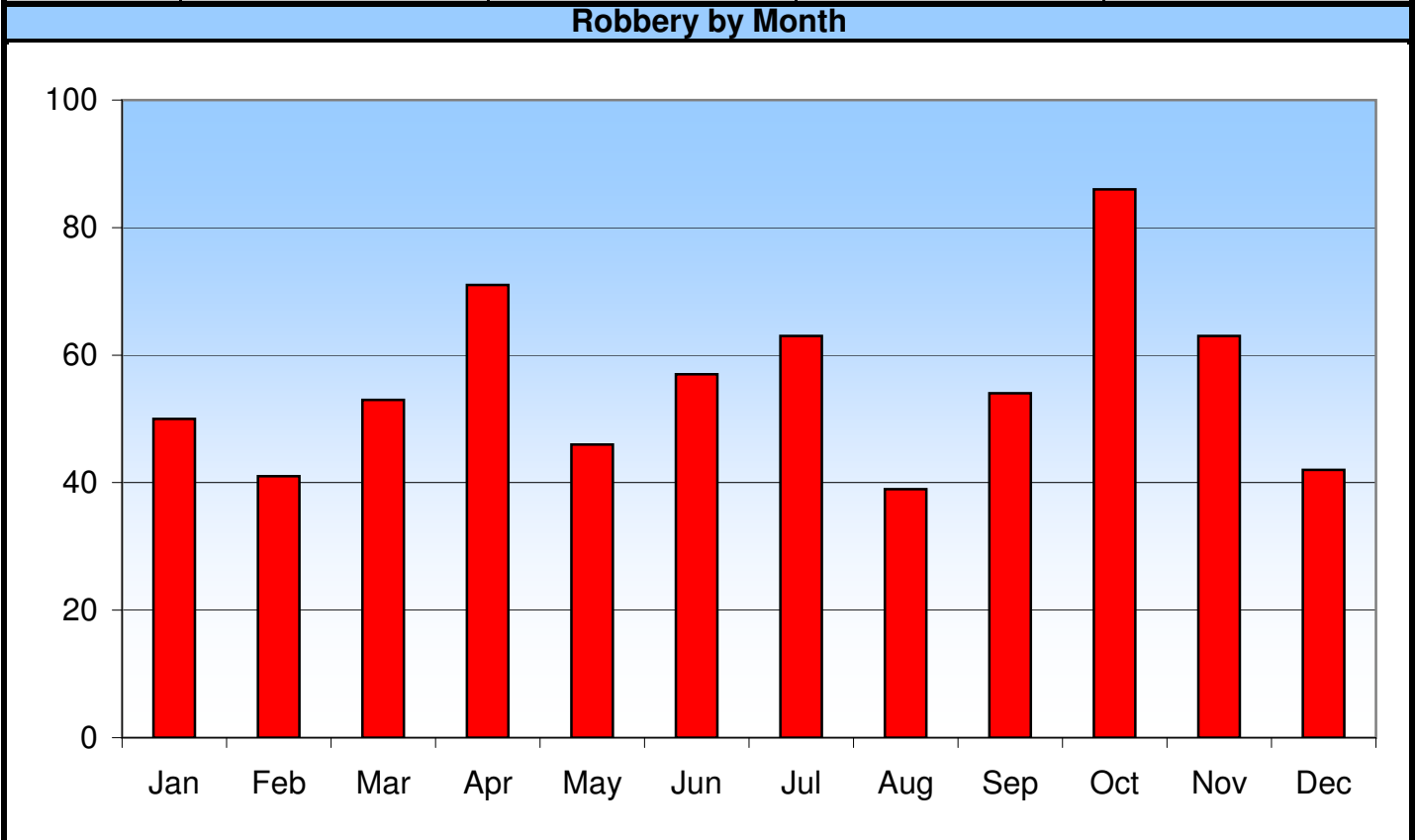
Robbery

Robbery by District

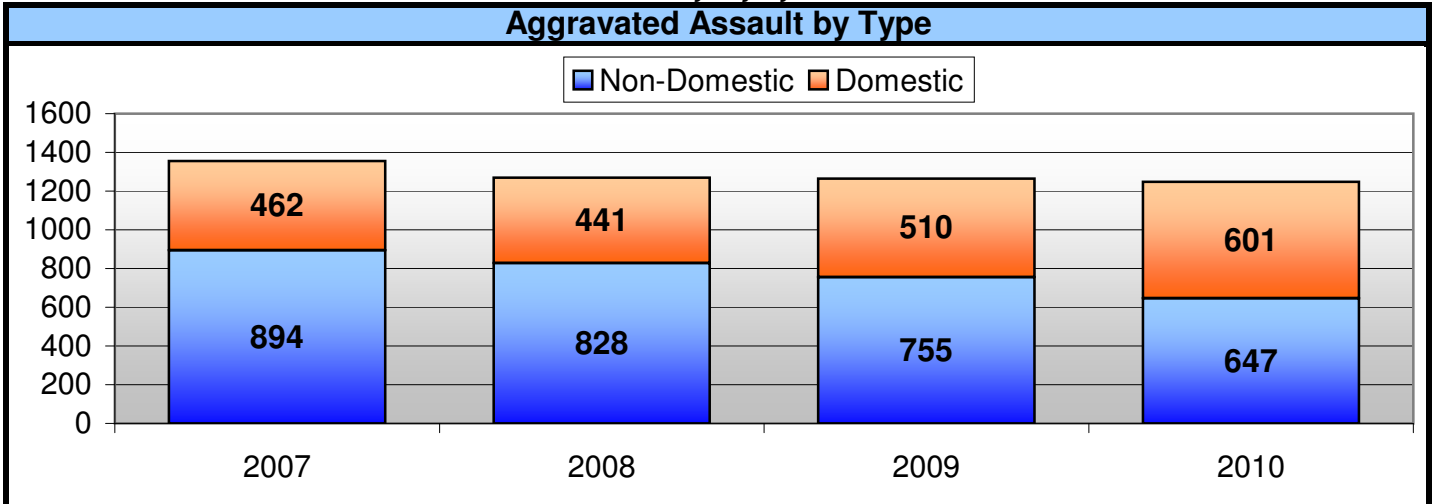

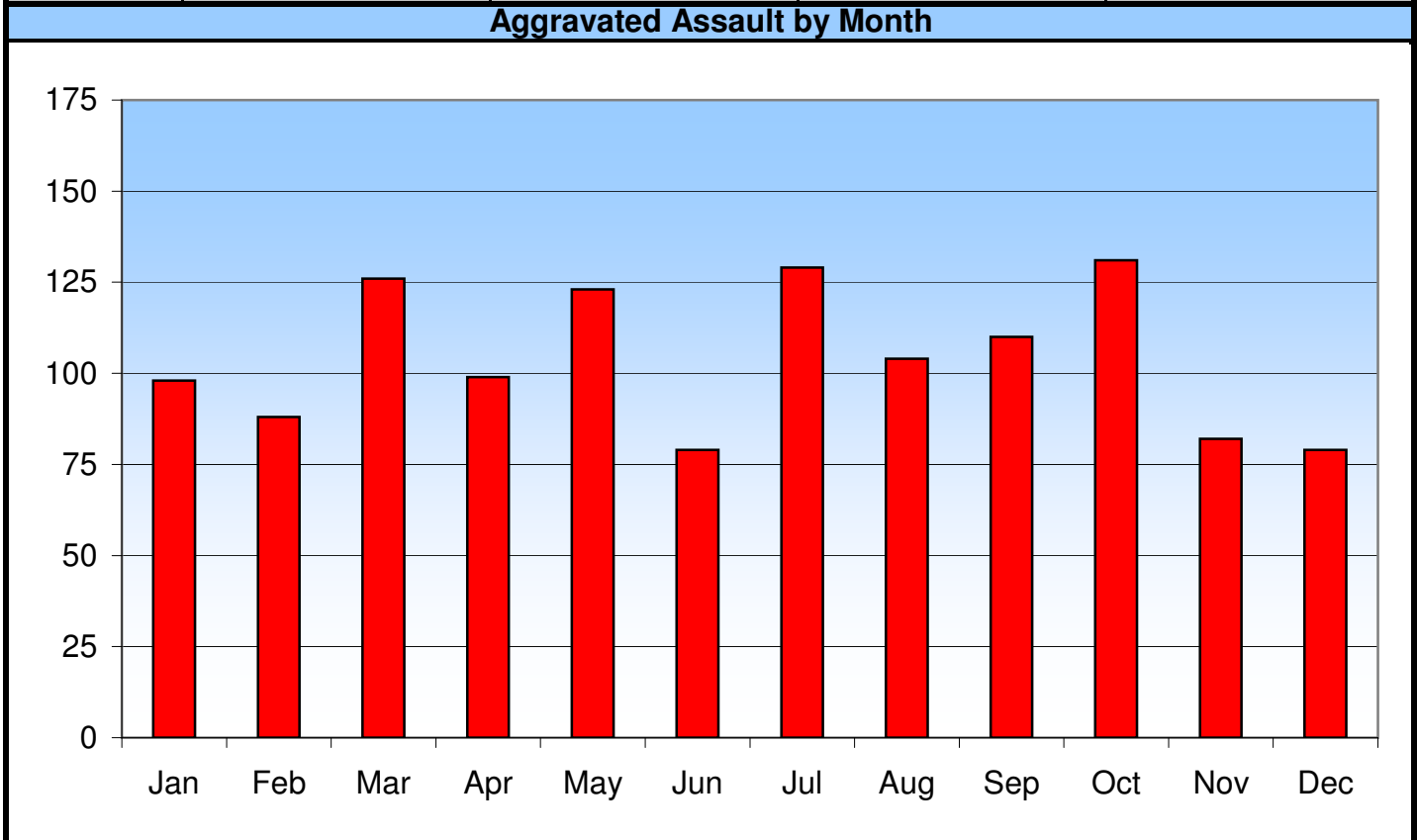

Aggravated Assault by District

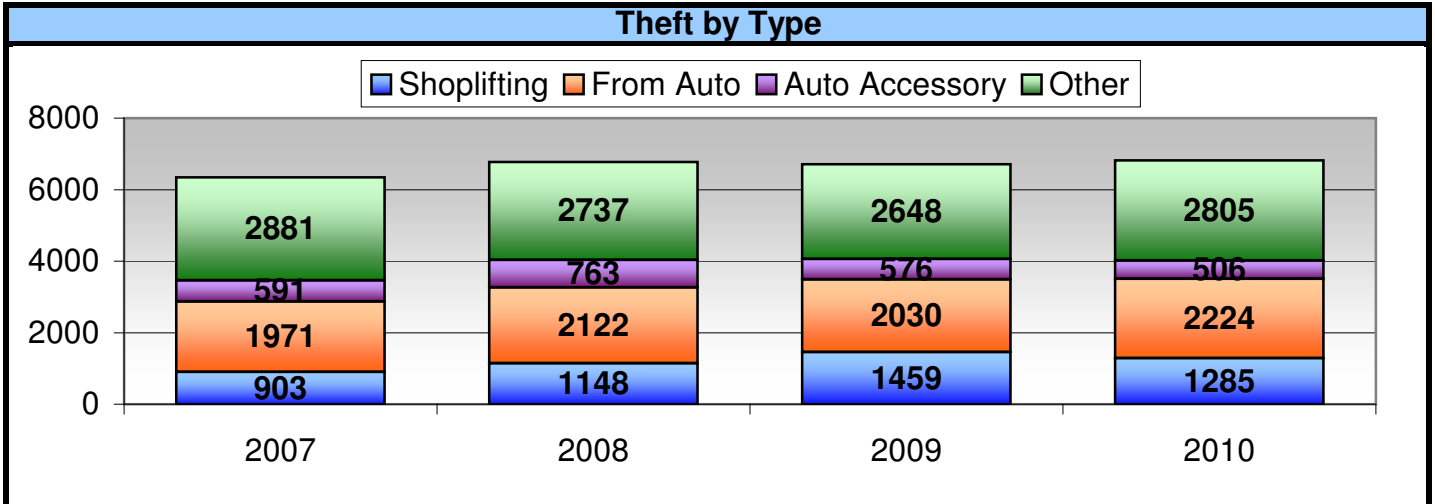

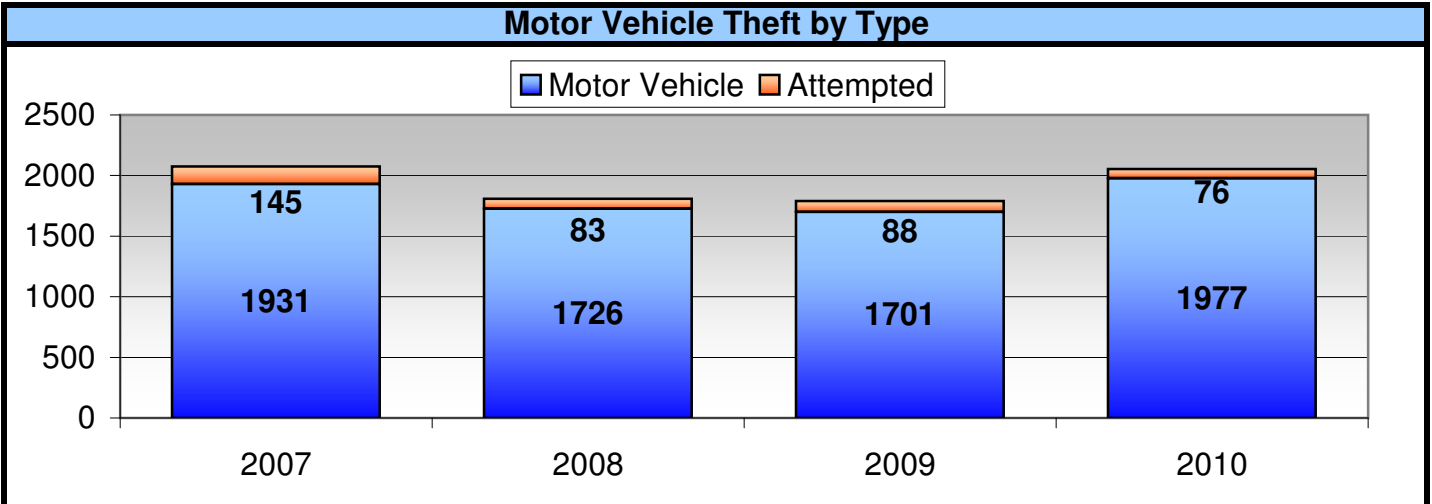

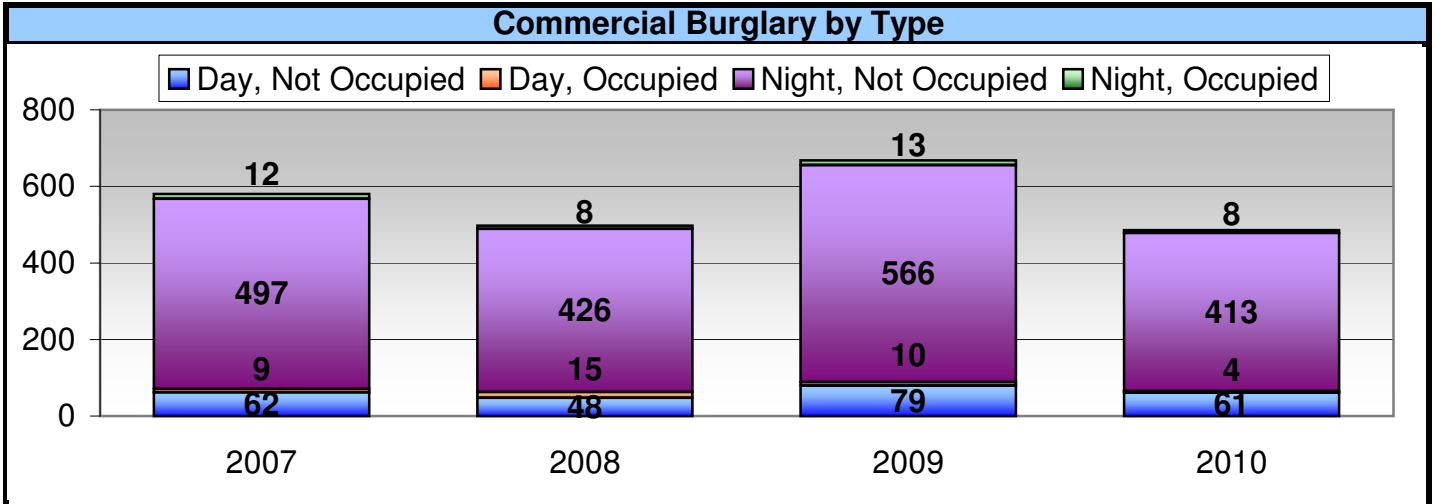

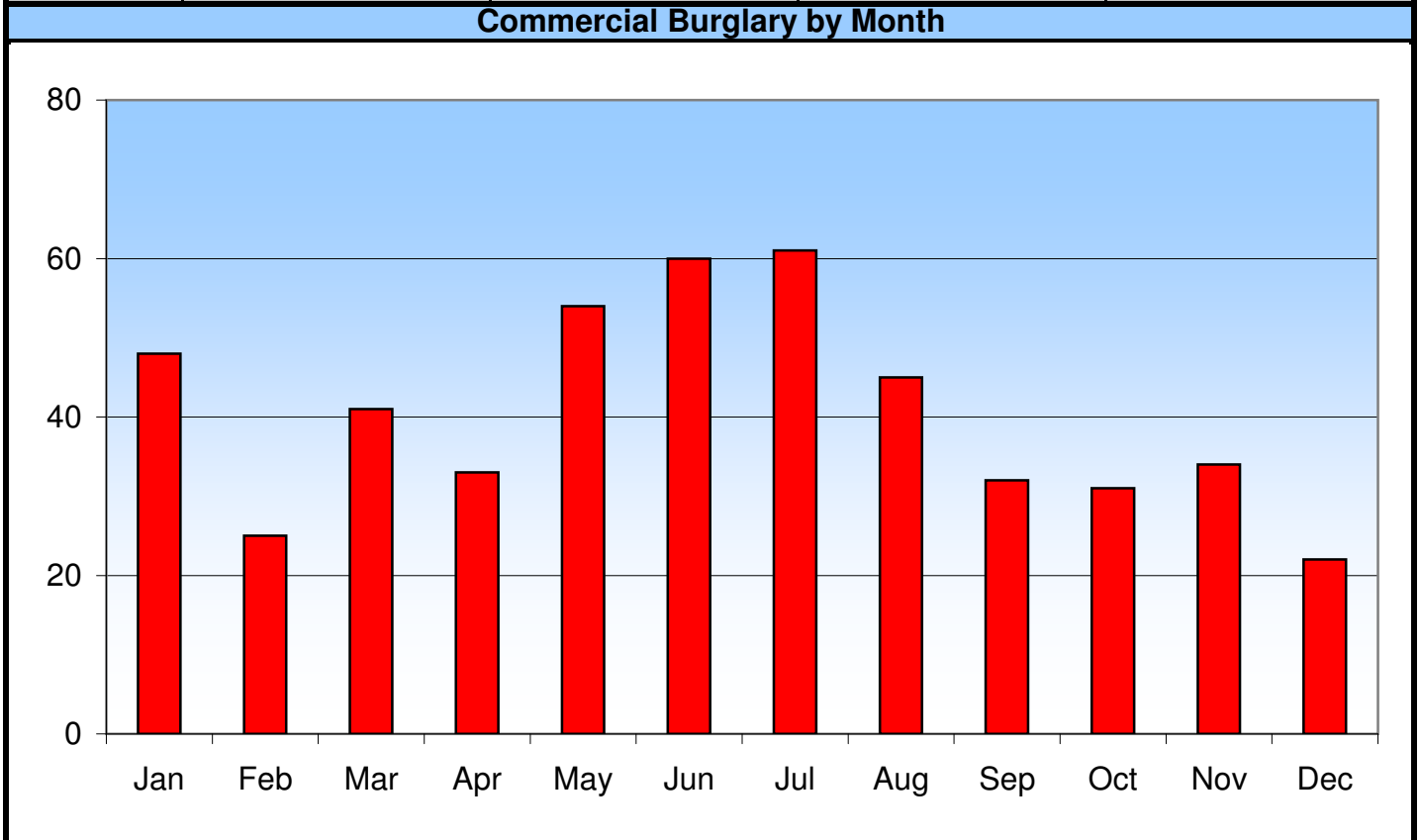

Commercial Burglary by District

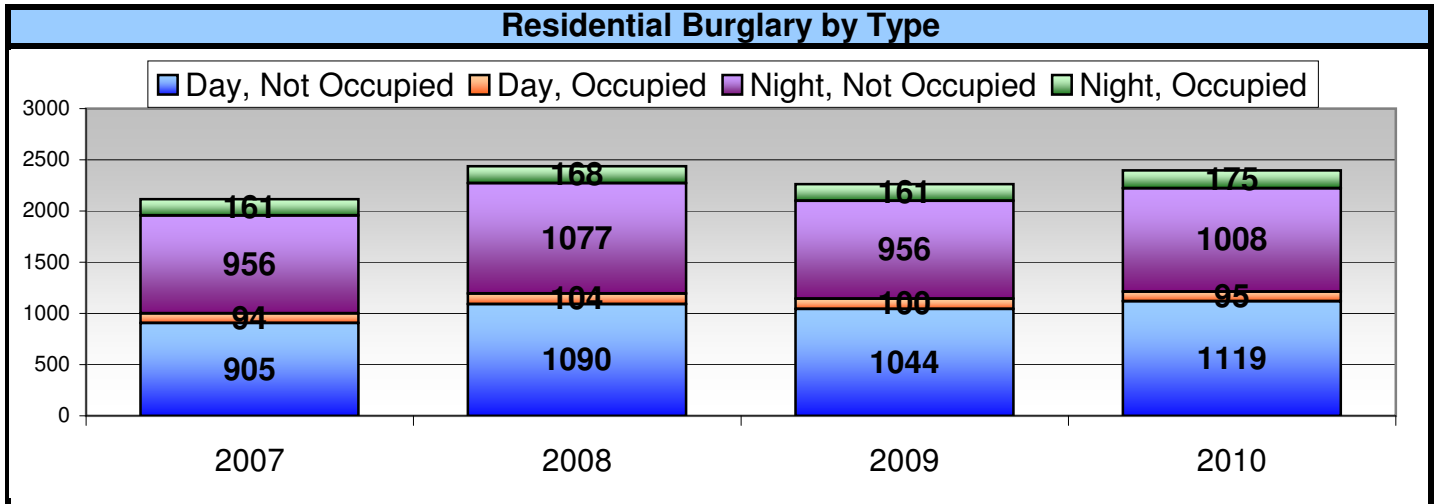

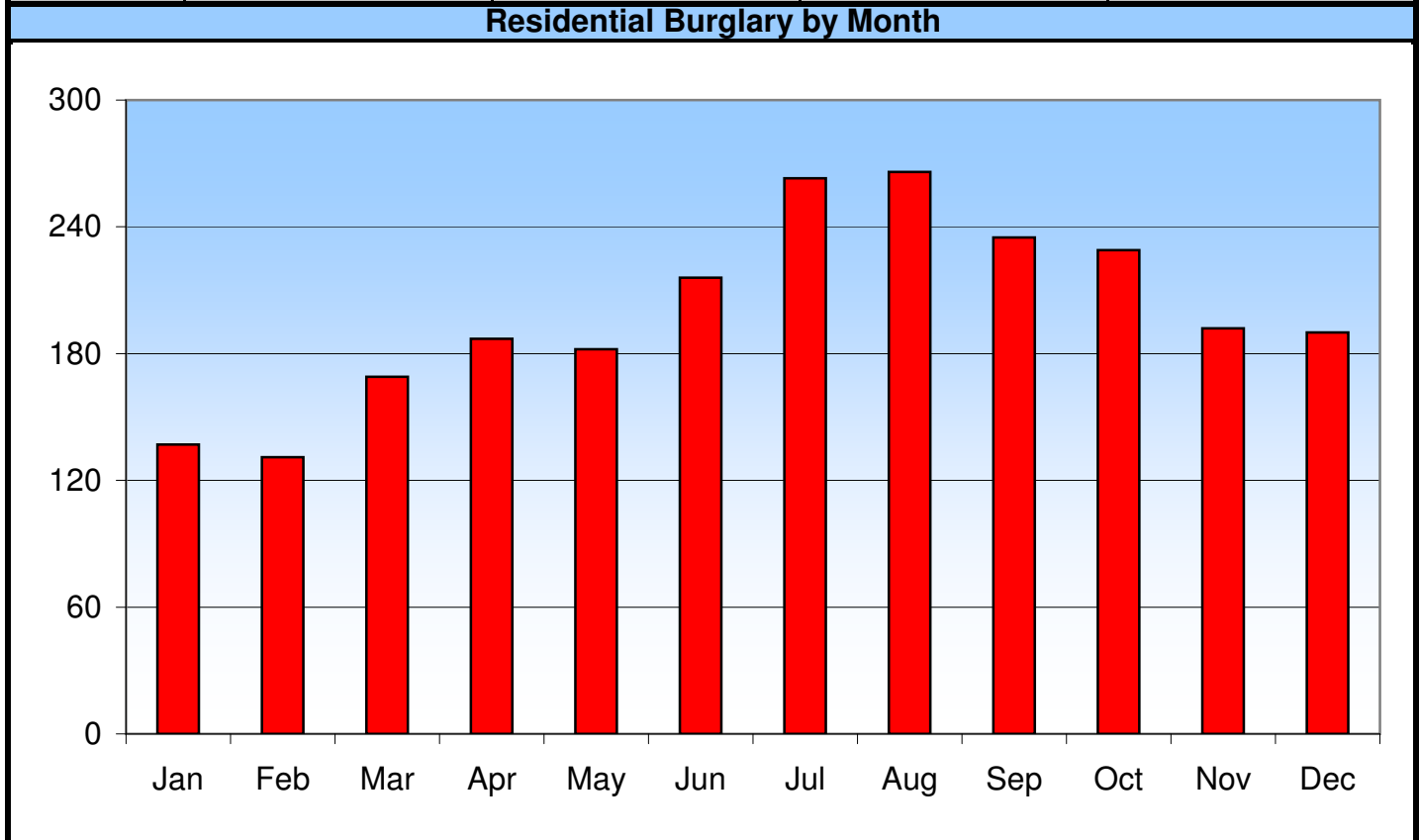

Residential Burglary by District

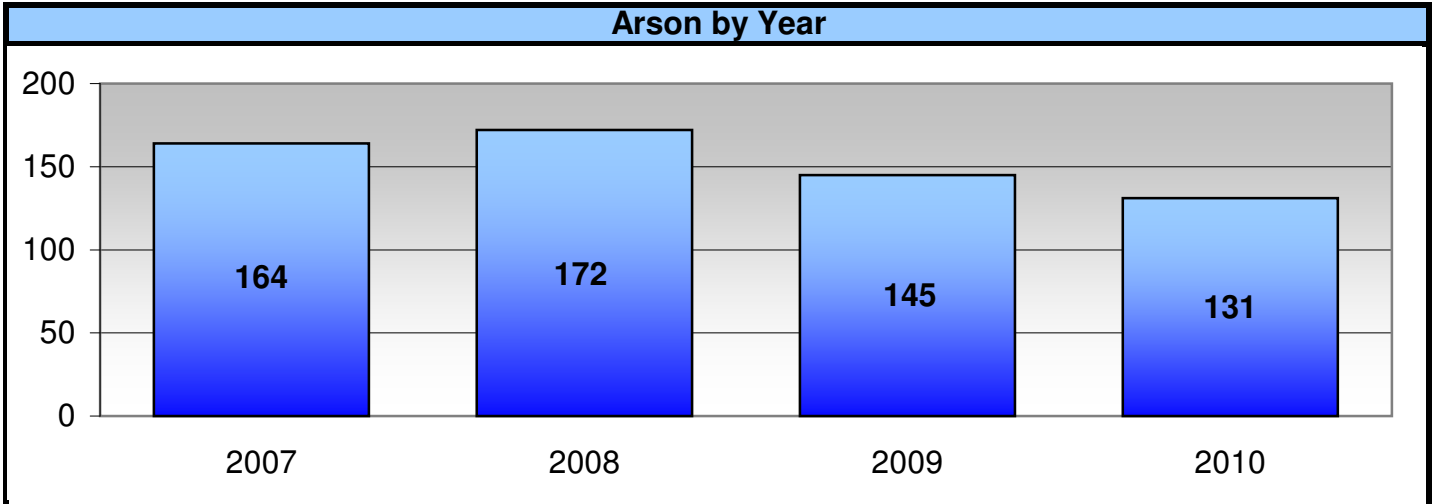

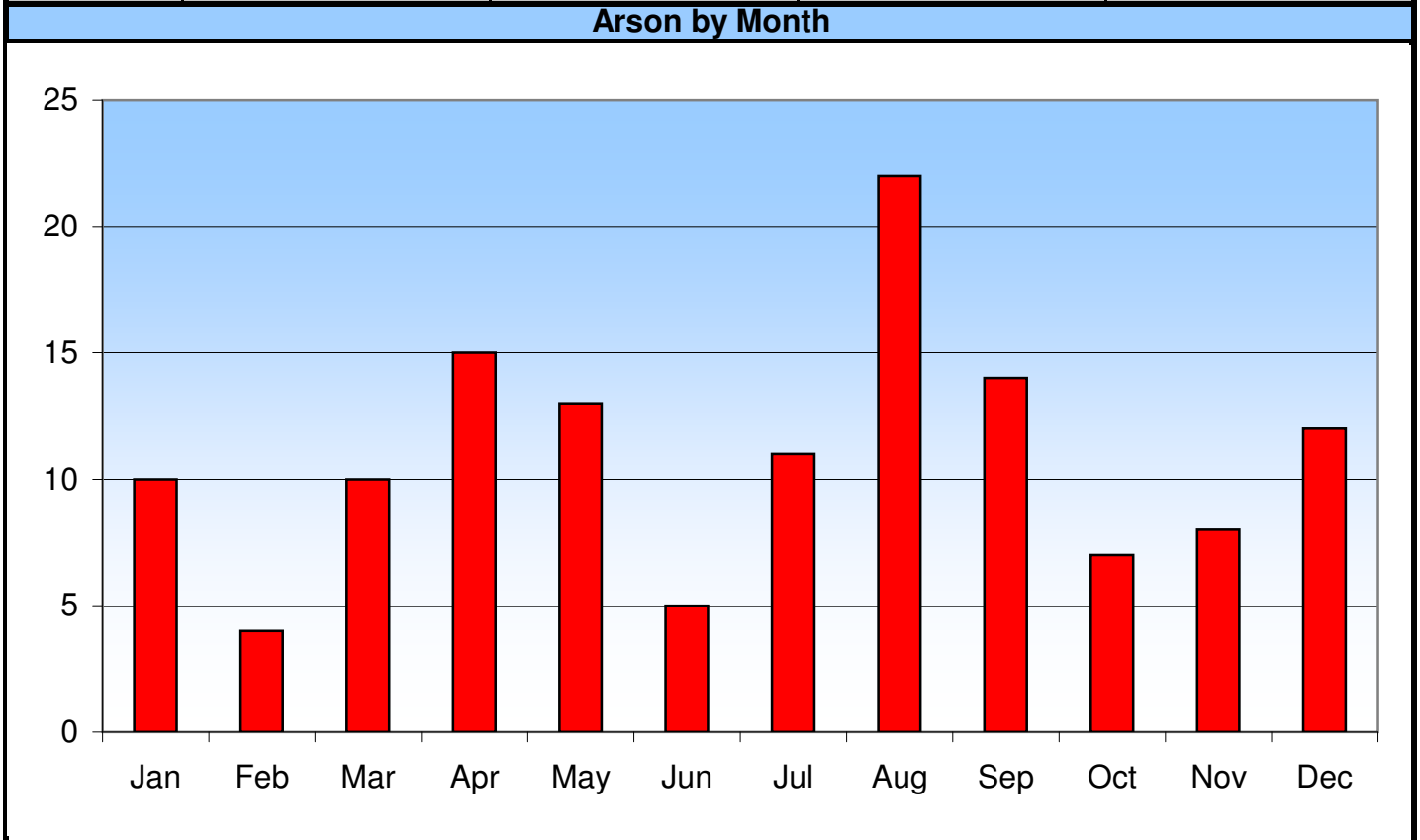

Arson by District

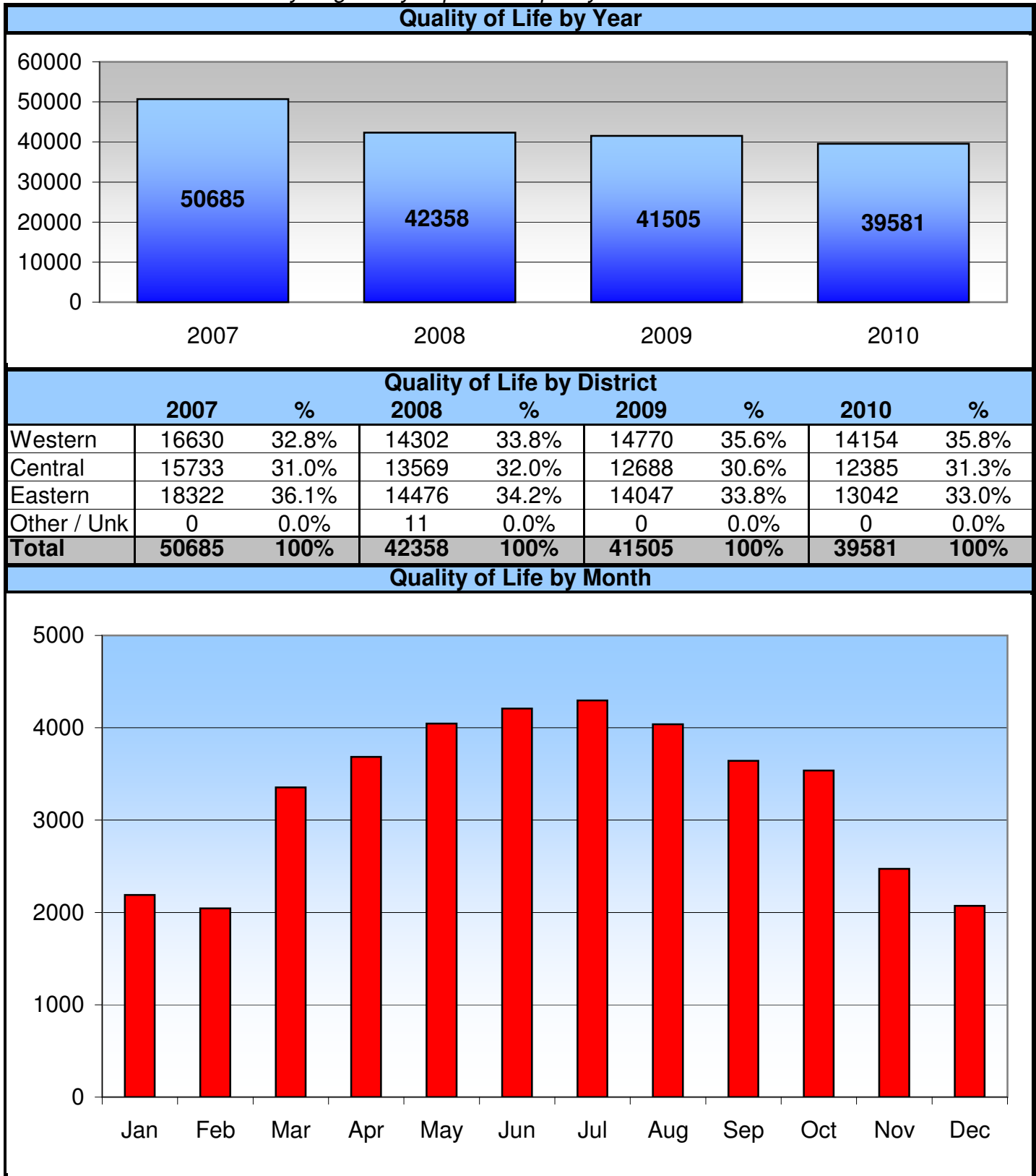

Quality of Life

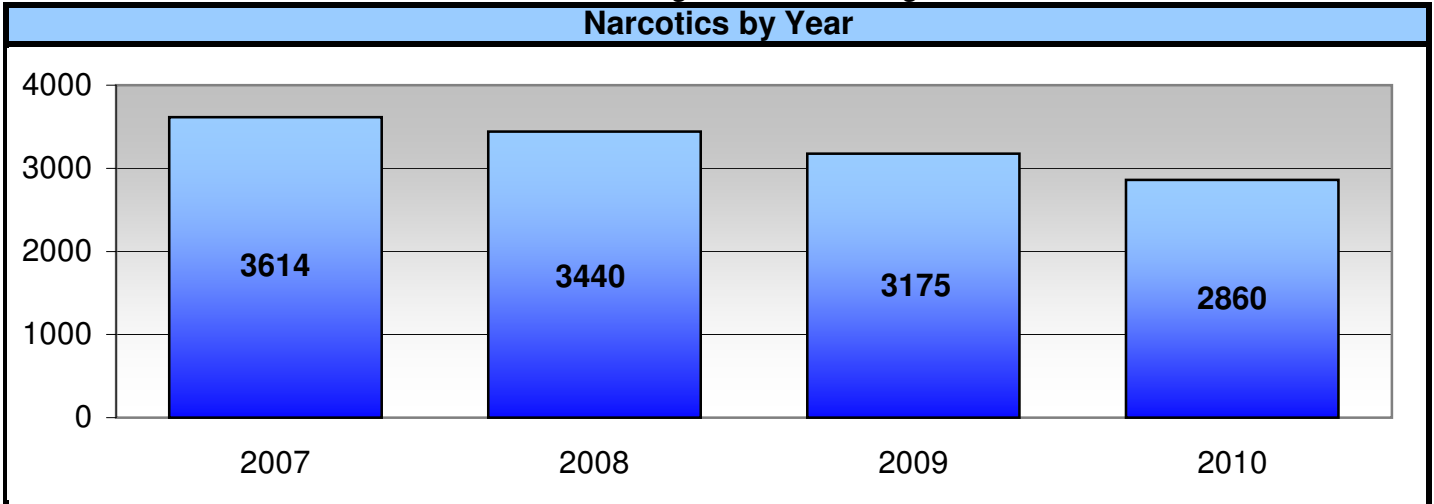
Definition: Commonly referred to as 'nuisance crimes'. These are violations that left unchecked, may negatively impact the quality of life of an area.

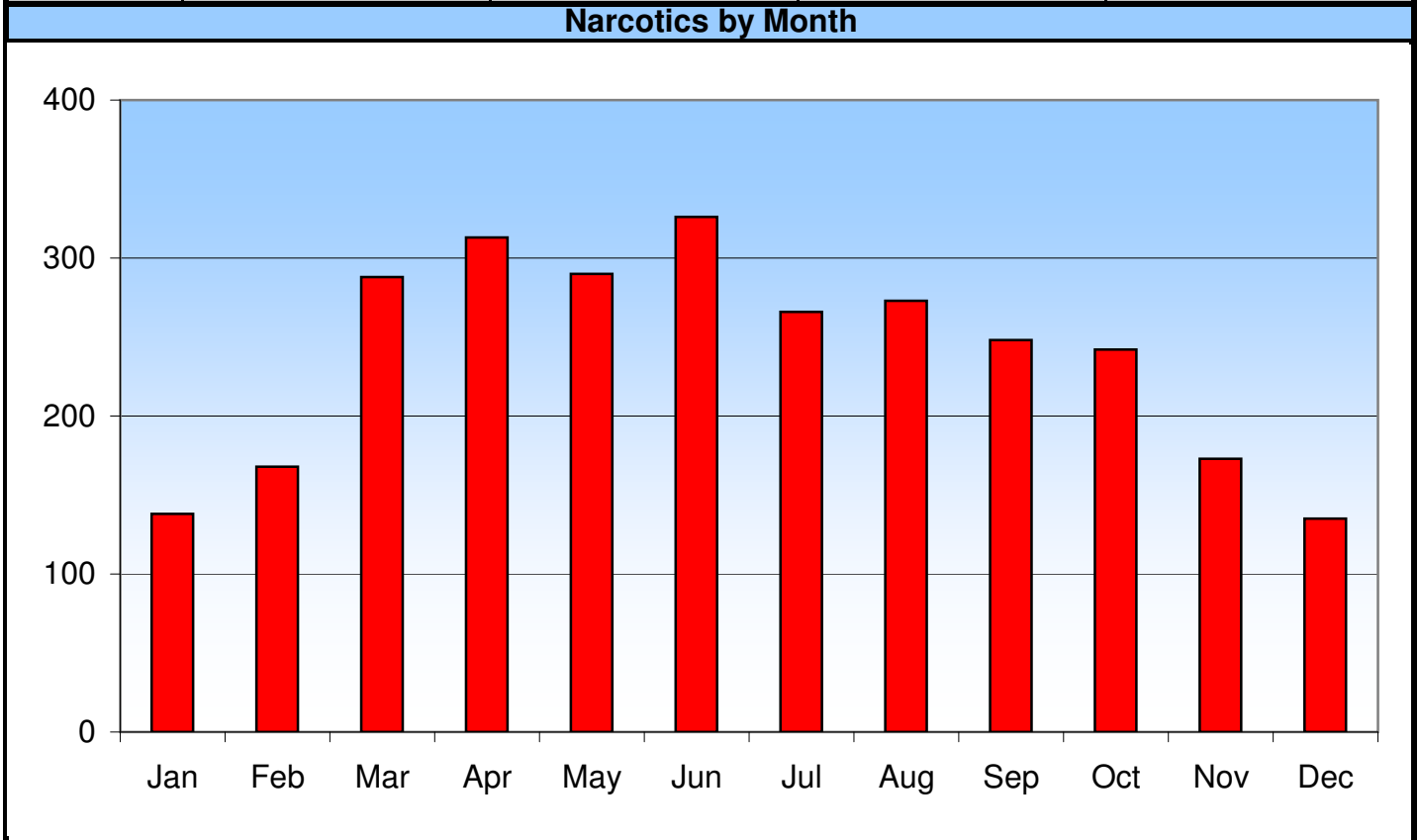
Narcotics

Narcotics by District

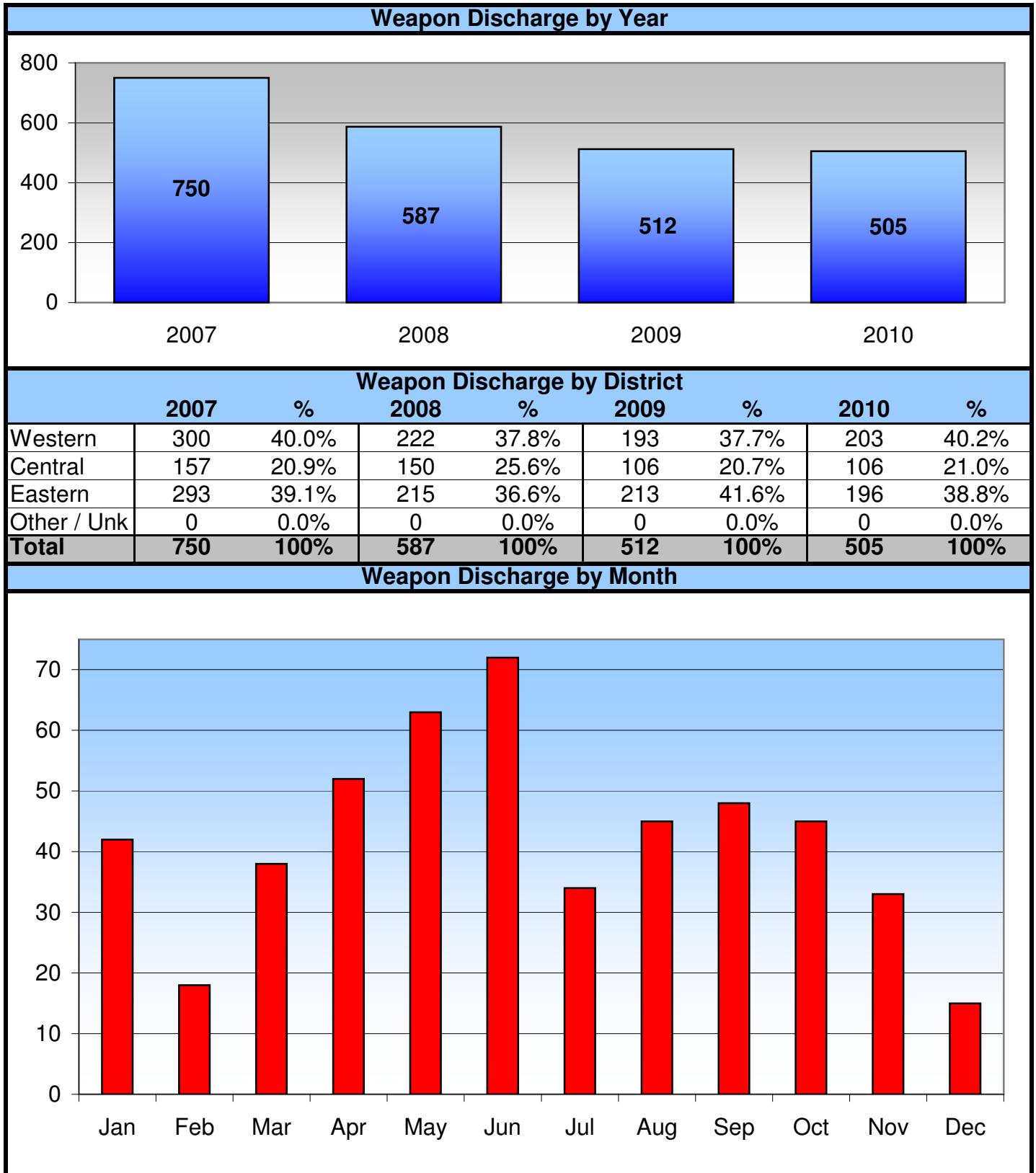

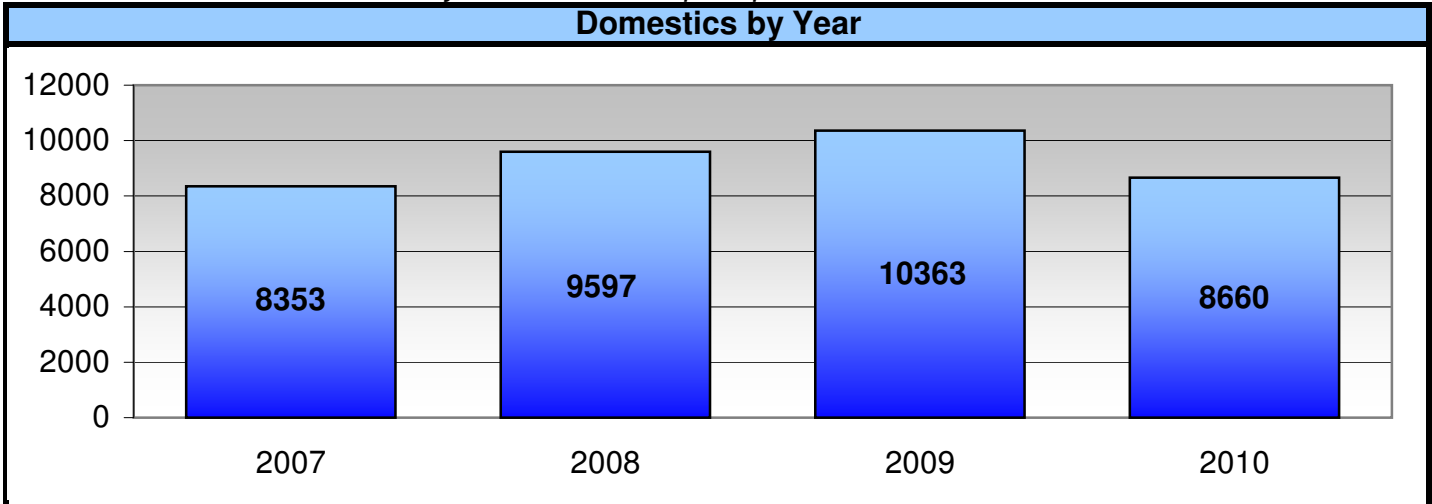

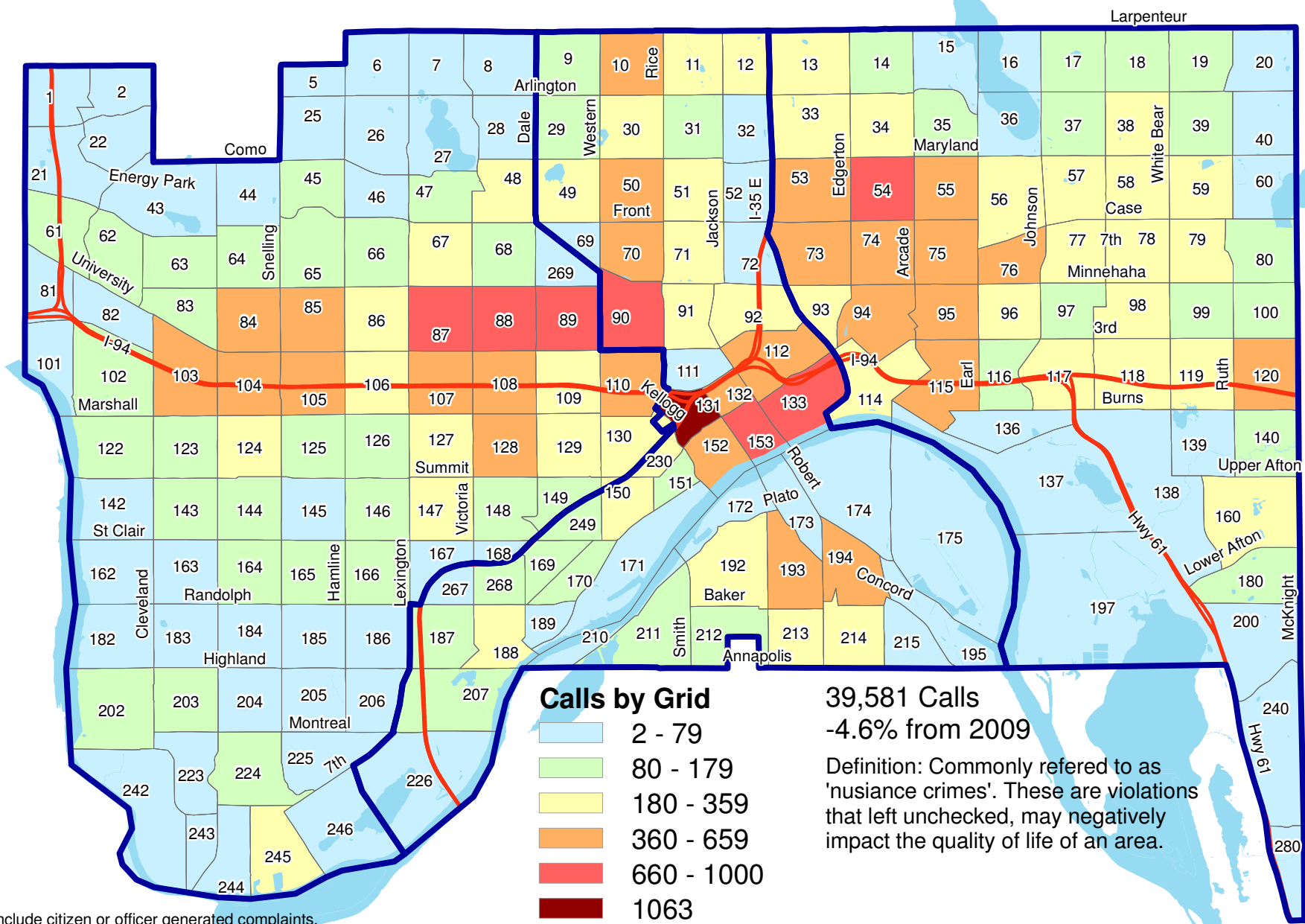

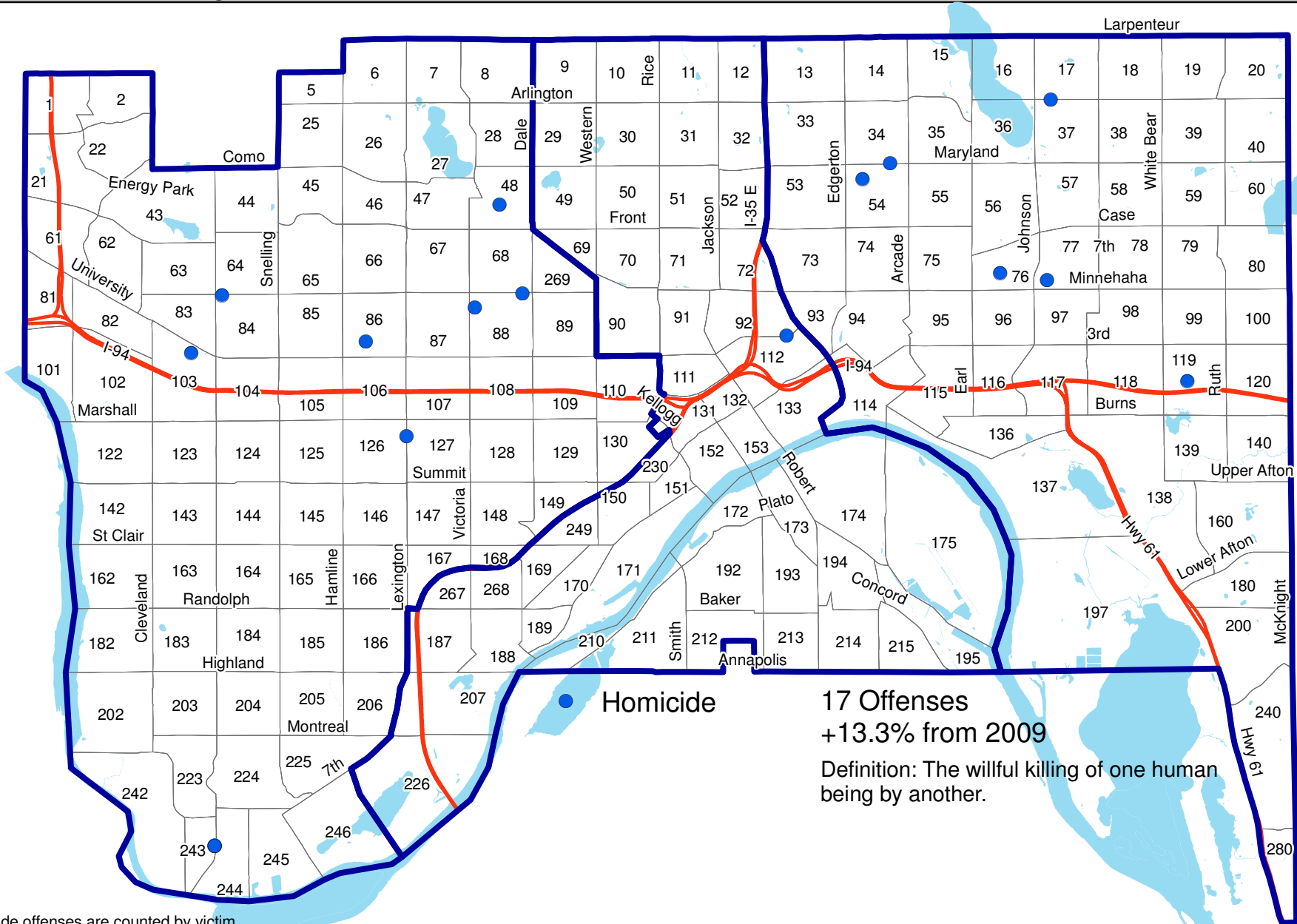

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City of Saint Paul - Homicide Offenses: 2010



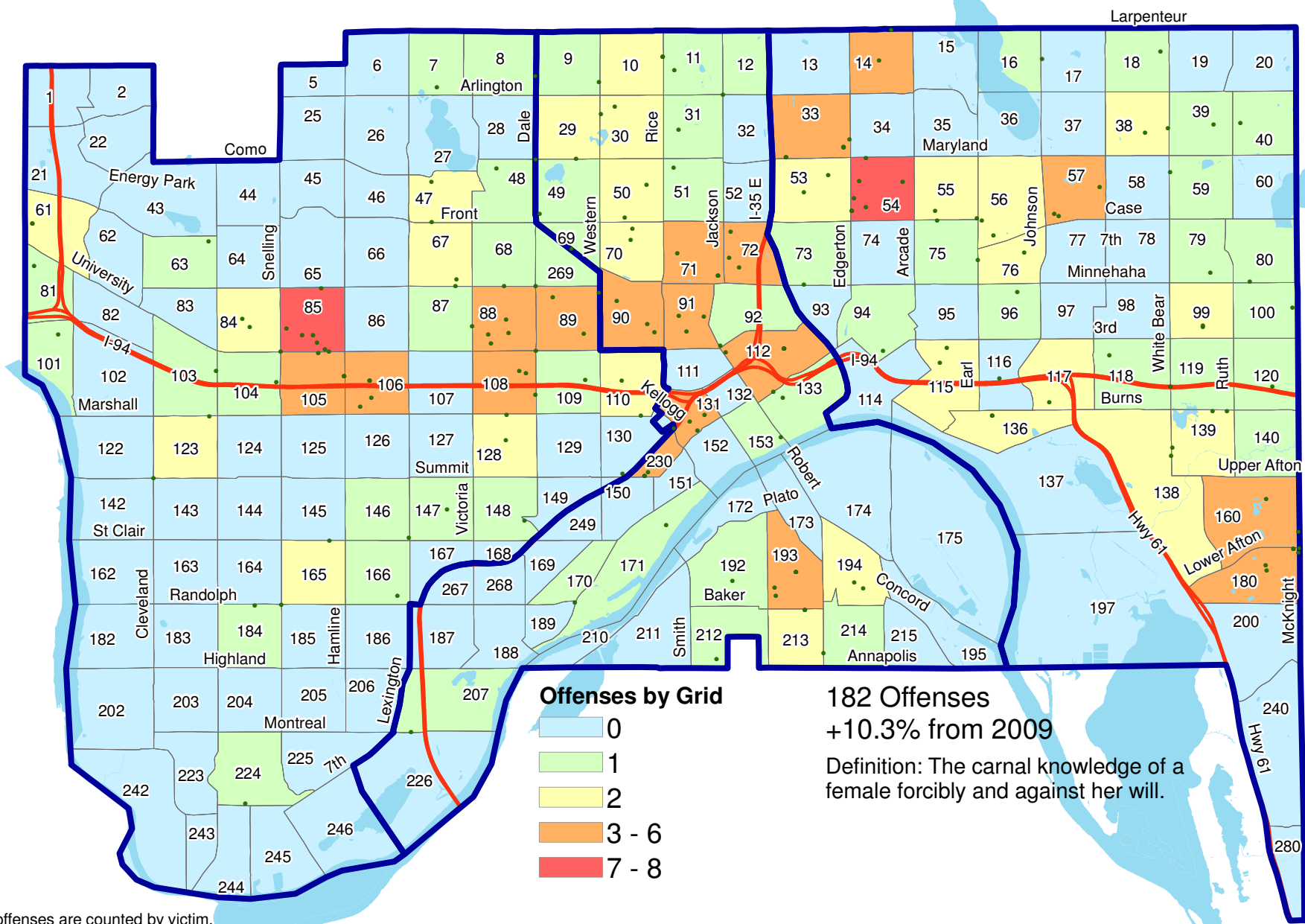

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City of Saint Paul - Rape Offenses: 2010

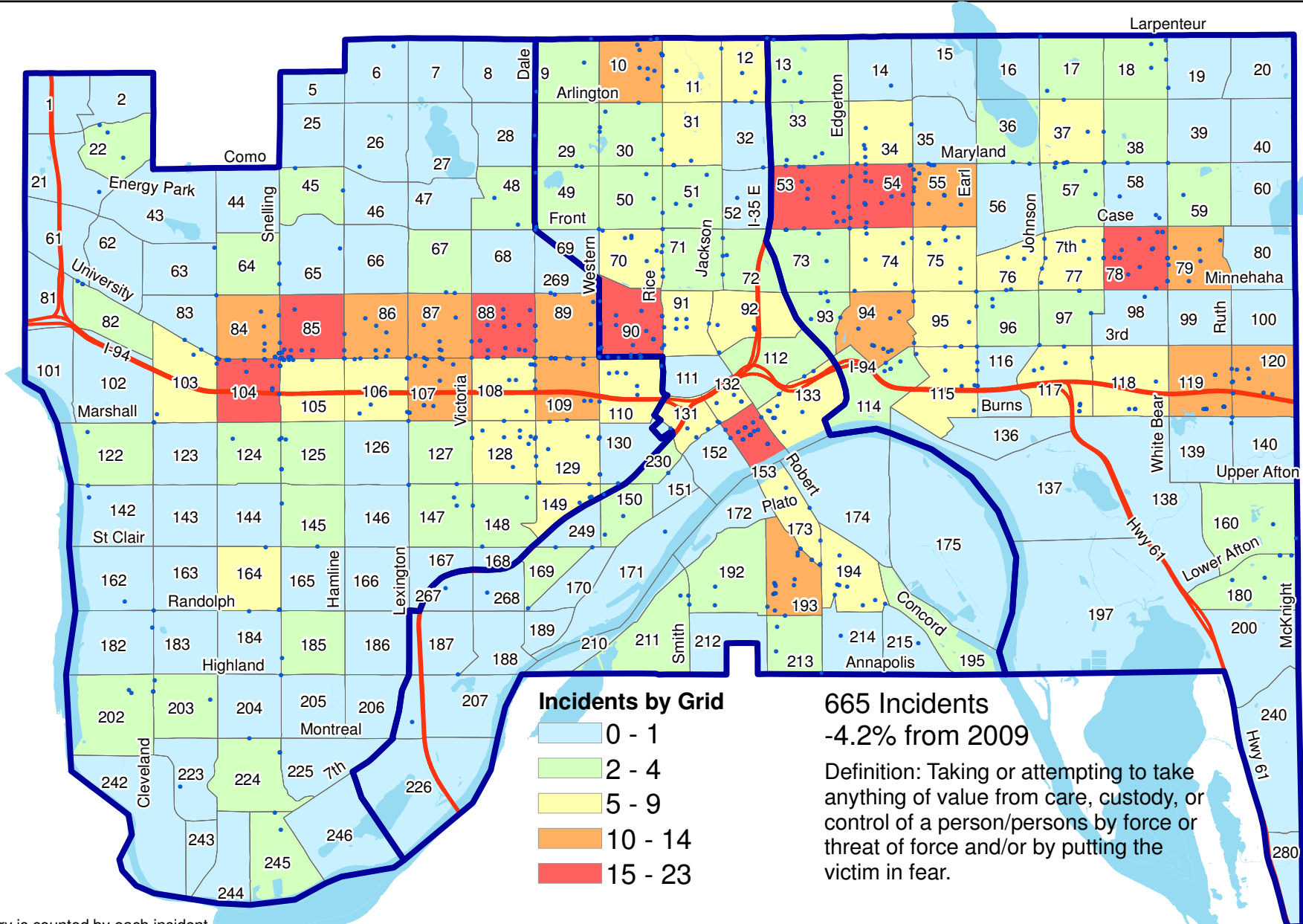

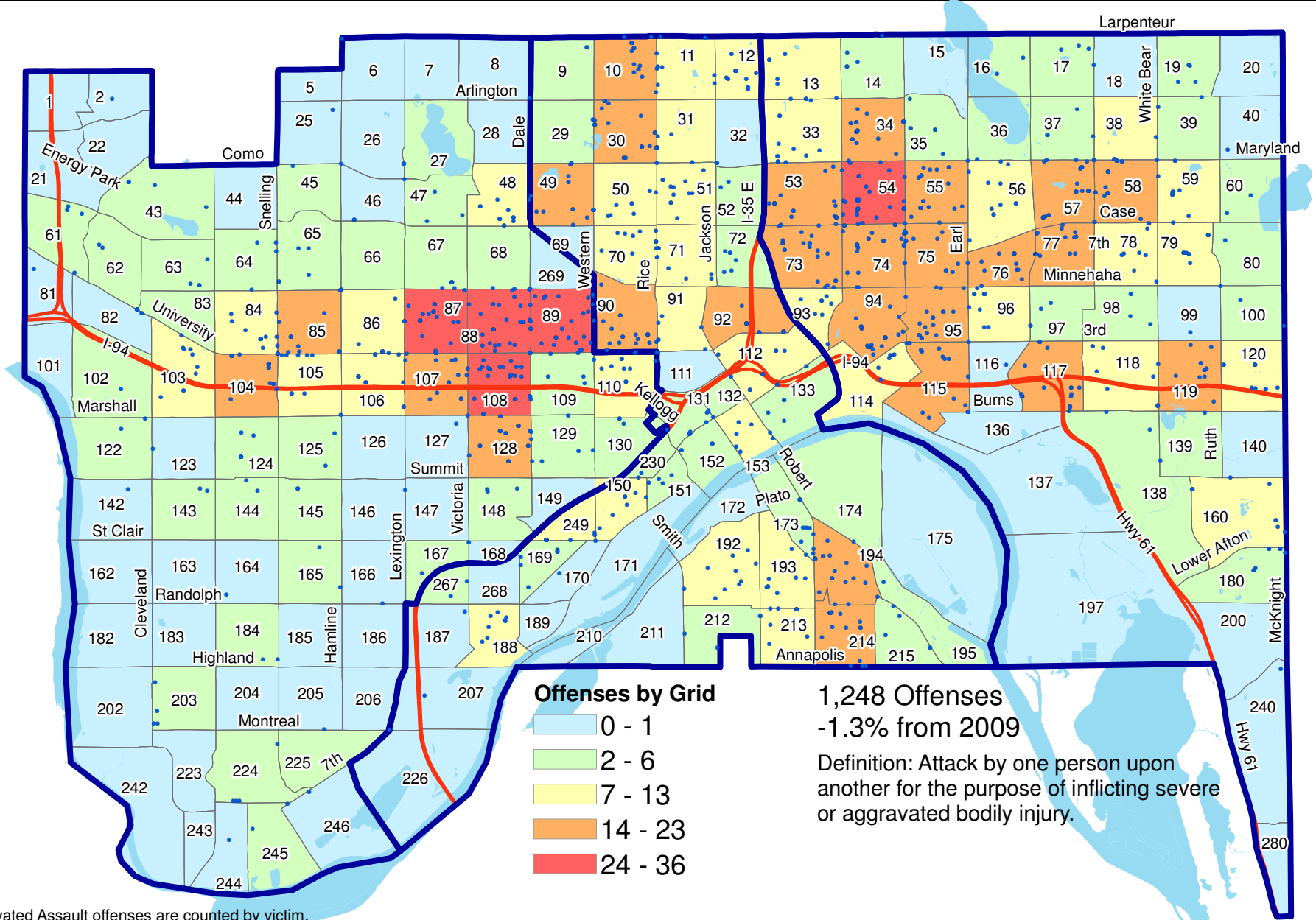

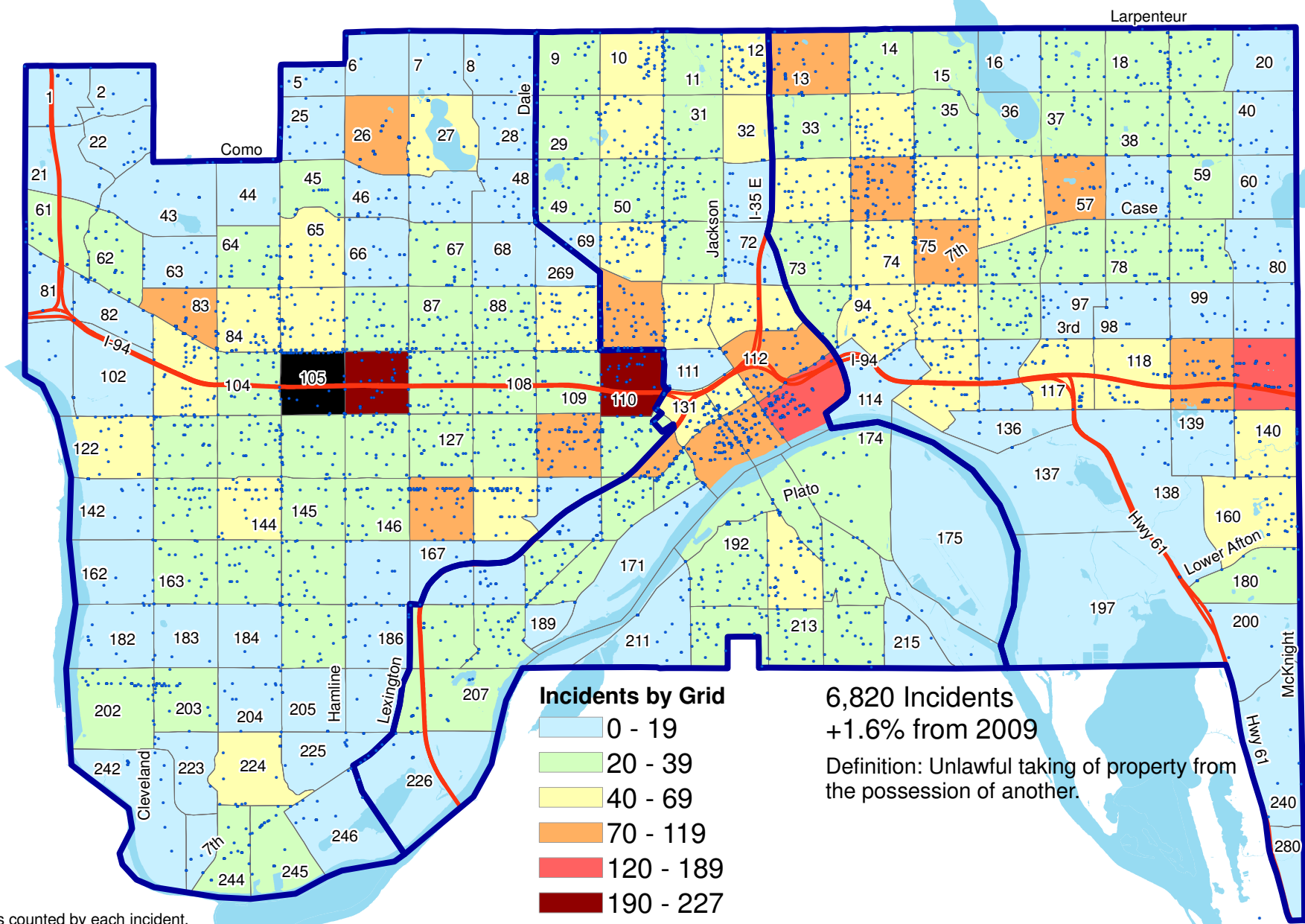

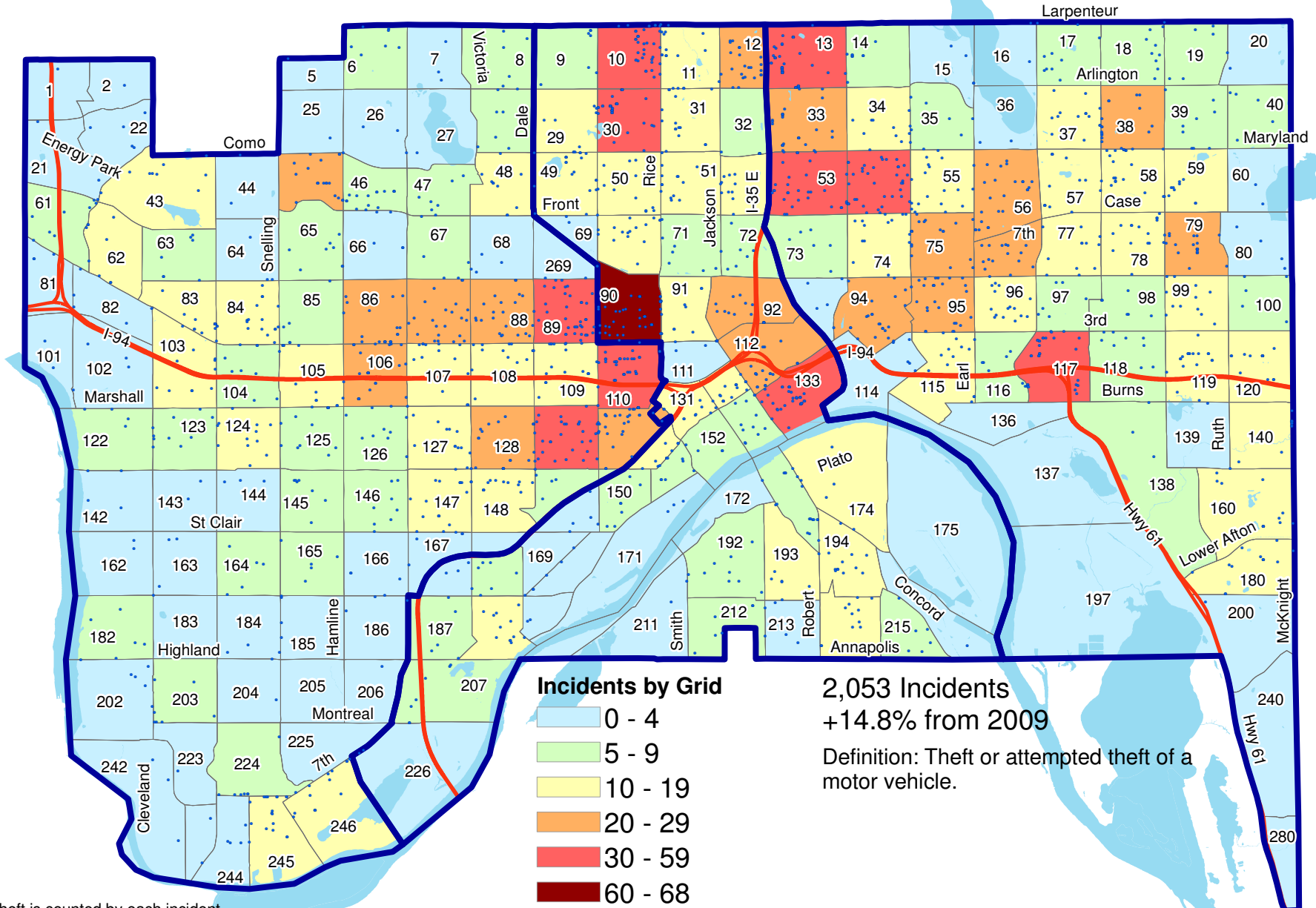

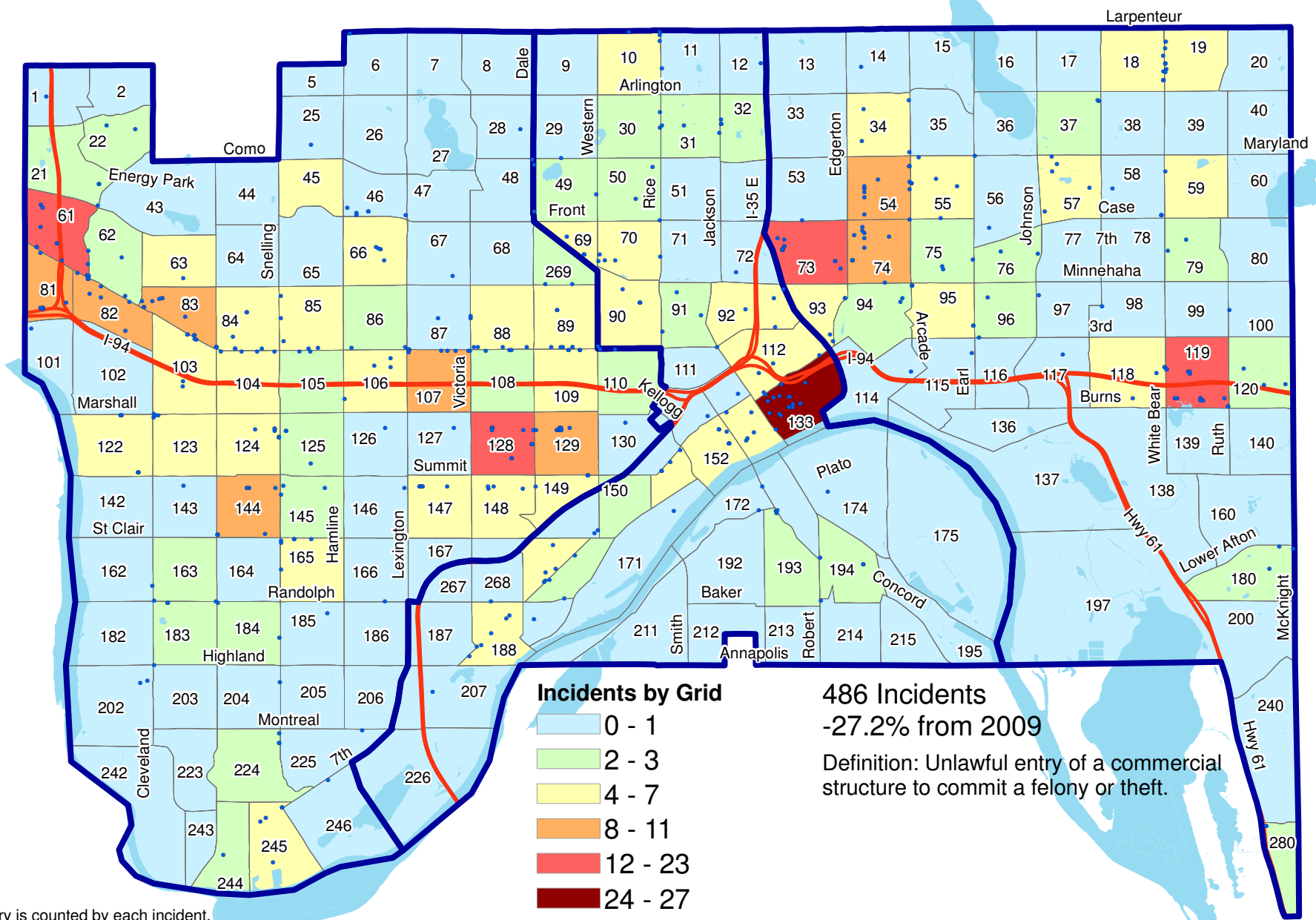

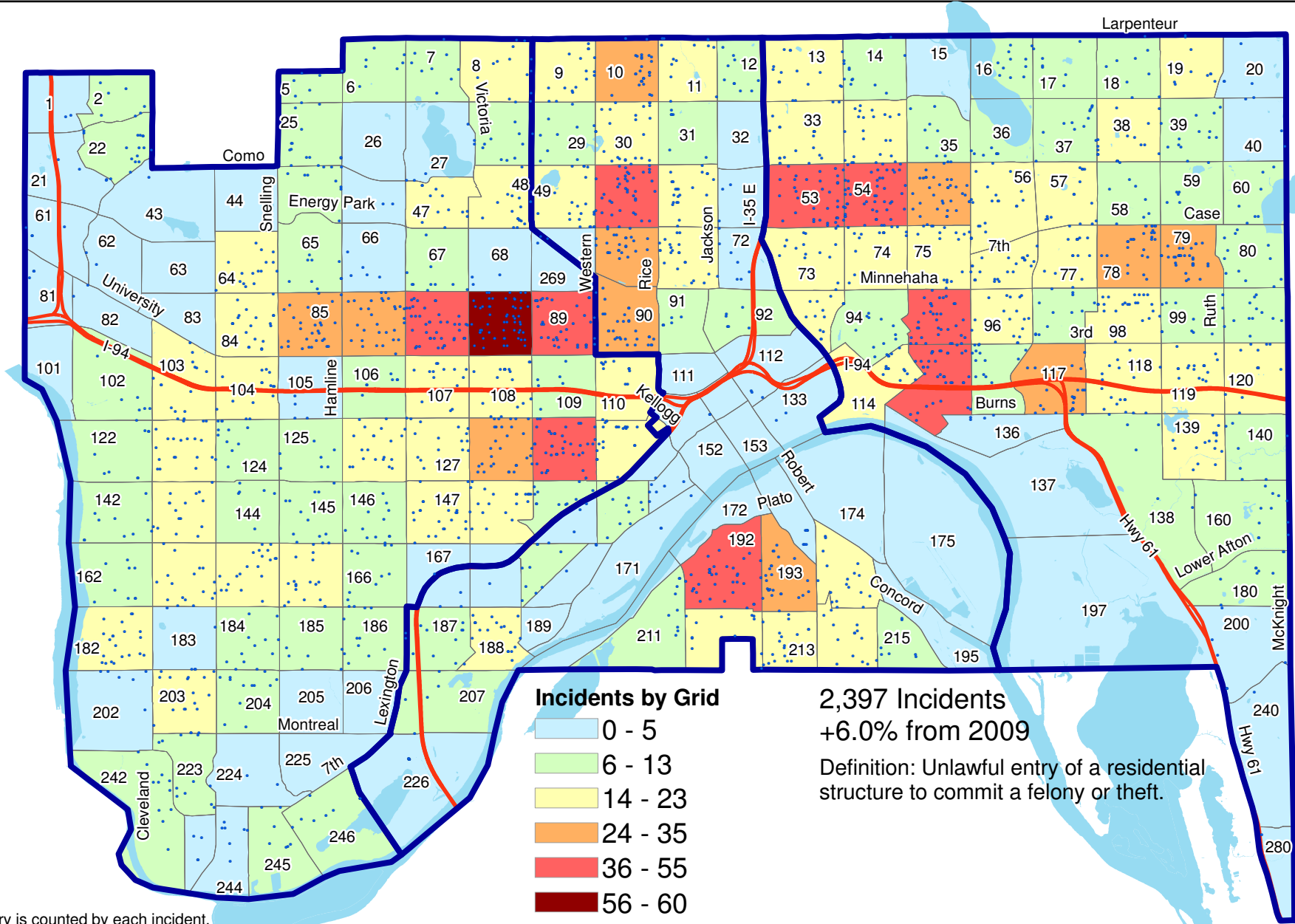

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City of Saint Paul - Residential Burglary Incidents: 2010



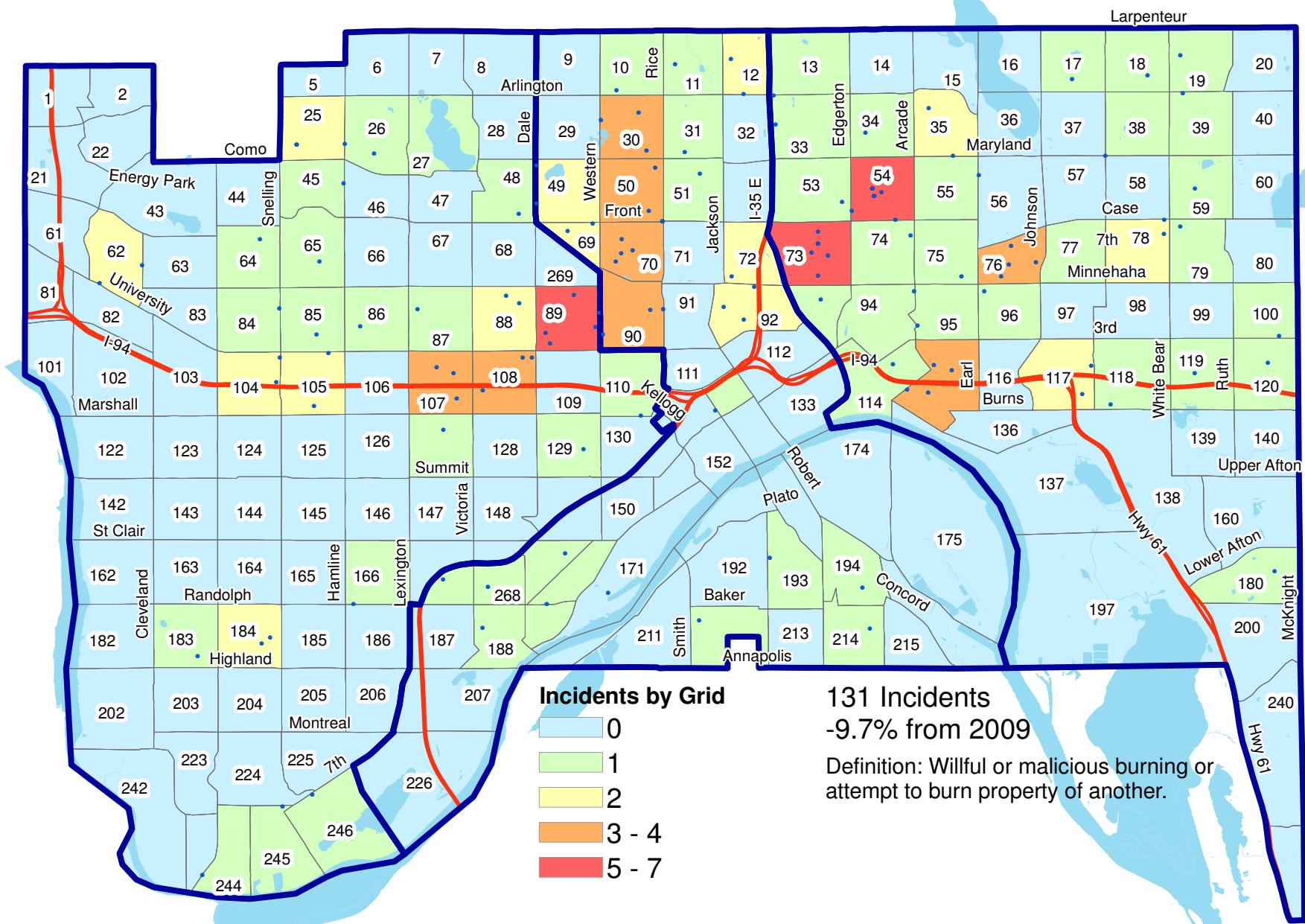

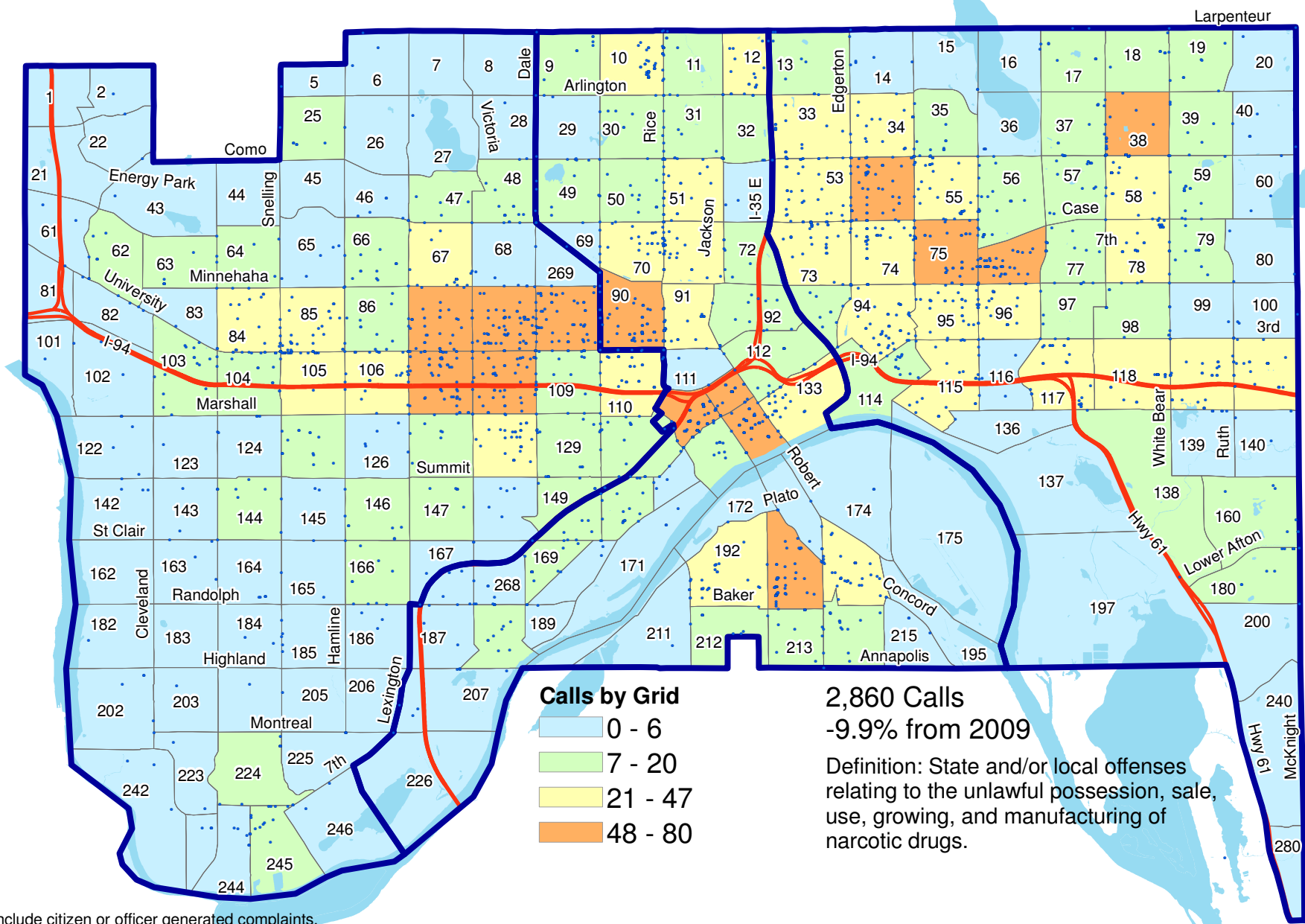

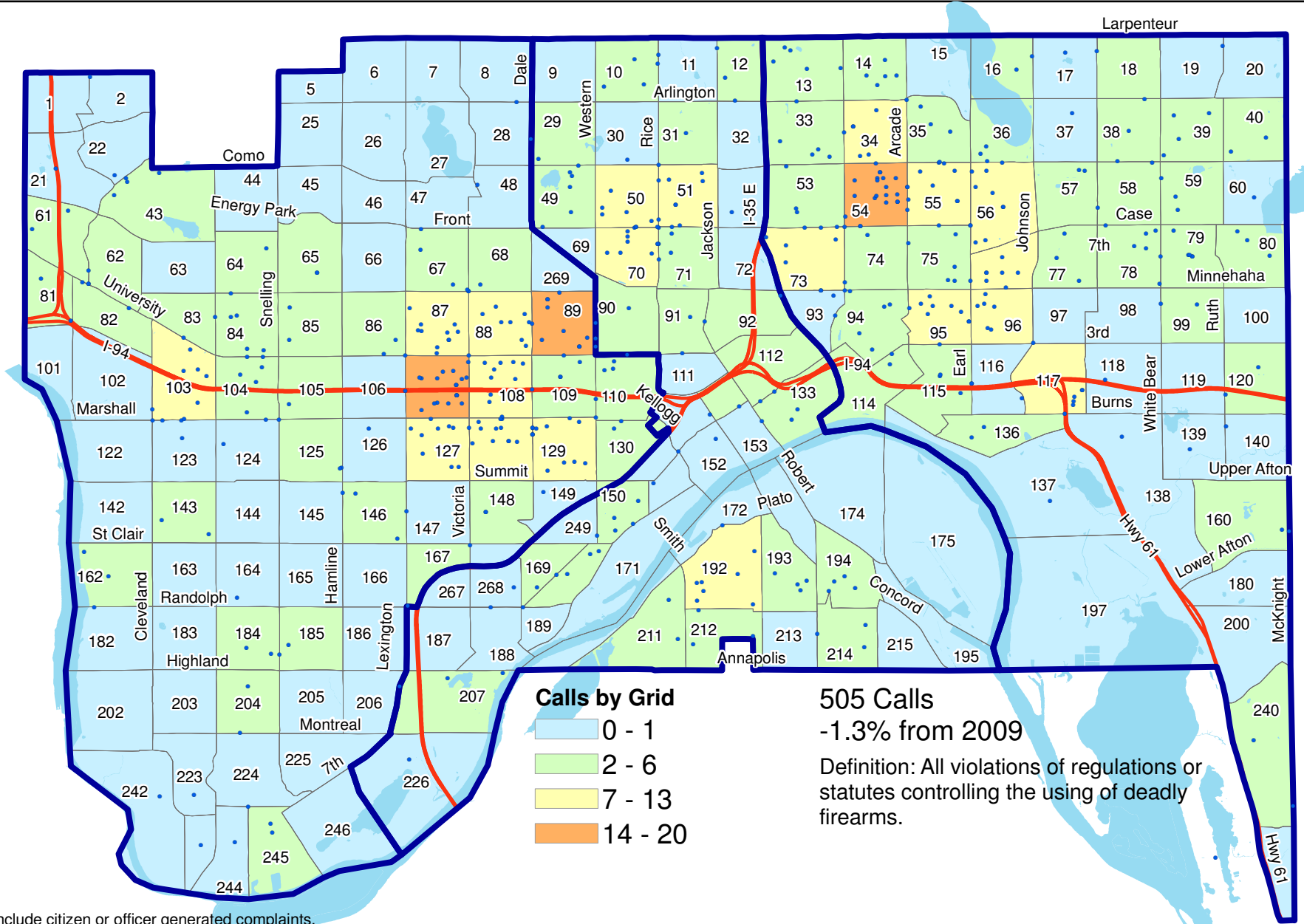

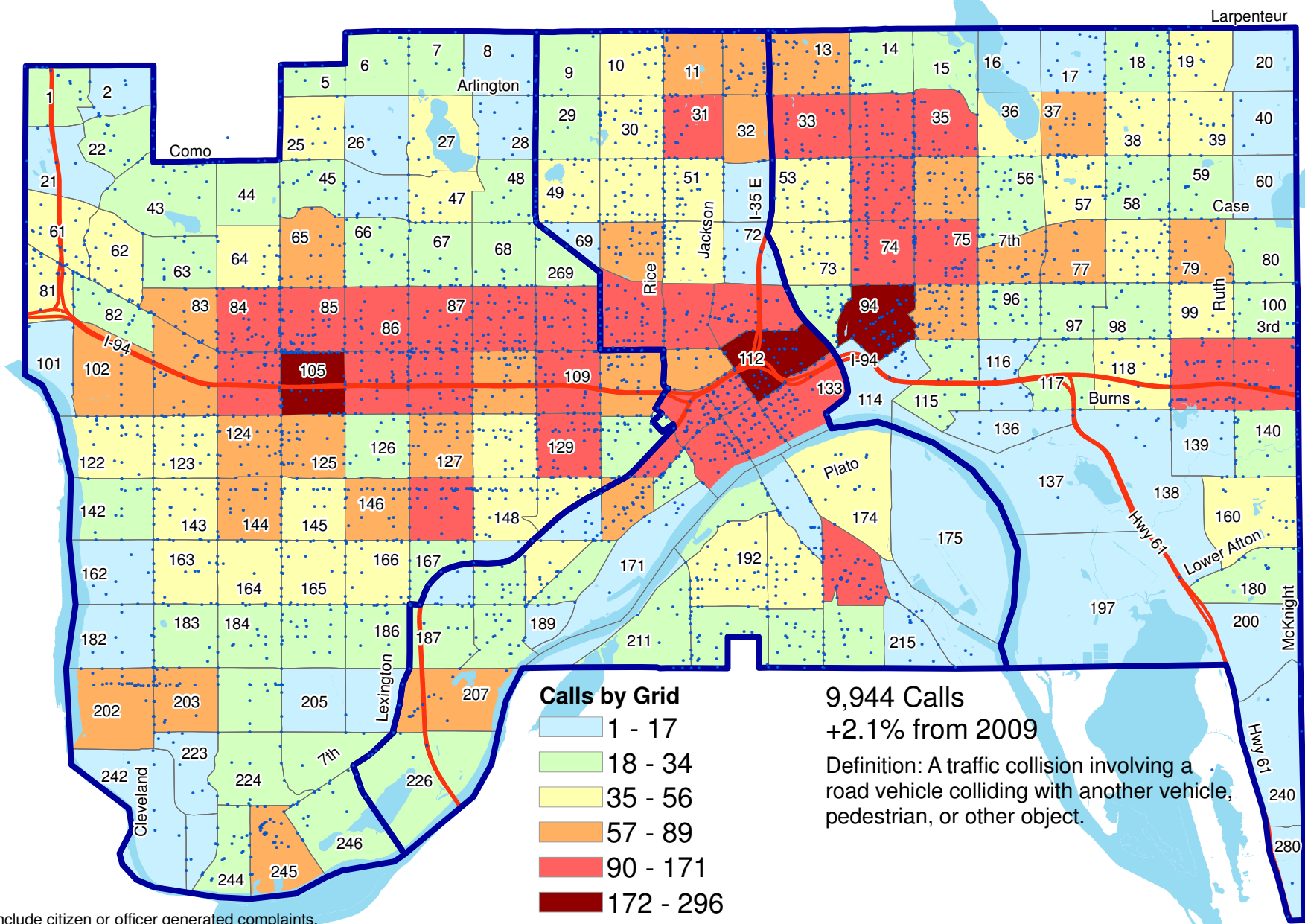

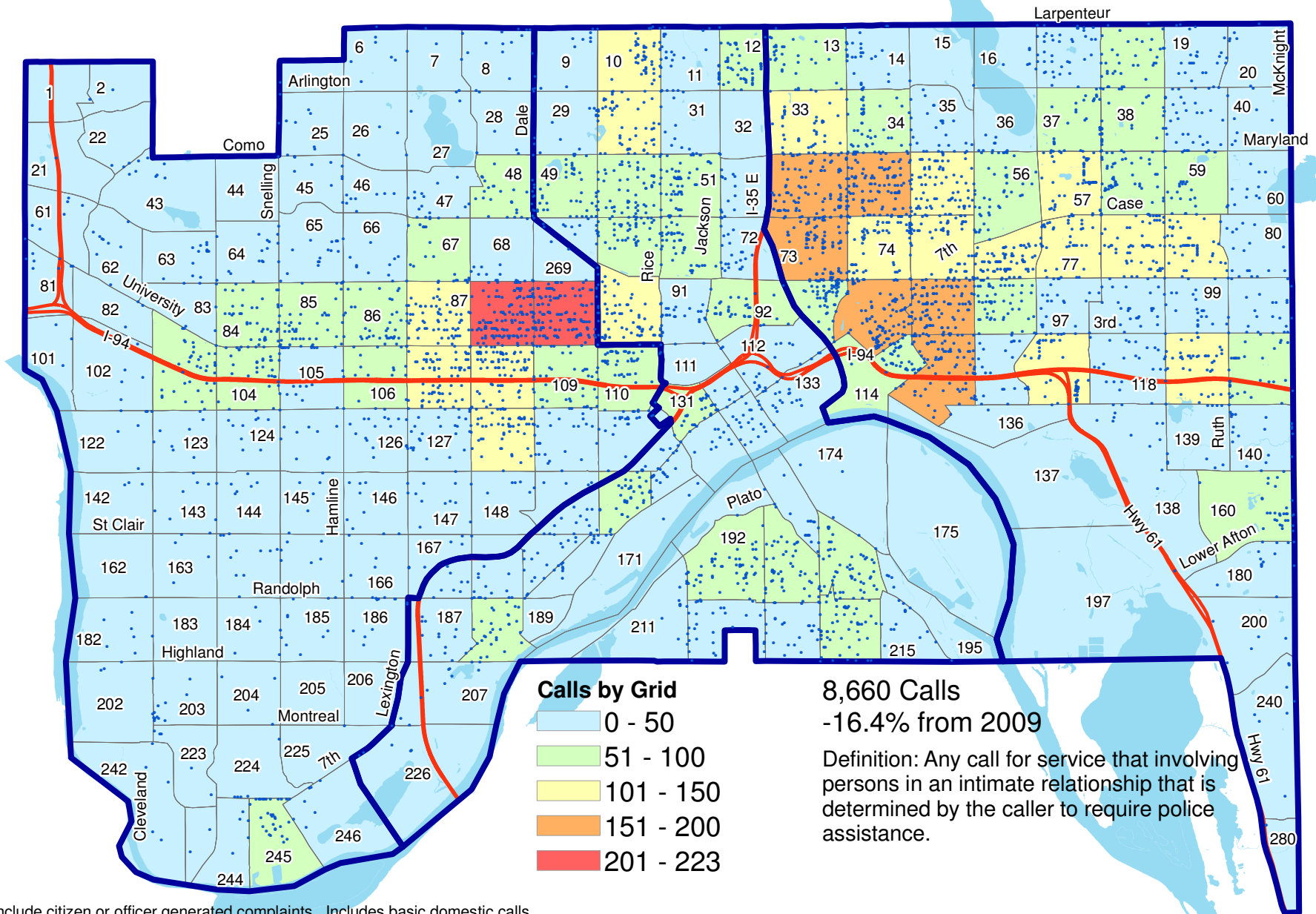

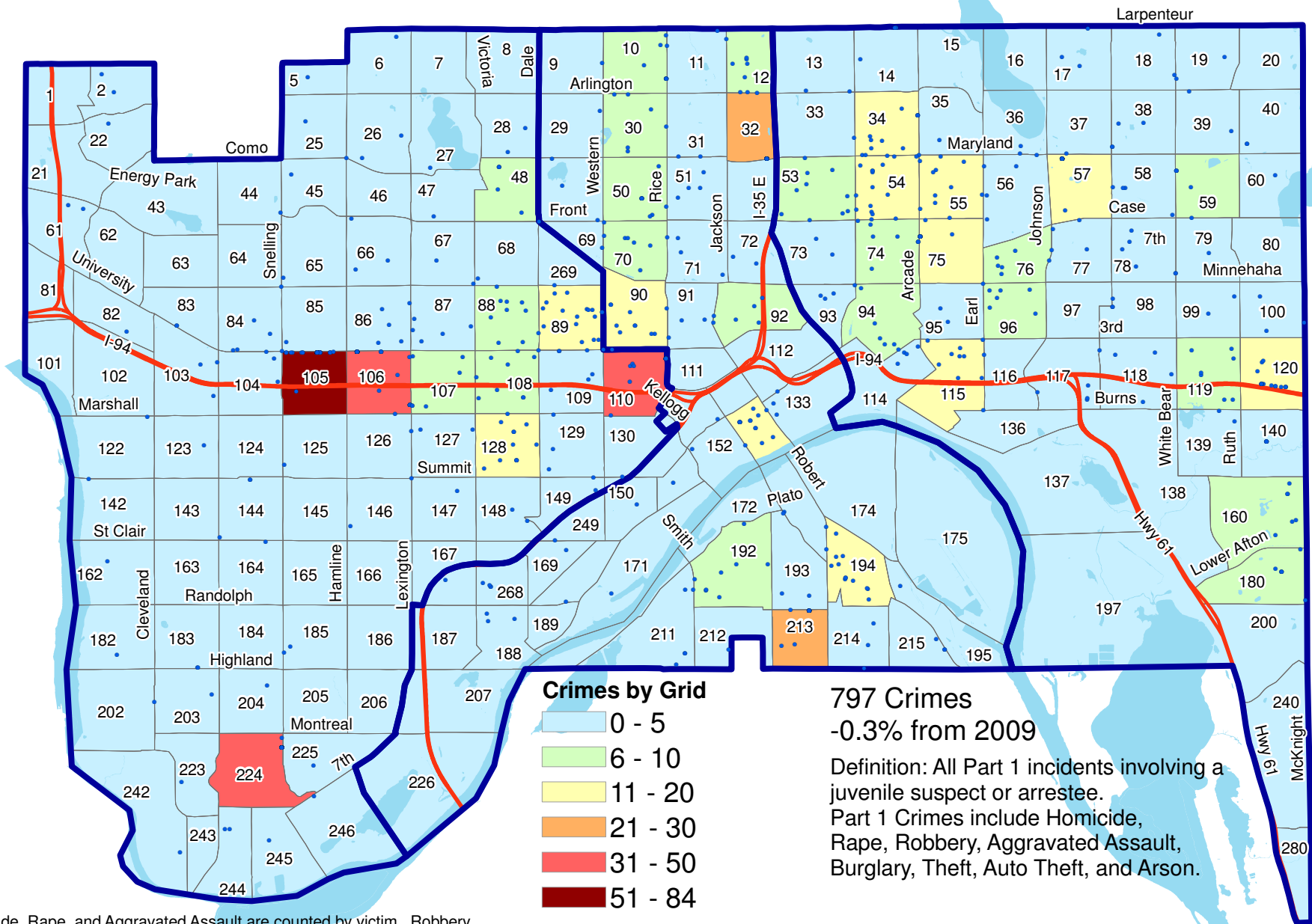
