Project Update

Como Avenue between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue

Como Avenue continues to be reduced to one lane in each direction between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue with ongoing work in the south half of the roadway.

Crews will be performing the following work in this area over the next week:

- Complete curb, sidewalk, and pavement installation at Gibbs Avenue
- Complete pavement patching along new curb sections
- Continue street light conduit and foundation installation
- Seed and mulch around curb, sidewalk, and light foundation areas

No Parking on Como Avenue between Snelling Avenue and Arona Street

To allow for upcoming work, there will be no parking on Como Avenue between Snelling Avenue and Arona Street starting on Friday, August 14 through October 2020. Business driveway and parking lot access in the area will be maintained and parking will be allowed on side streets.

Como Avenue Closed between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue

Work on Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue continues, and the roadway remains closed through October 2020. Drivers in the area should follow the detour using Midway Parkway and bicyclists should follow the detour

using Albany Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue. Local resident access is maintained from Pascal Street and Albert Street.

Crews will be performing the following work in this area over the next week:

- Continue sanitary sewer and water main service replacements (see more information on page 2)
- Begin sanitary sewer manhole rehabilitation and lining

Sanitary Sewer and Water Main Service Work East of Arona Street


Crews continue sanitary sewer and water main service replacements on Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue.

- Crews can complete up to five-services each day. Work is anticipated to progress to the area between Pascal Street and Albert Street by the end of this week.
- Work on water service installation may require short-term water service interruption within the block where work is occurring, generally between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Any water interruption, if necessary, is anticipated to last less than one (1) hour. Saint Paul Regional Water Services staff are providing advance notice via flyers for anticipated water service work.
- Residents with sewer service replacement are requested to not flush toilets or utilize washing machine or dishwashers during the service line replacement. Construction staff will notify impacted residents prior to starting sewer service replacement work.

Reminder on Temporary Garbage and Recycling Collection

Reminder to residents with direct driveway access to Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue to please make the following adjustments to allow for weekly garbage and recycling collection during construction:

- Clearly label your garbage and recycling bin on the front and/or cover with your address
- Place garbage and recycling containers either along the west side of Pascal Street at Como Avenue OR along the west side of Hamline Avenue at Como Avenue (north of the bus stop) by 7:00 a.m. on collection day, with the opening facing outward/toward the street
- Pick-up containers at the end of the collection day
