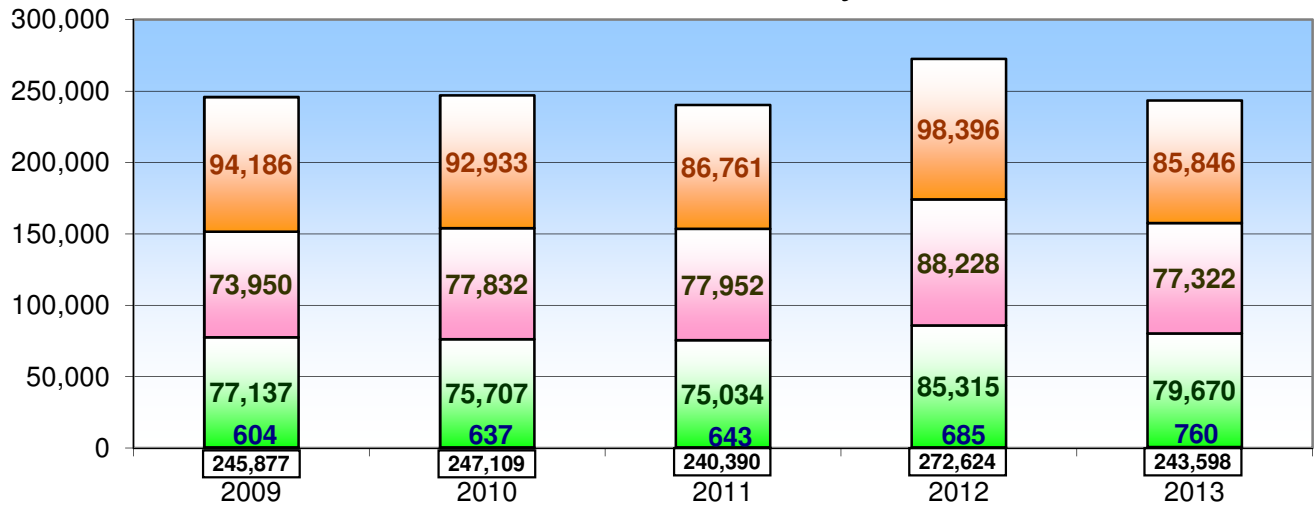

* Please note: Beginning in 2013, the FBI issued a new definition for the classification of rape. Prior to 2013, rape was defined (for the purposes of reporting Part I crimes in the annual Uniform Crime Report) as “The carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will”. Effective January 1, 2013, rape is now defined as “Penetration, no matter how slight, of the vagina or anus with any body part or object, or oral penetration by a sex organ of another person, without the consent of the victim”. This new definition now allows the counting of male rape victims who were not countable under the old definition and contributes to an annual increase of 29.8% over 2012 rape statistics. This new definition also contributes to the overall count of Part I crimes committed in 2013 compared to 2012.

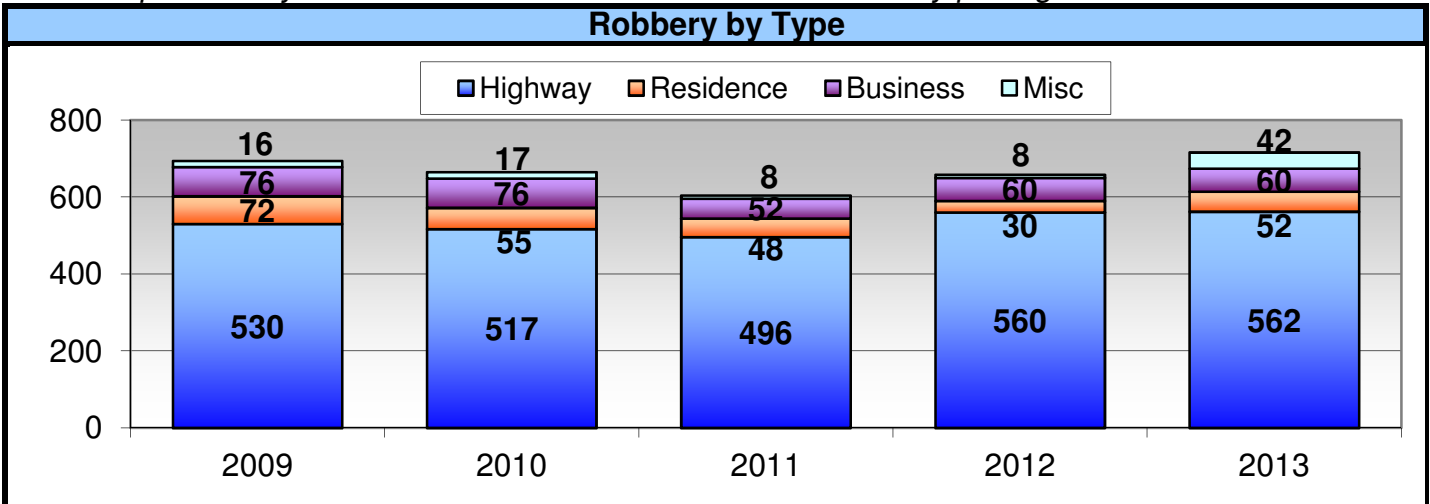

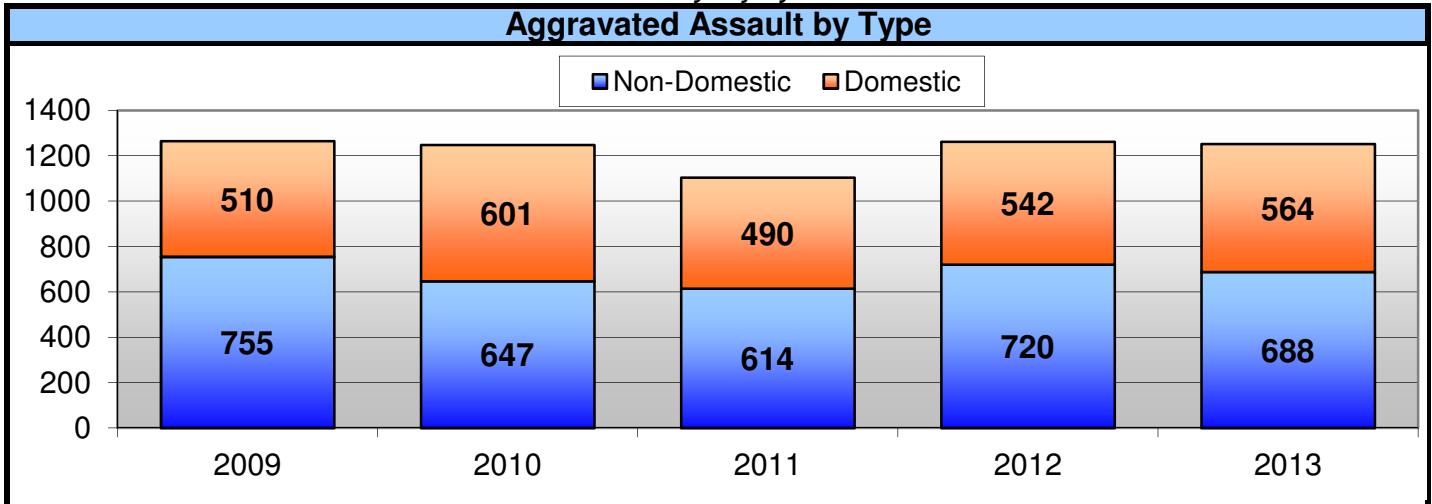

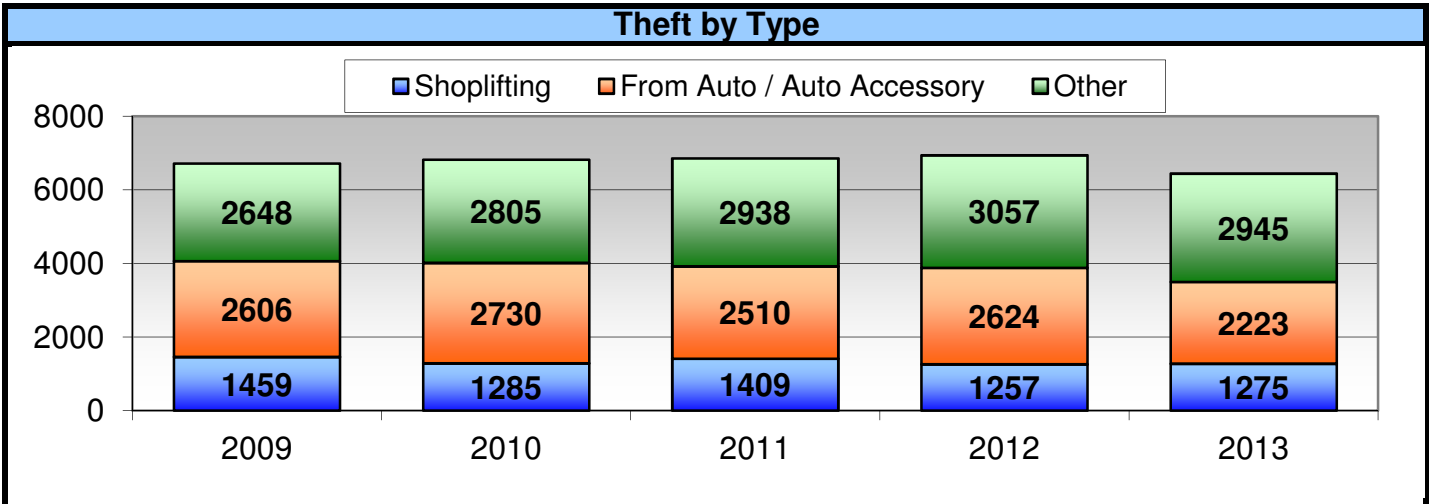

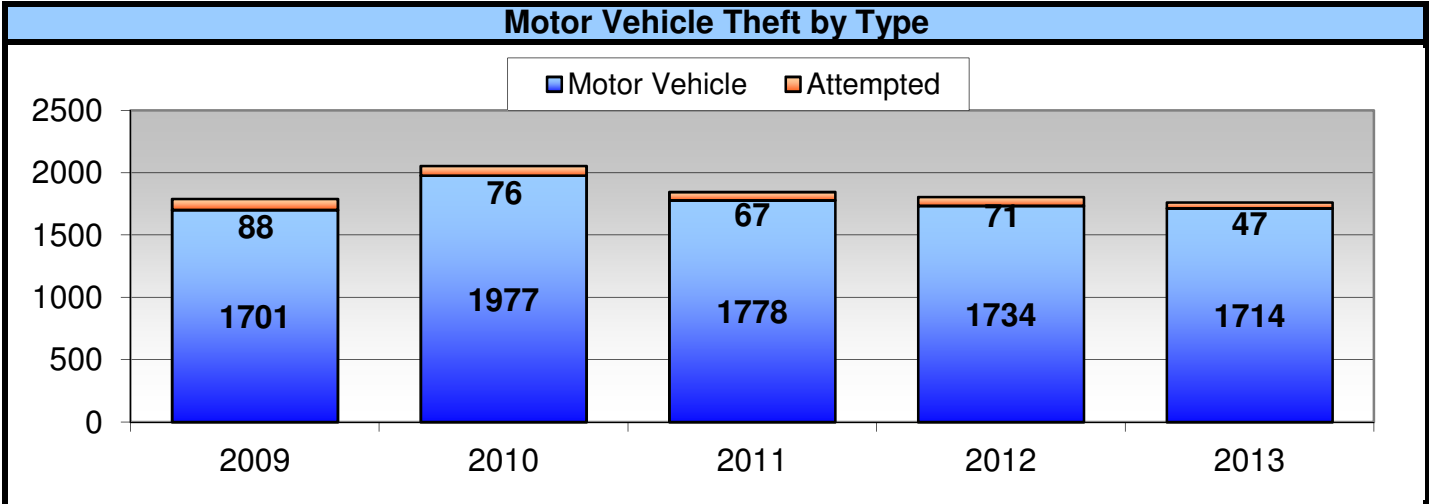

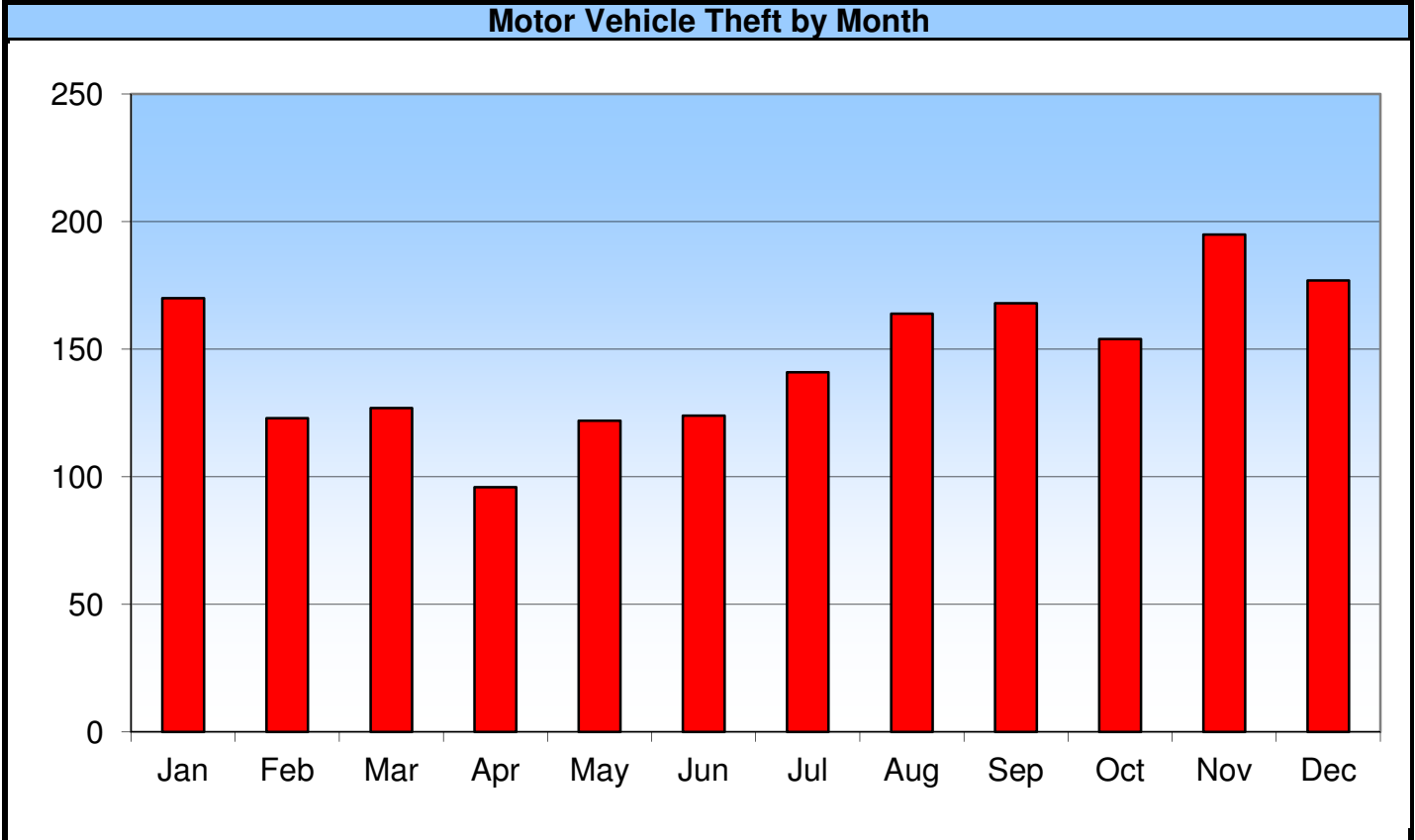

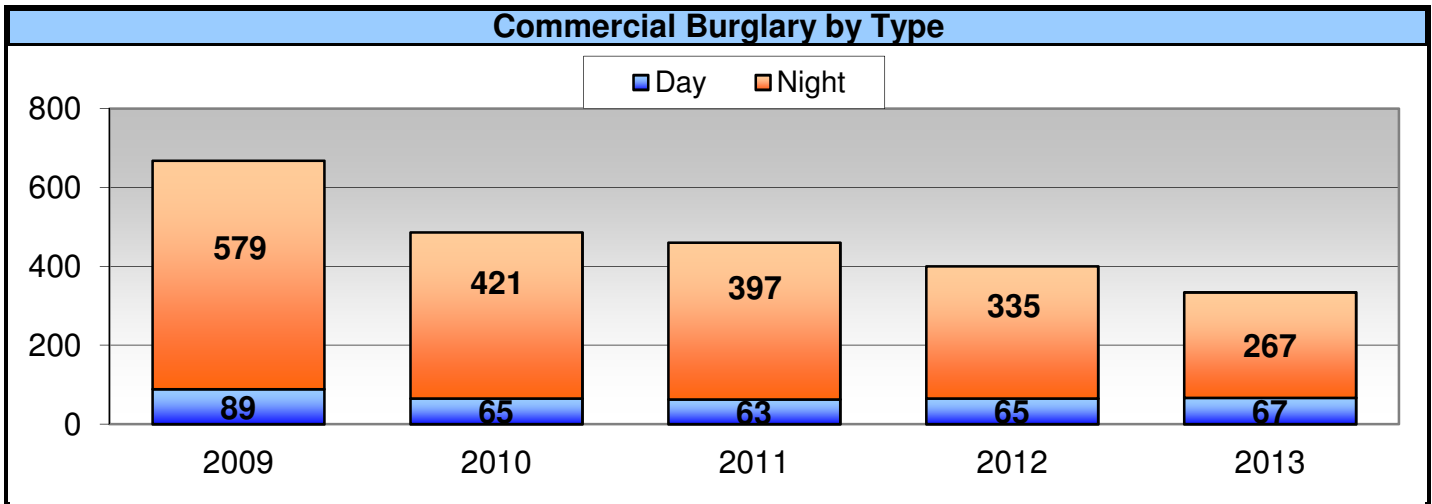

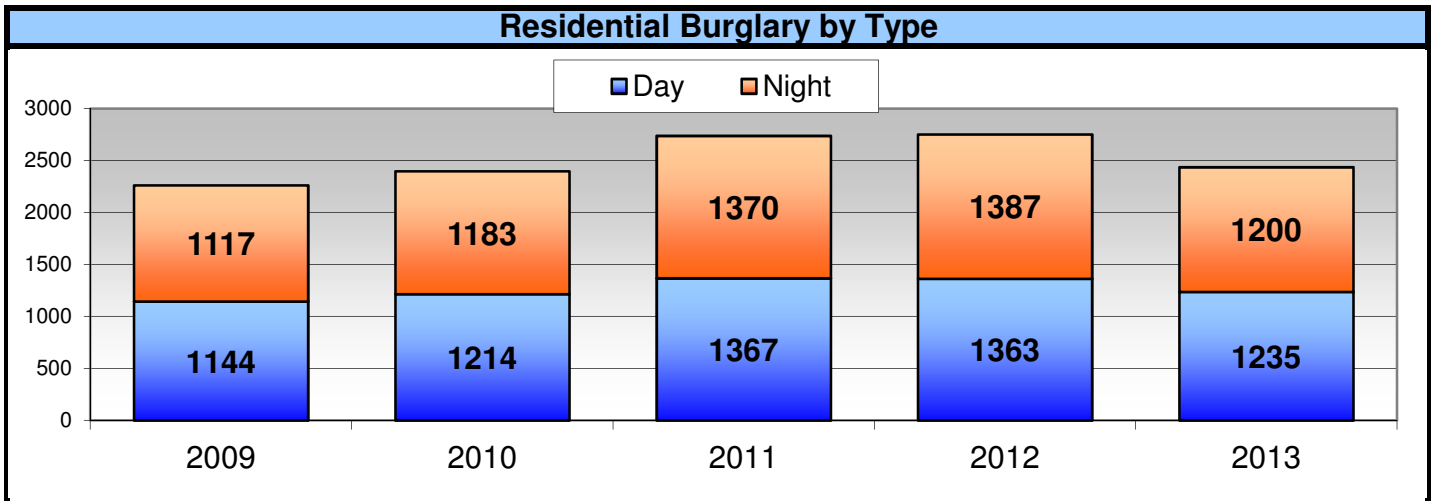

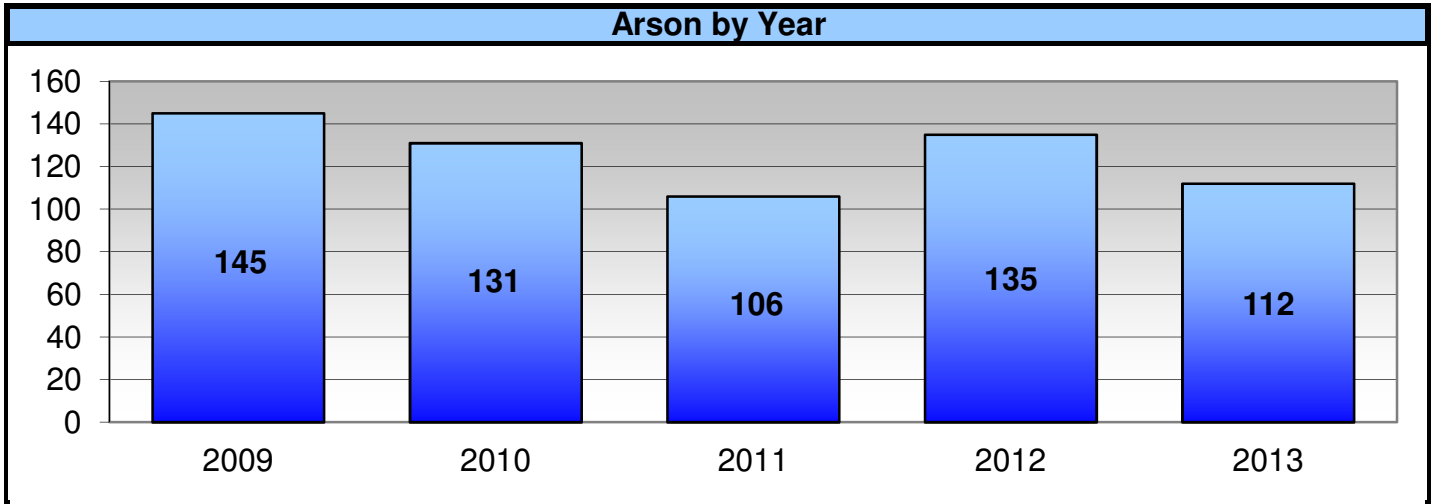

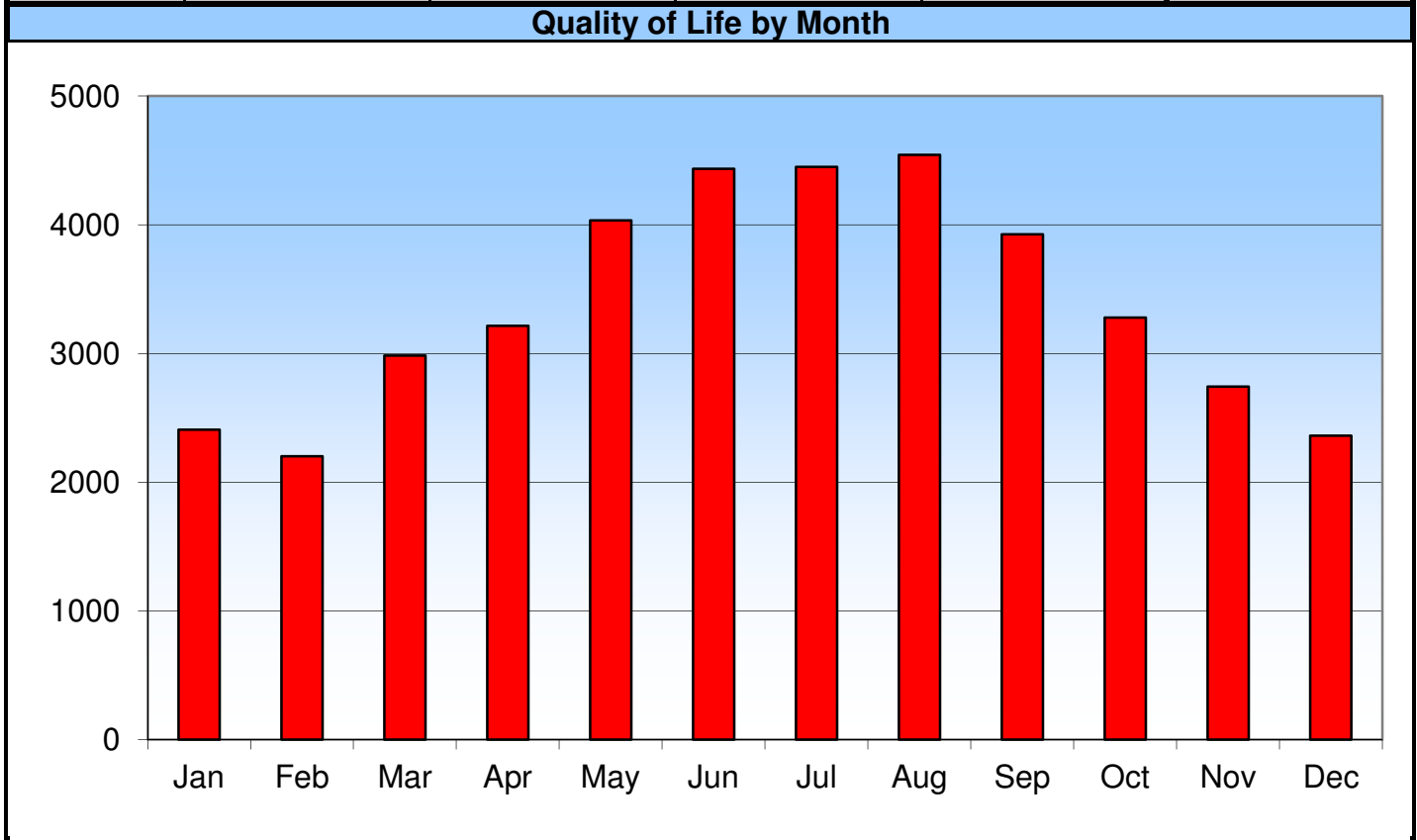

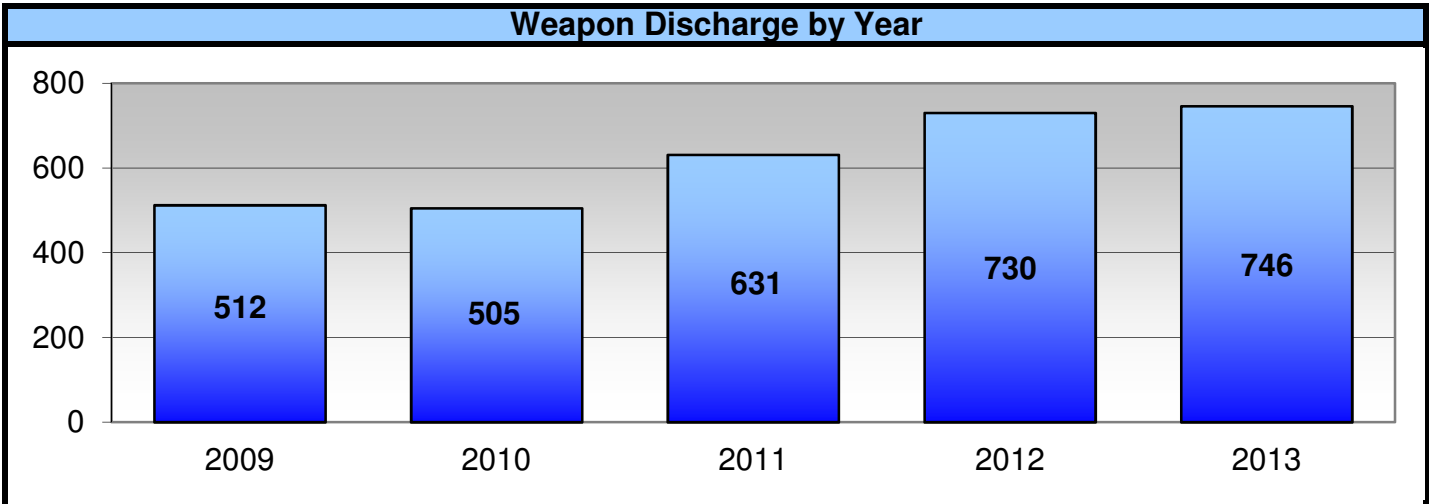

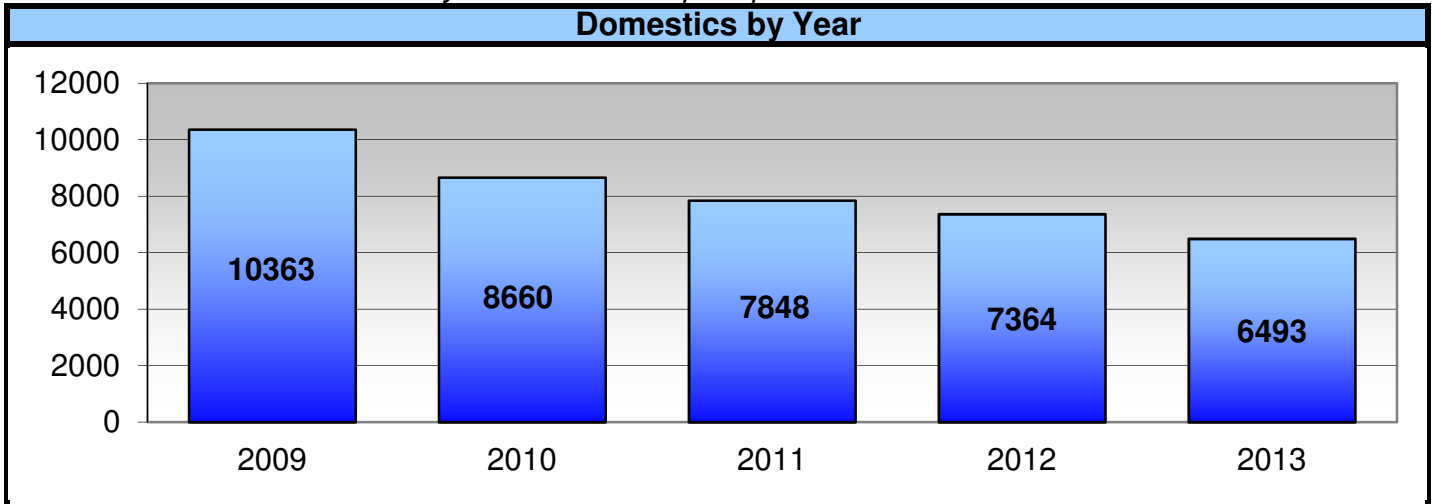

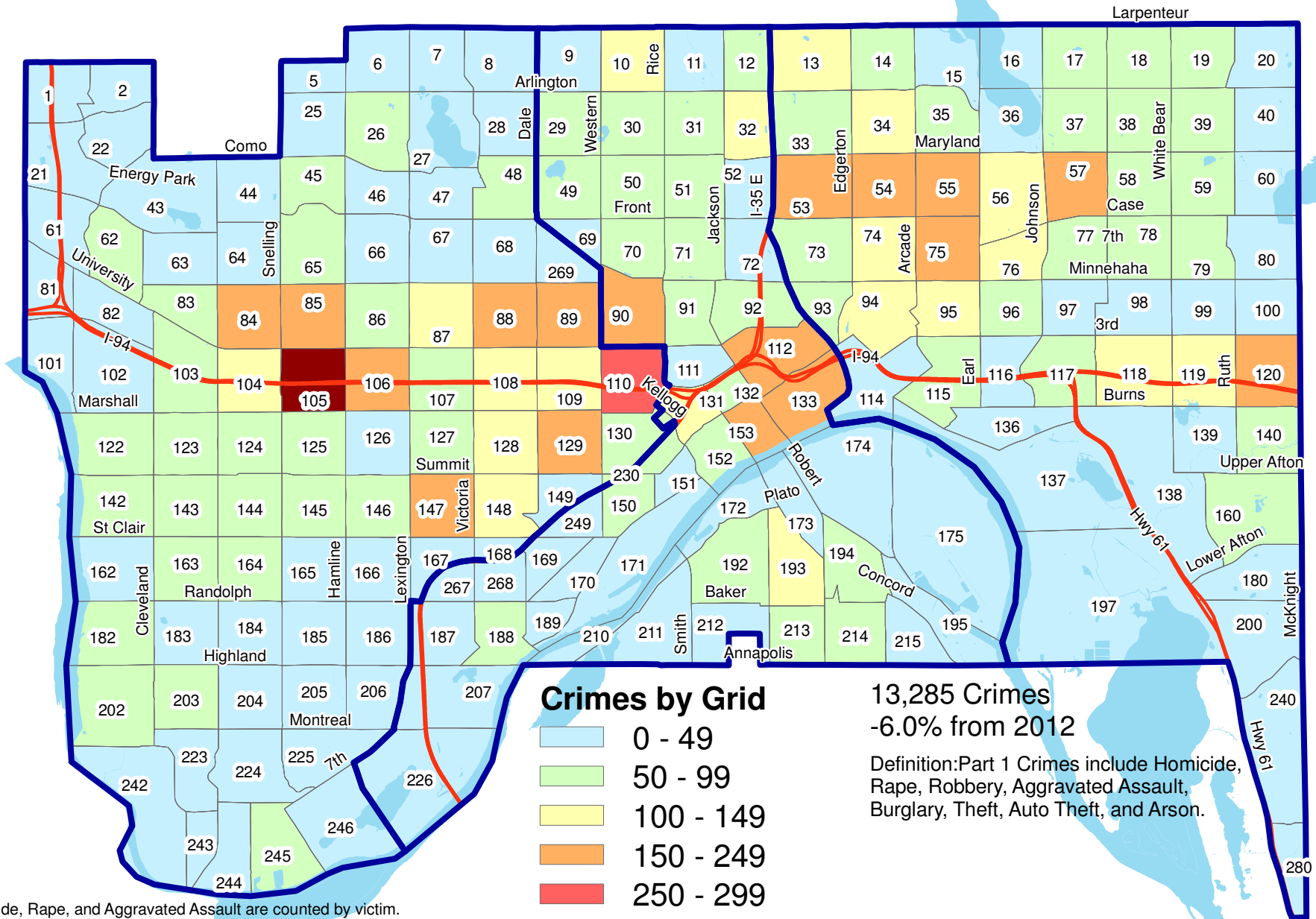
Saint Paul Police Grid and Planning District Boundaries

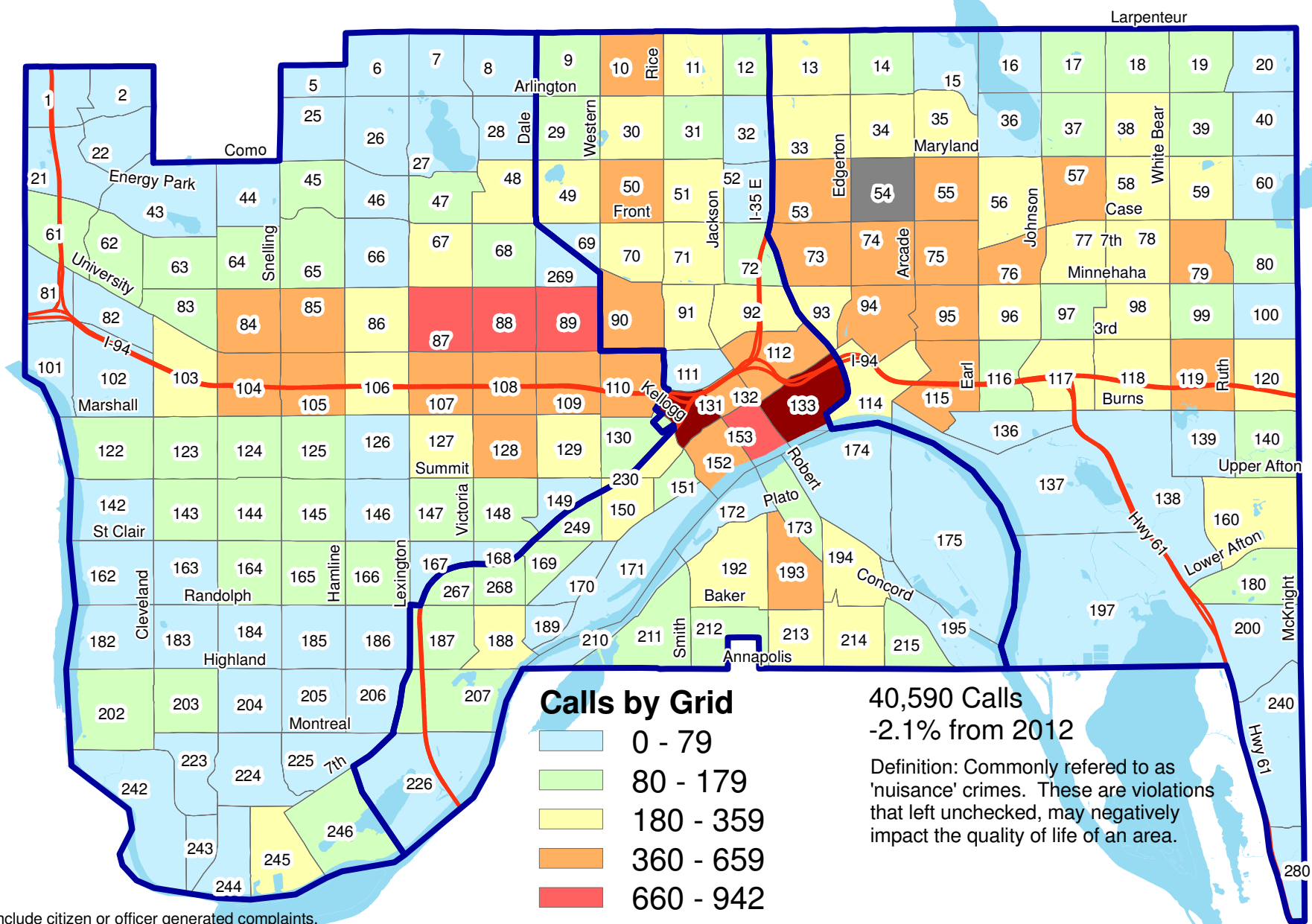

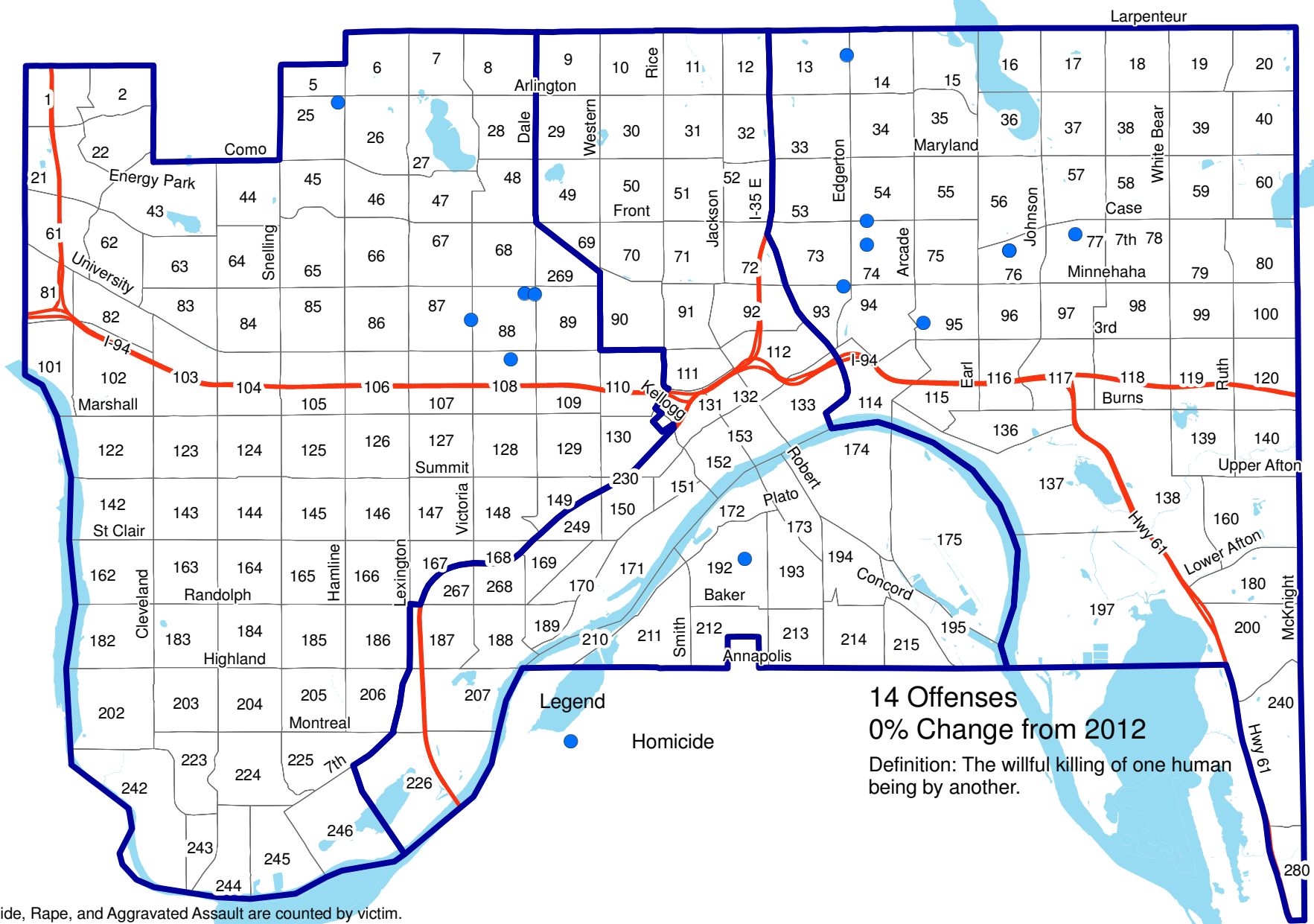

City of Saint Paul: Homicide Offenses: 2013

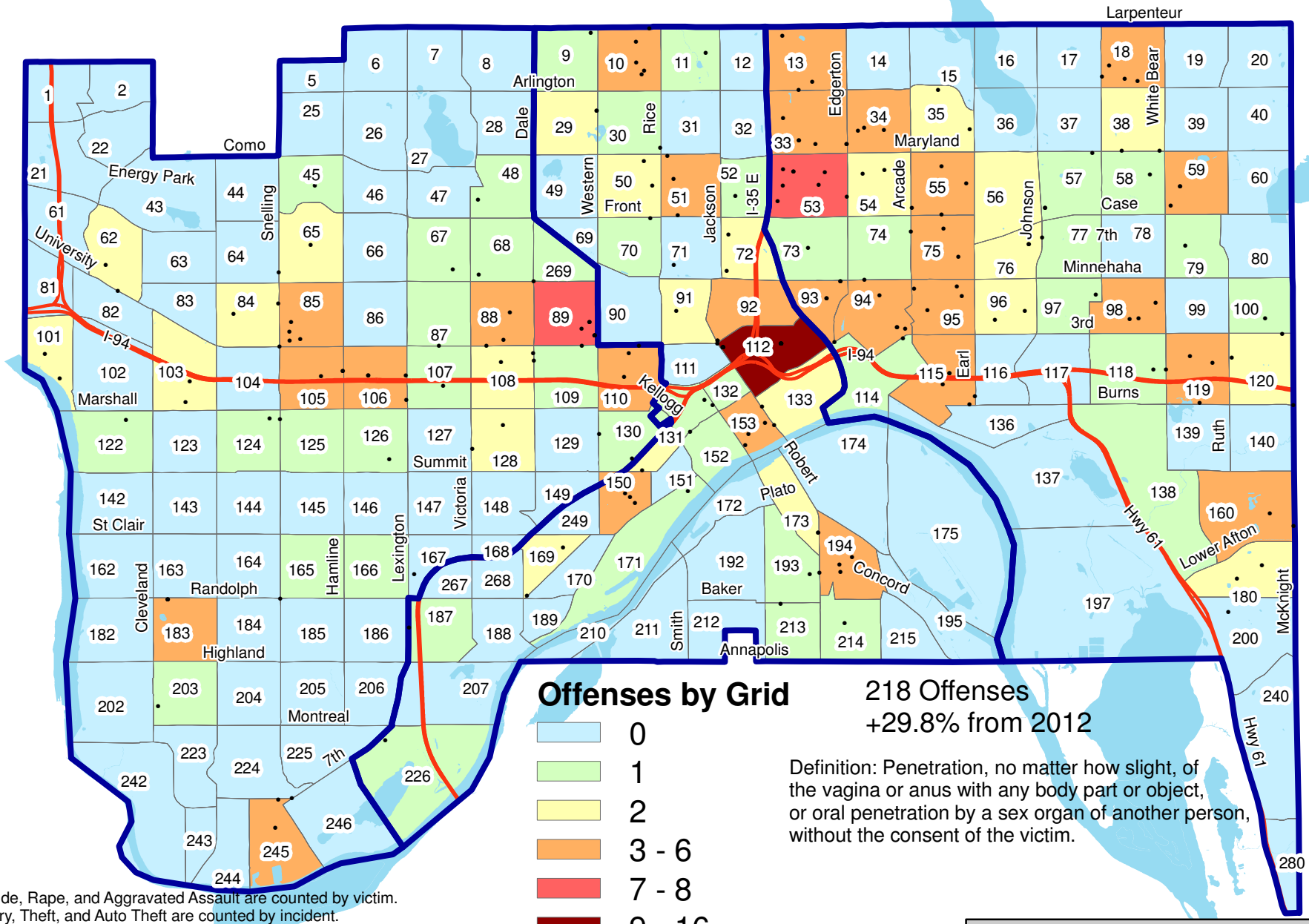

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City of Saint Paul: Rape Offenses: 2013



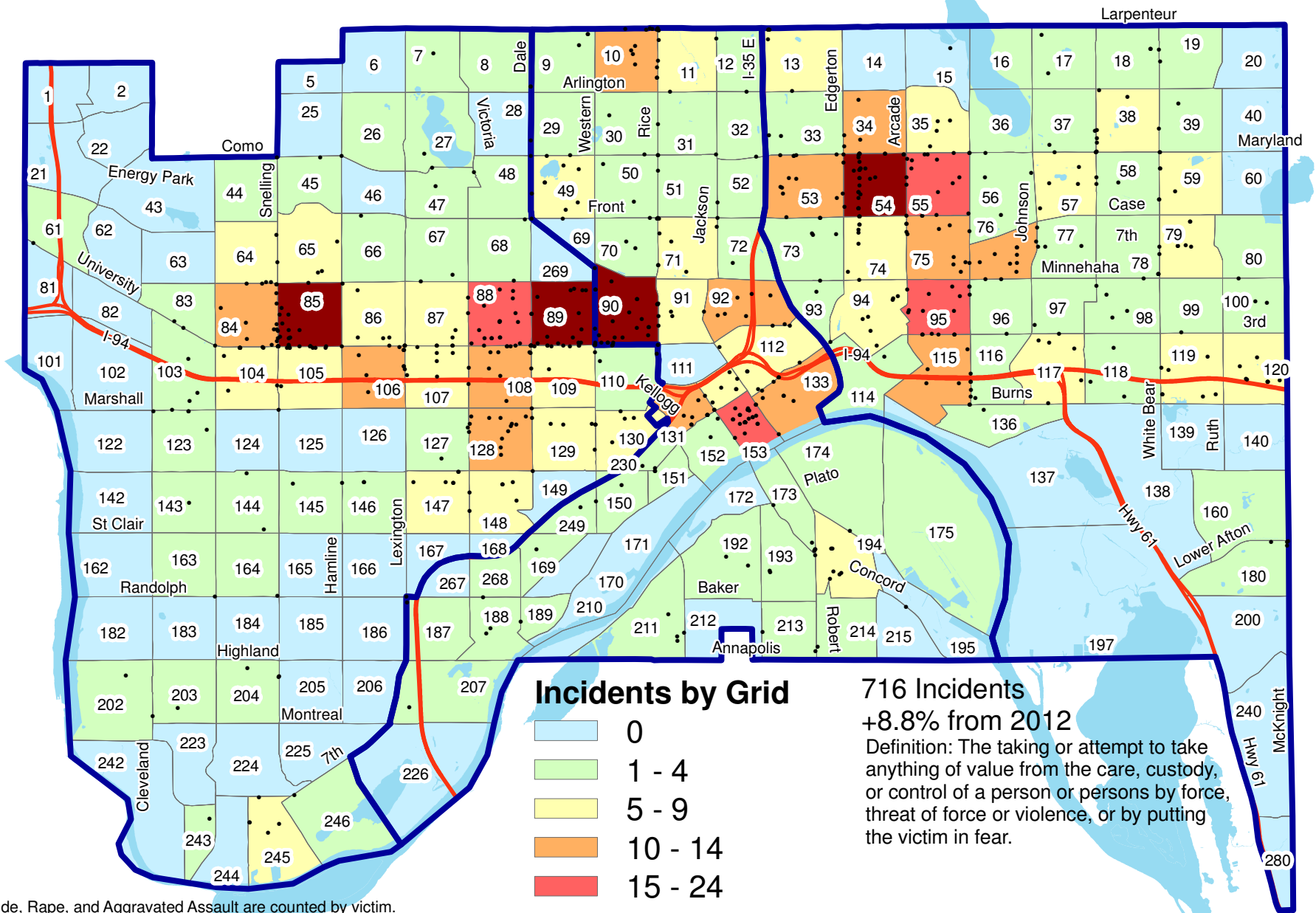

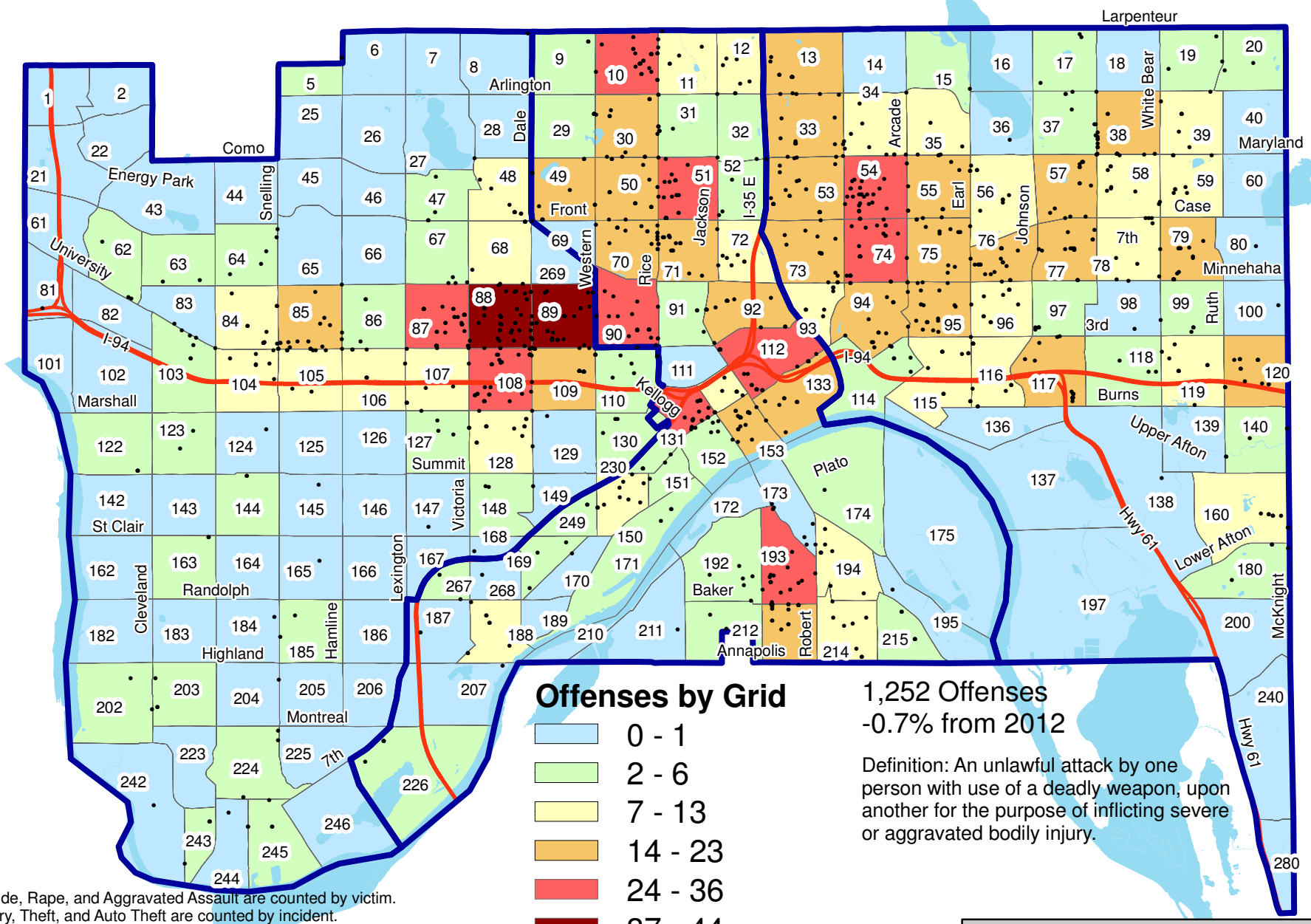

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City of Saint Paul: Aggravated Assault Offenses: 2013



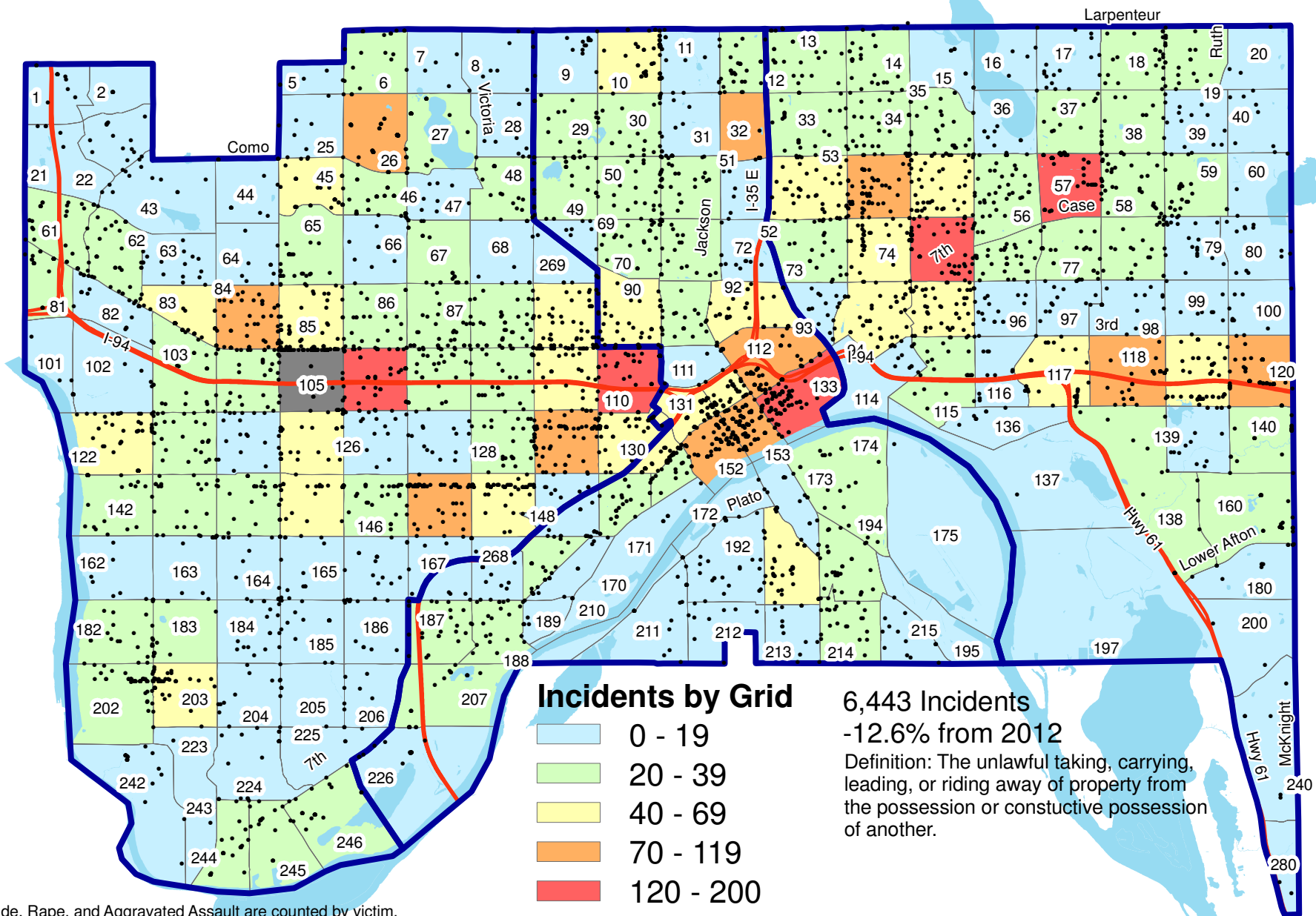

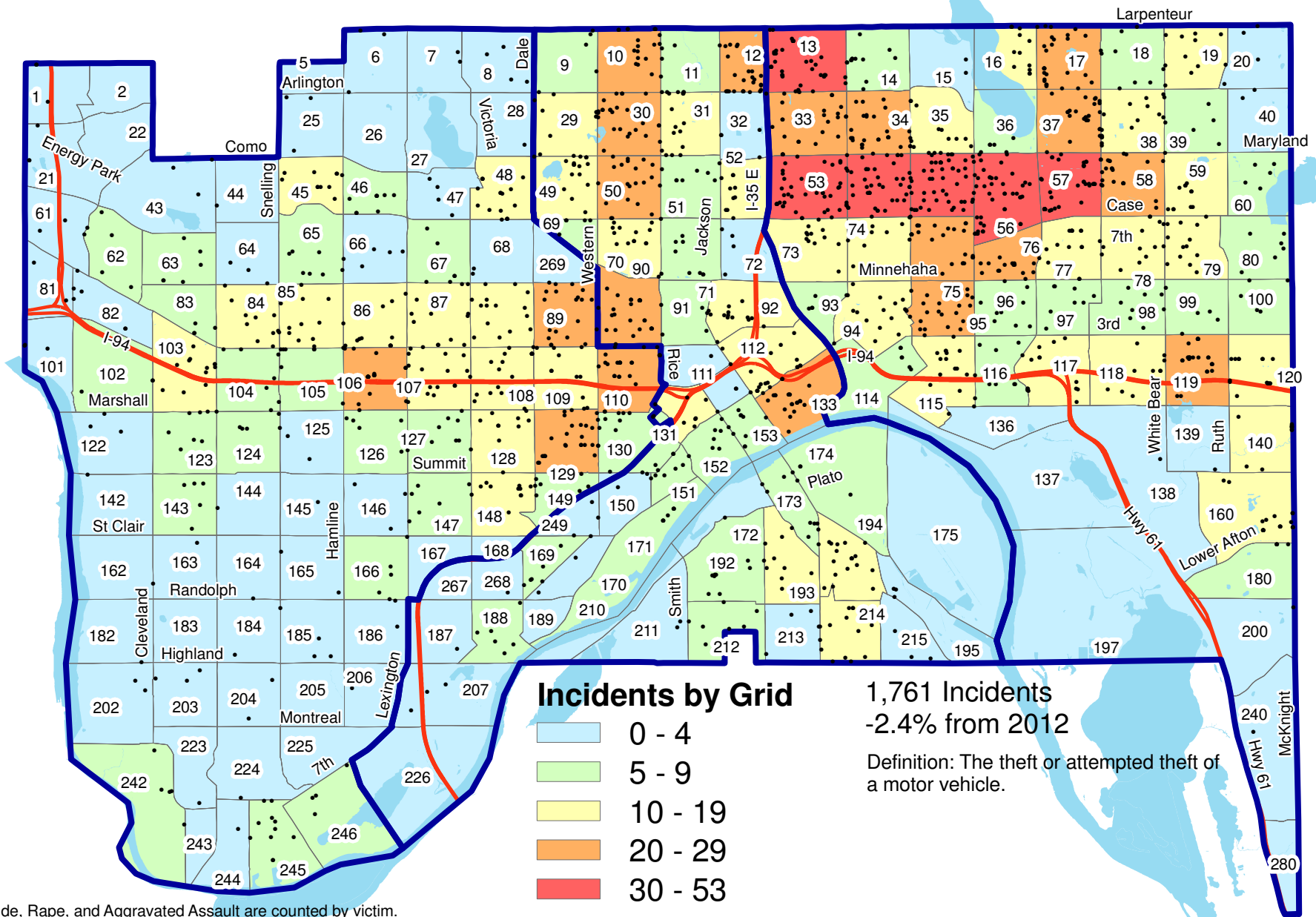

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City of Saint Paul: Motor Vehicle Theft Incidents: 2013

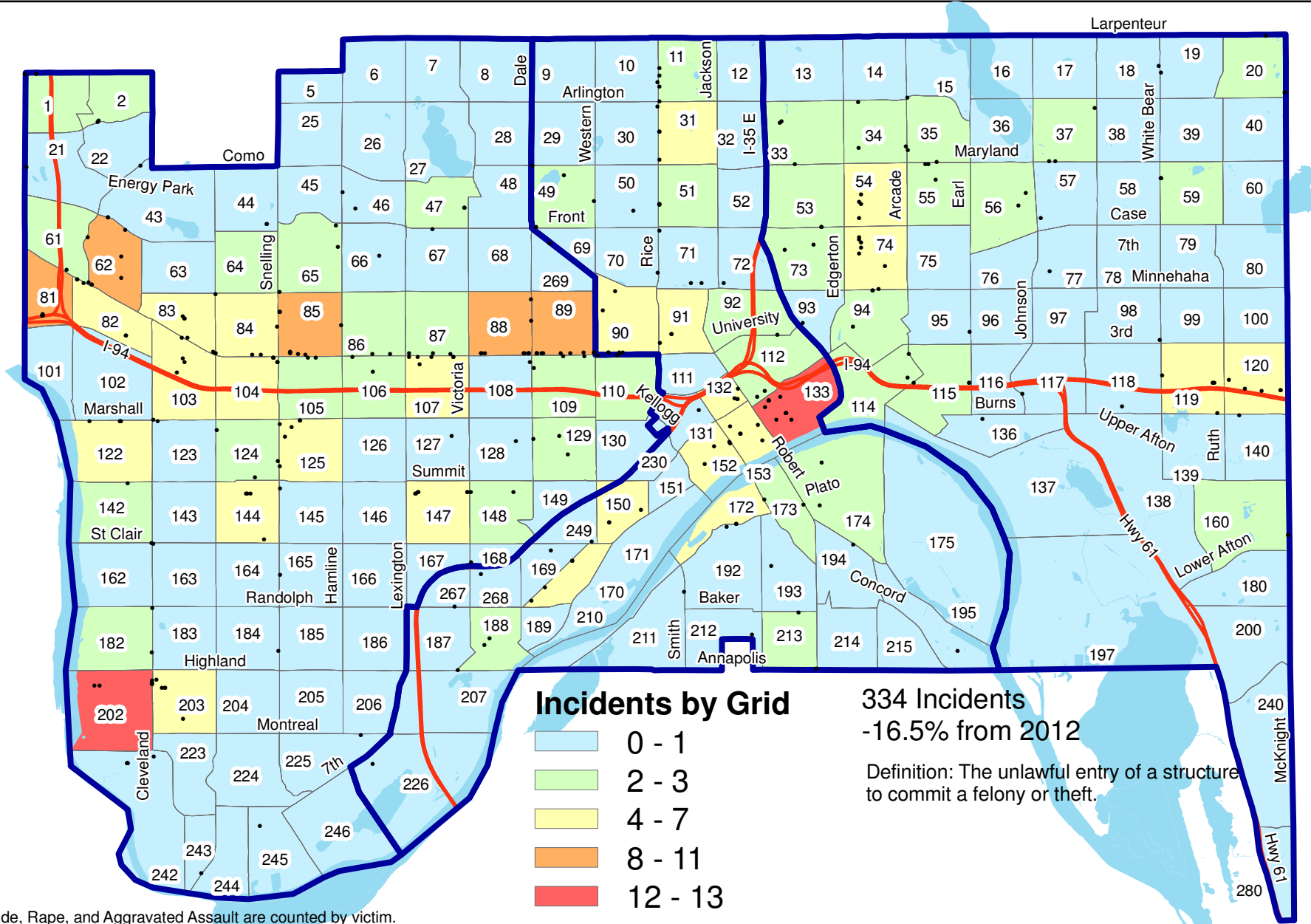

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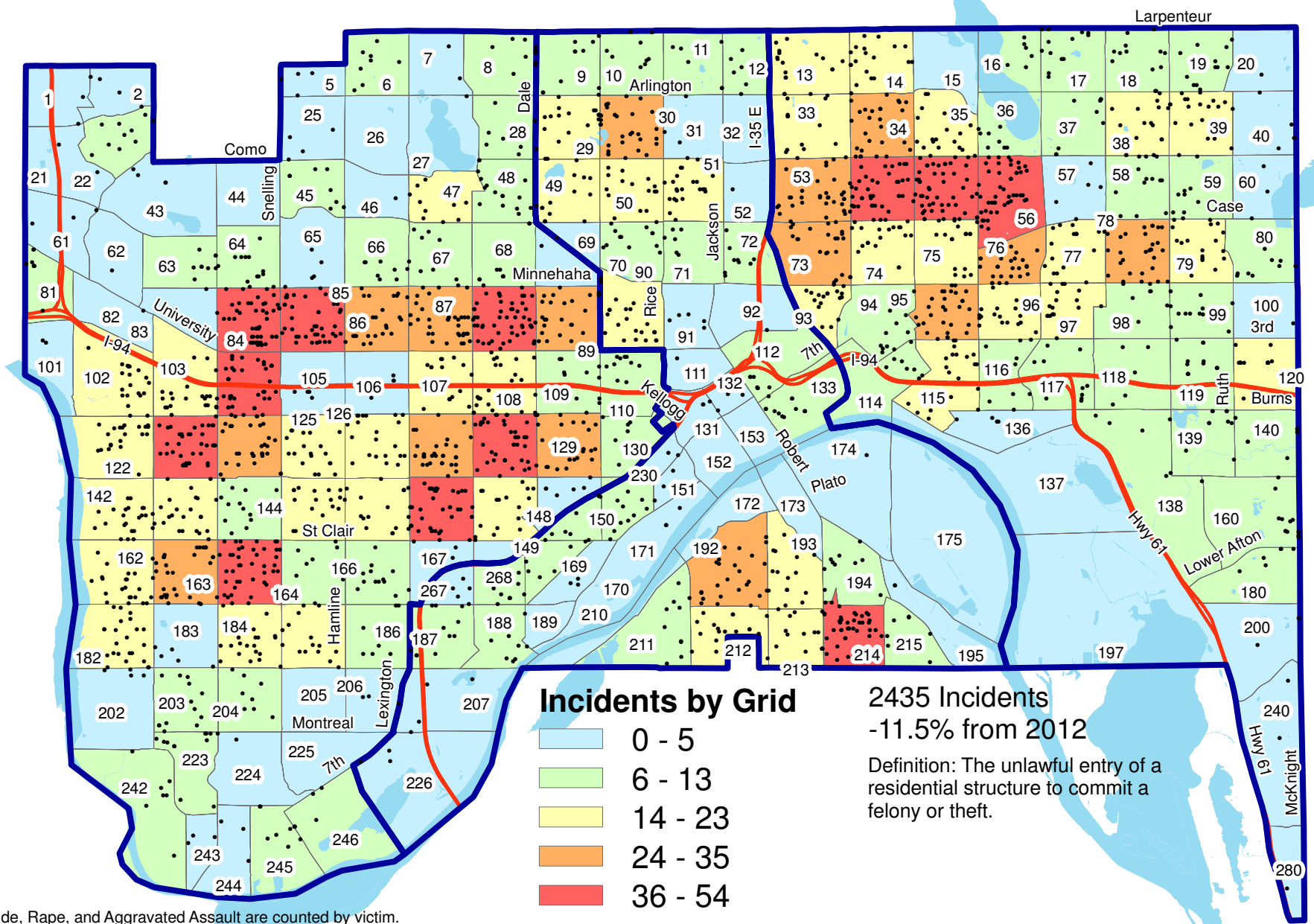


City of Saint Paul: Commercial Burglary Incidents: 2013

City of Saint Paul: Residential Burglary Incidents: 2013

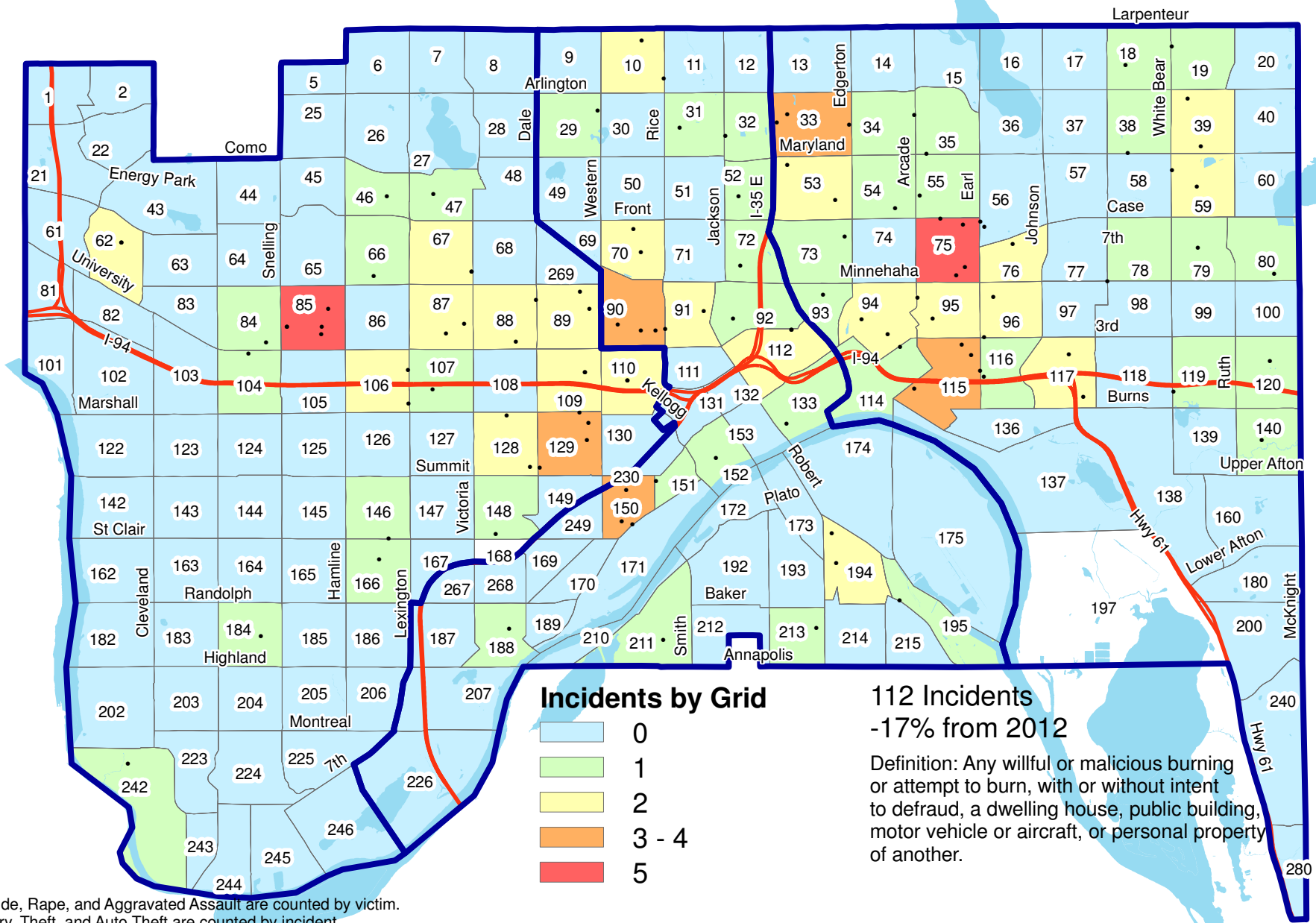

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City of Saint Paul: Arson Incidents: 2013



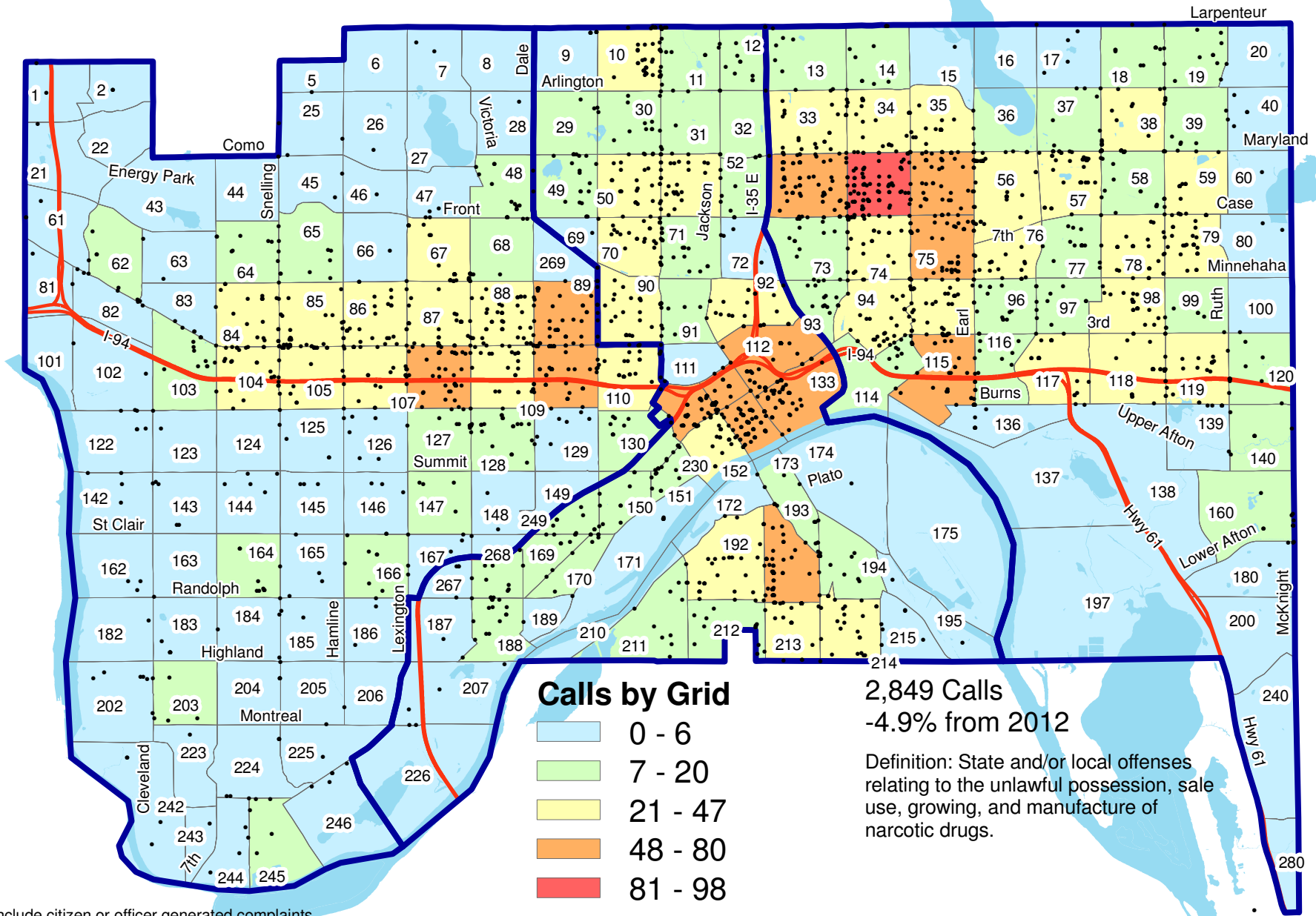

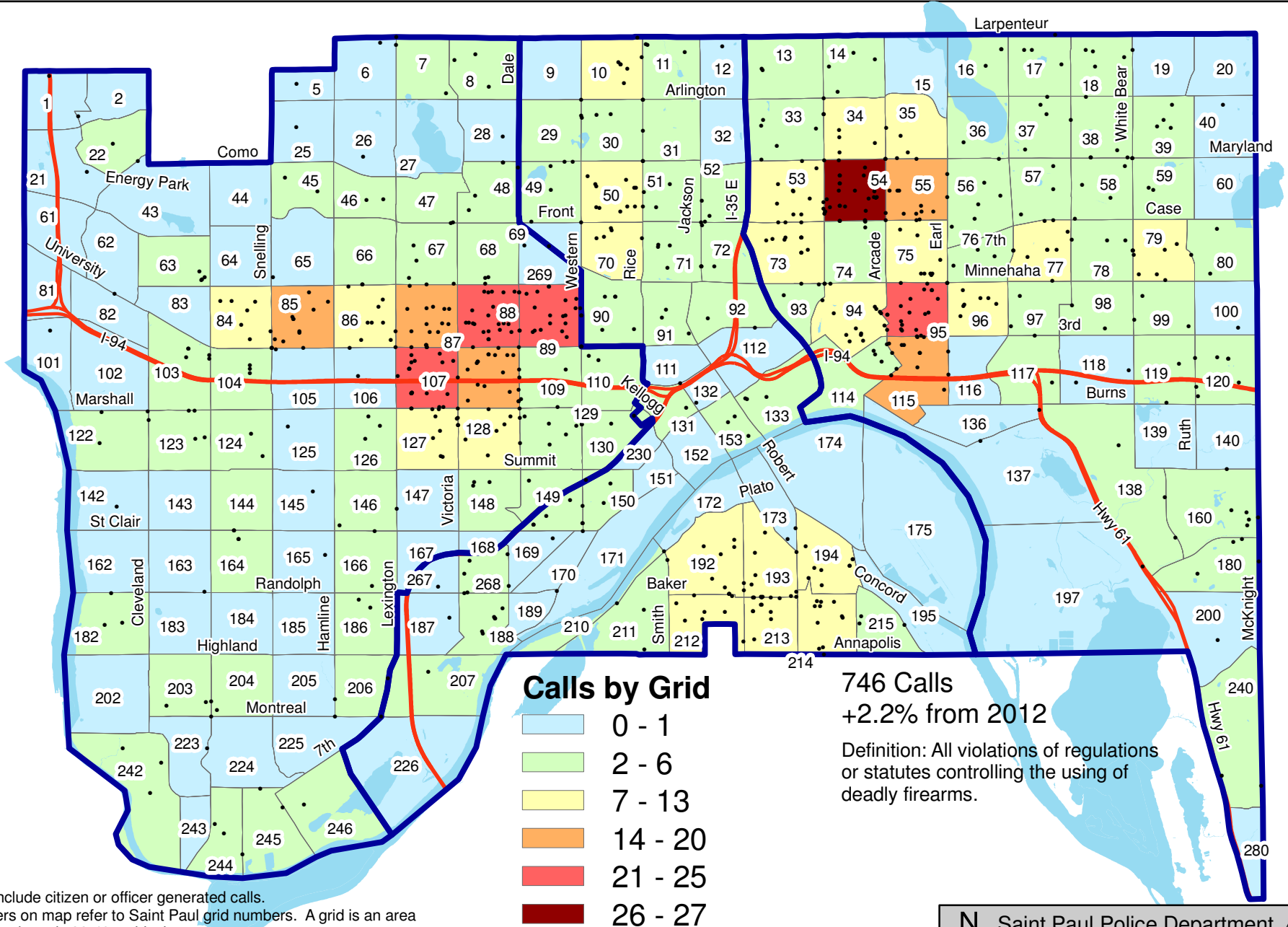

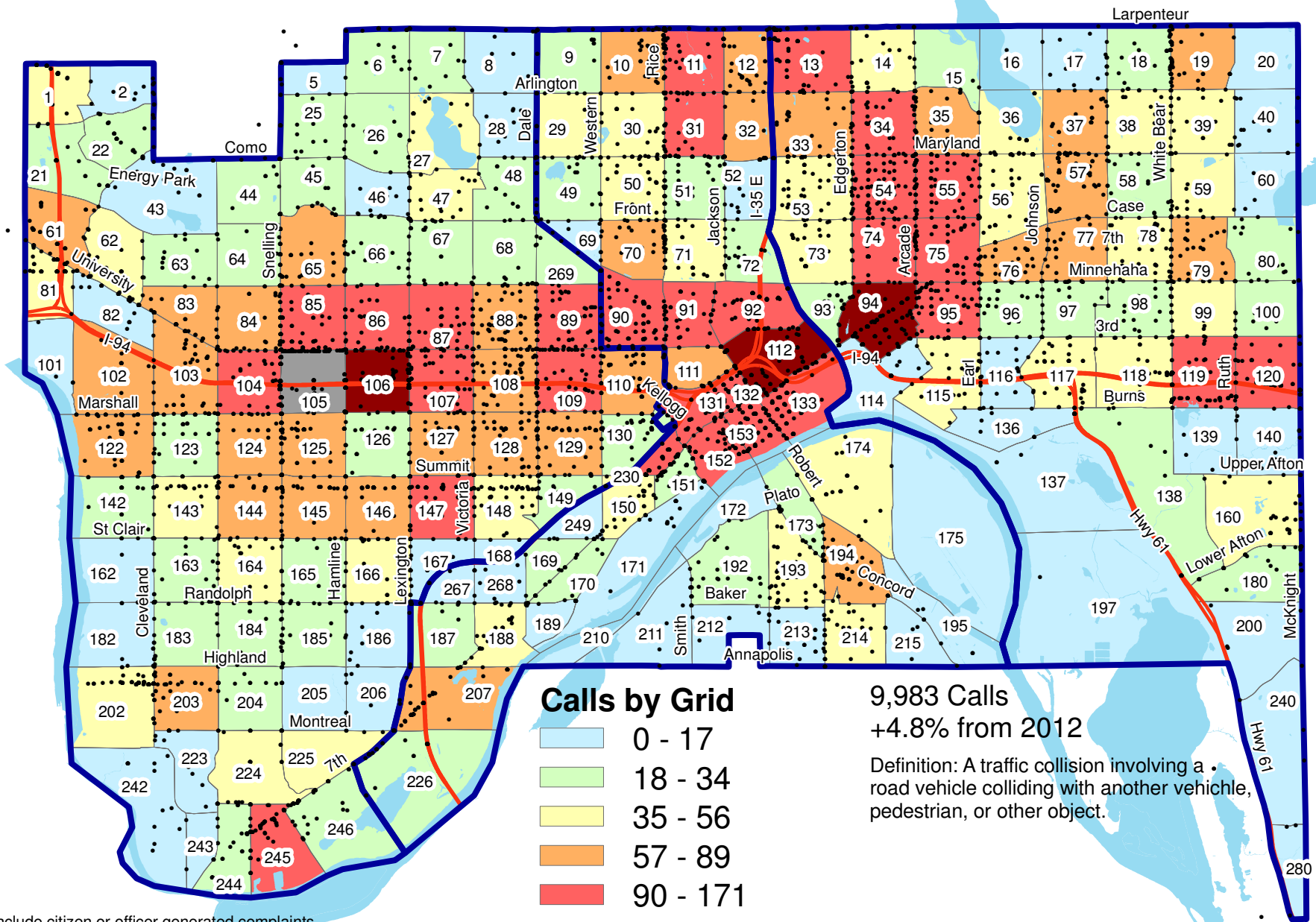

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City of Saint Paul: Traffic Accident Calls: 2013



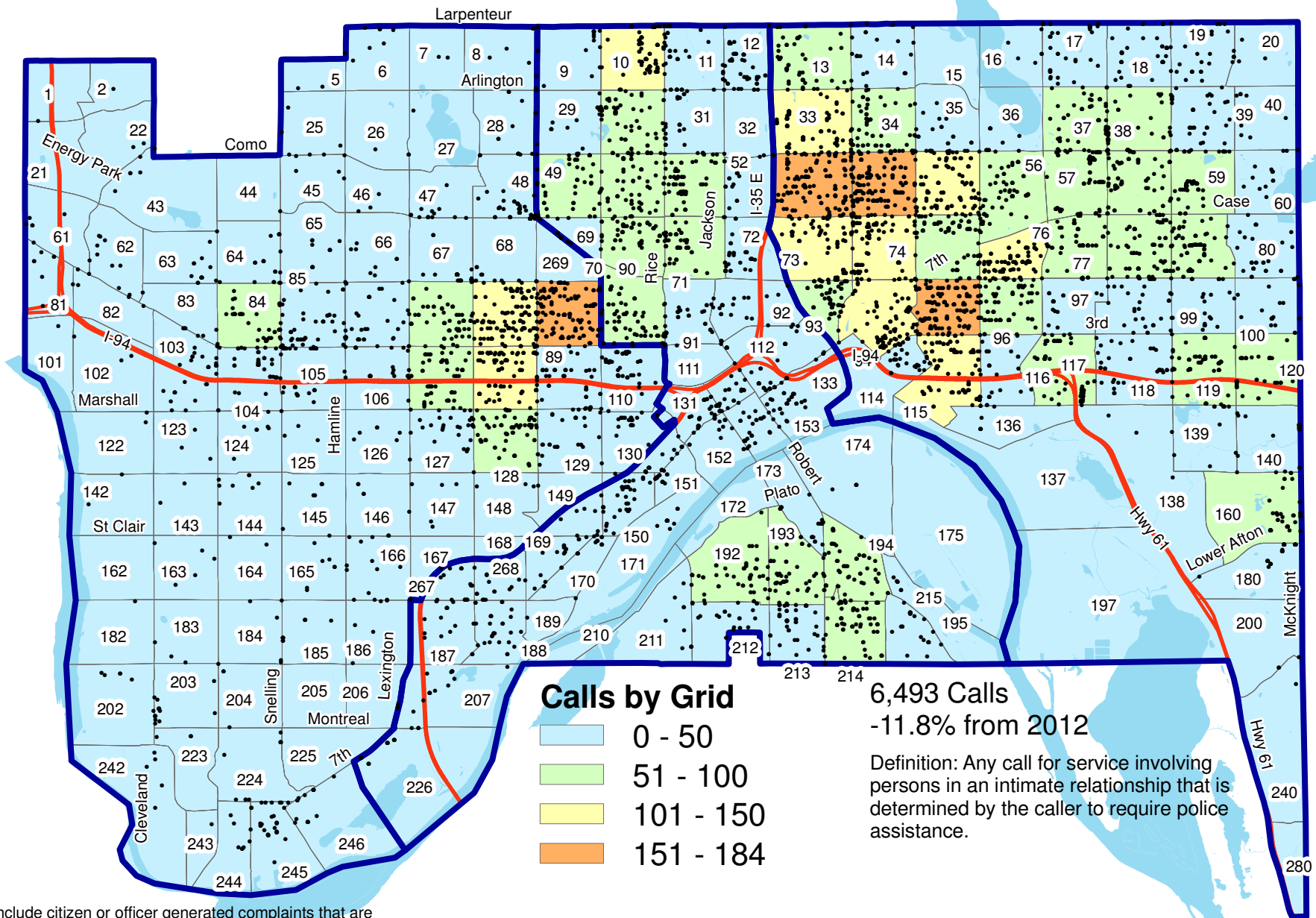

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City of Saint Paul: Domestic Calls: 2013

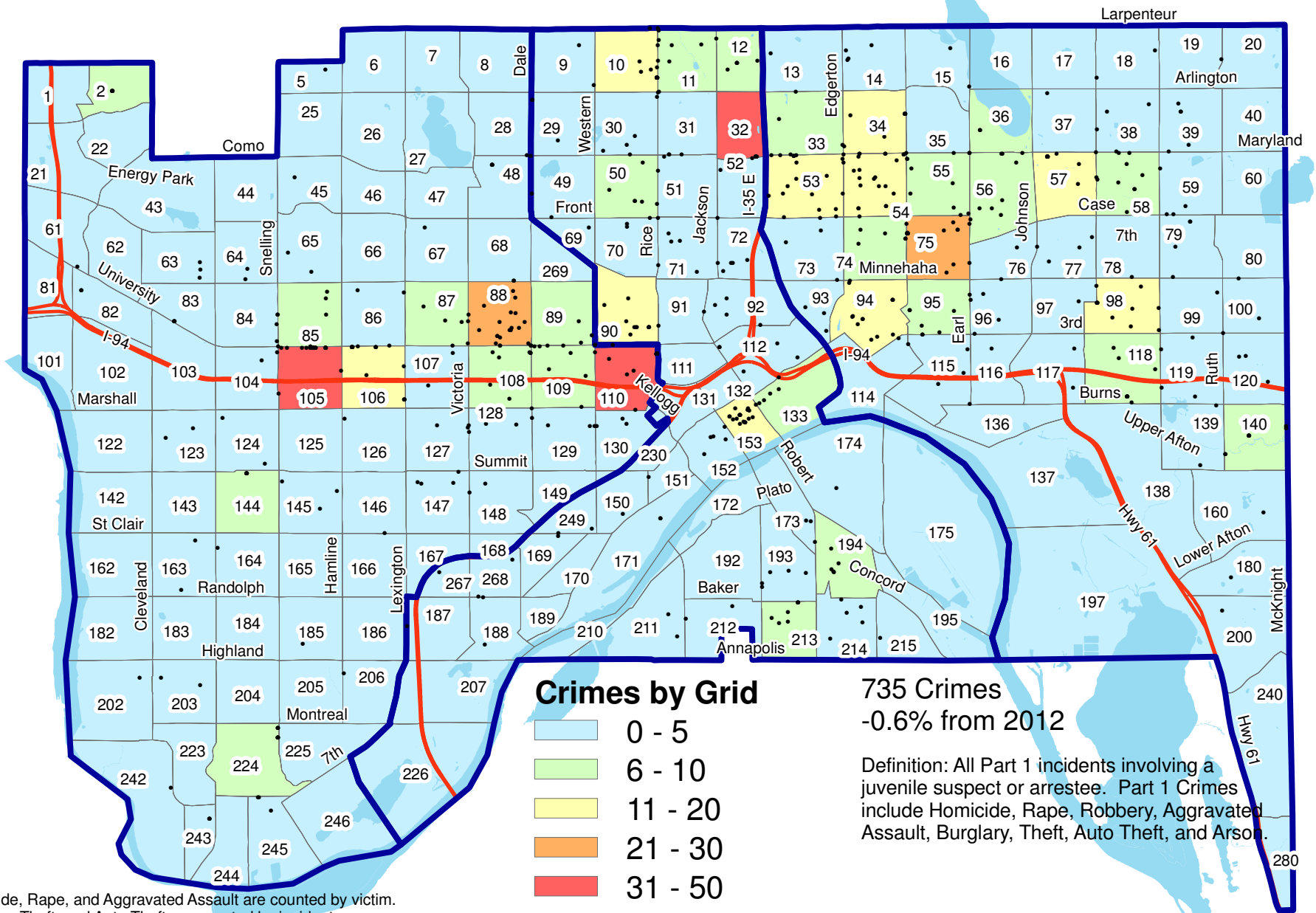
