Project Update

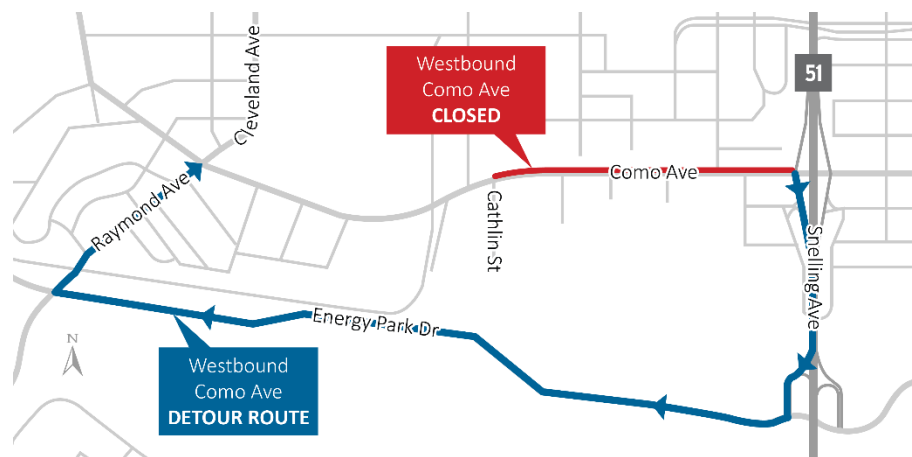

Como Avenue between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue

Como Avenue continues to be reduced to one lane in each direction in this area. Work on the south half of the road will be complete this week and traffic will shift to the south half of the roadway starting on Friday, August 14. Como Avenue will be closed to westbound traffic between Cathlin Street and Snelling Avenue, beginning on Wednesday, August 19. Traffic will be detoured to Energy Park Drive via Snelling Avenue and Raymond Avenue.

Crews will be performing the following work in this area over the next week:

- Complete pavement patching and curb/boulevard restoration along new curb sections
- Begin curb and sidewalk removals on the north side of Como Avenue.



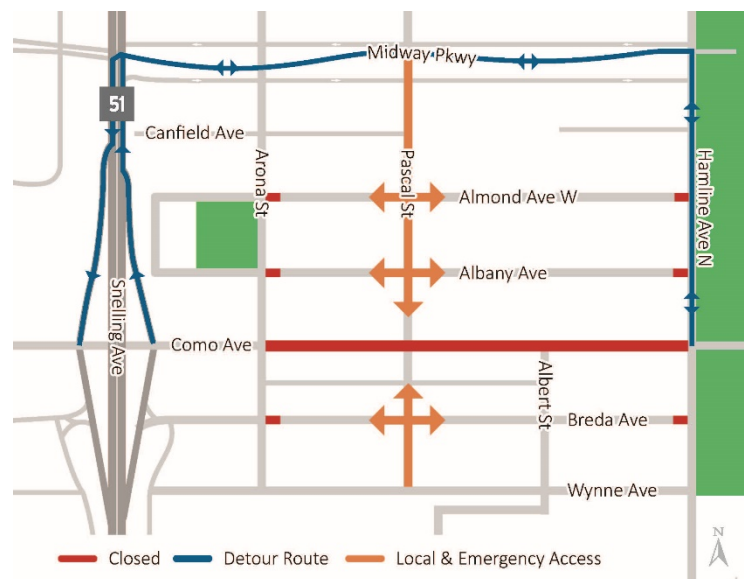
Westbound vehicle detour from Como Avenue using Energy Park Dr

Como Avenue between Snelling Avenue and Arona Street

No parking in this area continues and traffic will shift to the south half of the roadway starting on Friday, August 14. Crews will begin work on the north half of the roadway, including pavement, curb, and boulevard removals. The sidewalk on the north side of Como Avenue will remain in place to provide access to businesses.

Como Avenue Closed between Arona Street and Hamline Ave.

Work on Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue continues, and the roadway will remain closed through October 2020. Additionally, Almond Avenue, Albany Avenue, and Breda Avenue have been closed between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue to prevent cut-through traffic. Local resident access is being maintained from Pascal Street and Albert Street (see detour map on page 2).

Crews will be performing the following work in this area over the next week:

- Complete removal of pavement and streetcar tracks on the south half of Como Avenue.
- Continue sanitary sewer and watermain service replacements (see more information below)
- Continue sanitary sewer manhole lining and repairs.

Sanitary Sewer and Watermain Work East of Arona Street

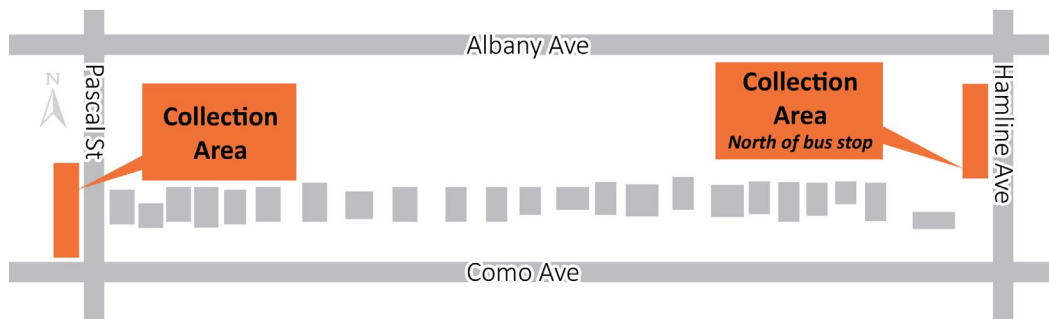
Crews continue sanitary sewer and watermain service replacements on the north side of Como Avenue between Pascal Street and Hamline Avenue.

- Crews complete up to five services each day and work is anticipated to progress to the area east of Albert Street by the end of the week.
- Work on water service installation may require short-term water service interruption within the block where work is occurring, generally between 8 AM and 5 PM. Any water interruption, if necessary, is anticipated to last less than one (1) hour. St. Paul Regional Water Service staff are providing advance notice via flyers for anticipated water service work.

Reminder on Temporary Garbage and Recycling Collection

Reminder to residents with driveways on Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue should make following adjustments to allow for weekly garbage and recycling collection:

- Label your garbage and recycling bin on the front and/or cover with your address.
- Place garbage and recycling containers either along the west side of Pascal Street at Como Avenue OR along the west side of Hamline Avenue at Como Avenue (north of the bus stop) by 7 a.m. on collection day with the opening facing outward/toward the street.
- Pick-up containers at the end of the collection day.
