

Project Update

Reduced Lanes on Como Avenue between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue

Como Avenue continues to be reduced to one lane in each direction between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue with ongoing work in the south half of the roadway. Construction on Como Avenue will continue through October 2020.

Crews will be performing the following work in this area over the next week:

- Complete storm sewer installation at Gibbs Avenue
- Complete pavement patching between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue
- Complete sidewalk installation at intersections and backfill curbs
- Begin street light installation

Como Avenue Closed between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue



Vehicle detour for Como Avenue using Midway Parkway

Project work on Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue continues, and the roadway will remain closed to through traffic through October 2020. Local resident access is being maintained from Pascal Street and Albert Street (see map).

Crews will be performing the following work in this area over the next week:

- Complete pavement removal on the north side of Como Avenue, including removal of streetcar tracks
- Begin pavement removal on the south half of Como Avenue
- Begin sanitary sewer and water service replacements, starting at Arona Avenue and working east




COMO AVENUE TRAIL

Bicycle Detour between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue

To bypass the Como Avenue closure, bicyclists should follow the detour using Albany Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue. Bicyclists and drivers will continue to share the road on Como Avenue between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue.




Bicycle detour for Como Avenue using Albany Avenue

Update on Temporary Garbage and Recycling Collection

For residents with direct driveway access to Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue, we have added a second collection area for garbage and recycling collection. Please make the following adjustments to allow for weekly garbage and recycling collection during construction:

- Label your garbage and recycling bin on the front and/or cover with your address.
- Place garbage and recycling containers either along the west side of Pascal Street at Como
 Avenue OR along the west side of Hamline Avenue at Como Avenue (north of the bus stop) by
 7 a.m on collection day with the opening facing outward/toward the street.
- Pick-up containers at the end of the collection day.
