Rape

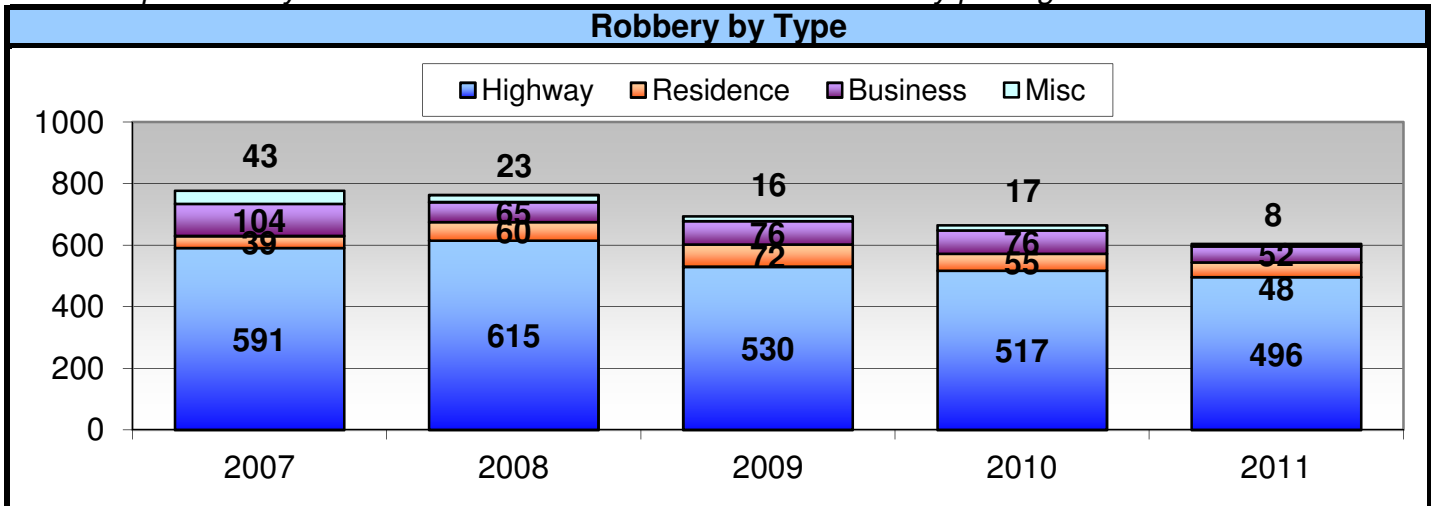
Definition: The carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will.



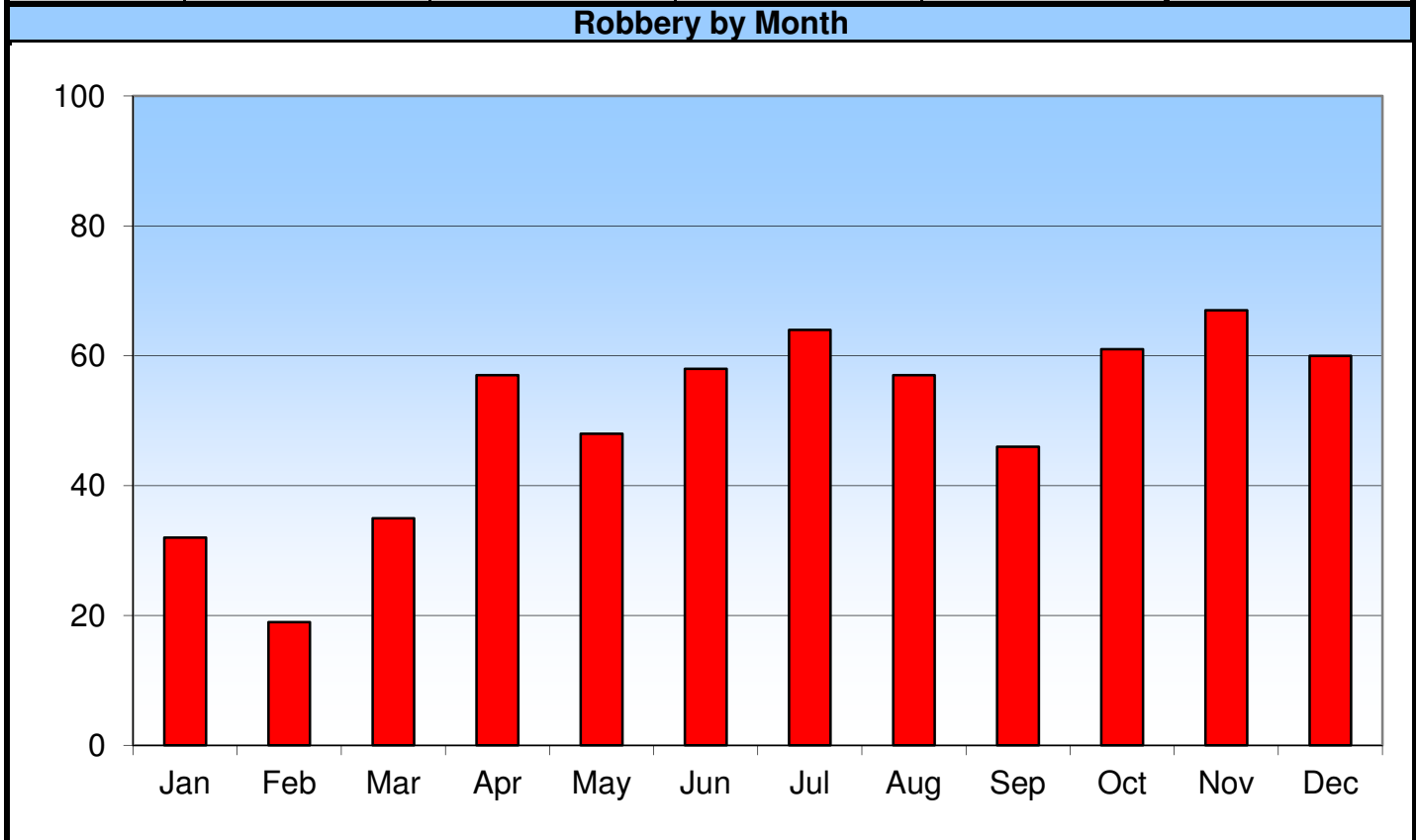

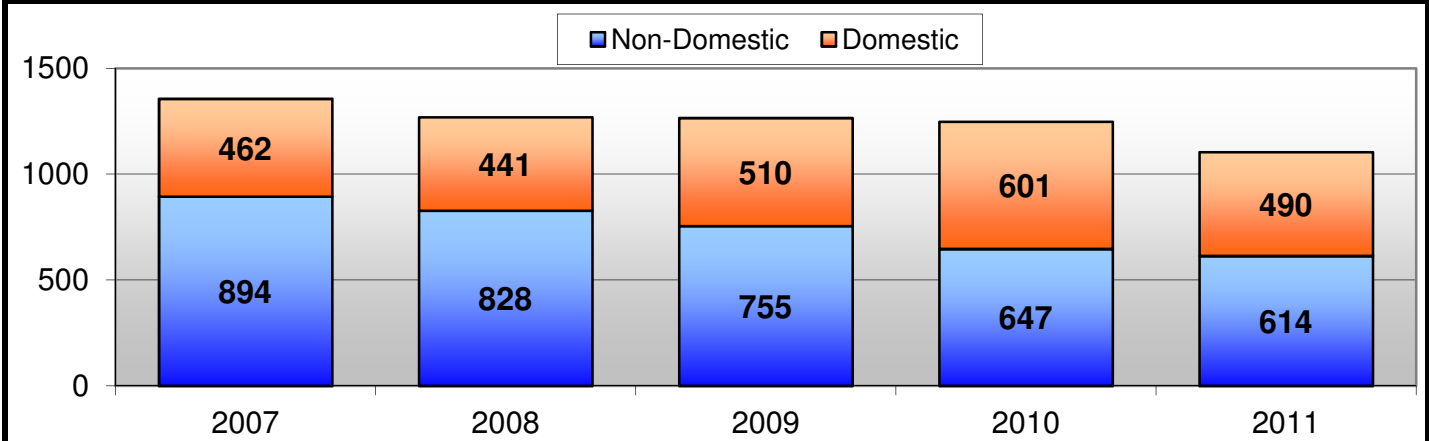

Definition: Attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury.

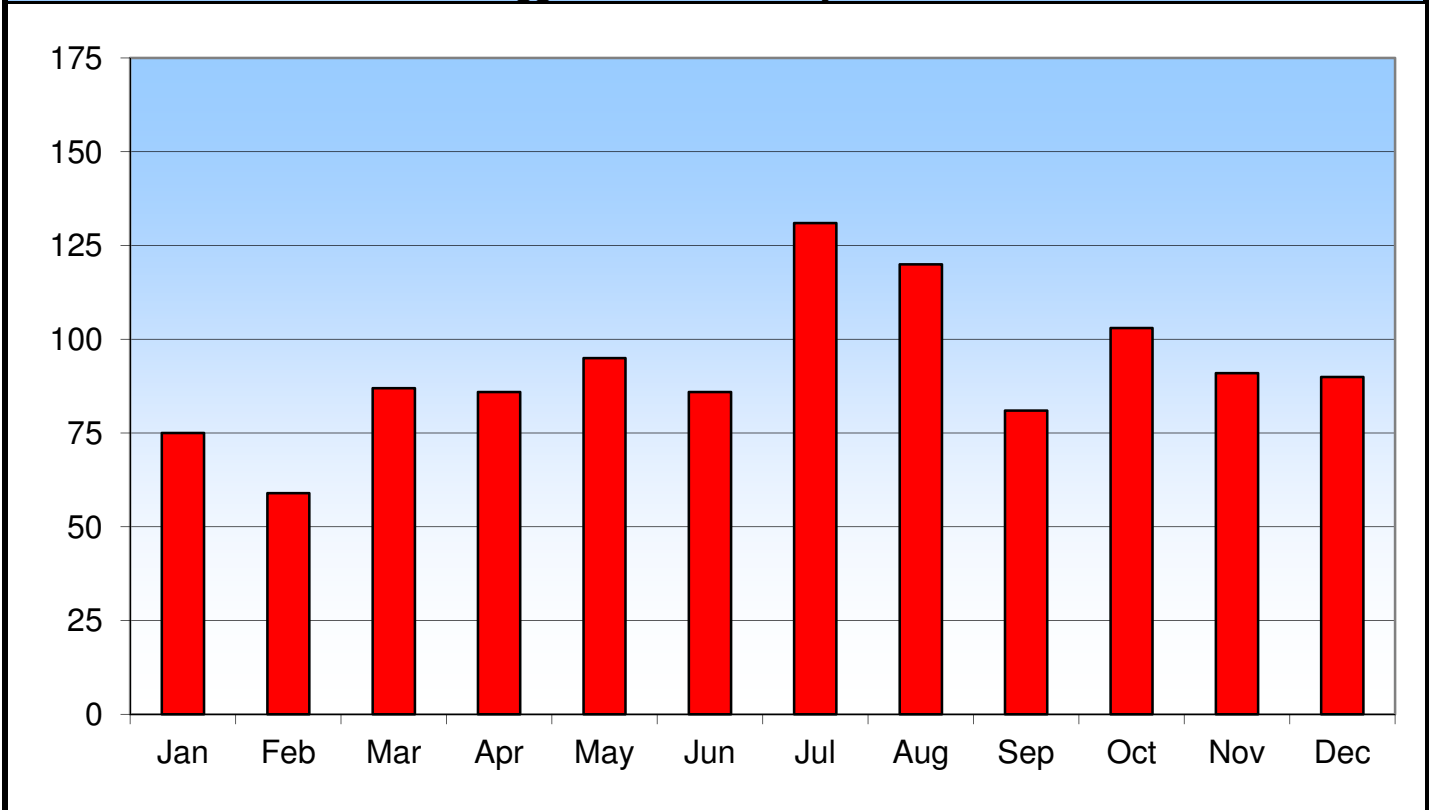
Aggravated Assault by Type

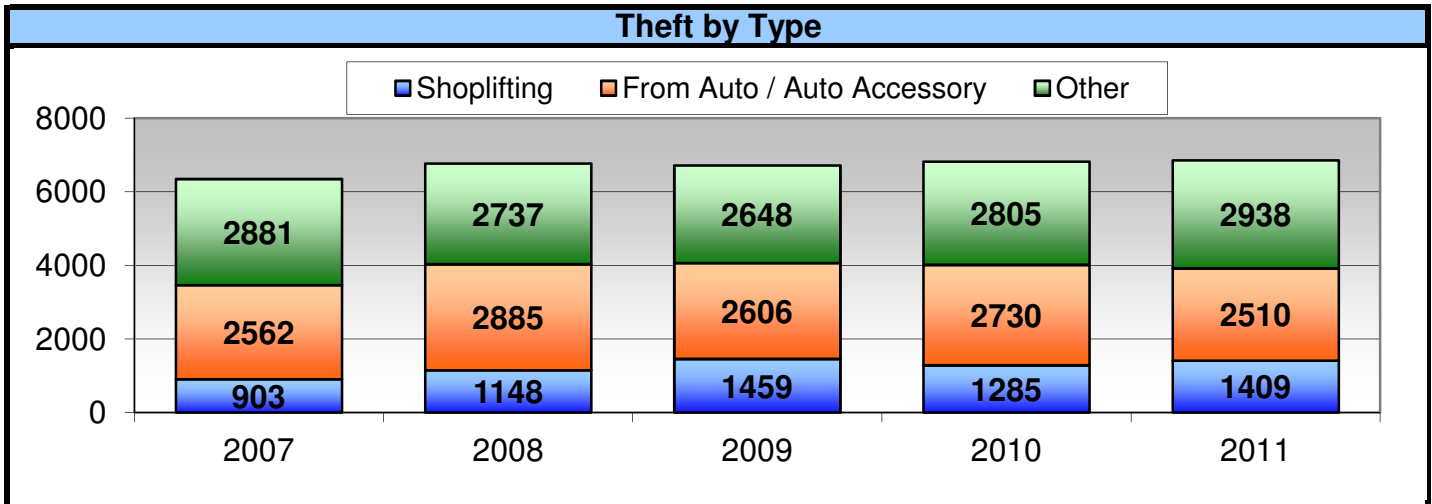
Aggravated Assault by Month



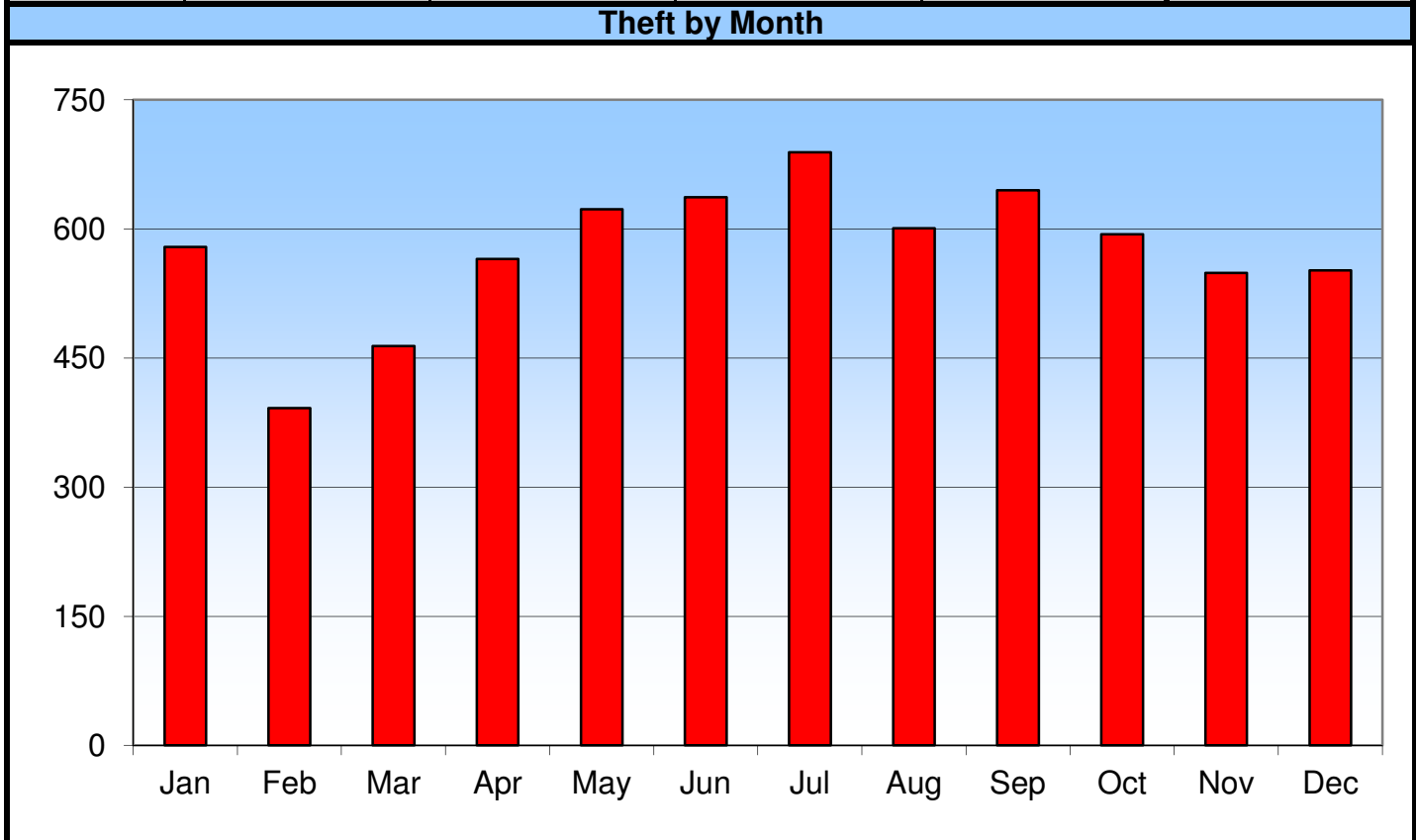

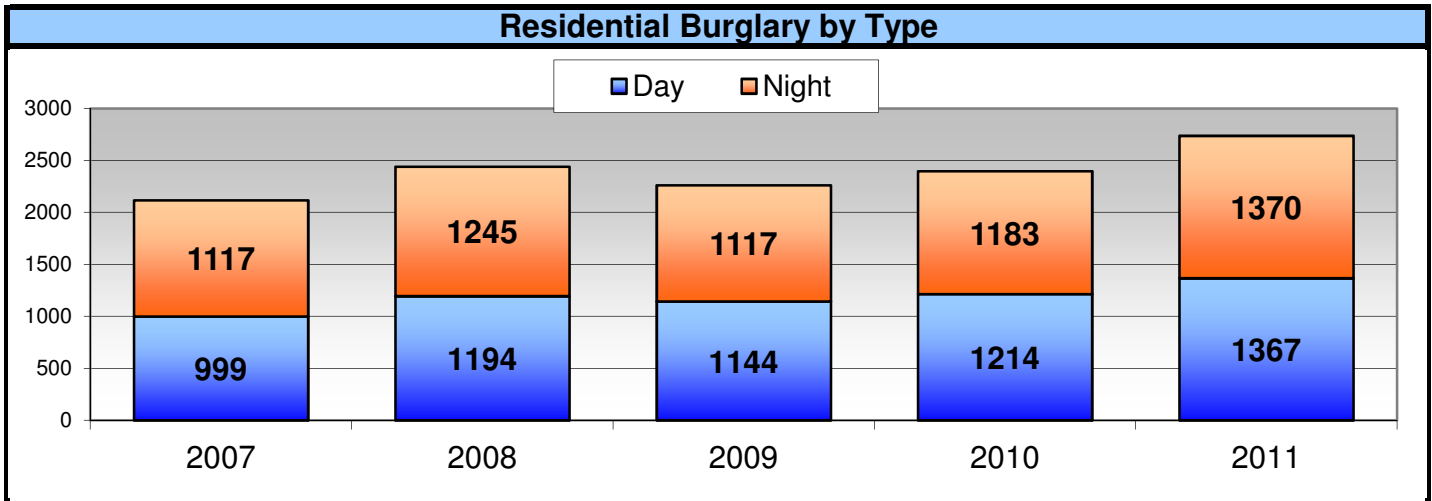

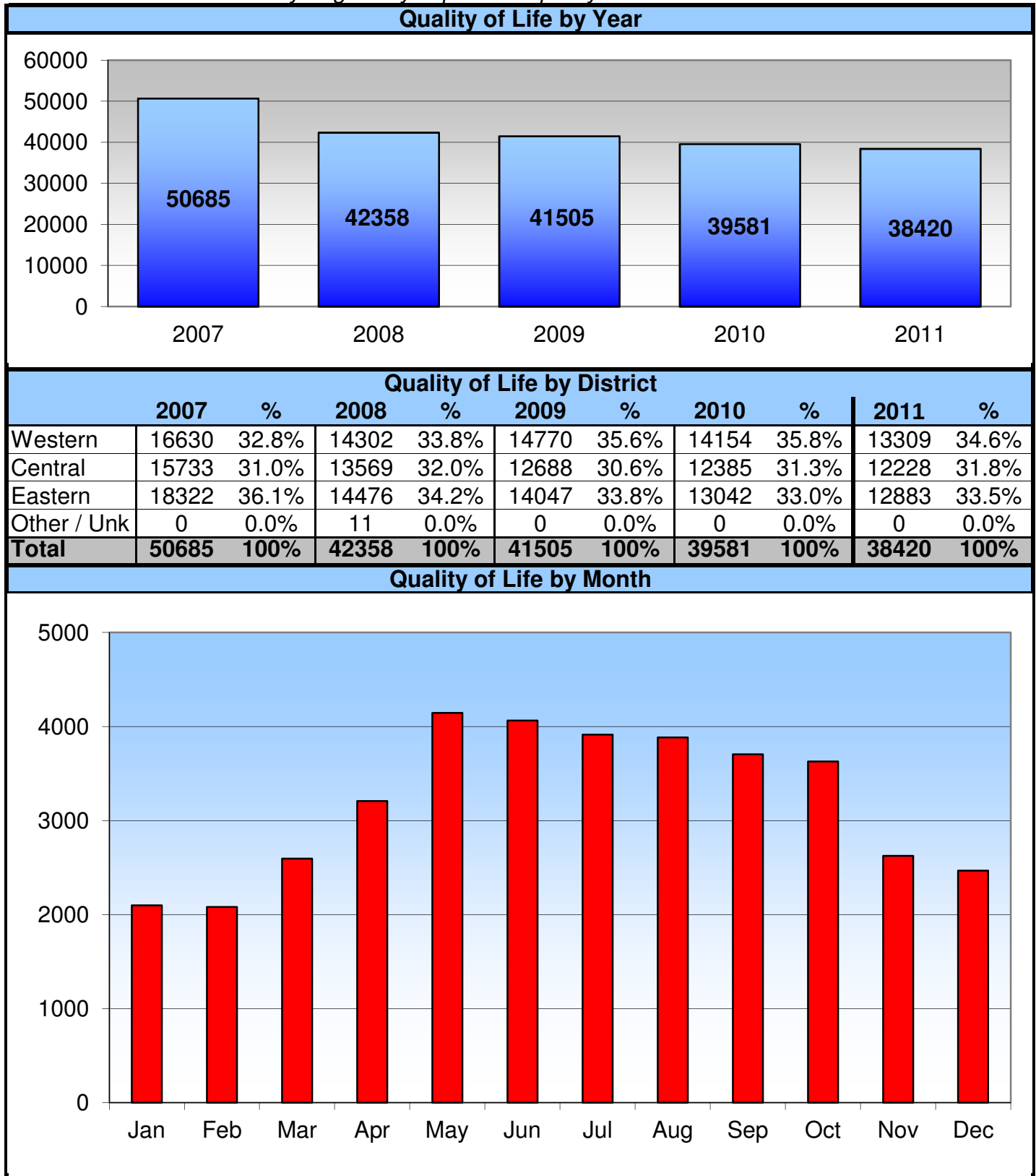

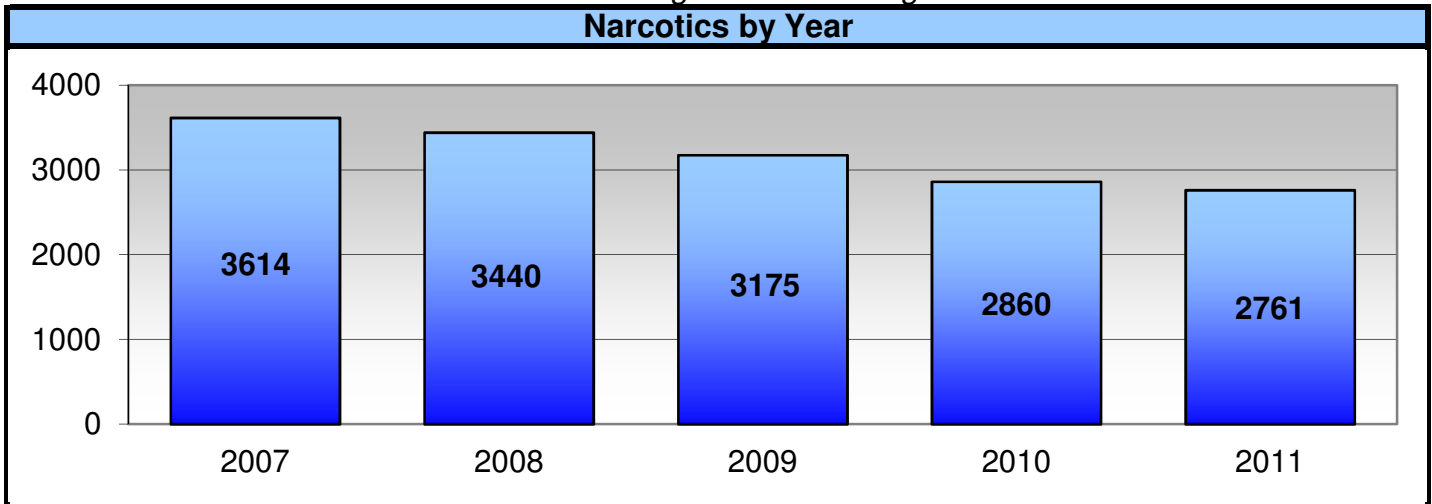

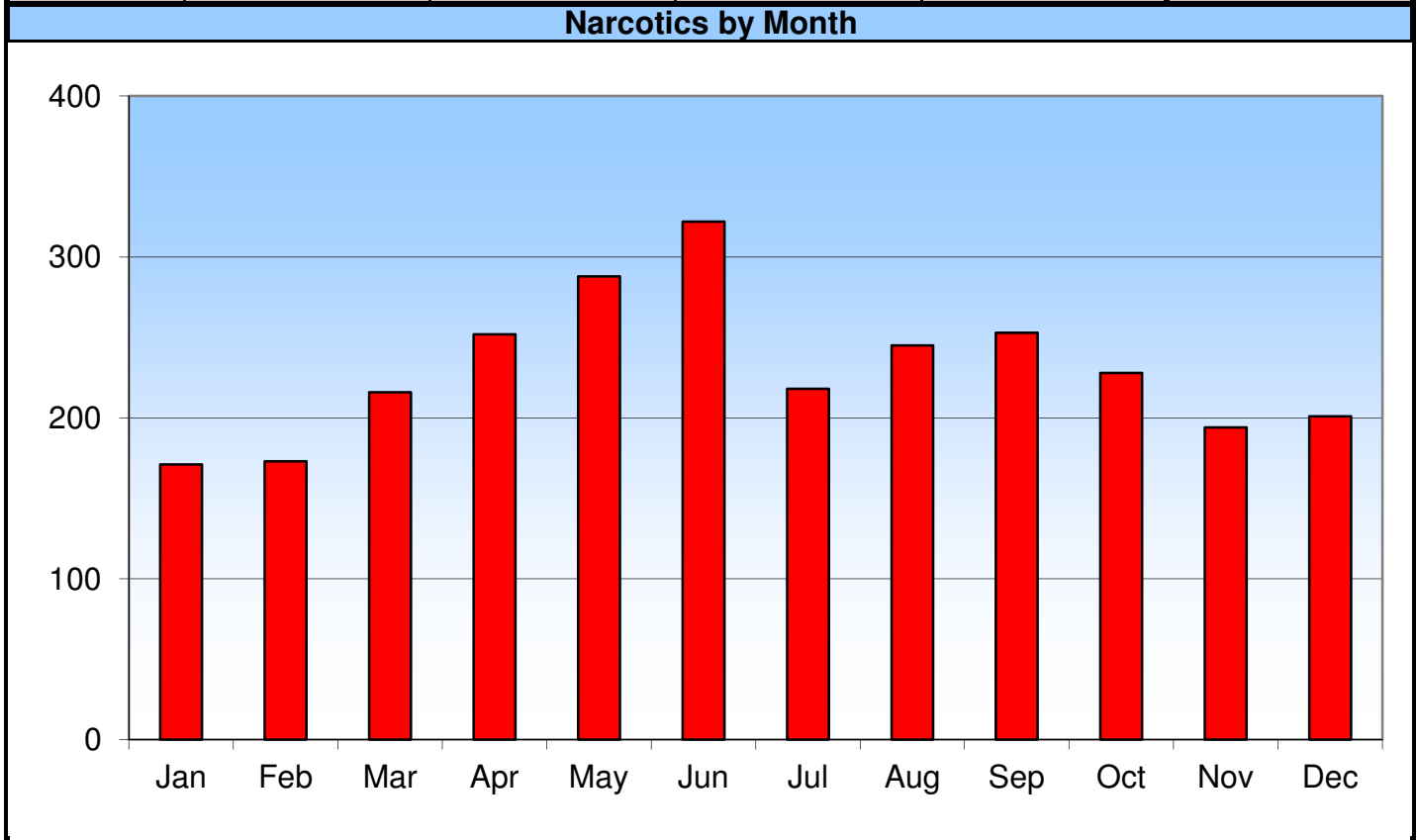

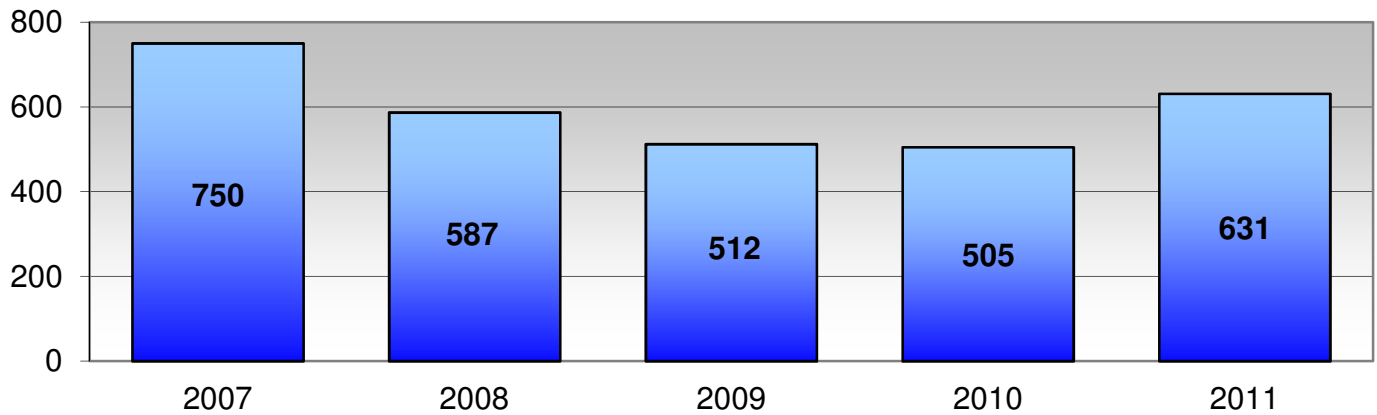

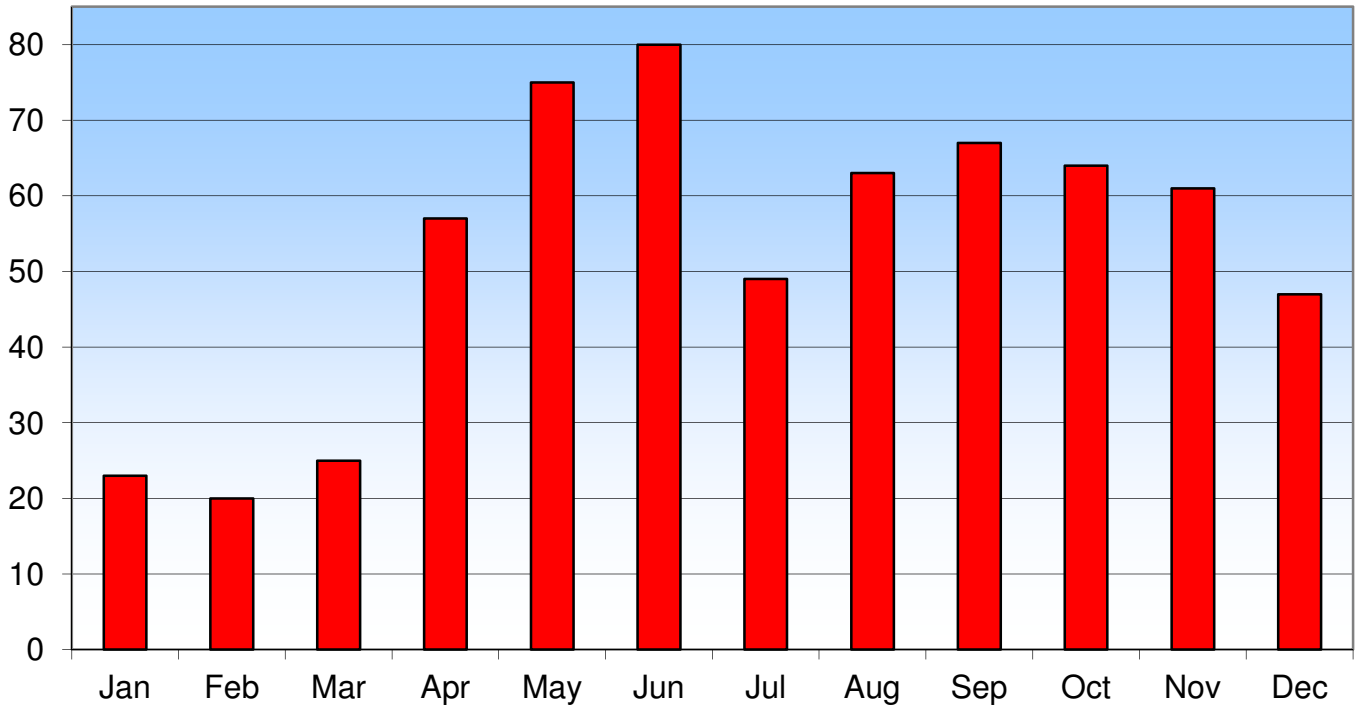
Weapon Discharge by Year

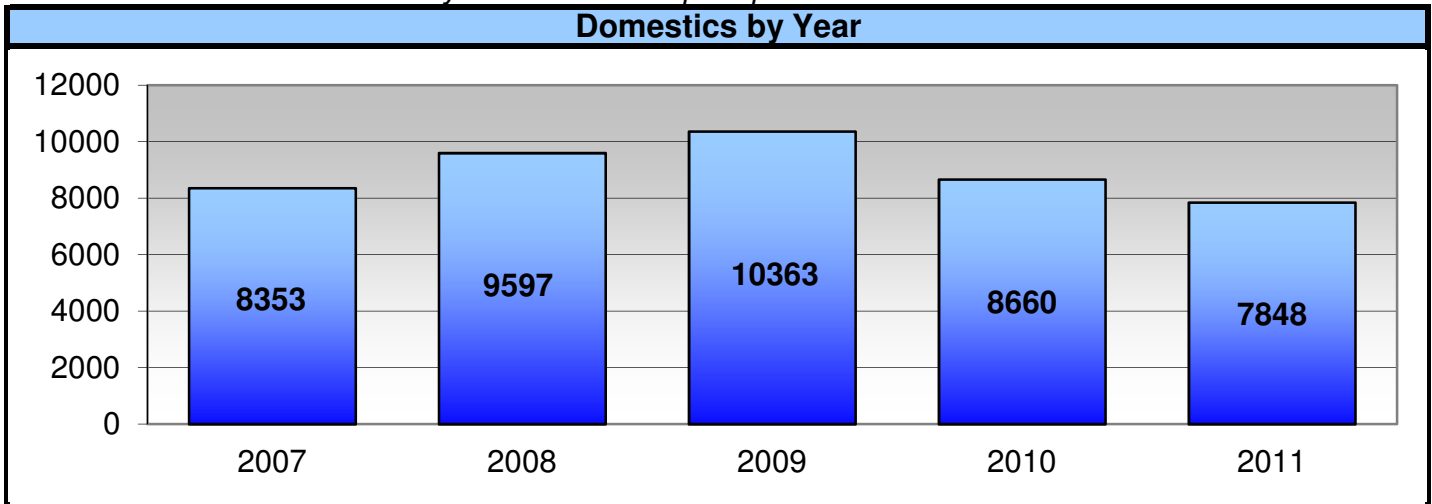
Weapon Discharge by Month



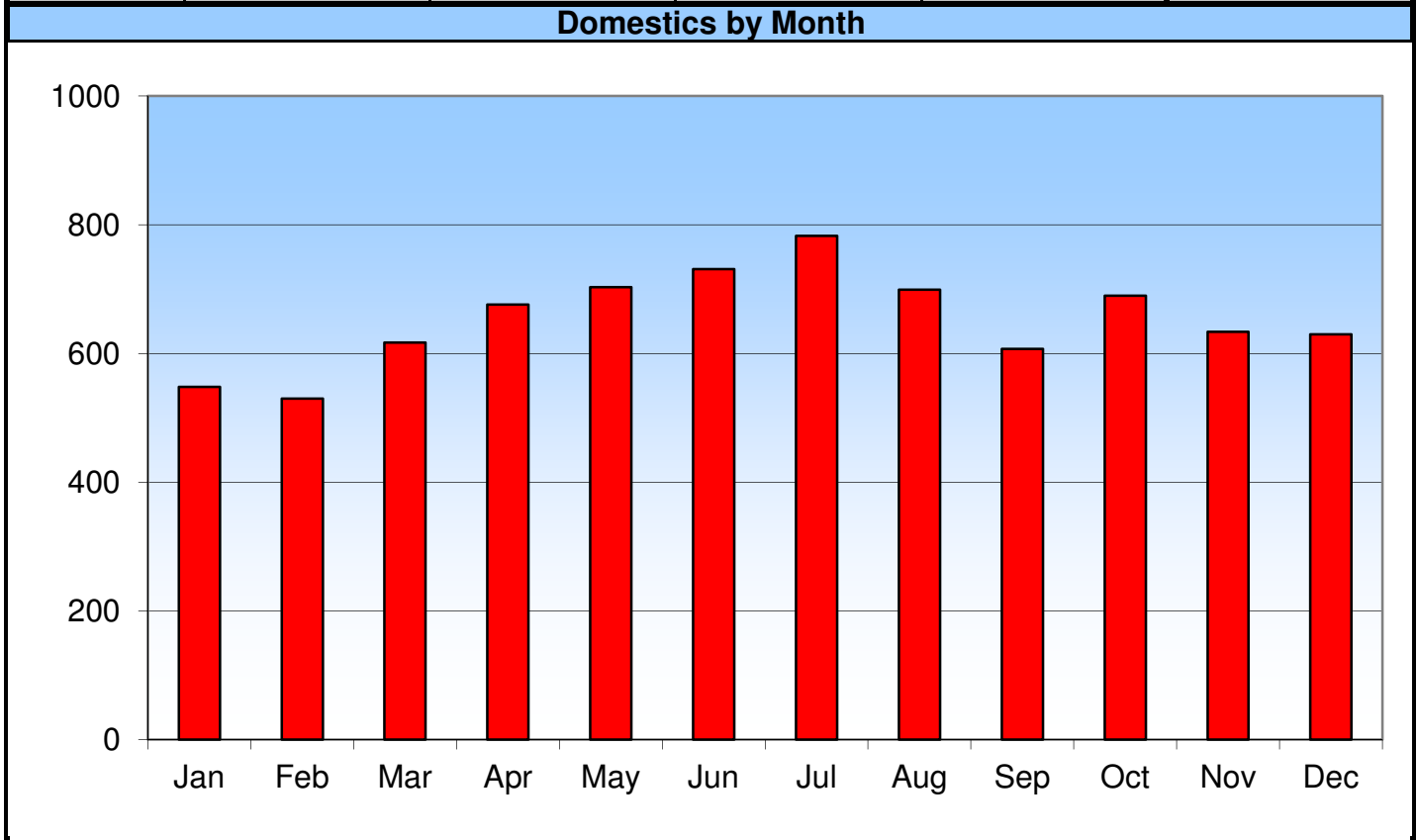

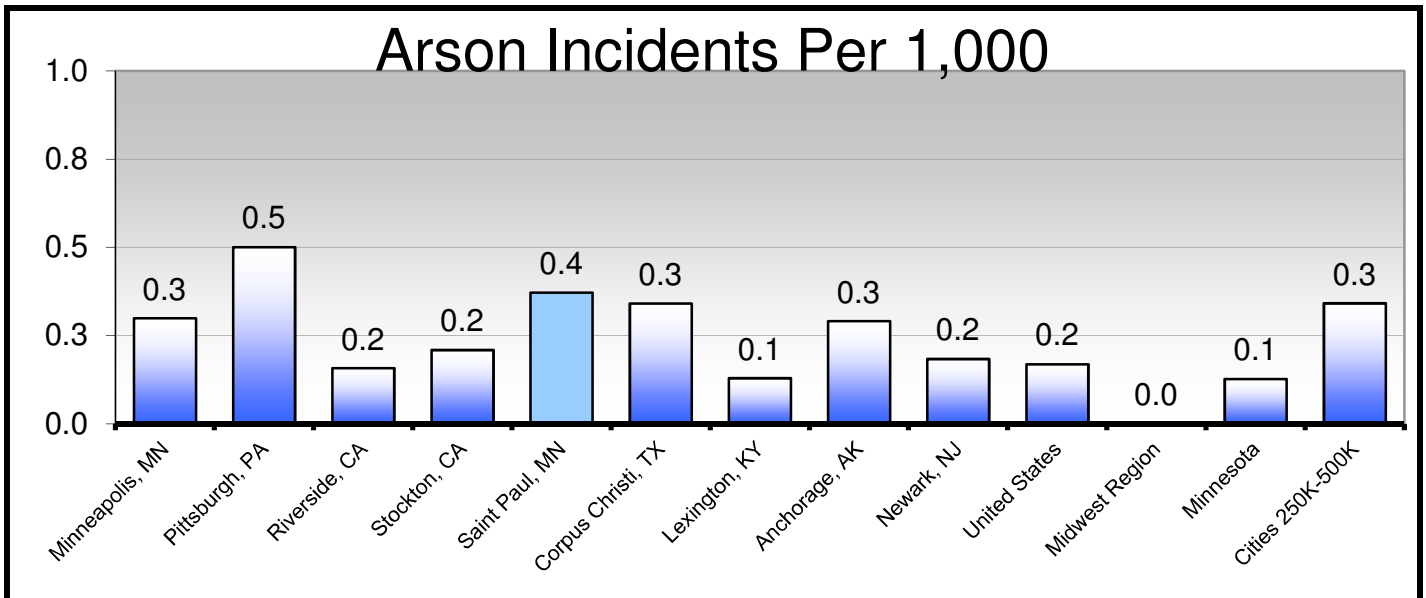
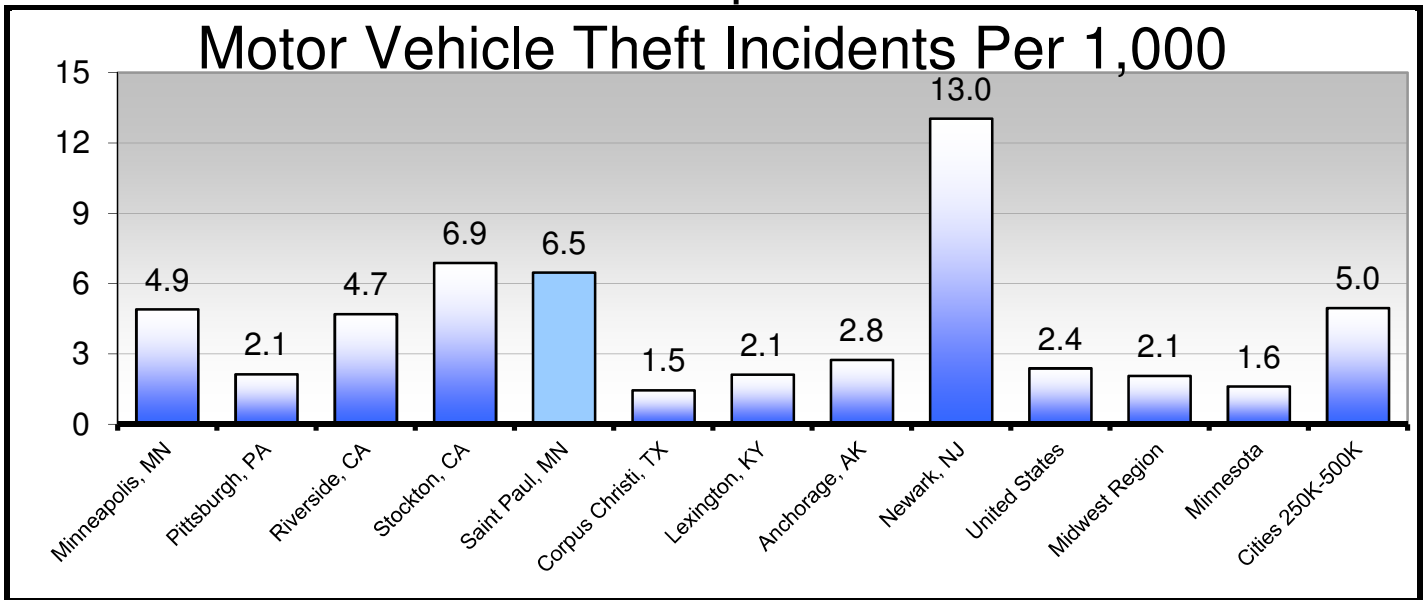
Part 1 Crime Total Comparison to Other Cities

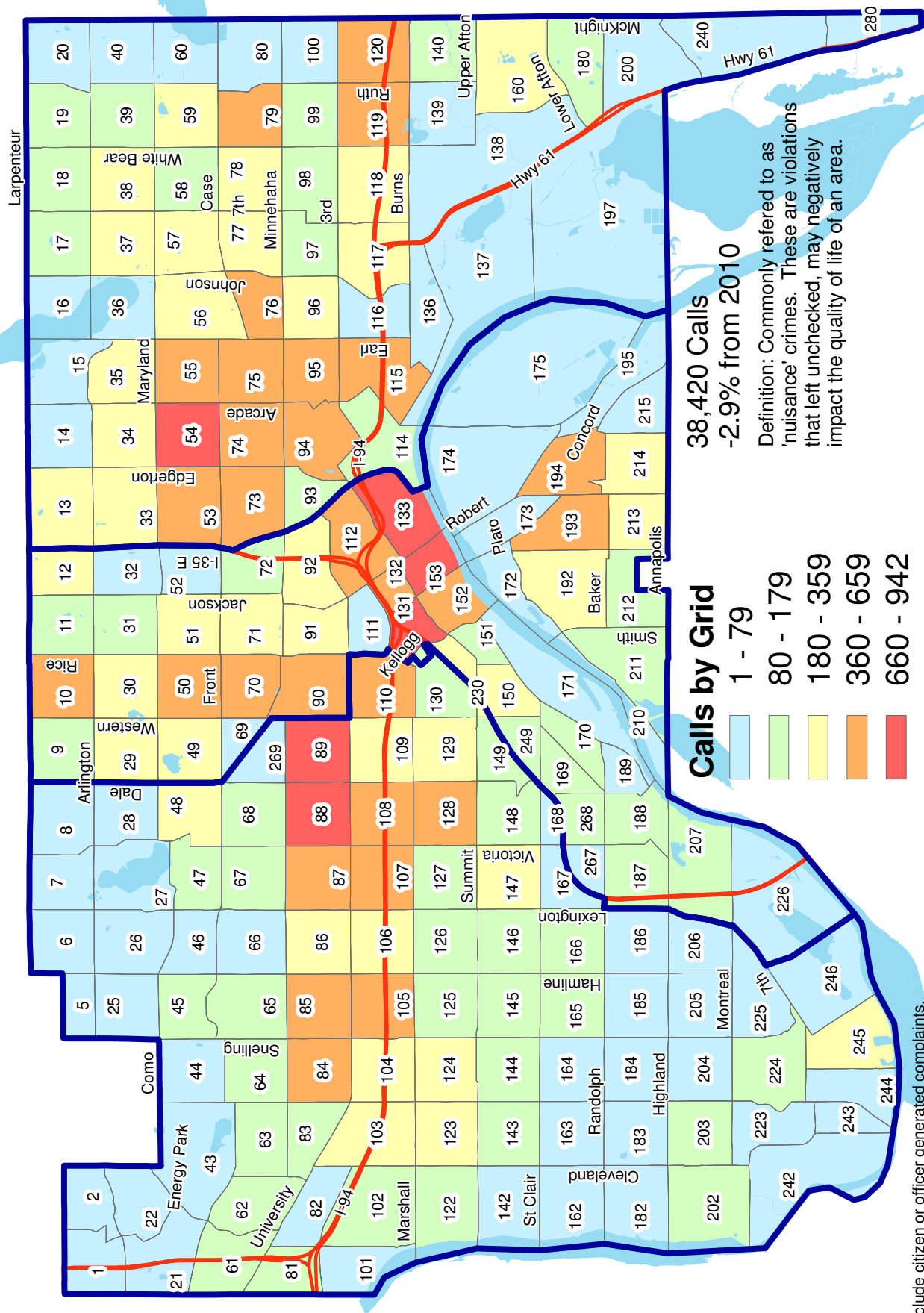

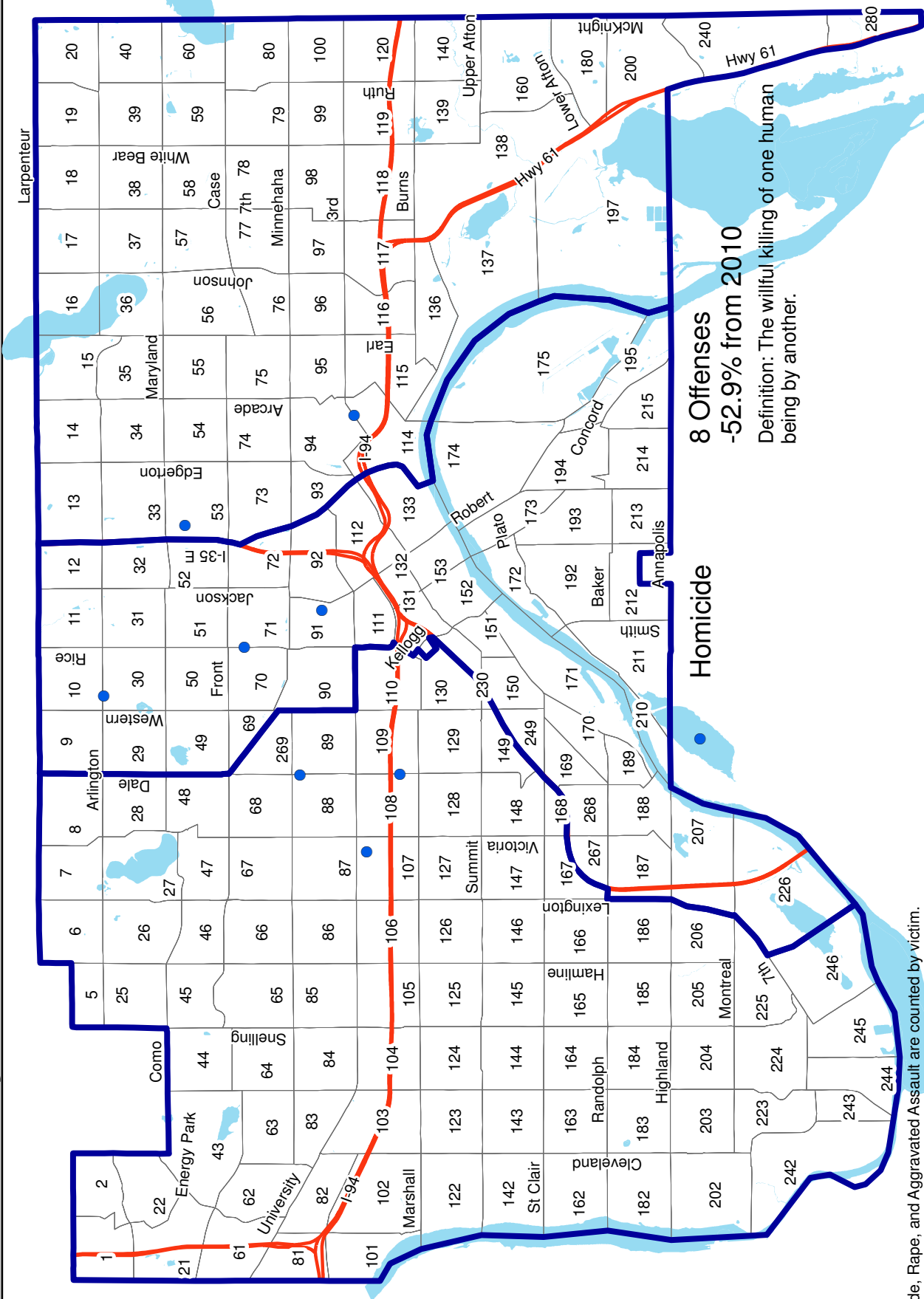

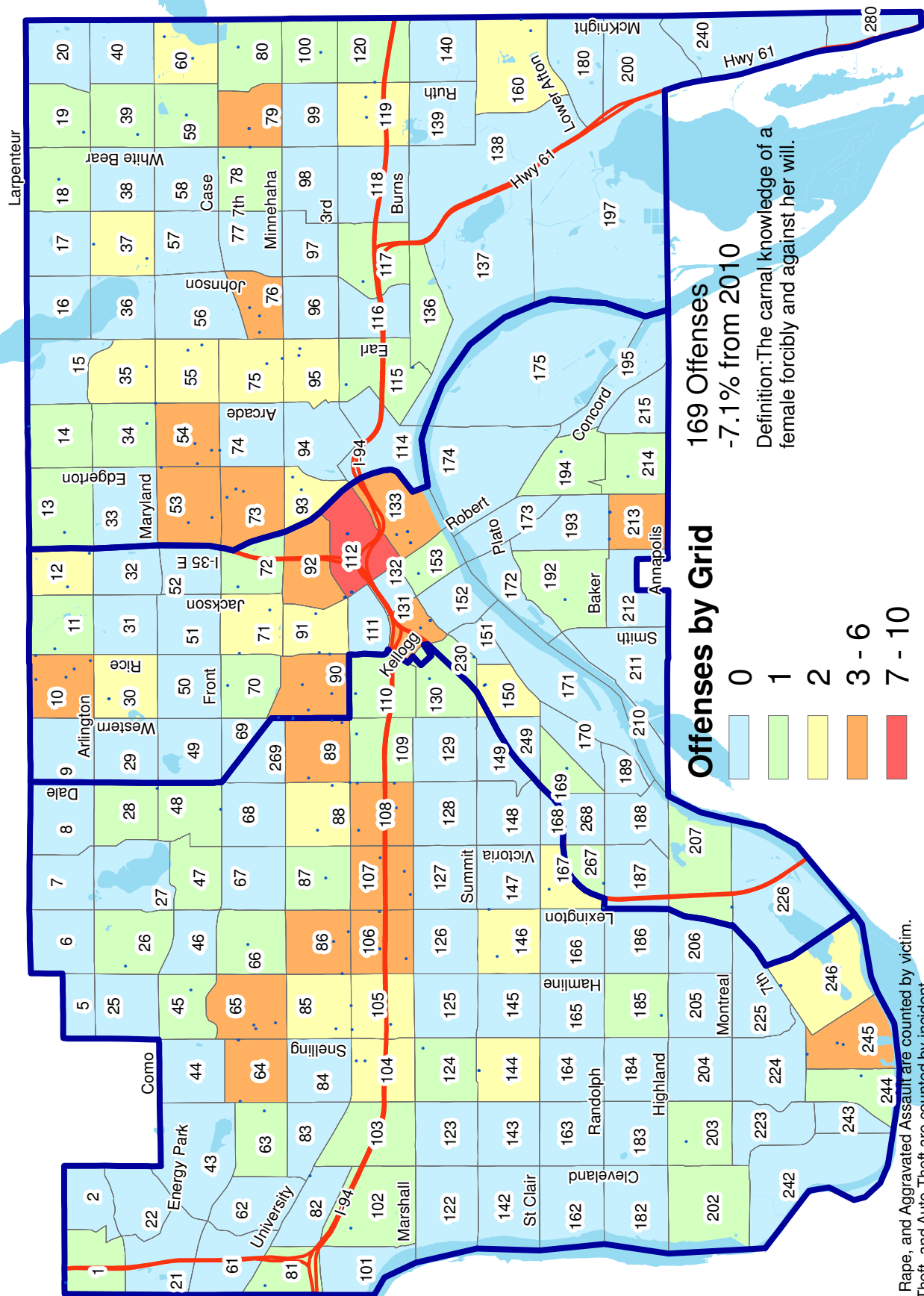


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City of Saint Paul: Homicide Offenses: 2011

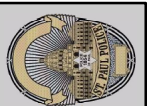


City of Saint Paul: Rape Offenses: 2011



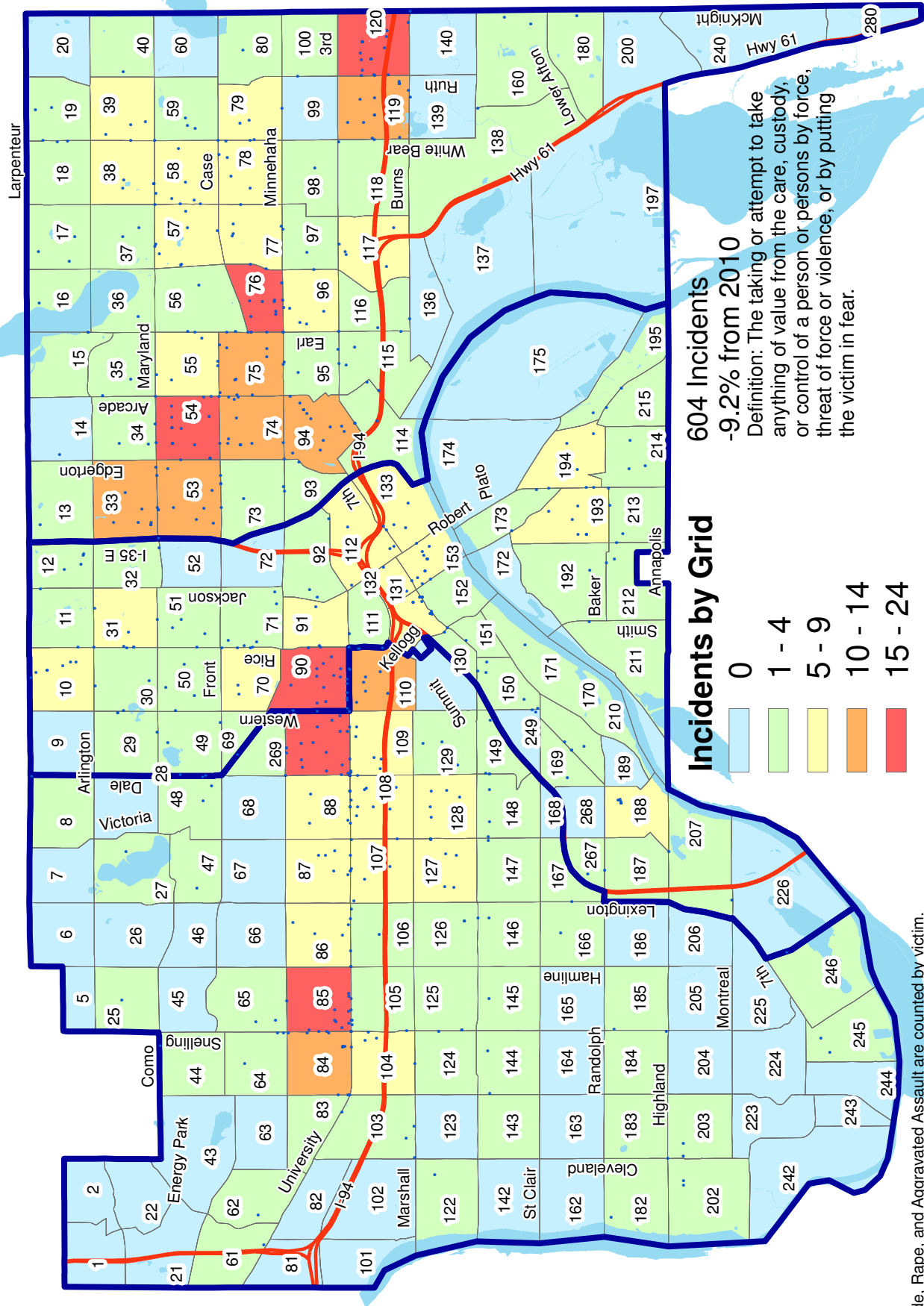

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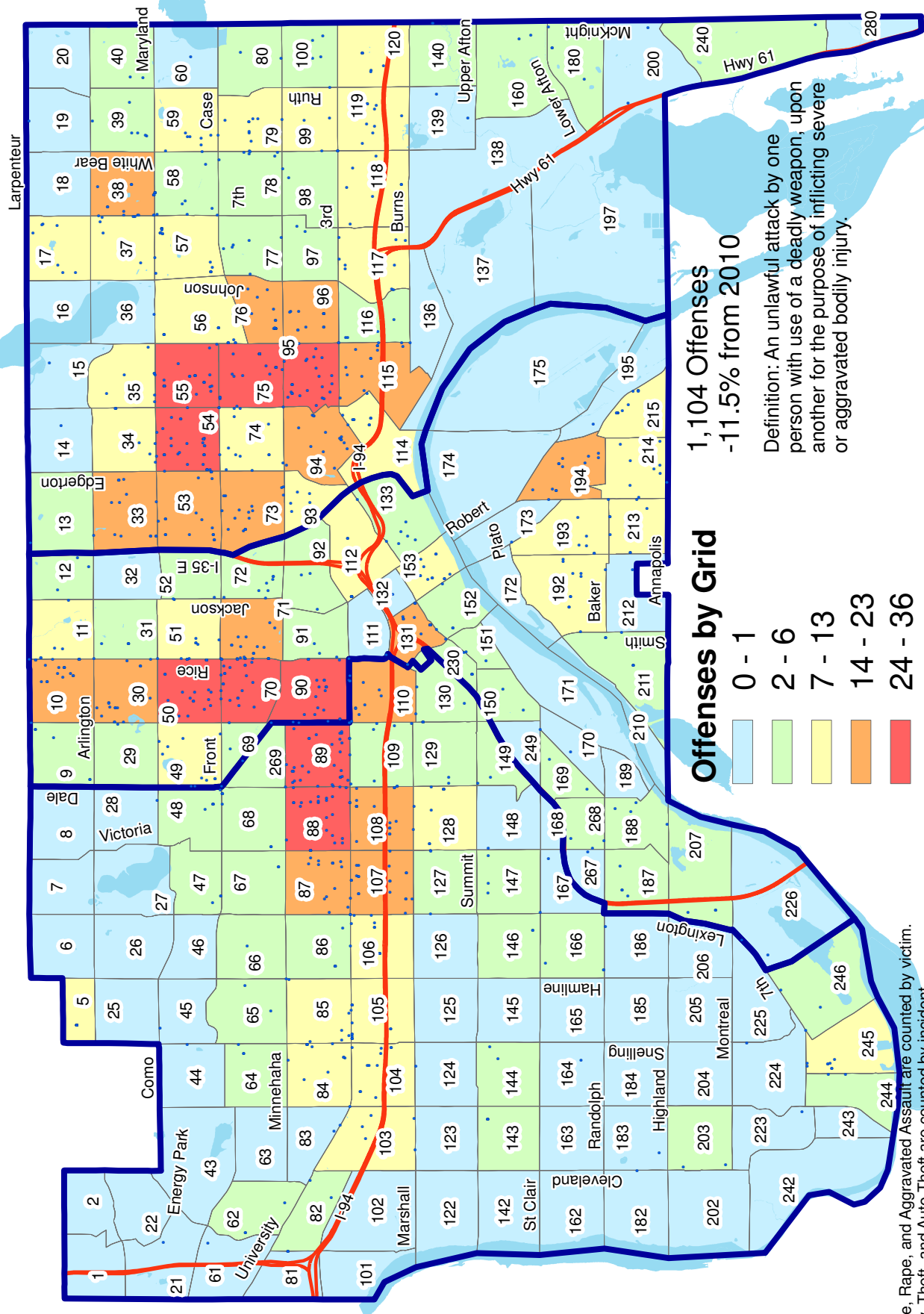
City of Saint Paul: Robbery Incidents: 2011

City of Saint Paul: Aggravated Assault Offenses: 2011

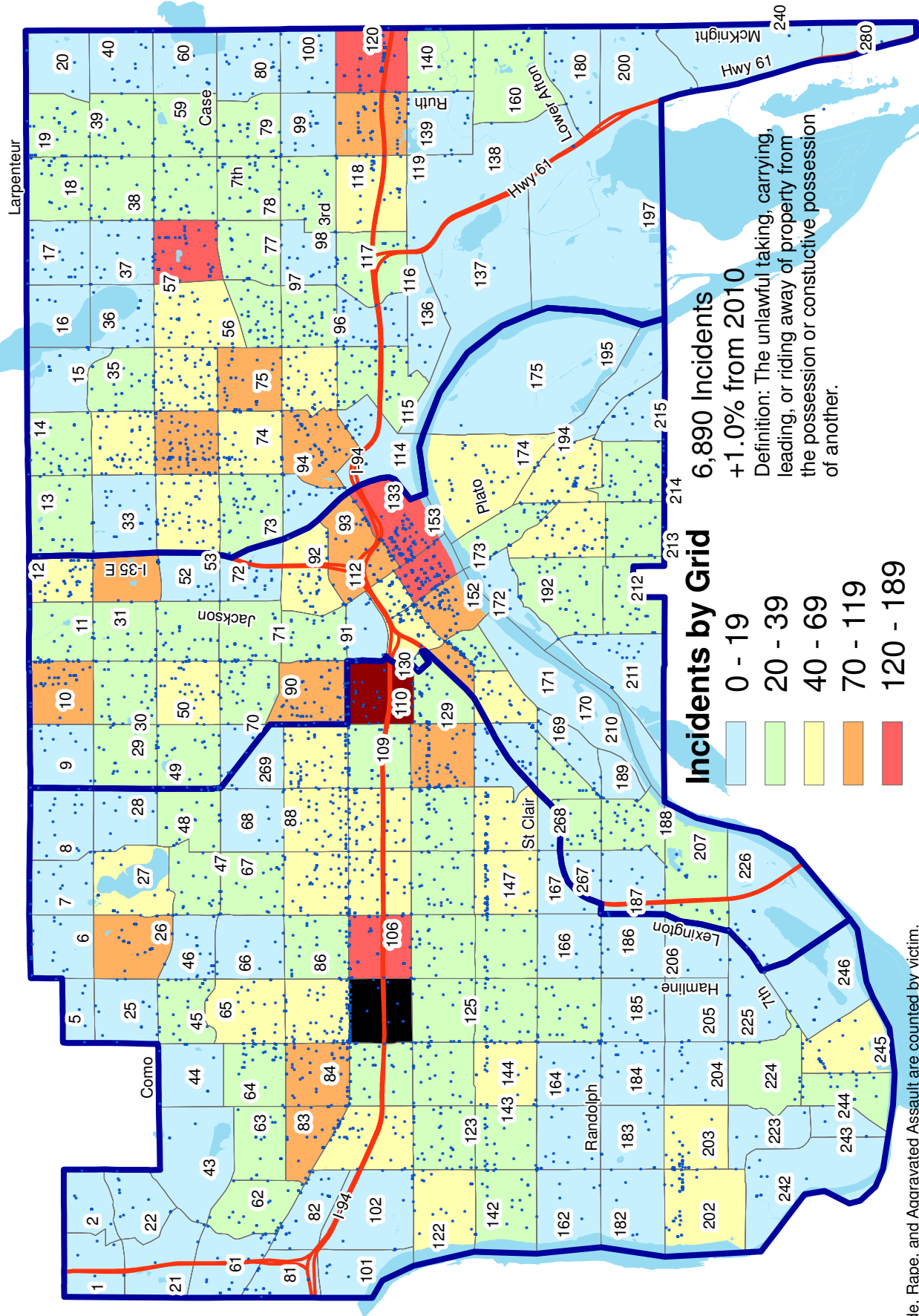

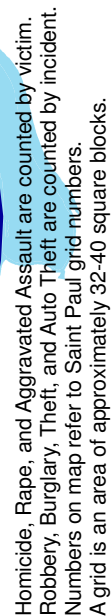
City of Saint Paul: Theft Incidents: 2011

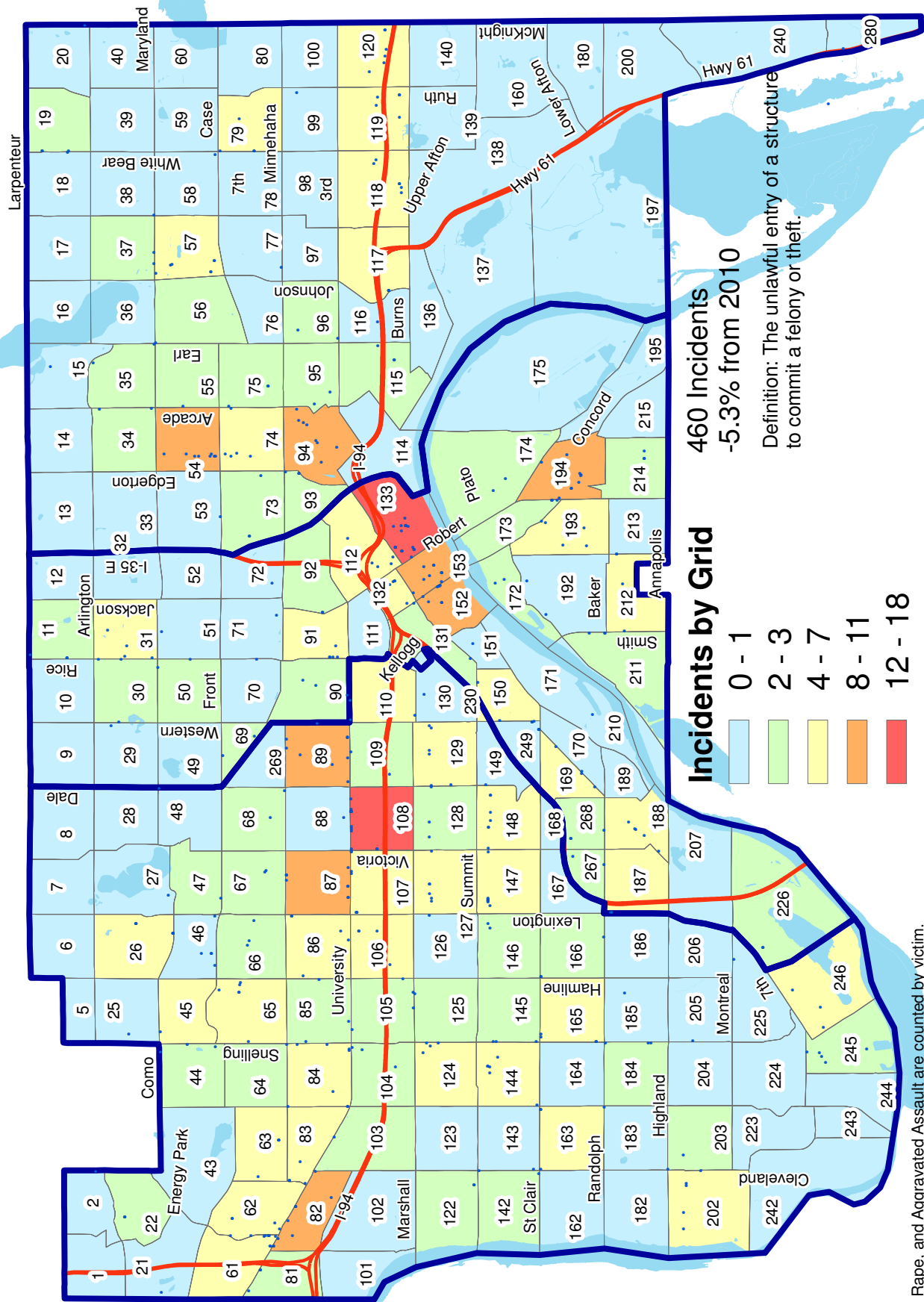

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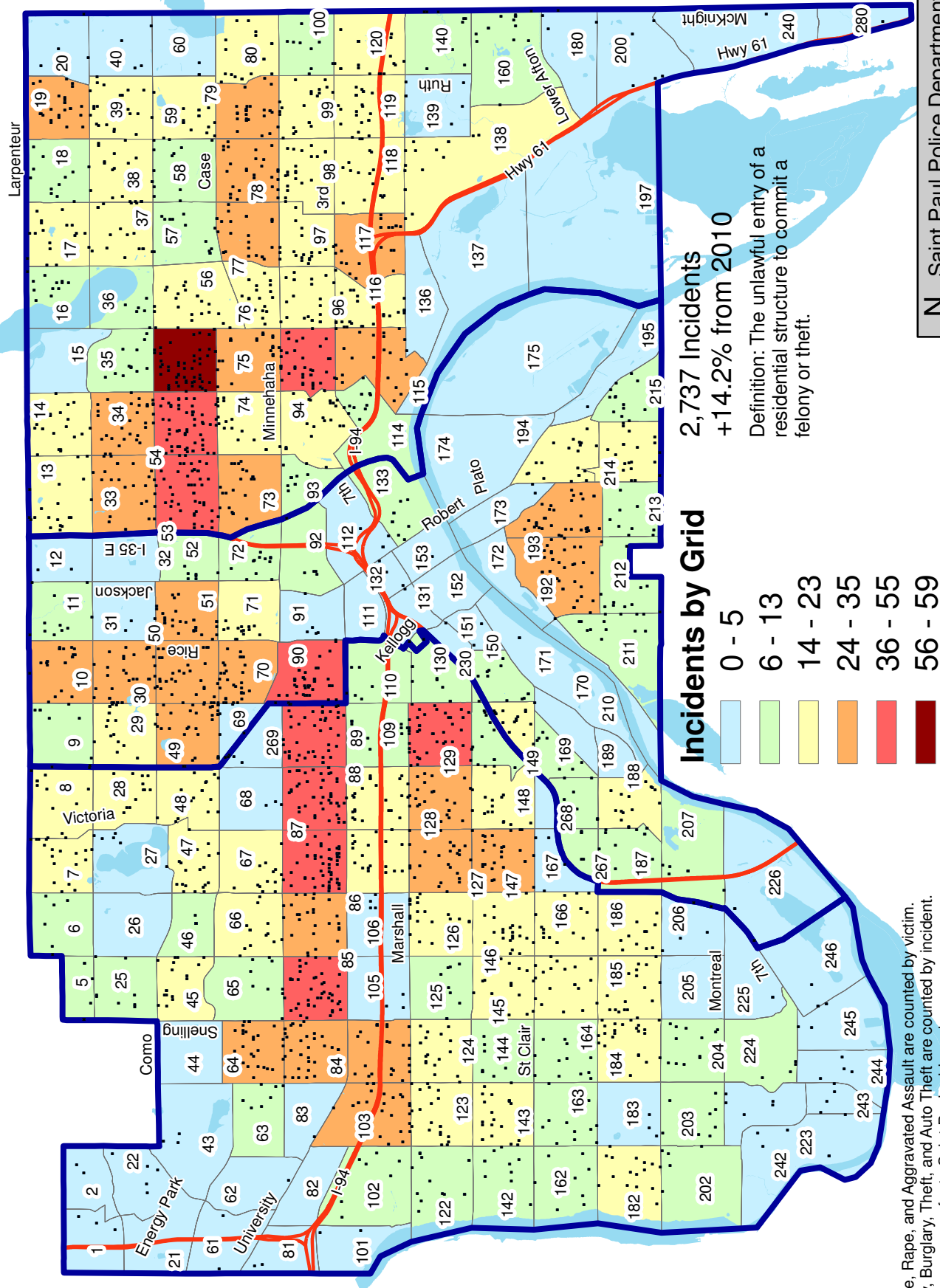
City of Saint Paul: Commercial Burglary Incidents: 2011

City of Saint Paul: Residential Burglary Incidents: 2011

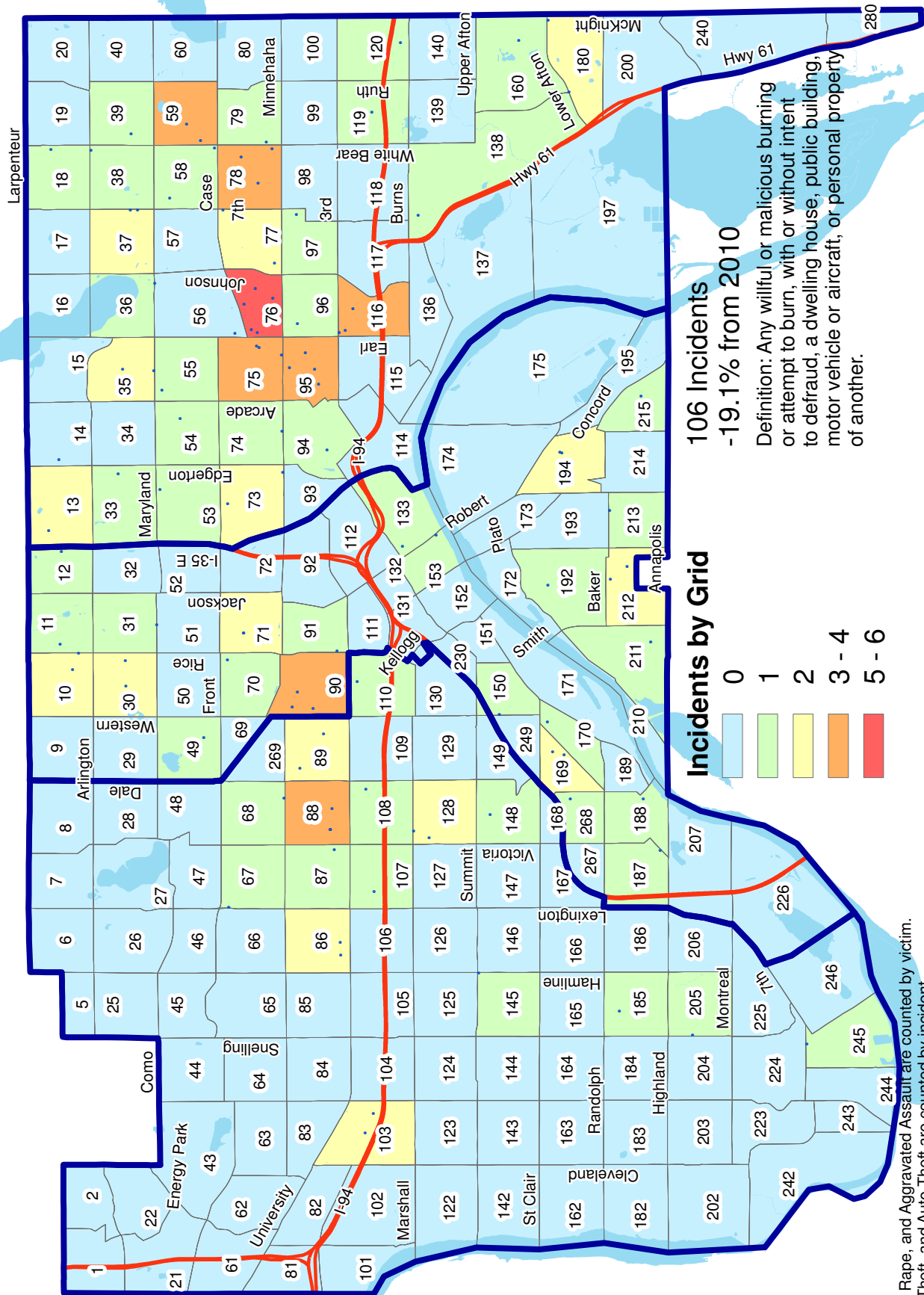

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City of Saint Paul: Arson Incidents: 2011

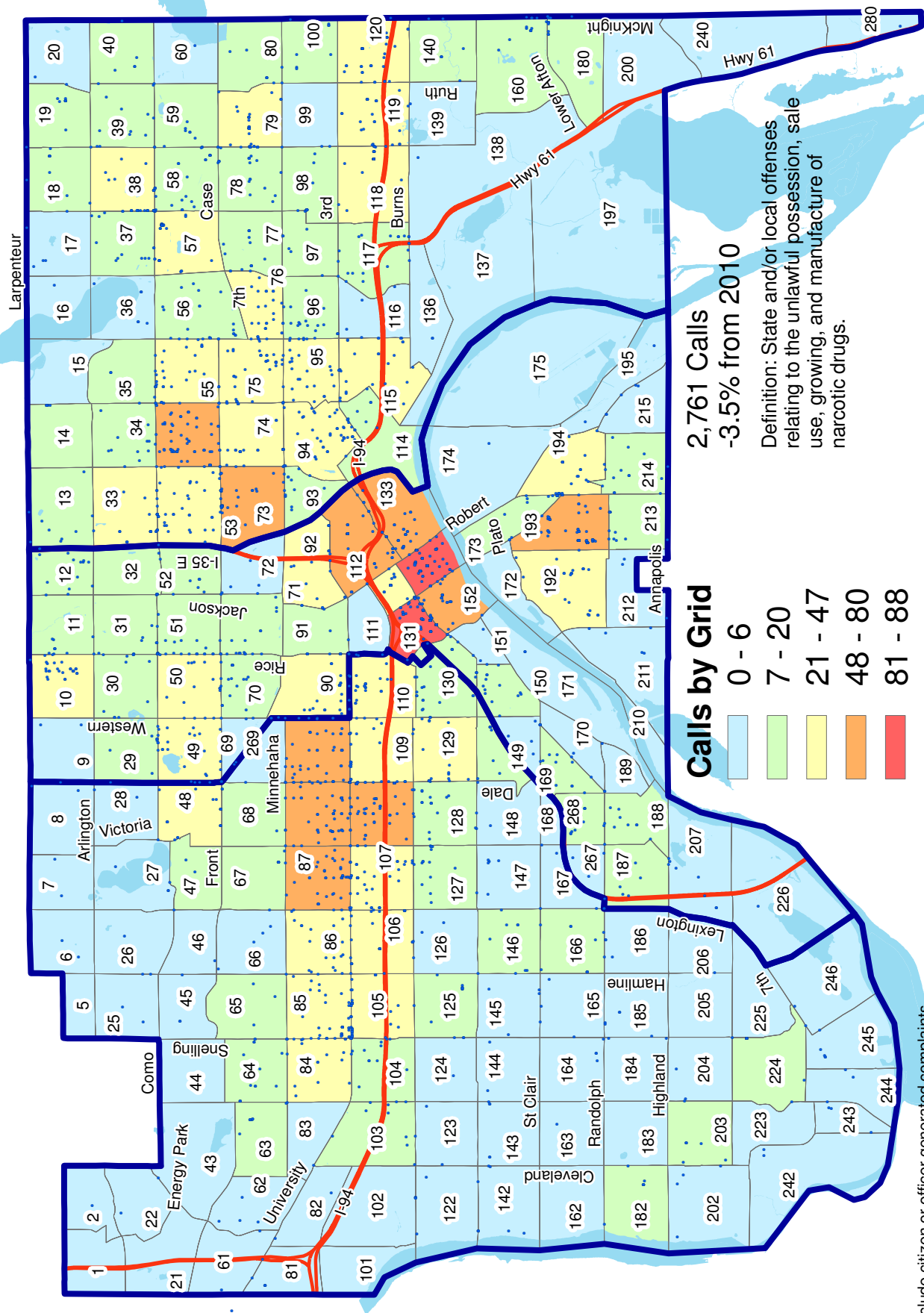

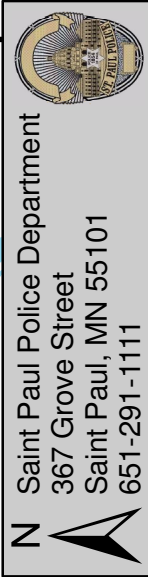


City of Saint Paul: Narcotics Calls: 2011

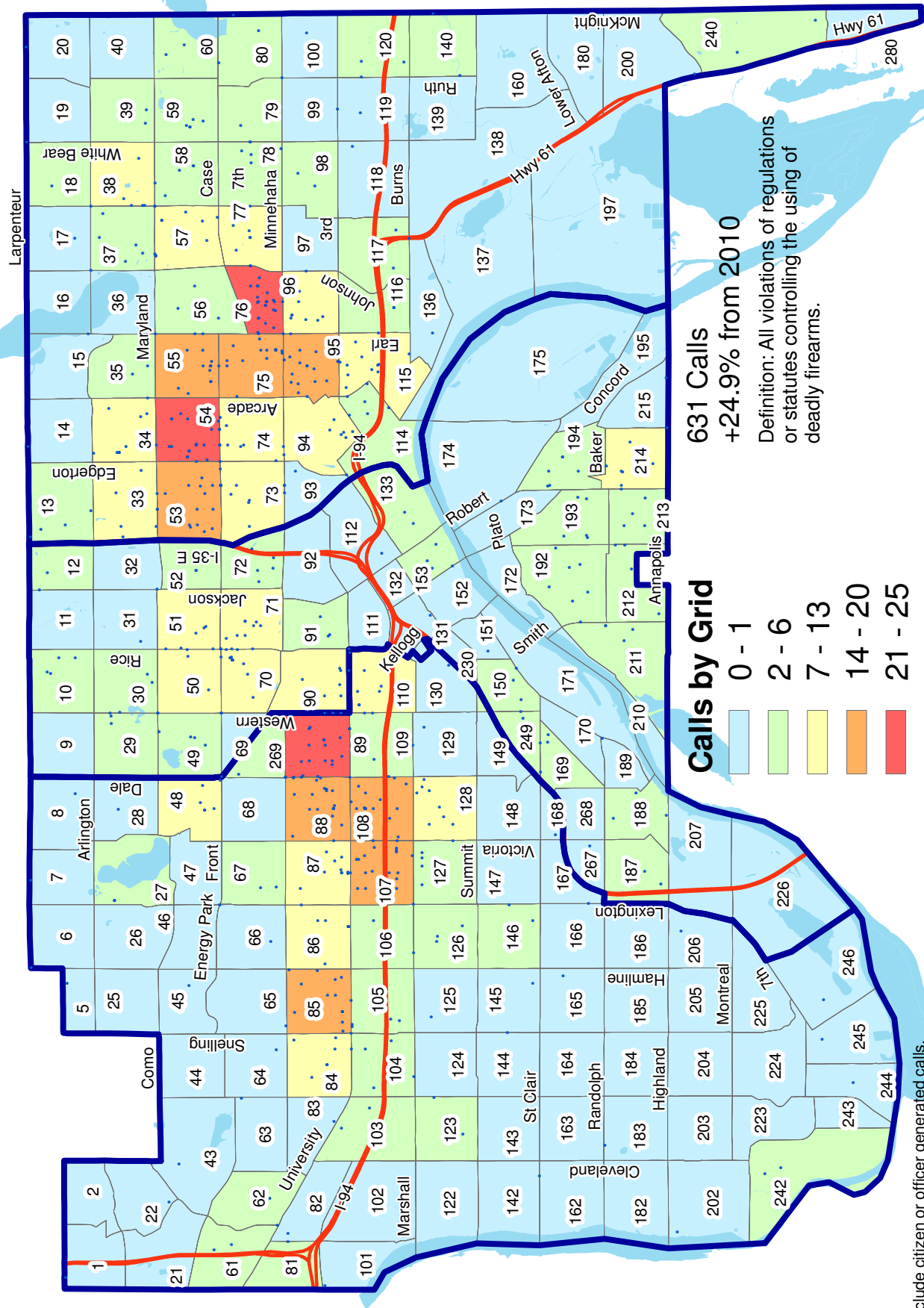

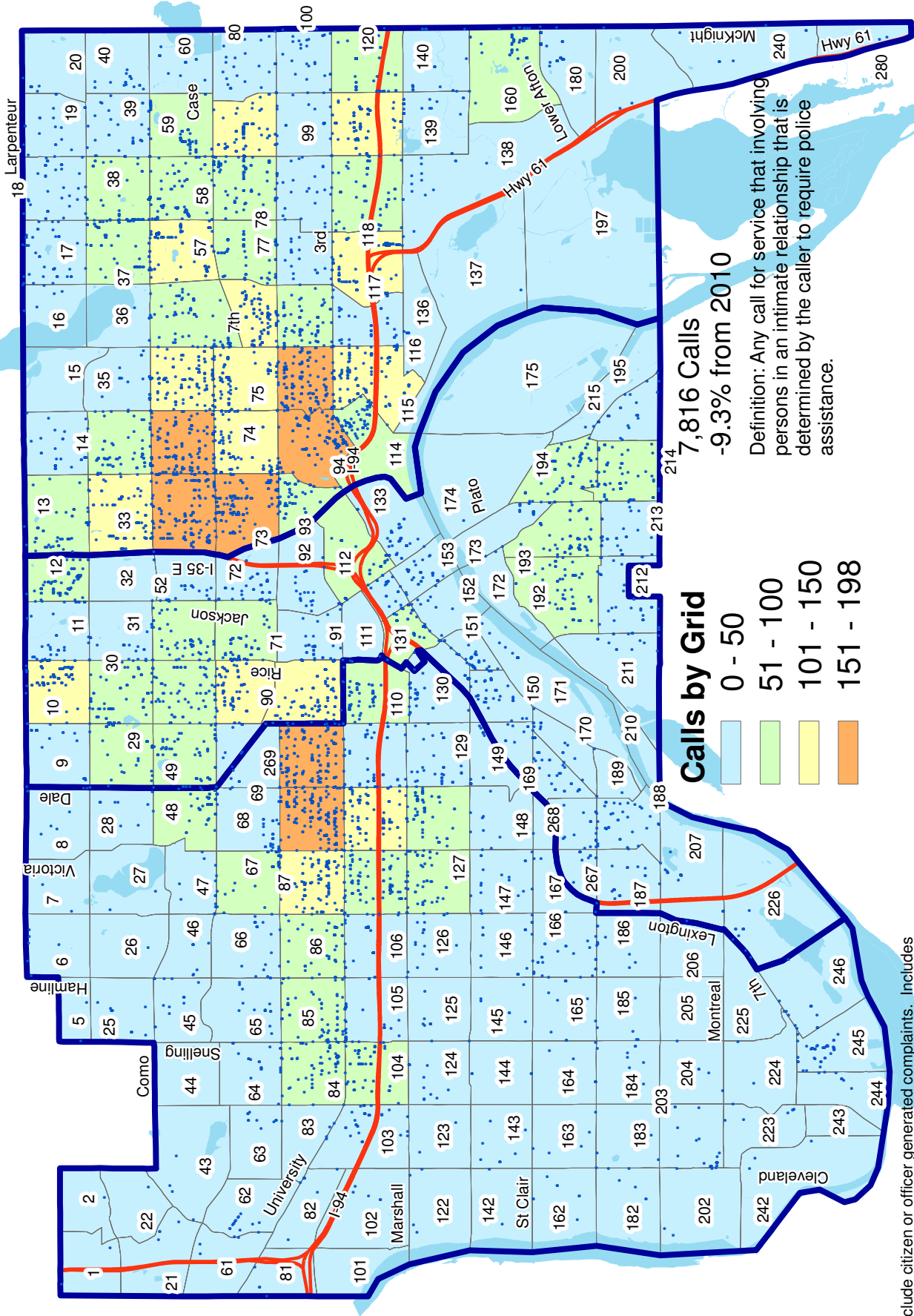

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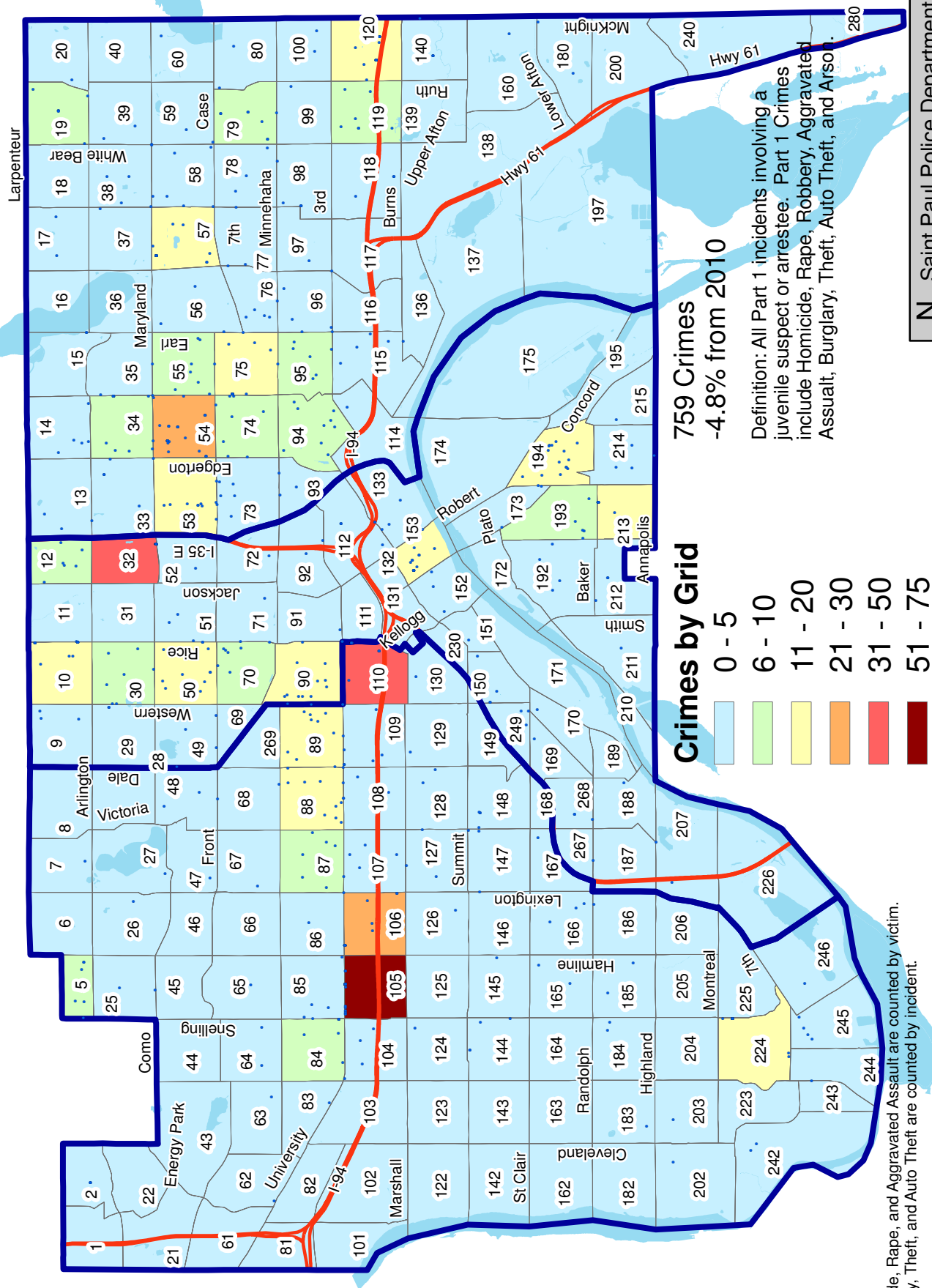
City of Saint Paul: Domestic Calls: 2011
