Rape by District

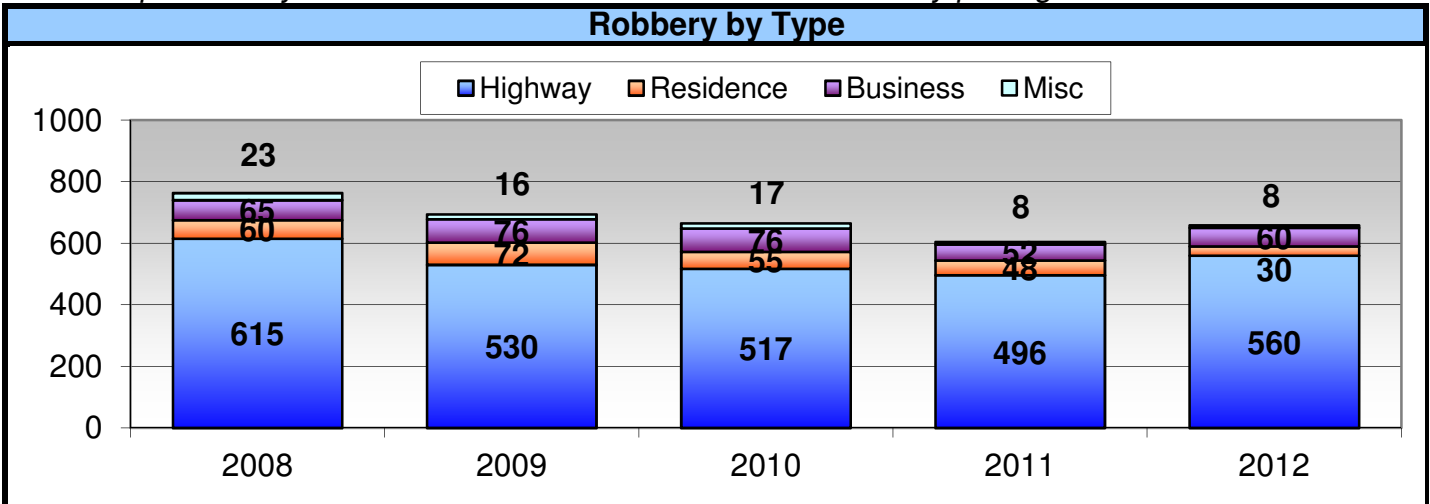

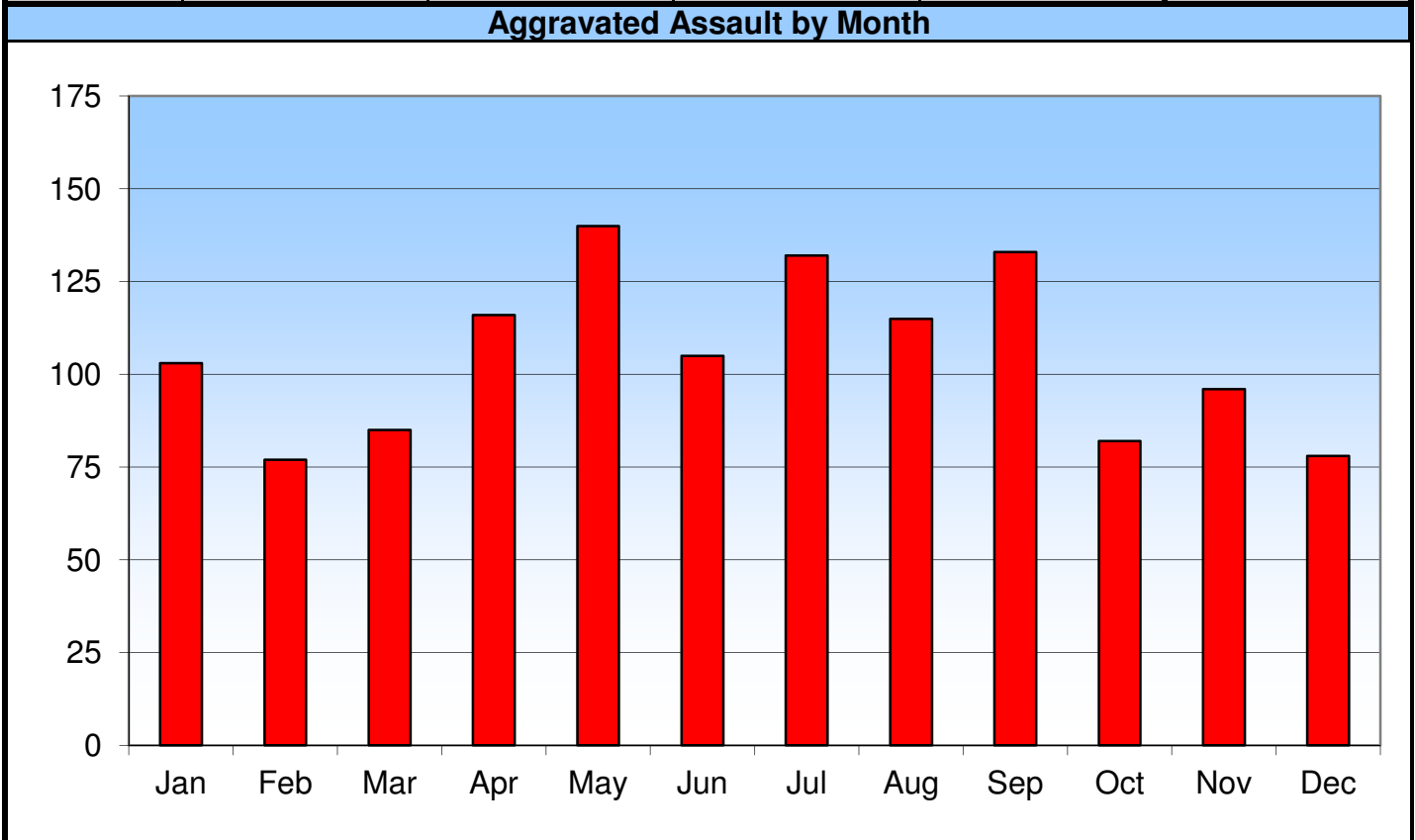

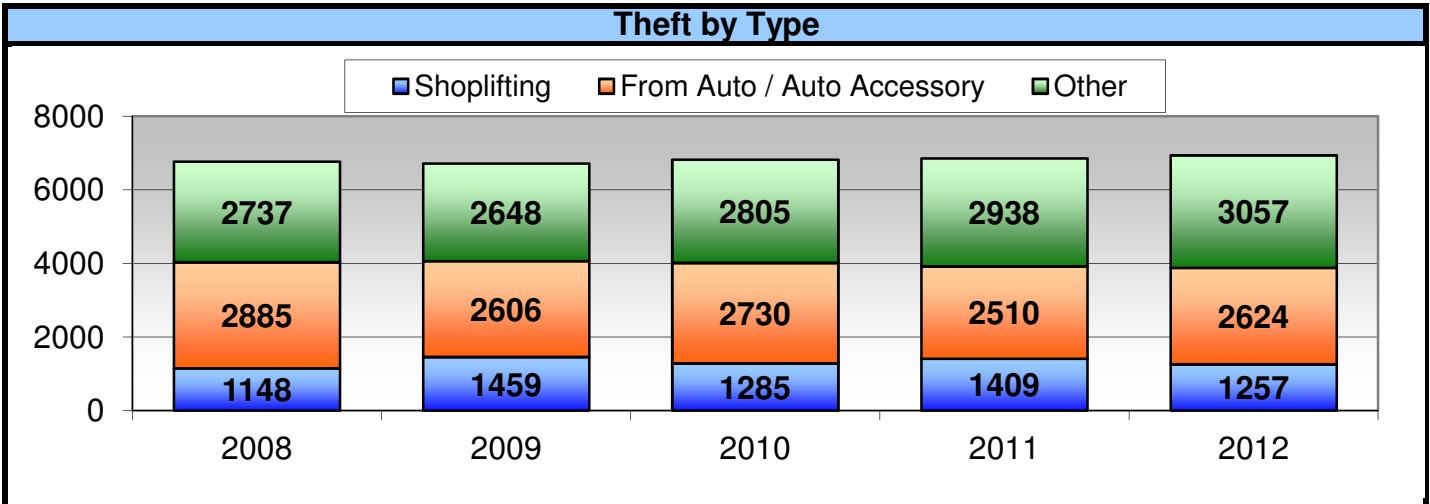

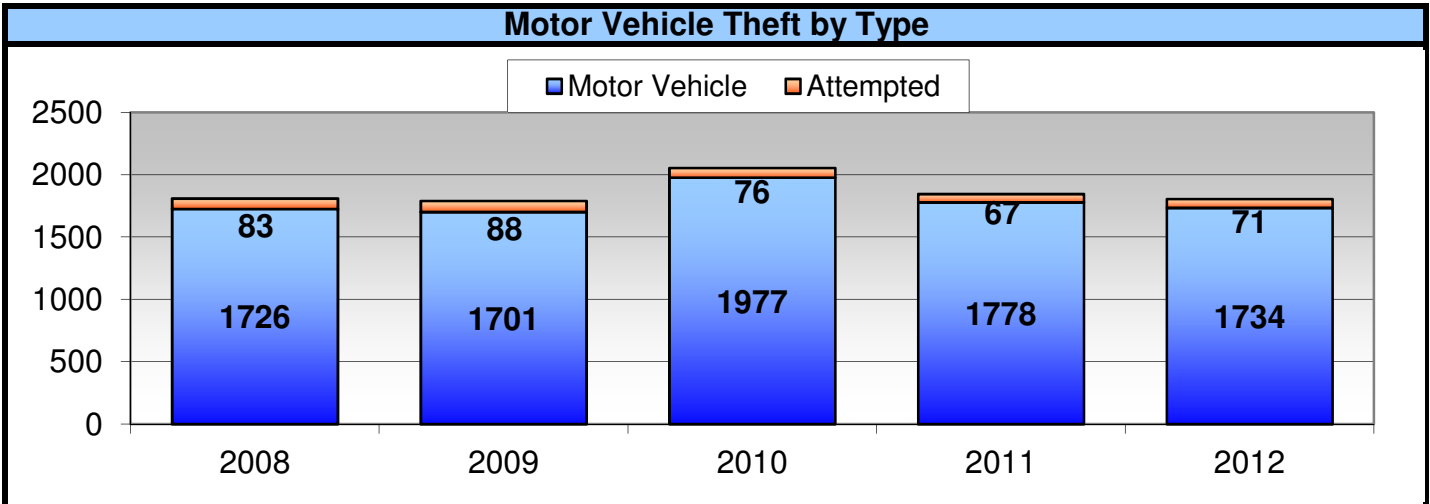

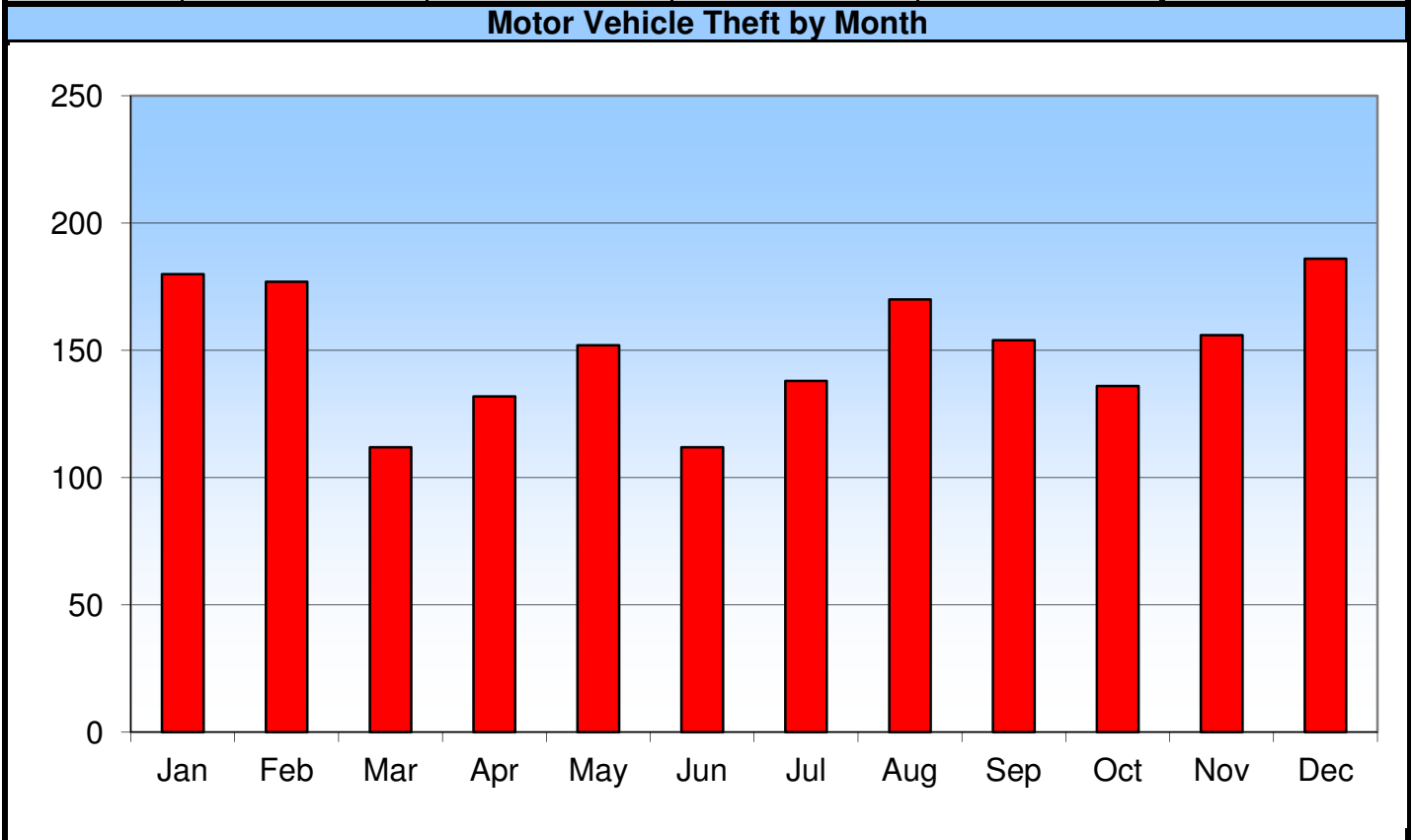

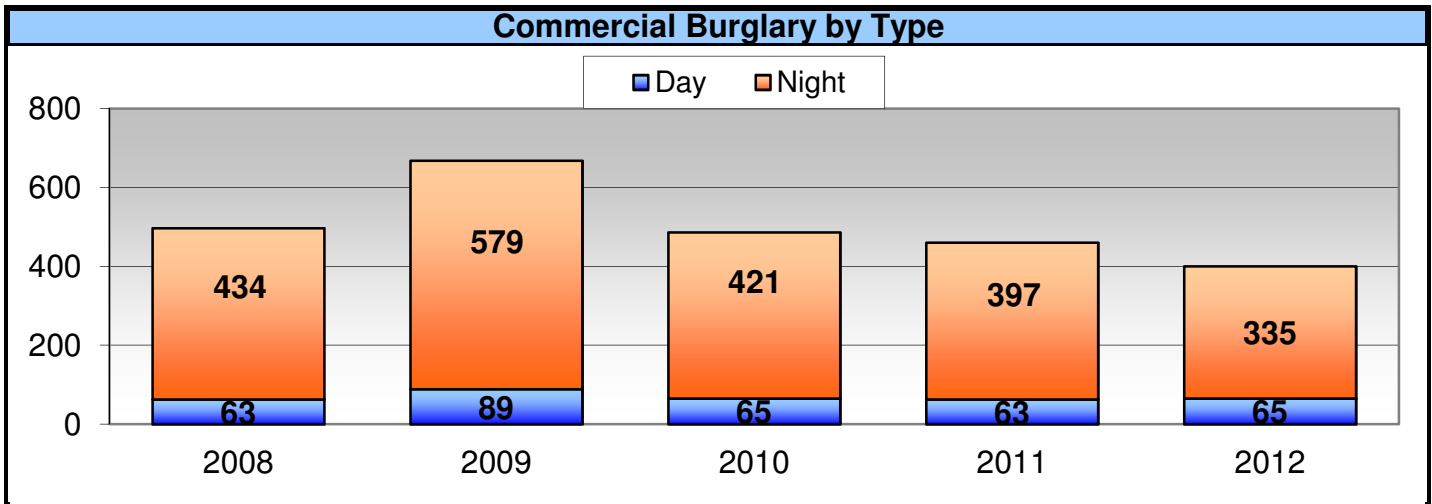

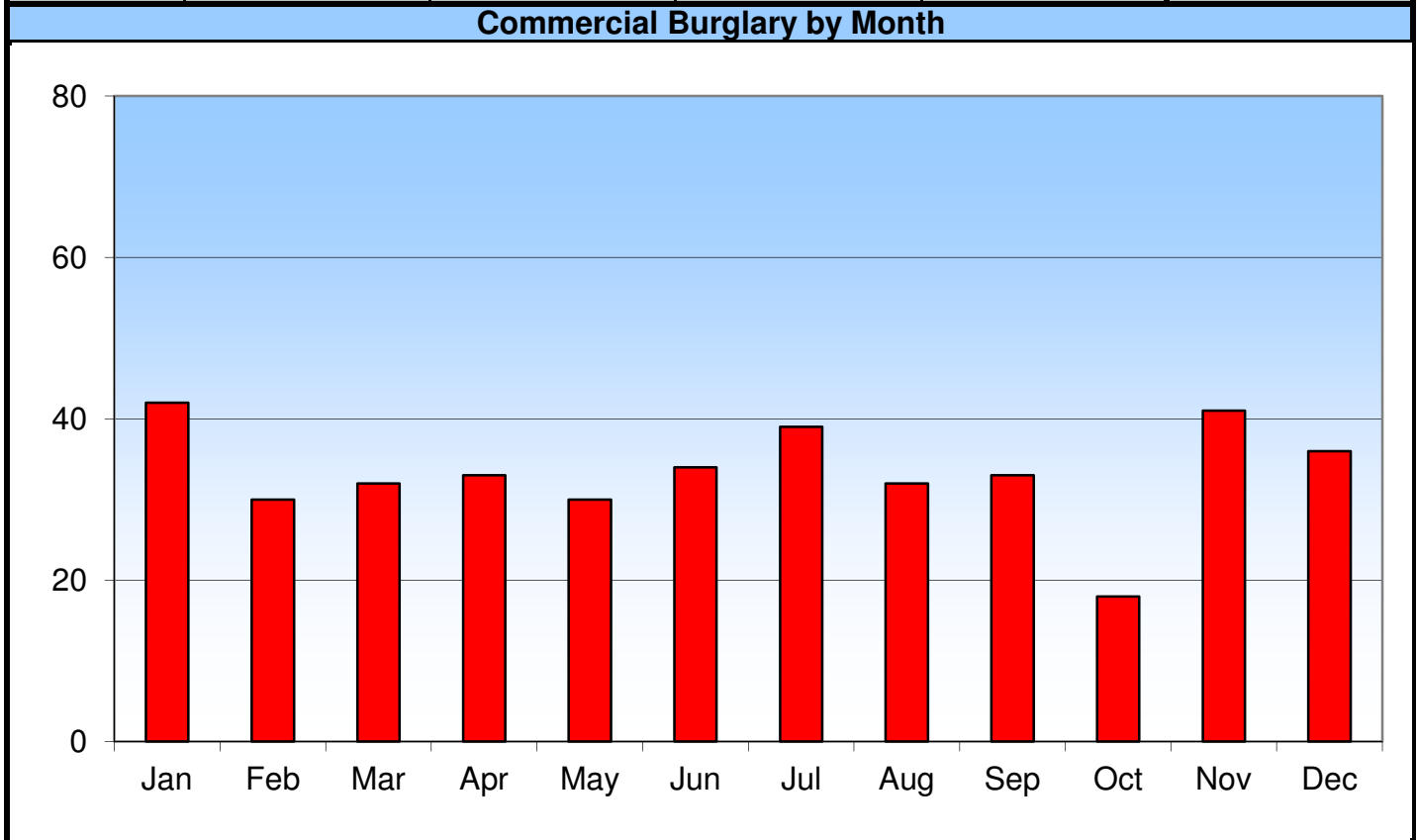

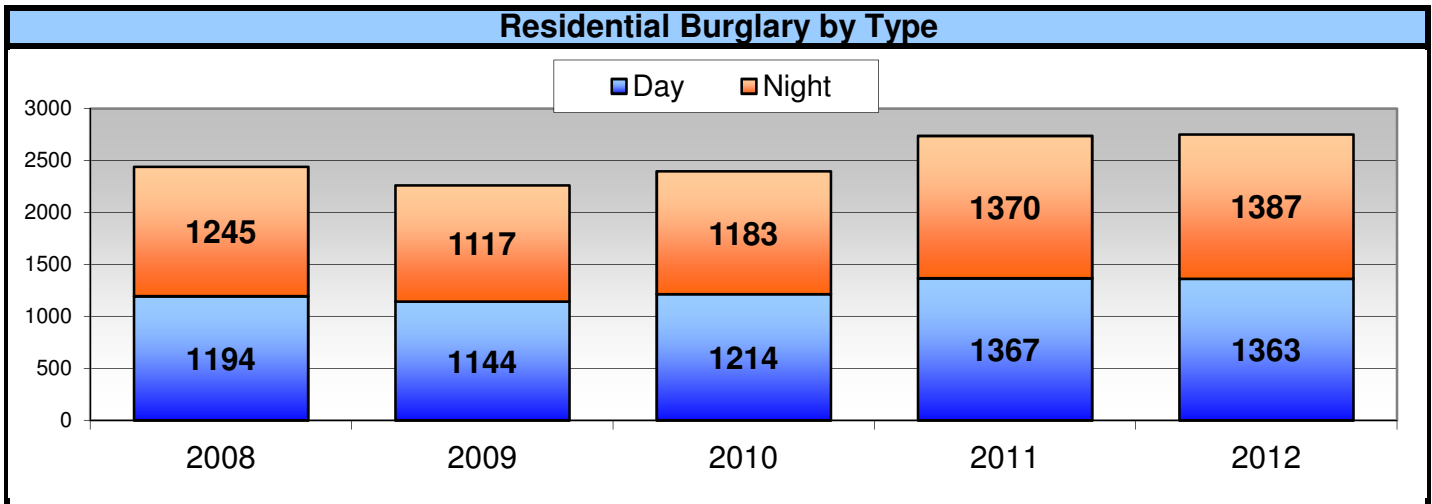

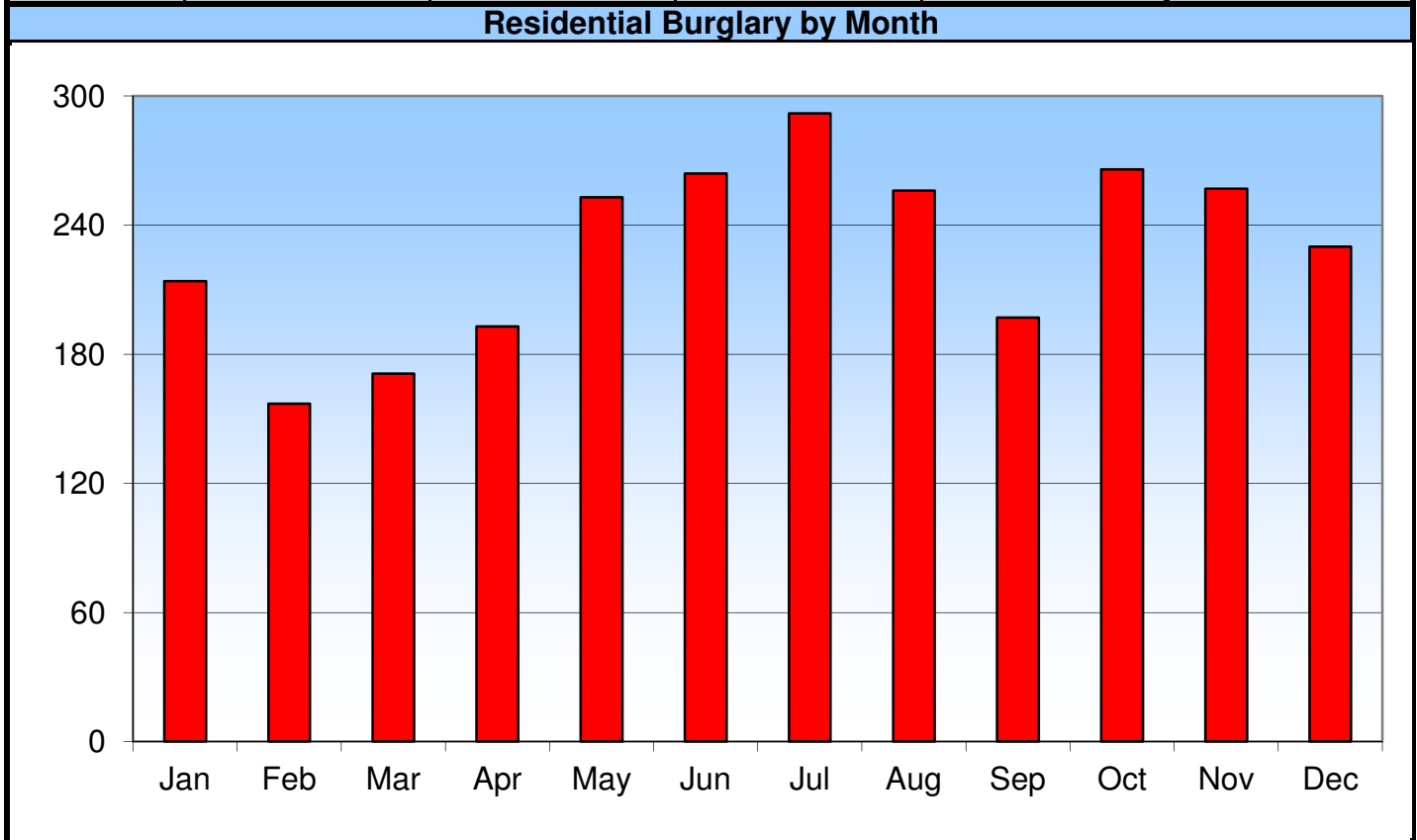

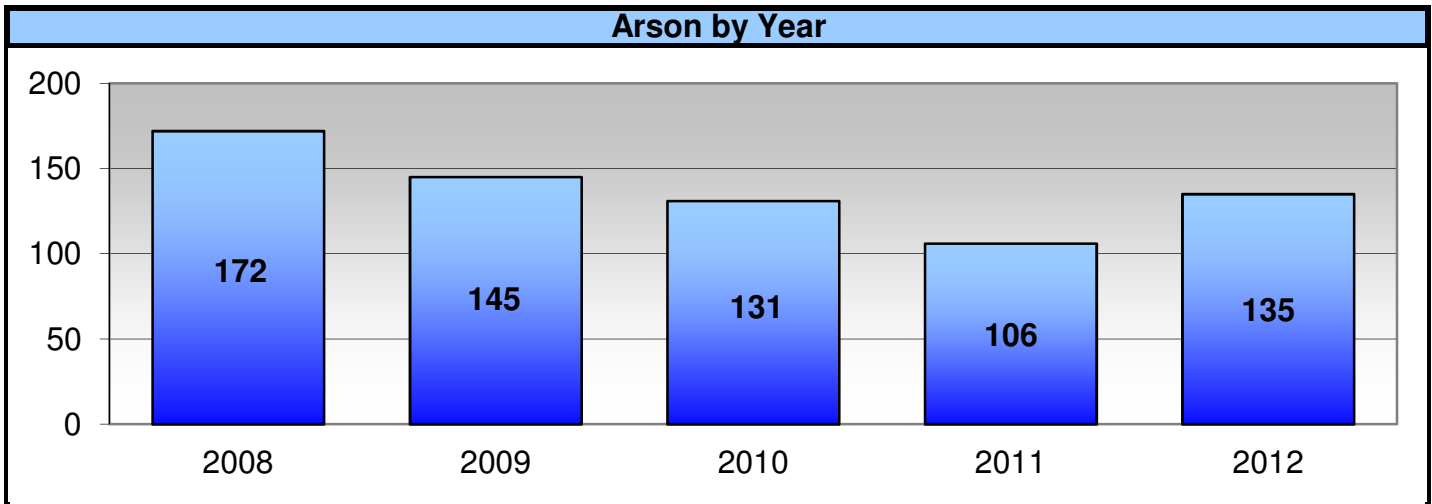

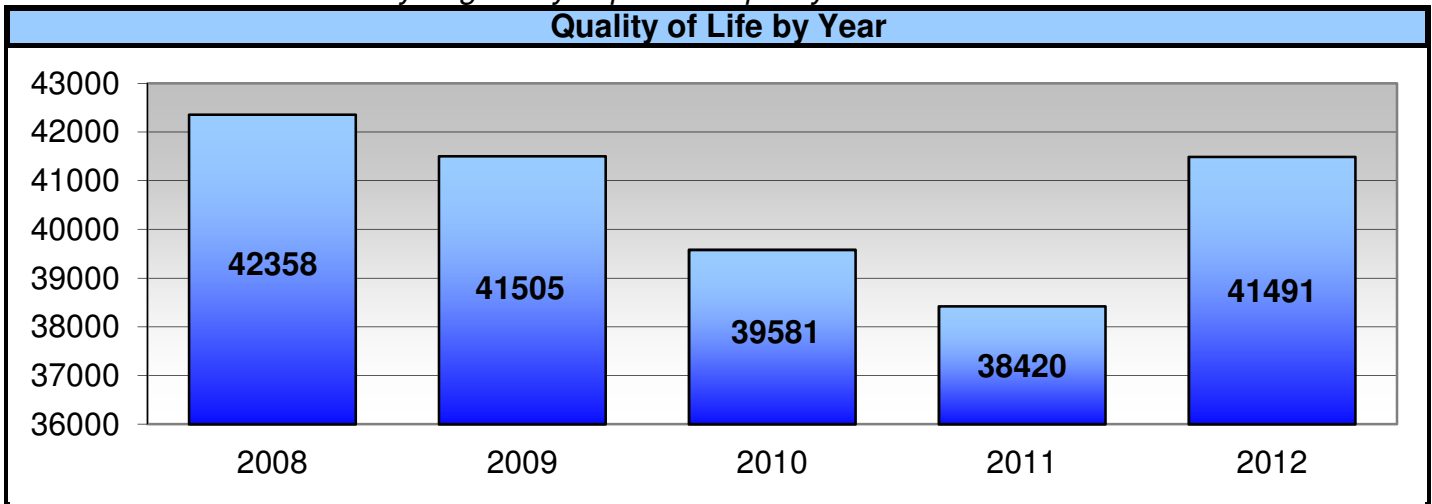

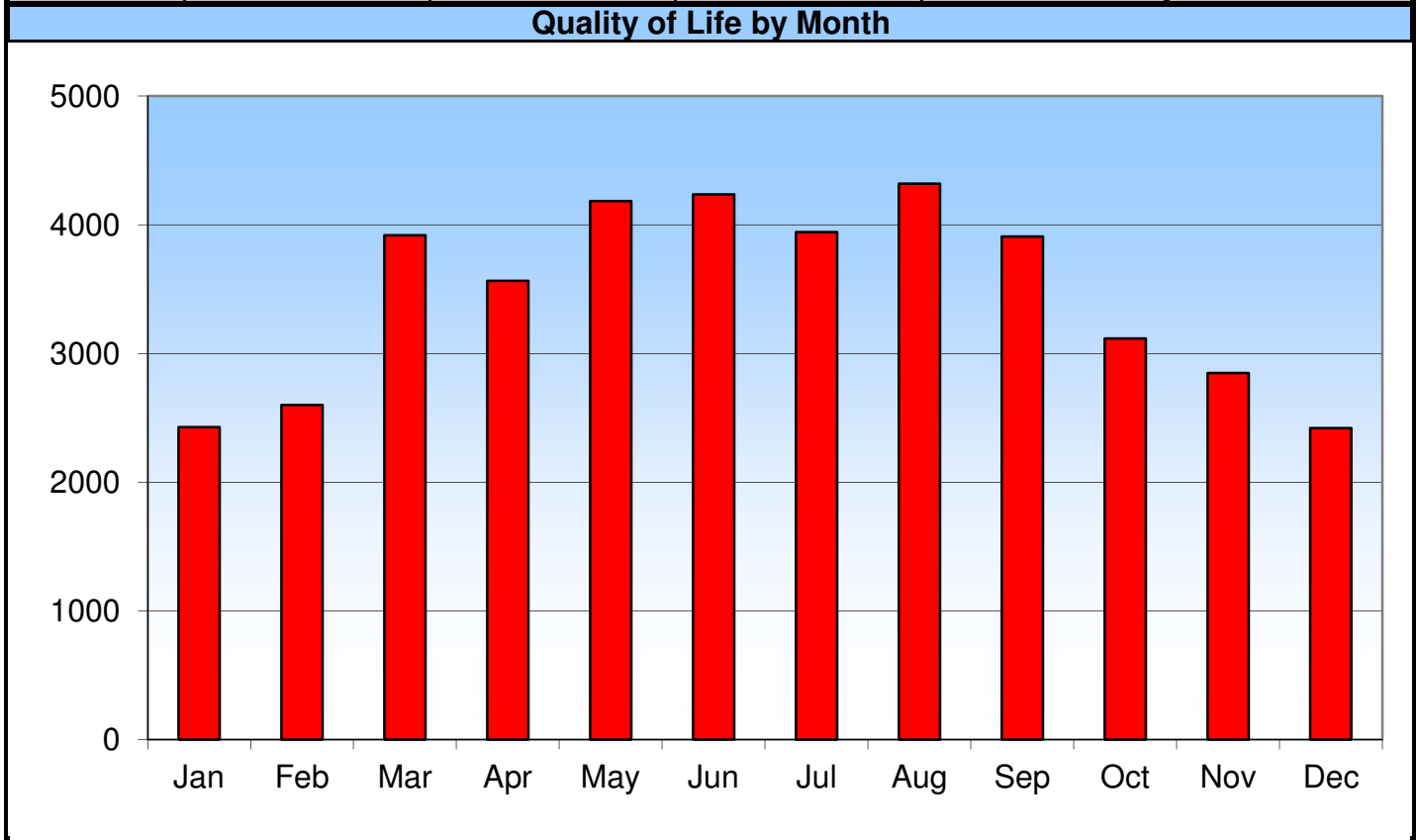

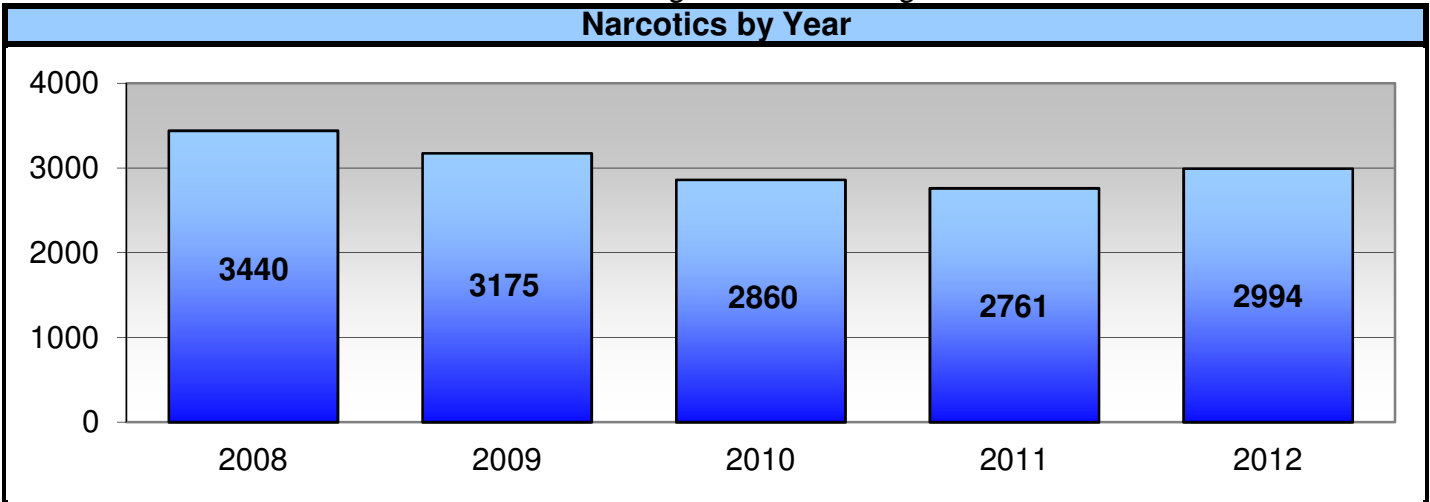

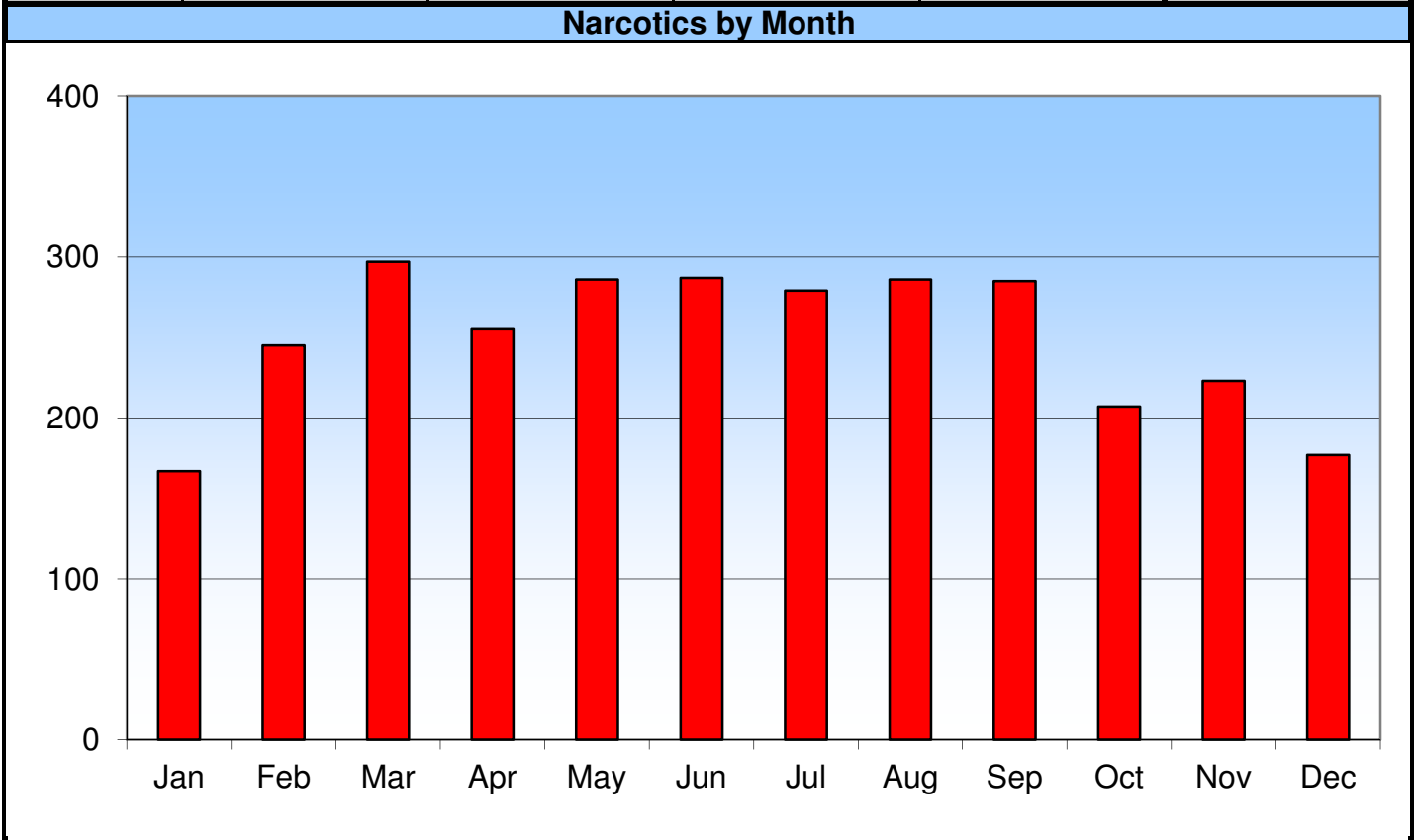

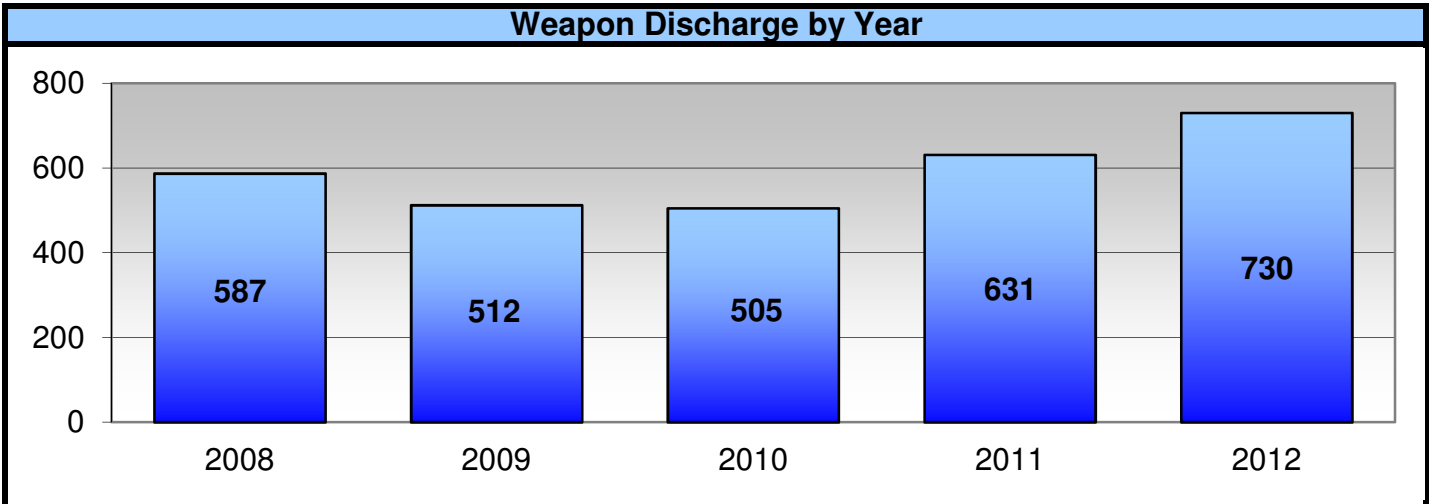

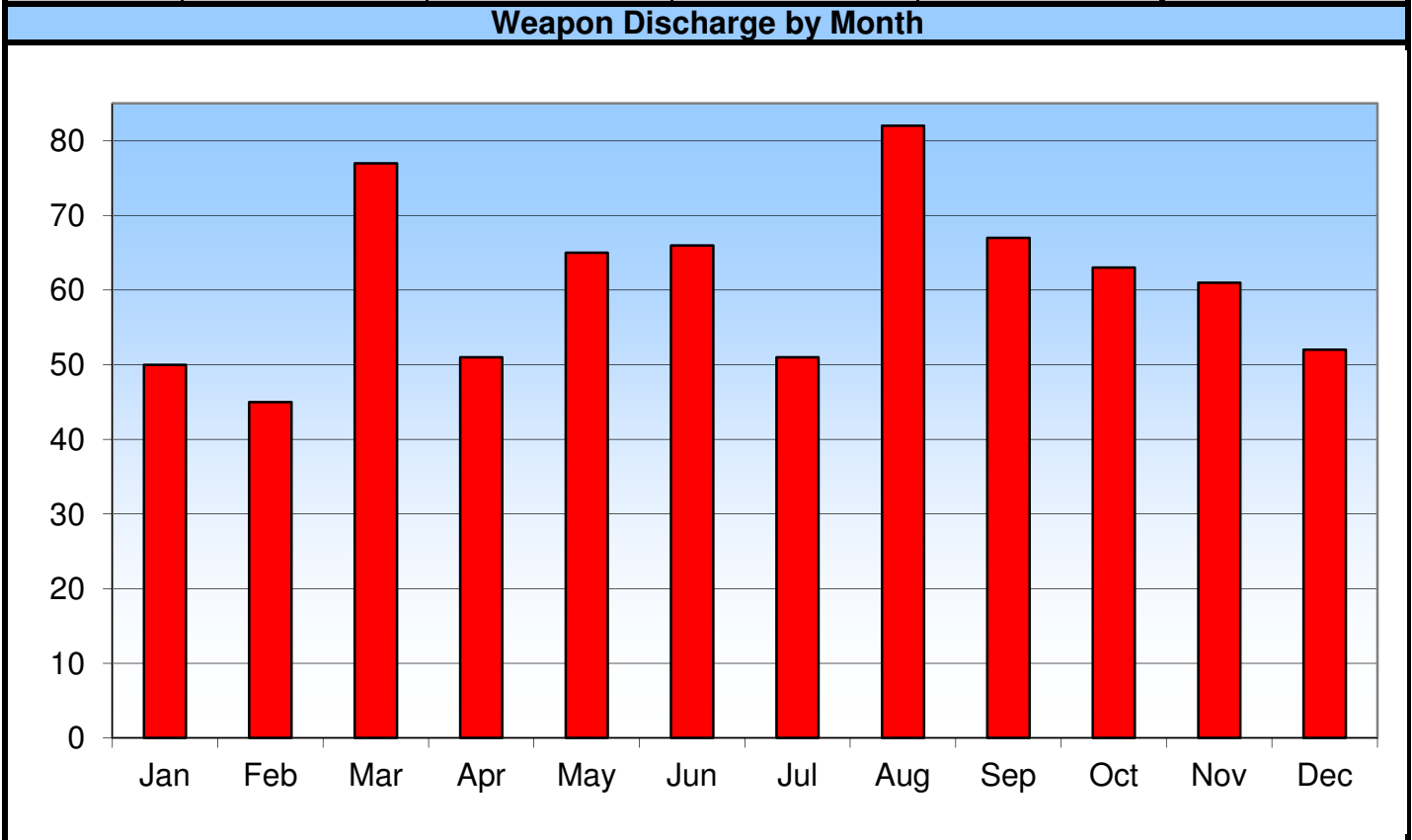

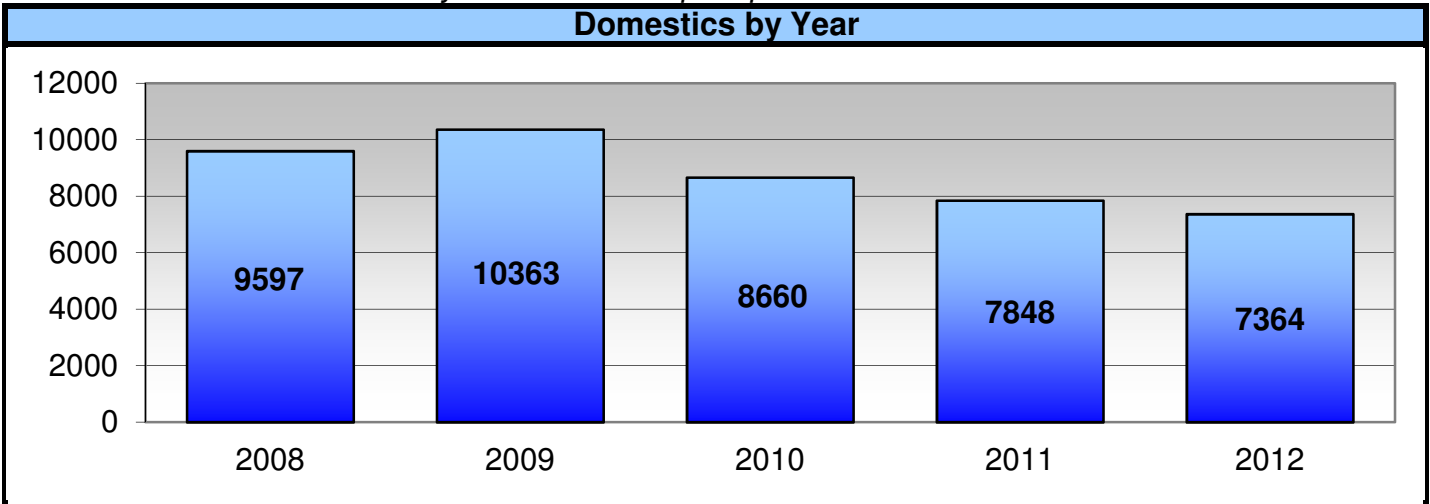

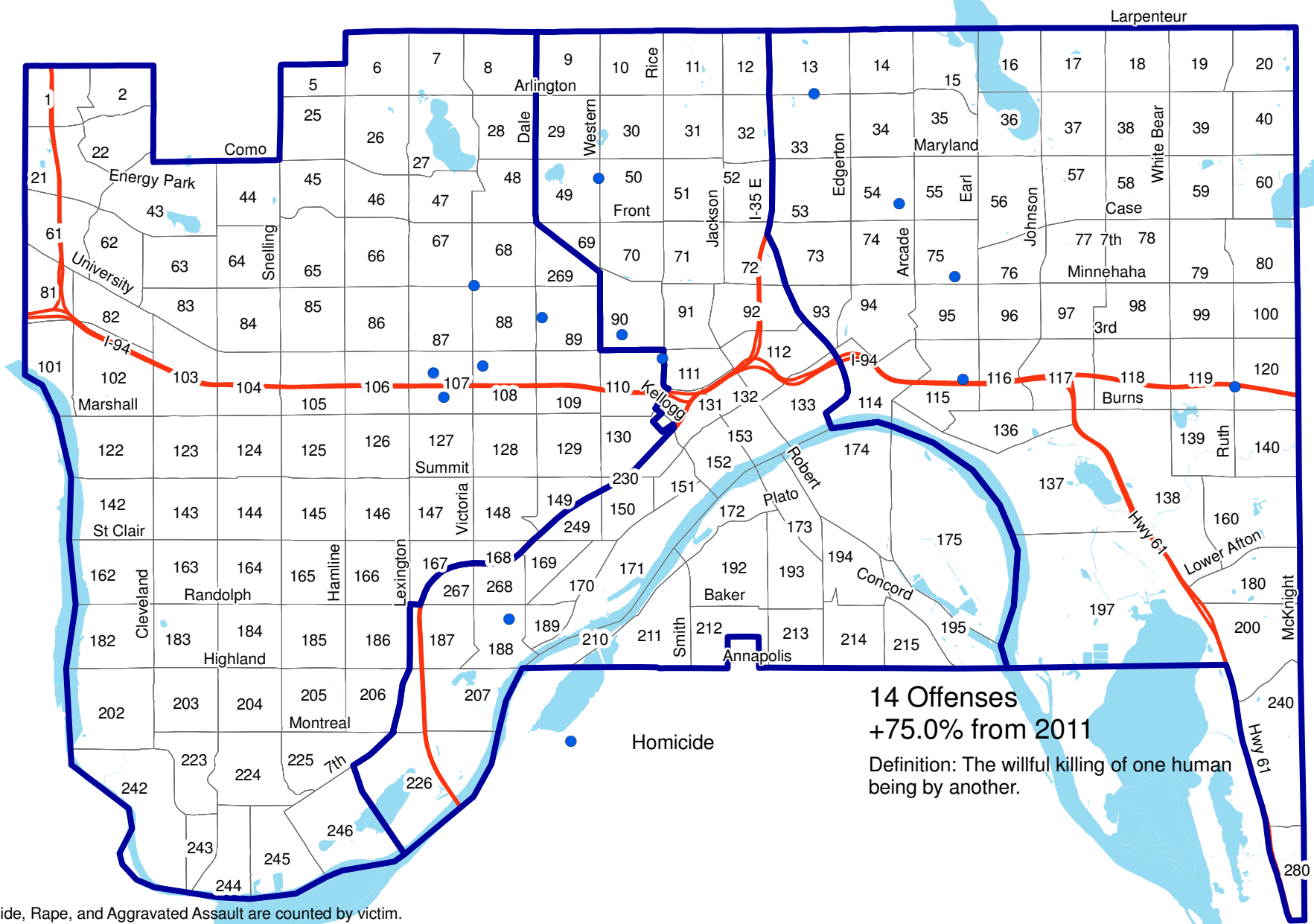

City of Saint Paul: Homicide Offenses: 2012



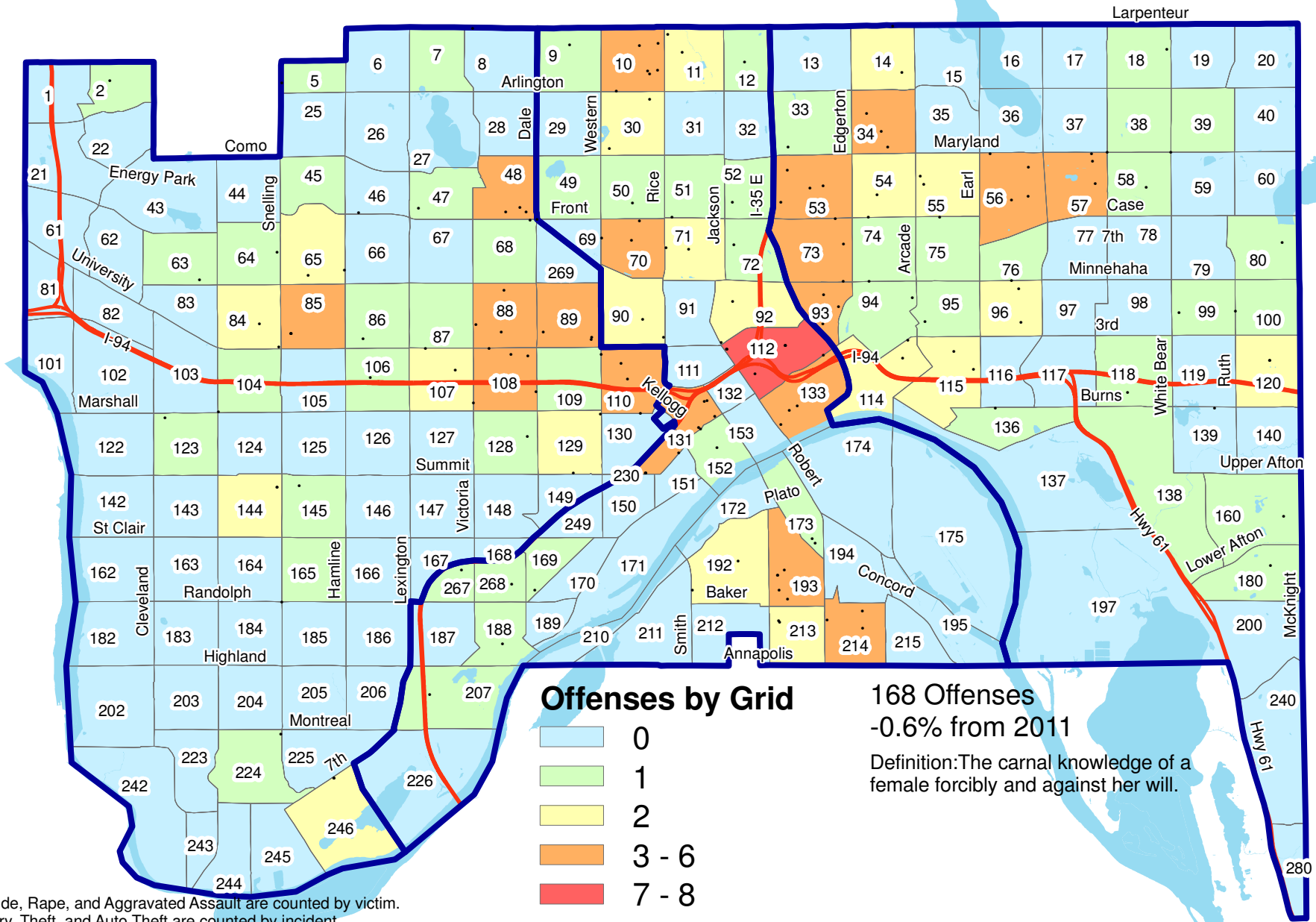

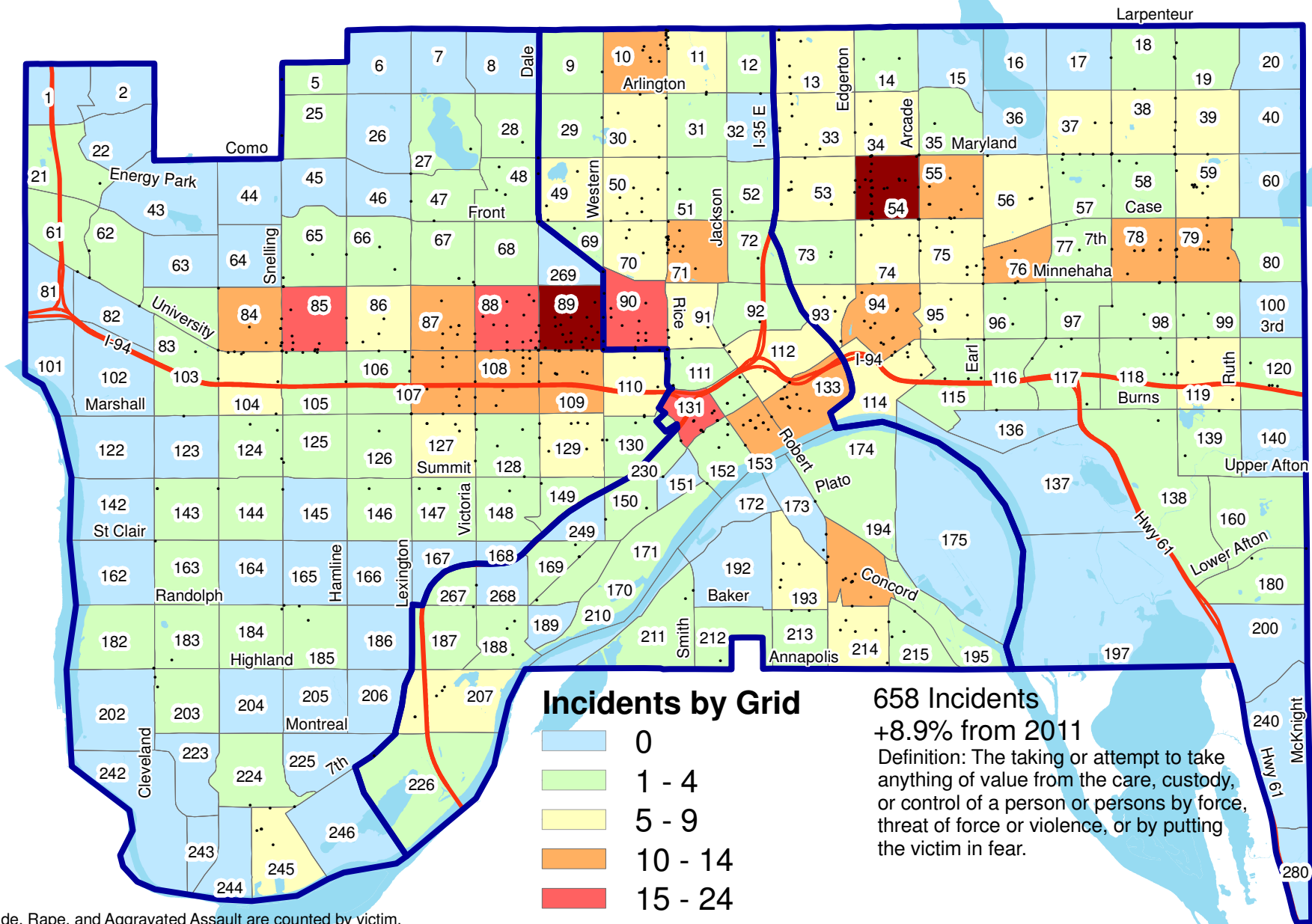

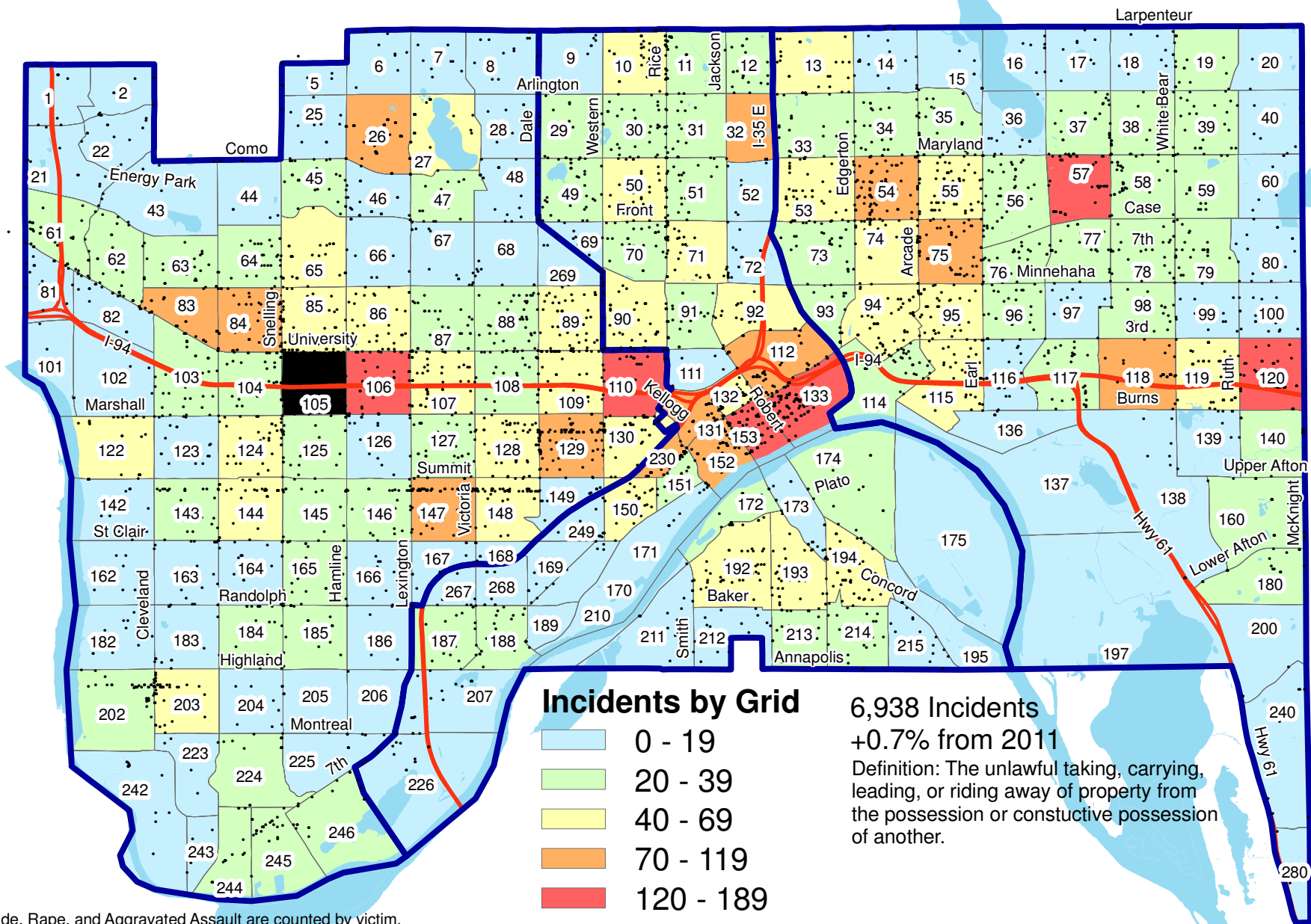

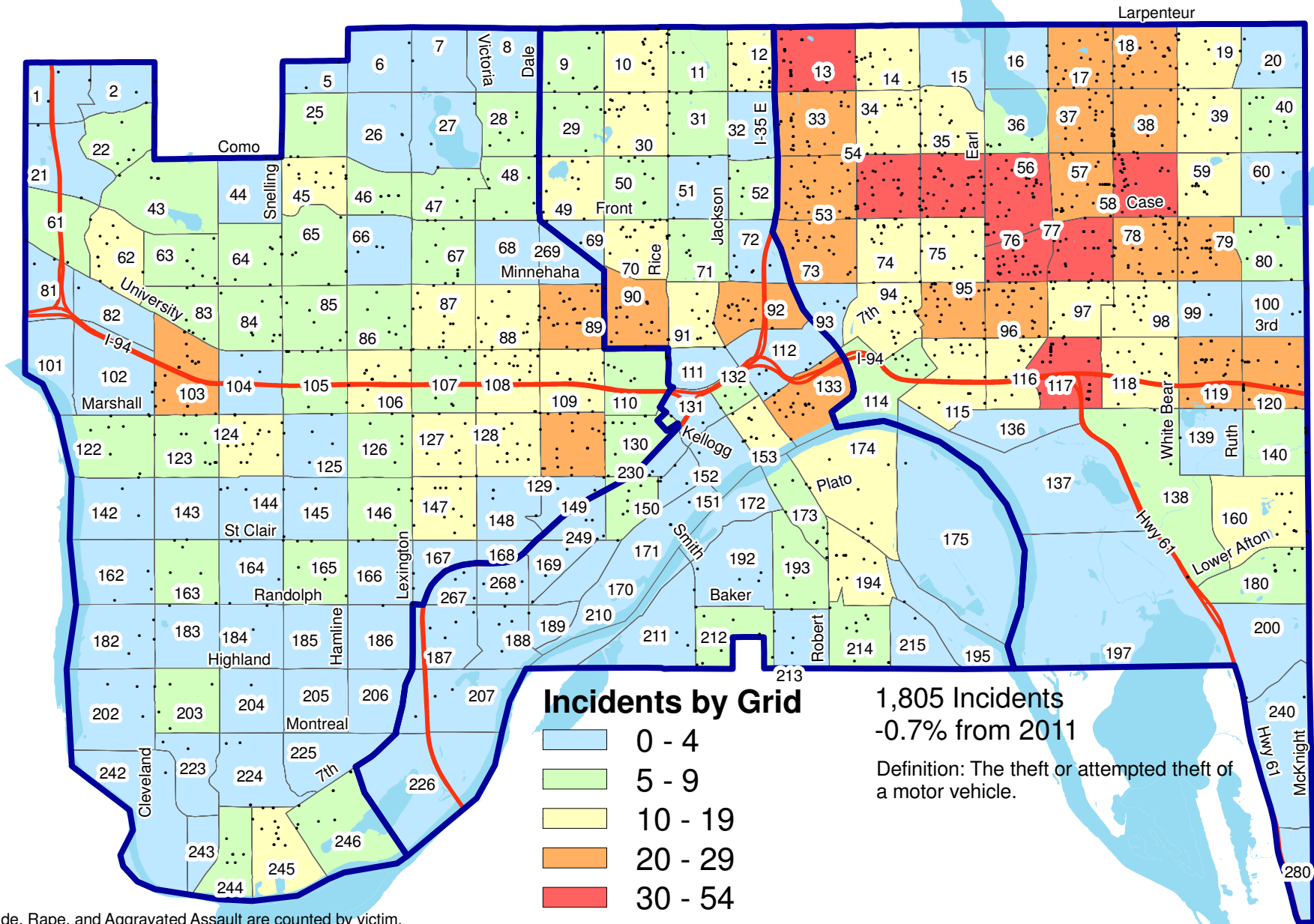

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City of Saint Paul: Motor Vehicle Theft Incidents: 2012

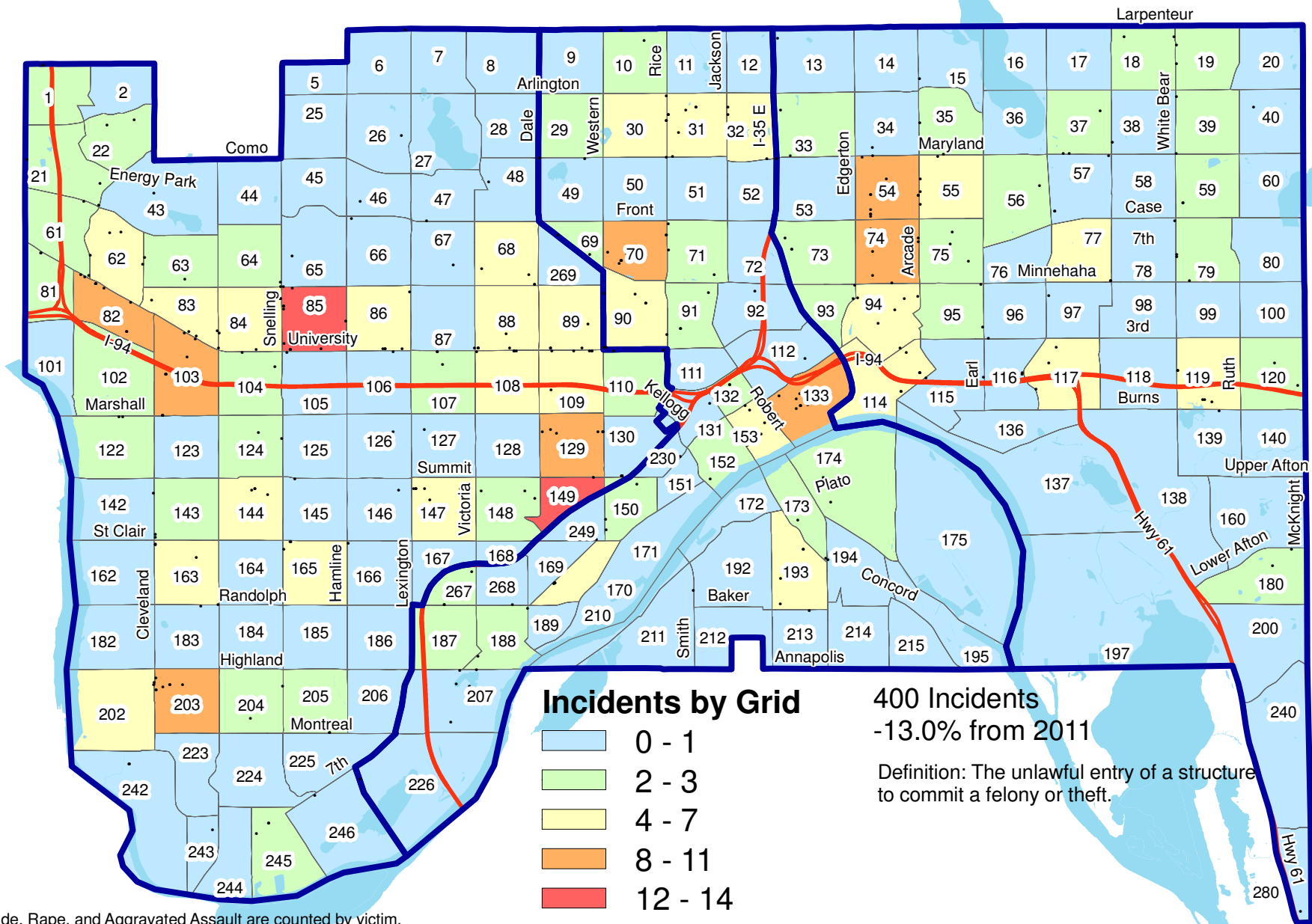

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City of Saint Paul: Commercial Burglary Incidents: 2012

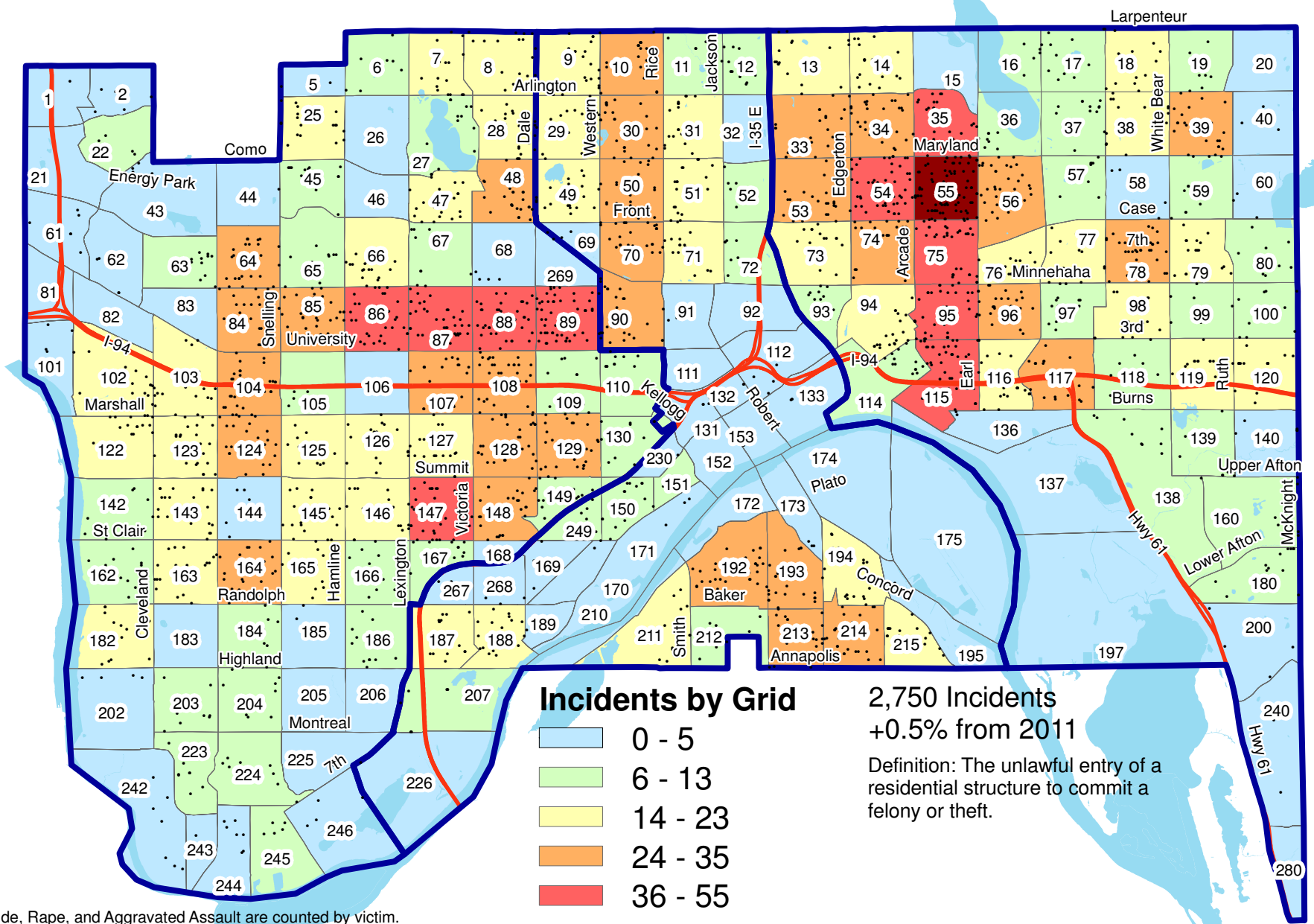

City of Saint Paul: Residential Burglary Incidents: 2012

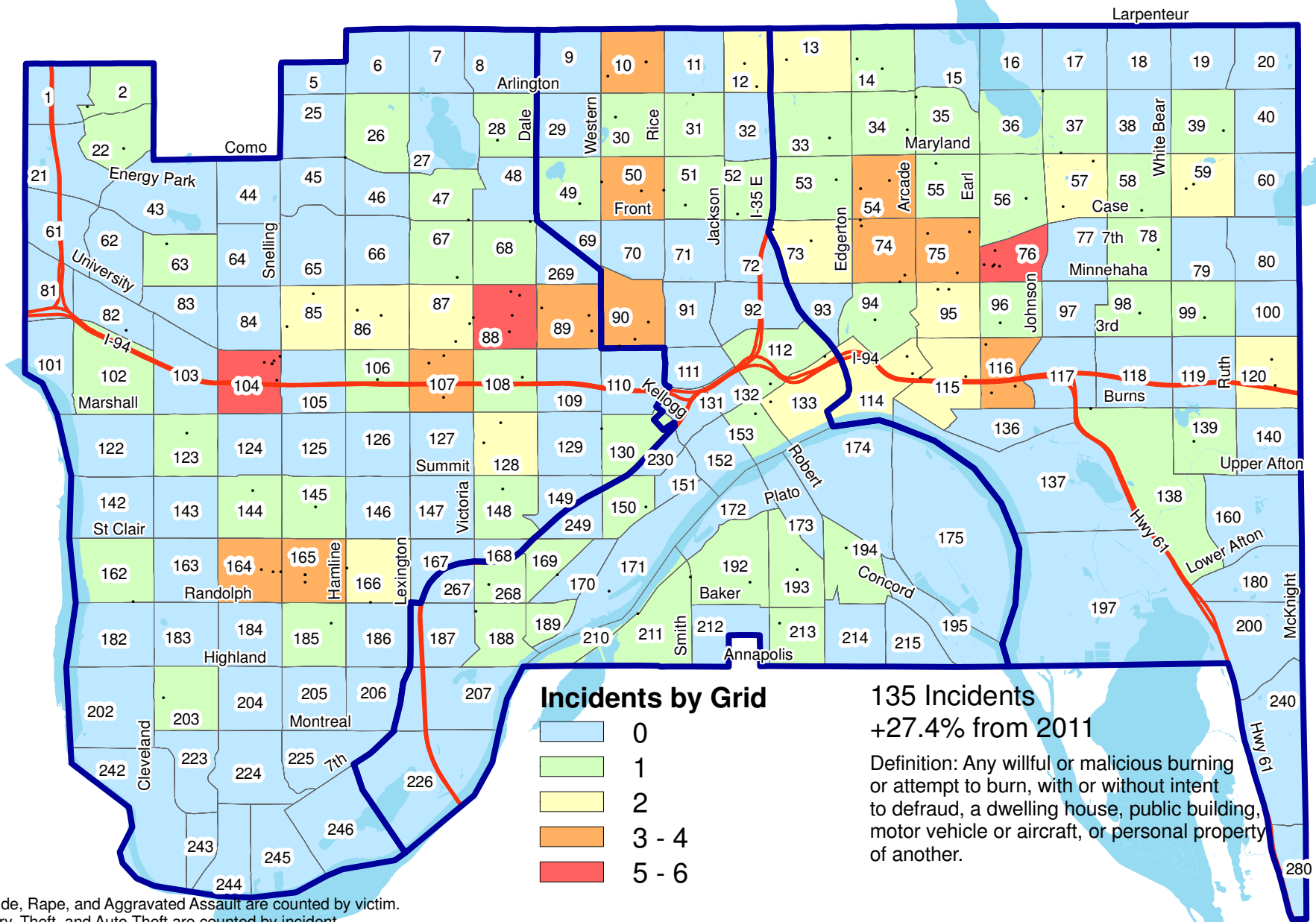

City of Saint Paul: Arson Incidents: 2012



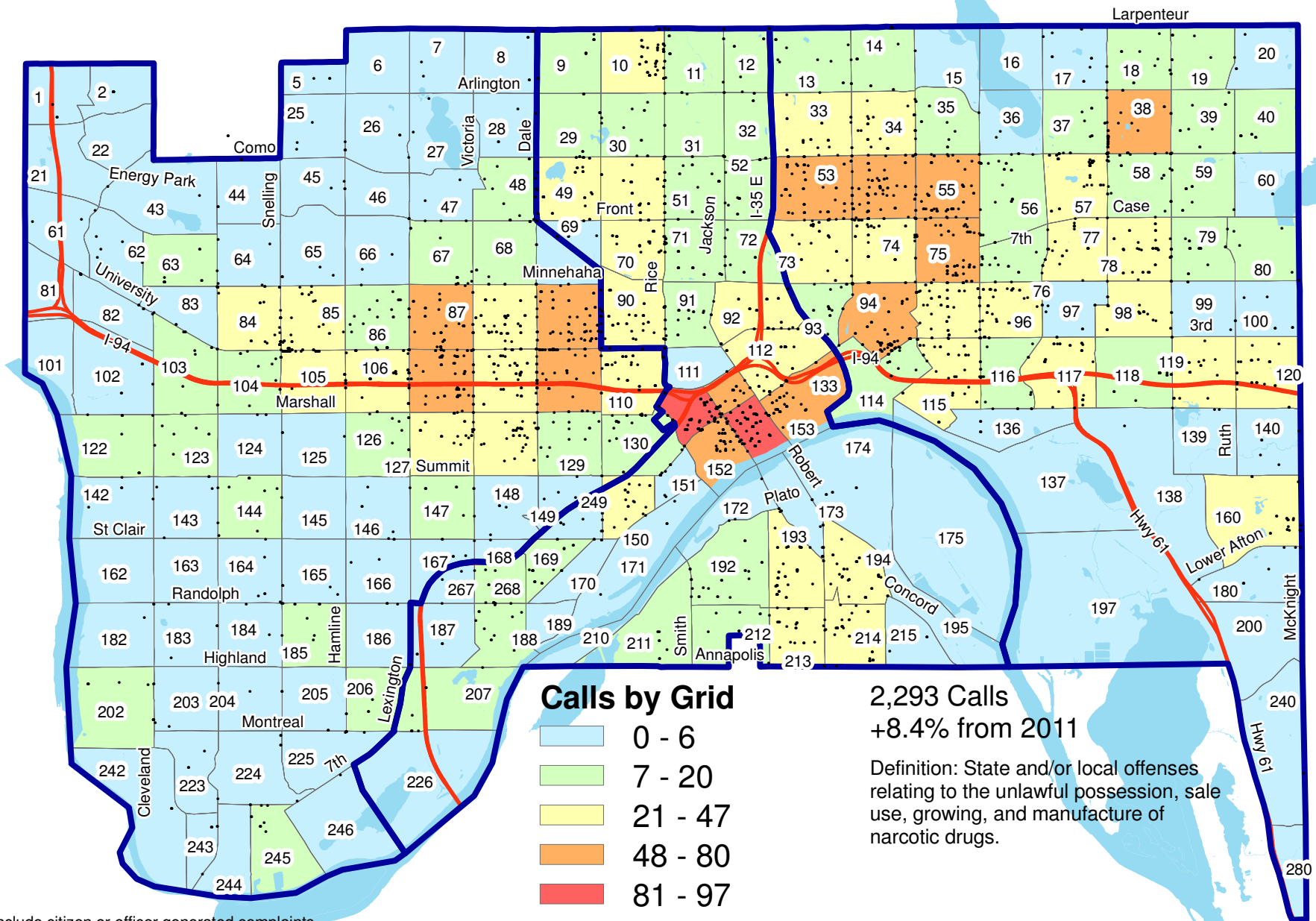

City of Saint Paul: Narcotics Calls: 2012



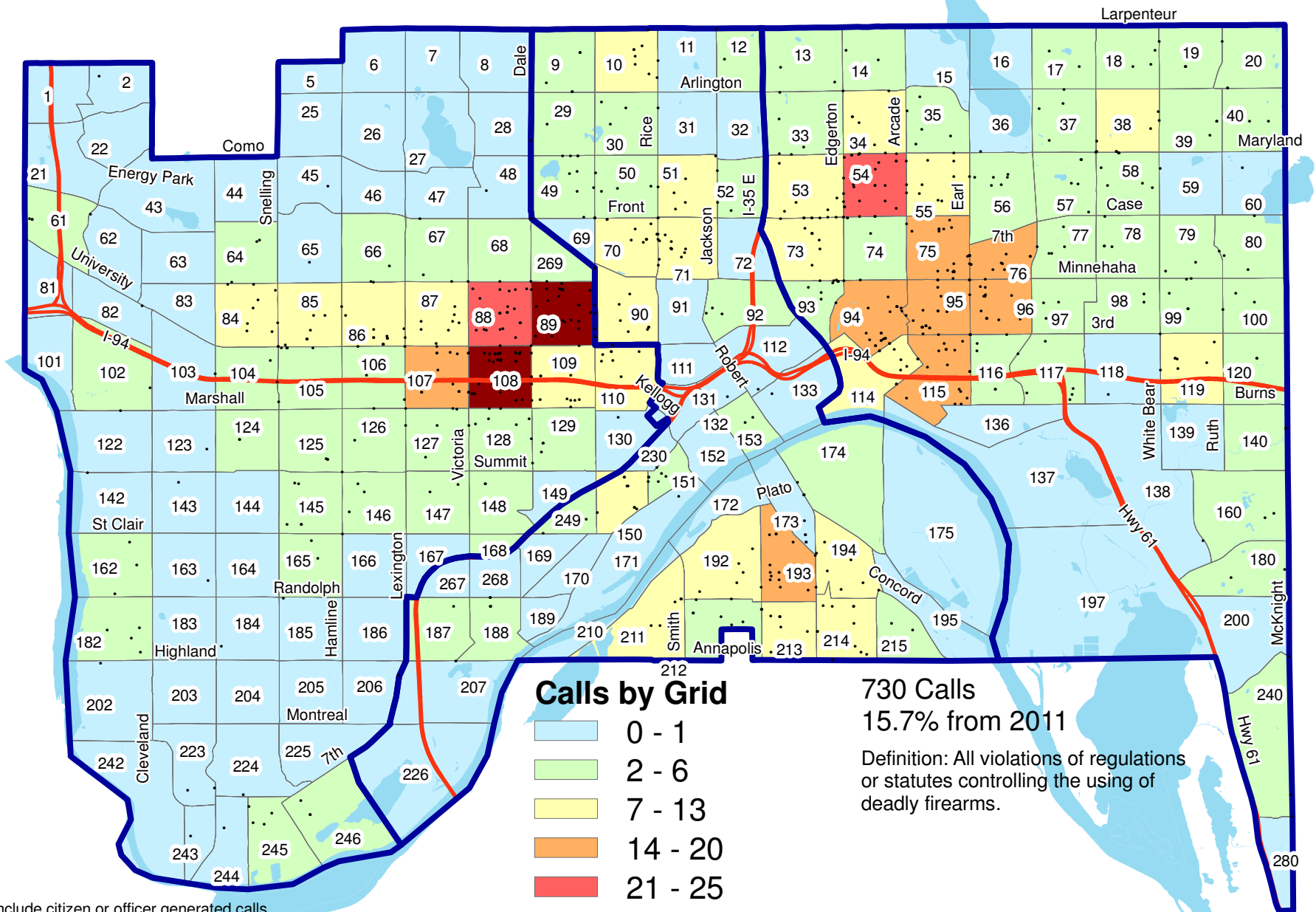

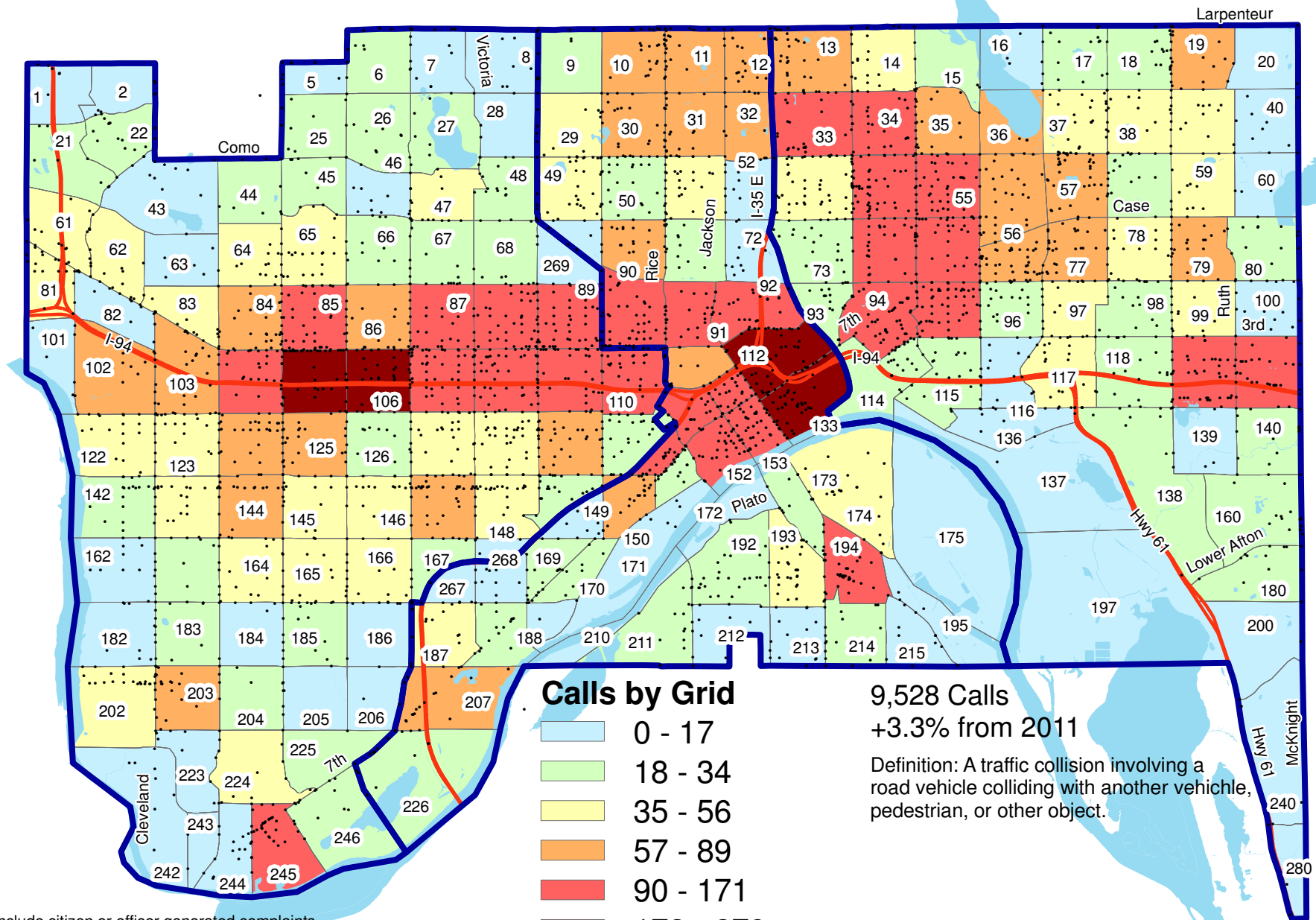

City of Saint Paul: Traffic Accident Calls: 2012



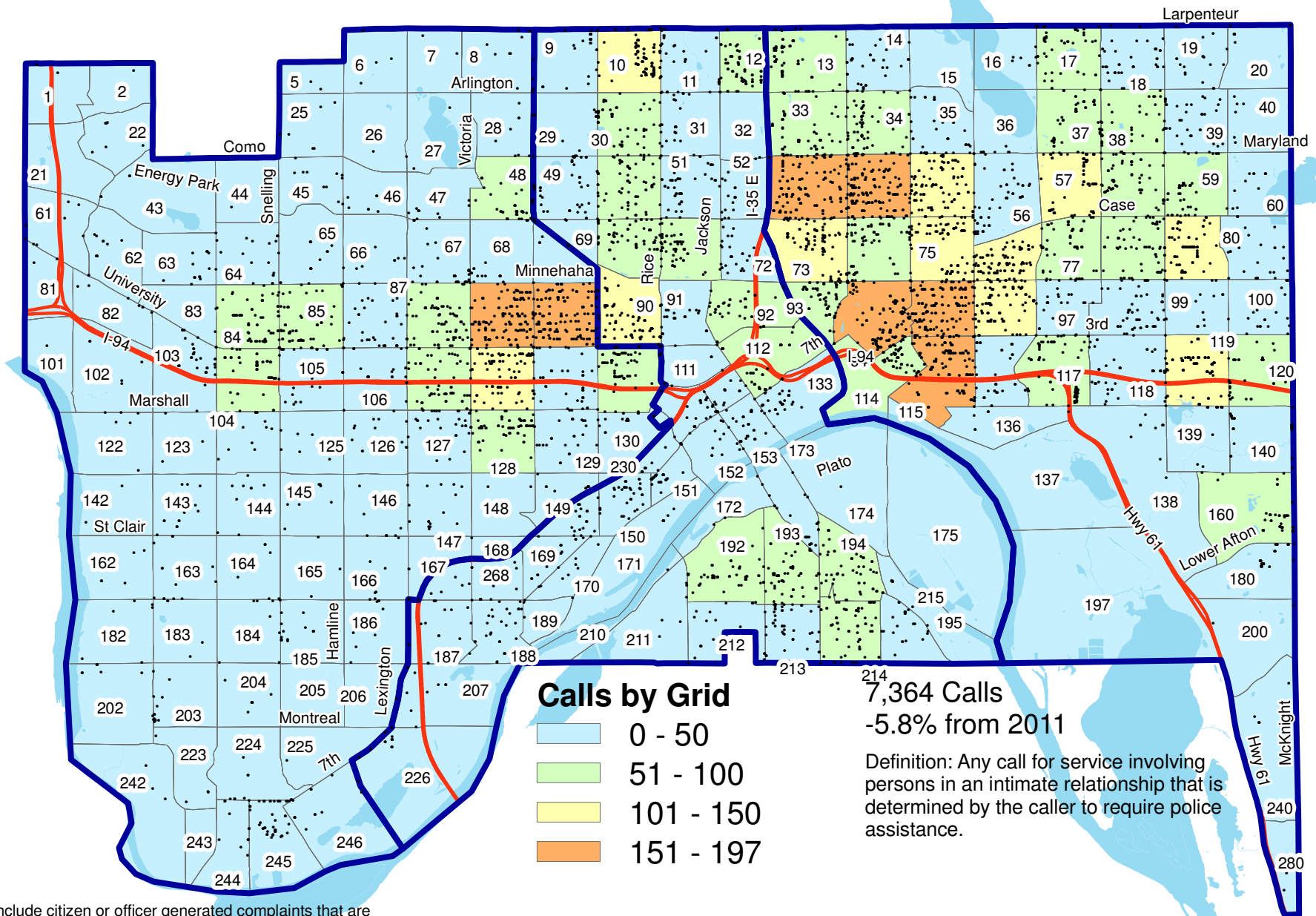

City of Saint Paul: Domestic Calls: 2012

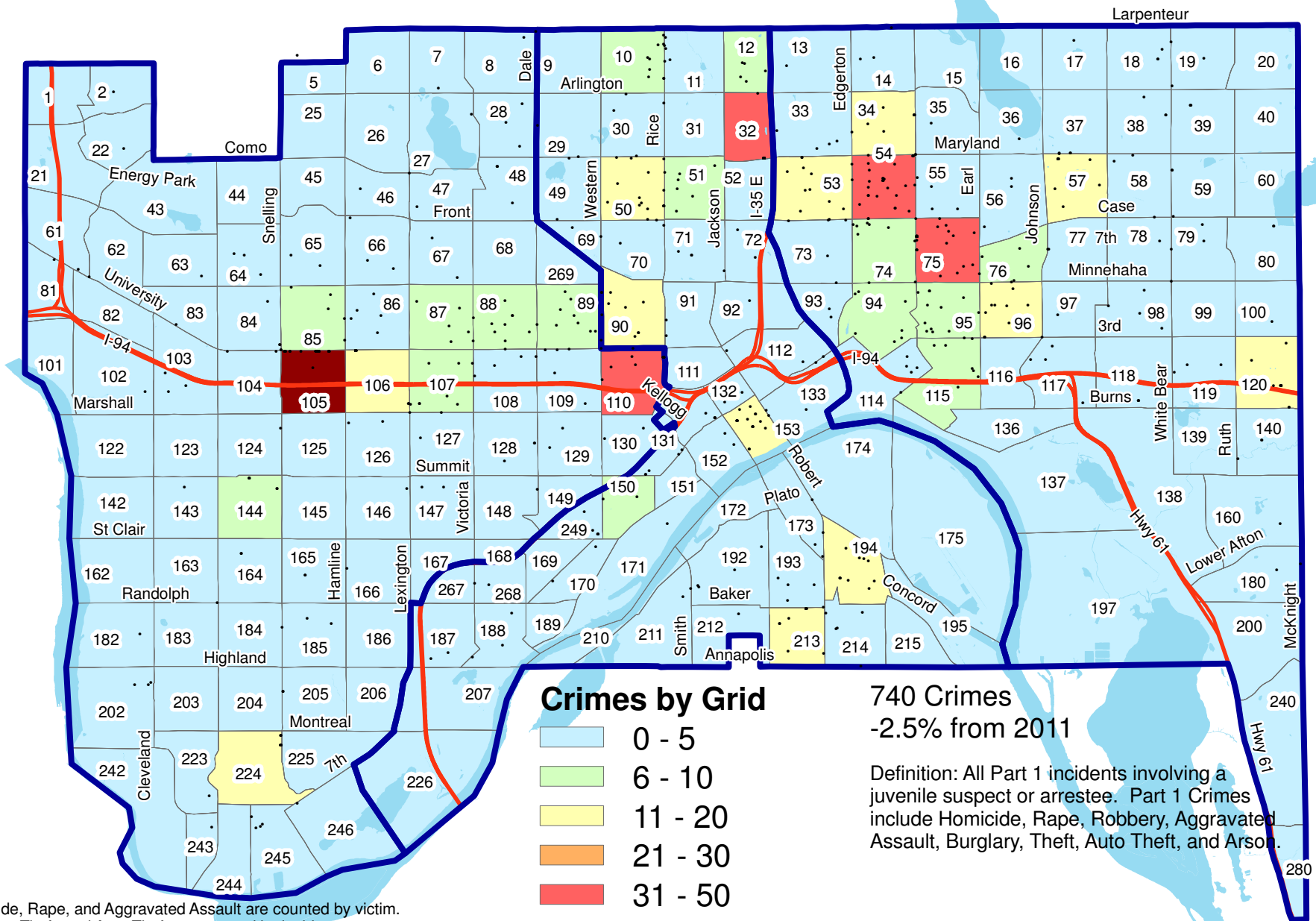
